We have been informed by the Plan administrator that Voya holds the Plan's investment assets and executes investment transactions. The Plan administrator has obtained a certification from Voya as of December 31, 2020 and 2019, and for the year ended December 31, 2020, that the information provided to the Plan administrator by Voya is complete and accurate.

Disclaimer of Opinion

Because of the significance of the matter described in the Basis for Disclaimer of Opinion paragraph, we have not been able to obtain sufficient appropriate audit evidence to provide a basis for an audit opinion on the financial statements. Accordingly, we do not express an opinion on the financial statements.

Other Matter – Supplemental Schedule

The schedule H, line 4(i) – schedule of assets (held at end of year) as of December 31, 2020, is required by the DOL's Rules and Regulations for Reporting and Disclosure under ERISA and is presented for the purpose of additional analysis and is not a required part of the financial statements. Paratransit Services 403(b) Plan Notes to Financial Statements

Note 1 – Description of Plan

The following description of the Paratransit Services 403(b) Plan (the Plan) provides only general information. Participants should refer to the Plan agreement, as amended, for a more complete description of Plan provisions.

General – The Plan is a 403(b) defined contribution plan covering substantially all employees of Paratransit Services, and is subject to provisions of the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA). Paratransit Services (the Organization) is the Plan's sponsor and serves as Plan administrator.

Eligibility – Employees of the Organization are eligible to participate in the Plan. Effective December 5, 2019, the Plan was amended to remove the age requirement from the Plan's eligibility provisions. Participants who have completed at least 1,000 hours of service and have completed one year of service are eligible to receive employer contributions.

Contributions

Participant contributions – Each year, participants may contribute between 1–100% of pretax annual compensation, as defined in the Plan. Participants who have attained age 50 before the end of the Plan year are eligible to make catch-up contributions. Participants who have at least 15 years of service and meet certain other qualifications can make special section 403(b) catch-up contributions. Participants may also contribute amounts representing distributions from other qualified defined benefit or defined contribution plans.

Employer contributions – The Organization may elect to make discretionary employer contributions to the Plan. For the year ended December 31, 2020, the Organization contributed 1% of eligible compensation for eligible employees, regardless of whether or not the employee made voluntary contributions to the Plan.

Contributions are subject to regulatory limitations.

Participant accounts – Each participant's account is credited with the participant's contributions and the Organization's employer contributions as well as allocations of Plan earnings. Participant accounts are charged with an allocation of administrative expenses that are paid by the Plan. Allocations are based on participant earnings, account balances, or specific participant transactions, as defined. The benefit to which a participant is entitled is the benefit that can be provided from the participant's vested account. Participants direct the investment of their contributions into various investment options offered by the Plan.

Vesting – Participants are vested immediately in their contributions plus actual earnings thereon. Vesting in the Organization's contribution portion of their accounts is based on years of continuous service. A participant will vest 20% each year after one year of credited service until fully vested after five years.

Notes to Financial Statements

Note 1 – Description of Plan (continued)

Payment of benefits – On termination of service due to death, disability, or retirement, if the vested benefit in the Plan exceeds \$5,000, a participant or their beneficiary may elect to receive either a lump-sum amount equal to the value of the participant's vested interest in his or her account, or annual installments over a period no greater than the participant's assumed life expectancy. For termination of service for other reasons, a participant may receive the value of the vested interest in his or her account as a lump-sum distribution only. For balances less than \$5,000, the account will automatically be distributed in a single lump sum.

Forfeitures – Forfeitures are the nonvested portion of a participant's account that is lost upon termination of employment. Forfeitures are retained in the Plan and are used to reduce future Organization employer contributions. As of December 31, 2020 and 2019, forfeited nonvested accounts totaled \$7,307 and \$9,806, respectively. For the year ended December 31, 2020, Organization employer contributions were reduced by \$4,142 from forfeited nonvested accounts.

