| - Payment of Pensions | Straight life annuity for single employees. Reduced Joint and 100% Survivor annuity for married employees. Optional forms of benefits include single sum and annuities. |
| Early Retirement Benefit | Same as Severance Benefit. |

- Minimum Benefit For employees also participating in the Healthcare Associates Profit Sharing Plan, contribution of 5% of total compensation to be provided under that plan.
- Minimum Vesting 50% after 2 years of service increasing 50% per year thereafter until 100% vested.
