Dear Sir or Madam:

I am writing in response to notification CP-406, dated 10-24-2016, regarding the filing of Form: 5500SF Plan #: 001 for the plan year ending 12-31-2014. My taxpayer ID number is 75-3056422.

I apologize for the delay in response, but as soon as I received this notice I took action by contacting Paychex, the company that held my 401K.

We had this 401K plan through our payroll provider PayChex. We cancelled the plan in December 2013 and cancelled our payroll account with PayChex at that time as well and moved to a private payroll service company. We did not start another 401K plan due to disinterest from our employees.

PayChex had told me that they would file all reports necessary that corresponded with our ending payroll and 401K plan, which I assumed that they did. Because the PayChex Company had filed everything for us prior to closing the account, I was unaware of the filing requirements or even what forms needed to be processed.

I did not realize that we were delinquent in filing anything, and I have always taken my responsibilities very seriously. I honestly thought that when they told me that they would make sure that everything was filed and that all final reports would be done that we were finished. I never received notification from them that I needed to file an ending form 5500SF for the year ending 2014. I thought that all requirements for closing this plan had been met.

I am writing to respectfully request consideration and leniency in the fines and penalties. This was an oversight on a closed plan, not a willful act of omission. I honestly did not realize that we were delinquent in filing anything, and I have always filed all other government reporting requirements and payments in a timely manner. We are a small family owned business trying to do something good for our employees.