Note 2 – Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

Basis of accounting – The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America, using the accrual method of accounting.

Use of estimates – The preparation of financial statements in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles requires the use of estimates and assumptions that may affect certain amounts and disclosures. Accordingly, actual results could differ from those estimates.

Investment valuation – The investments are reported at fair value. Voya Retirement Insurance and Annuity Company (Voya), certifies the fair market value of all investments. If available, quoted market prices are used to value investments.

Fair value is the price that would be received to sell an asset or paid to transfer a liability (the exit price) in an orderly transaction between market participants at the measurement date. See Note 3 for discussion of fair value measurements.

Income recognition – Purchases and sales of securities are recorded on a trade-date basis. The net appreciation in fair value of investments consists of both the realized gains and losses and unrealized appreciation and depreciation of those investments.

Payment of benefits – Benefits are recorded when paid.

Expenses – General plan administrative expenses may be paid by the Organization. Investment management expenses are netted against investment income and distribution transaction fees are paid by the Plan participants.

Note 2 – Summary of Significant Accounting Policies (continued)

Subsequent events – Subsequent events are events or transactions that occur after the statement of net assets available for benefits date but before the financial statements are issued. The Plan recognizes in the financial statements the effects of all subsequent events that provide additional evidence about conditions that existed at the date of the statement of net assets available for benefits, including the estimates inherent in the process of preparing the financial statements. The Plan's financial statements do not recognize subsequent events that provide evidence about conditions that did not exist at the date of the statement of net assets available for benefits but arose after the statement of net assets available for benefits date and before the financial statements are issued. The Plan has evaluated subsequent events through July 15, 2021, which is the date the financial statements were available to be issued.

Note 3 – Fair Value Measurements

The framework for measuring fair value provides a hierarchy that prioritizes the inputs to valuation techniques used to measure fair value. The hierarchy gives the highest priority to unadjusted quoted prices in active markets for identical assets or liabilities (Level 1) and the lowest priority to unobservable inputs (Level 3).

The three levels of the fair value hierarchy are described as follows:

Level 1 – Inputs to the valuation methodology are unadjusted quoted prices for identical assets or liabilities the Plan has the ability to access.

Level 2 – Inputs to the valuation methodology include quoted prices for similar assets or liabilities in active markets; quoted prices for identical or similar assets or liabilities in inactive markets; inputs other than quoted prices that are observable for the asset or liability; and inputs that are derived principally from or corroborated by observable market data by correlation or other means. If the asset or liability has a specified (contractual) term, the Level 2 input must be observable for substantially the full term of the asset or liability.

Level 3 – Inputs to the valuation methodology are unobservable and significant to the fair value measurement.

The asset or liability's fair value measurement level within the fair value hierarchy is based on the lowest level of any input that is significant to the fair value measurement. Valuation techniques maximize the use of relevant observable inputs and minimize the use of unobservable inputs.

Notes to Financial Statements

Note 3 – Fair Value Measurements (continued)

Following is a description of the valuation techniques used for assets measured at fair value. There have been no changes in the techniques used at December 31, 2020 and 2019.

The following investments are only available as investment options in Voya Variable Annuity Contracts:

Pooled separate accounts: The pooled separate account has registered with the Security and Exchange Commission (SEC) as a unit investment trust (UIT). The underlying investments in the UIT are unitized investments. Participants invest in units of the underlying investments. These units are valued using the net asset value (NAV) of the fair value of the underlying assets (which are generally mutual funds), minus its liabilities, and then divided by the number of units outstanding. Because the fair values of the underlying investments are published and the NAV is used as the basis for transactions, these investments are deemed to have a readily determined fair value. The valuation inputs are observable and therefore considered to be level 2 in the fair value hierarchy.

There are no unfunded commitments and generally no restrictions to redemption or ability to sell units of the underlying investments in the PSA. Under the terms of the agreement with Voya, surrender charges may be assessed if investments in the PSAs are withdrawn prior to normal plan distribution methods. At December 31, 2020 and 2019, such surrender charges would have been \$0.

