Notes to Financial Statements

Years Ended December 31, 2009 and 2008

1. Description of Plan and Major Plan Provisions

Effective January 1, 1994, SIGMA International, LLC (Plan Sponsor) established a 401(k) savings retirement plan for its employees. The Plan is a defined contribution plan intended to conform to the requirements of ERISA and subsequent legislation when applicable.

The Plan sponsor amended and restated the Plan effective January 1, 2002 in the form of the prototype cash or deferred profit sharing plan and trust sponsored by Nationwide Life Insurance Company. A further update was made on March 28, 2005 for legislative changes implemented by GUST and EGTRRA.

Subsequent to year end (June 1, 2010), the Plan Sponsor switched the Plan to a 401(k) Profit Sharing Plan and Trust sponsored and managed by John Hancock Life Insurance Company (USA). This new Plan arrangement has been updated and amended for all required mandates of the Federal Tax Code. The Plan also includes a Roth 401(k) contribution provision.

Information about the Plan agreement and the vesting and benefit provisions is contained in the Summary Plan Description of SIGMA International 401(k) Savings Plan. Copies of this pamphlet are available from the Plan administrator.

A summary of major Plan provisions is as follows:

Participation

All employees of SIGMA International, LLC who have attained age 21 are eligible for participation in the Plan through December 31, 2009. Effective with the Plan move to a new trust on June 1, 2010, Plan eligibility for participants was changed to age 18 and completion of six (6) months of service.

Vesting

Participant contributions are 100 percent vested upon contribution. The participant's vesting percentage in employer matching contributions is shown in the following schedule:

Contributions

Participants may elect to defer a percentage of their compensation, subject to Internal Revenue Code (IRC) limitations, including "catch up contribution" limitations. The Plan Sponsor may match a percentage of each participant's contribution.

Effective January 1, 2002, the Plan sponsor matched 25 percent of the employee's elective deferral each pay period up to 3 percent of the employee's pay period compensation. This matching formula was in place through the end of the Plan year, December 31, 2009.

Effective June 1, 2010, with the establishment of the new Plan Trust, the match was enhanced to 50% of the employee's elective deferral each pay period up to 5 percent of the employee's pay period compensation.

Plan Termination

Although it has not expressed any intent to do so, the Plan sponsor has the right to terminate the Plan subject to the provisions of ERISA. In the event of Plan termination, participants will become 100% vested in their accounts.

1. Description of Plan and Major Plan Provisions (continued)

Forfeitures

Participants who leave the Company with less than six years of service (three years of service effective June 1, 2010) forfeit the nonvested portion of the Company's discretionary and matching contribution. The amount of forfeited nonvested amounts was \$15,998 and \$2,204 at December 31, 2009 and 2008, respectively.

Allocation

Discretionary profit sharing contributions made by the Plan sponsor are allocated annually based upon each participant's compensation to total participant compensation.

There were not any discretionary profit sharing contributions made by the Plan Sponsor during the years ended covered by this report, December 31, 2009 and 2008.

Plan Expenses

Substantially all of the costs of Plan administration are paid by the Plan sponsor, SIGMA International, LLC.

Participant Loans

Effective January 31, 2002, participants may borrow from their fund accounts up to a maximum equal to the lesser of \$50,000 or 50% of their vested account balance. Loan terms range from 1-5 years. The loans are secured by the balance in the participant's account and bear interest at a rate commensurate with local prevailing rates as determined quarterly by the Plan administrator. Principal and interest is paid ratably through monthly payroll deductions.

2. Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

Basis of Accounting

The accounting records of the Plan are maintained on the accrual basis.

Investments

The Plan's assets are held by Nationwide Life Insurance Company under the Trust Agreement with the Plan dated August 2, 2002 (by John Hancock Life Insurance Company of NY as of June 1, 2010). During 2009 and 2008, all Plan investments were participant directed.

All investment information disclosed in the accompanying financial statements and schedule, including investments held at December 31, 2009 and 2008, and net appreciation (accretion) on investments for the years then ended, were obtained or derived from information supplied to the Plan administrator and certified as complete and accurate by Nationwide Life Insurance Company.

