The Alliance for the Arts, a New York City-based nonprofit, has been in the process of dissolving for the past two years. Our final employees were terminated as of August, 2011, our offices were closed at the end of January 2012, and we expect to file our dissolution papers with the New York State Attorney General's office next month. All final work to complete this process has been handled by the Board of Directors with the assistance of pro bono lawyers.

It recently came to our attention that the 5500 Forms for FY2010 – FY2012 had not been filed. We are now in the process of filing those forms for all three years, and I am writing to request that we be excused from any penalties for the late filing of the 2010 Form 5500 for reasonable cause, since the organization has had no staff nor anyone knowledgeable about 403(b) filing requirements.
