To Whom it may concern,

I, Richard Mancuso, am the President of G.J. Smith Associates, Inc. I'm writing in response to a letter we received from the I.R.S. in respect of the late filing of a form 5500. First, please accept my sincere apologies for this oversight. Until I received the aforementioned notice, I was unaware the form in question had not been filed. I'll do my best to explain what I discovered upon looking into the matter.

First, we are a very small company with only three employees at present. The 401k plan in question was also a small one and in fact due to the lack of interest on the part of my employees in participating in the plan, it was closed at the end of 2011.

In short, my bookkeeper, Doreen Feldman (who left the company over two years ago) thought she had filed the return. I researched old emails between myself, my bookkeeper and our plan administrator which revealed that I had viewed the filing online but which also revealed that we were under the impression that the plan administrator actually filed the return once reviewed by the participant. The reason for this is due to the fact the plan administrator had sent an email to our bookkeeper advising that once we viewed the filing online provided we did not receive an email from the plan administrator to the contrary, the filing would have successfully gone through automatically. As such, after I viewed the filing online and advised my bookkeeper of the same and whereas my bookkeeper received no failure notice from our plan administrator, my bookkeeper believed the filing was complete and successful. Therefore, when I questioned my bookkeeper at the time as to whether we had fully complied with all IRS filing requirements, she mistakenly advised that we had when in fact we had not and as said, unfortunately I just became aware of our noncompliance upon receipt of this notice.