Subsequent to year end, effective June 1, 2010, the Plan's assets were moved to John Hancock Life Insurance Company (USA) and this organization will be responsible for the investment management of the Plan's assets from this effective date forward.

Use of Estimates

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with generally accepted accounting principles requires management to make estimates that affect the amounts reported in the financial statements and accompanying notes. Actual results may differ from those estimates.

3. Transactions with Parties-in-Interest

All legal and accounting services were provided at the expense of the Plan sponsor. Fees paid during the year for these and other services rendered by parties-in-interest were based on customary and reasonable rates for such services.

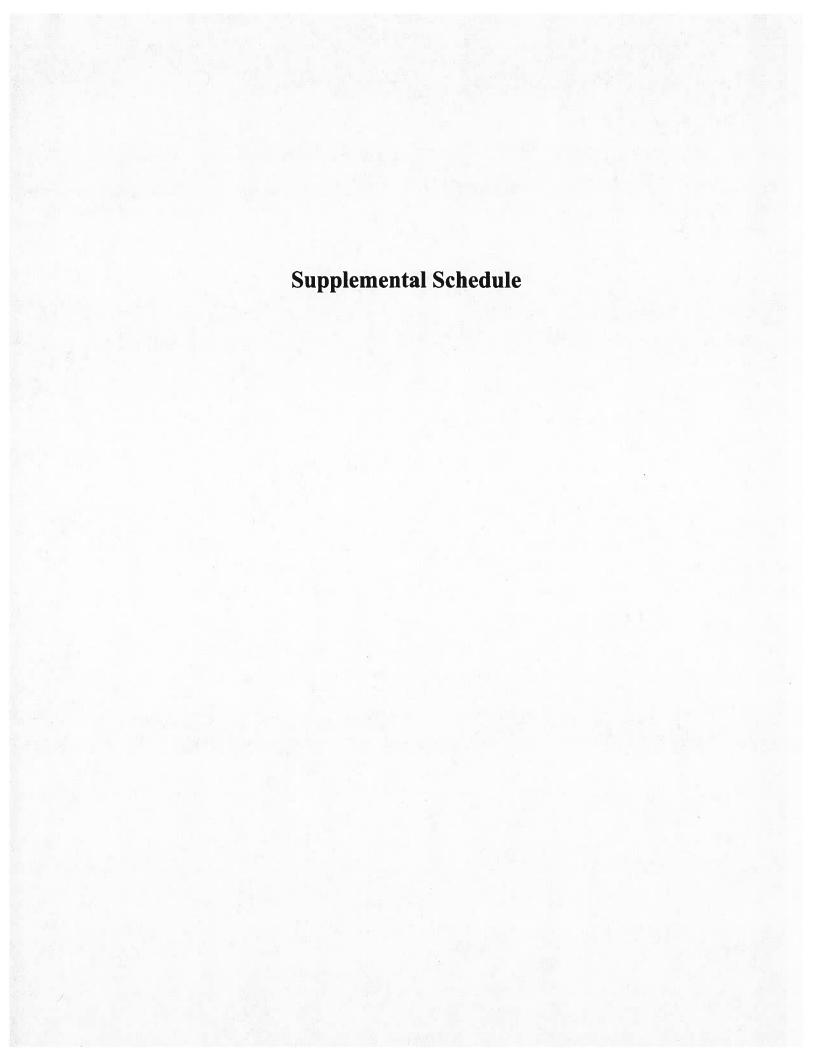

4. Income Tax Status

The Plan has received an opinion letter from the Internal Revenue Service dated August 7, 2001 stating that the written form of the underlying prototype plan document is qualified under Section 401(a) of the Internal Revenue Code (the "Code"), and that any employer adopting this form of the Plan will be considered to have a plan qualified under Section 401(a) of the Code. Therefore, the related trust is exempt from taxation. Once qualified, the Plan is required to operate in conformity with the Code to maintain its qualification. The Plan administrator believes the Plan is being operated in compliance with the applicable requirements of the Code and, therefore, believes that the Plan is qualified and the related trust is tax exempt.

5. Reportable Transactions

There were no reportable transactions (a single transaction that exceeded 5% of value) that occurred in the plan for the years ended December 31, 2009 and 2008, respectively.
