Dear Sirs,

We are writing you in response to the notifications recently sent by the IRS regarding the filing of Form 5500SF for the Plans described below.

At the end of 2013, a decision was made to terminate our Payroll Service Provider and 401K Plan Administrator, Paychex. In addition, changes in personnel within our organization were made which resulted in us not following up with the terminated 401K Plan Administrator to ensure all 2013 Form 5500SF's were properly and timely filed. Effective January 2014 our new Payroll Service Provider and Retirement Plan Administrator was ADP. At that time, a decision was made to consolidate our multiple company plans into a single plan named M & R Enterprises of Brevard, Inc 401K Plan.

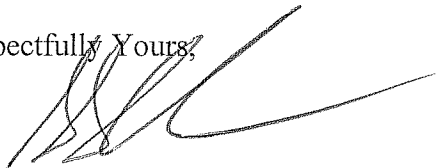
It has been determined that Form 5500SF for the following Plans were not filed by our 401K Plan Administrator for the plan year ending 12-31-2013:

- M & R United, Inc., Taxpayer ID No. 59-2514184 (The Final Return/Report)
- Sunshine Petro II, LLC., Taxpayer ID No. 20-1333665 (The Final Return/Report)
- Space Coast Petro Distributors, Taxpayer ID No. 59-3133348 (The Final Return/Report)
- Space Coast Hotels, LLC., Taxpayer ID No. 13-4312637 (The Final Return/Report)
- M & R Enterprises of Brevard, Inc., Taxpayer ID No. 59-3313478 (A Single-Employer Plan)

We have filed these forms on a timely basis in previous years and feel the reason the 2013 forms were not filed timely was due to an error made by our Payroll Service Provider. We recognize that the failure to timely file the forms is our responsibility and we have taken corrective action by filing immediately. Because of our past record of timely submissions, and the fact this problem was due to an error made by a third party coupled with changes in key personnel, we respectfully request abatement of any fees and penalties that may be associated with the late filing of the aforementioned 5500SF forms for 2013.