The following investment is considered a Fixed Annuity Contract:

Guaranteed interest accounts: The guaranteed interest accounts are valued at fair value which represents contributions made under the contract, plus earnings, less participant withdrawals. The inputs used to determine the fair value measurement of the guaranteed interest accounts are classified in Level 2 of the fair value hierarchy, as the credited interest rate, account balance, and formulas upon which payments may be based are observable through the contract and related communications.

The guaranteed interest accounts are guaranteed investment contracts with Voya. Voya deposits the contributions in their general account. The account is credited with earnings on the underlying investments and charged for participant withdrawals and administrative expenses. The contract issuer is contractually obligated to repay the principal and a specified interest rate that is guaranteed to the Plan. The crediting rate is based on a formula established by the contract issuer but may not be less than 4%.

The Plan's ability to receive amounts due is dependent on the issuer's ability to meet its financial obligations, which may be affected by future economic and regulatory developments.

The valuation methods used by the Plan may produce a fair value calculation that may not be indicative of net realizable value or reflective of future fair values. Furthermore, although the Plan believes its valuation methods are appropriate and consistent with other market participants, the use of different methodologies or assumptions to determine the fair value of certain financial instruments could result in a different fair value measurement at the reporting date.

Note 4 – Tax Status

The terms of the Plan have been prepared to conform with the sample language provided by the Internal Revenue Service. The Plan is required to operate in accordance with the Internal Revenue Code (IRC) to maintain the tax exempt status for participants under Section 403(b). The Plan has adopted a prototype plan sponsored by Voya, which has been designed to qualify under Section 403(b) the IRC. The Plan administrator believes that the Plan is designed and is currently being operated in compliance with the applicable requirements of the IRC.

In accordance with guidance on accounting for uncertainty in income taxes, the Plan administrator has evaluated the Plan's tax positions and does not believe the Plan has any uncertain tax positions that require disclosure or adjustment to the financial statements. The Plan is subject to routine audits by taxing jurisdictions; however, there are currently no audits for any tax periods in progress.

Note 5 – Risks and Uncertainties

The Plan invests in various investment securities. Investment securities are exposed to various risks, such as interest rate, market volatility, and credit risks. It is reasonably possible, given the level of risk associated with investment securities, that changes in the values of the investments in the near term could materially affect a participant's account balance and the amounts reported in the statement of net assets available for benefits. During March 2020, the World Health Organization characterized the outbreak of a novel coronavirus (COVID-19) as a pandemic. A variety of federal, state, and local governments have taken actions in response to COVID-19. The effects of the pandemic have ranged by jurisdiction with a variety of health and economic consequences, the final scope of which are not currently known or quantifiable.

Note 6 – Information Certified by the Qualified Certifying Institution

The Plan administrator has elected the method of compliance permitted by 29 CFR 2520.103-8 of the Department of Labor's Rules and Regulations for Reporting and Disclosure under ERISA. Accordingly, Voya, the qualified certifying institution of the Plan, has certified to the completeness and accuracy of:

- Investments reflected on the accompanying statements of net assets available for benefits as of December 31, 2020 and 2019.
- Net appreciation in fair value of investments and other income reflected on the accompanying statement of changes in net assets available for benefits for the year ended December 31, 2020.
- Investments reflected on the schedule of assets (held at end of year).

Note 7 – Party-In-Interest Transactions

The Plan paid expenses related to Plan operations and investment management to various service providers. Certain Plan investments are managed by Voya. Voya is the qualified certifying institution and, therefore, these transactions qualify as exempt party-in-interest transactions.

Note 8 – Plan Termination

Although it has not expressed any intent to do so, the Organization has the right to terminate the Plan and discontinue its contributions at any time, subject to the provisions of ERISA. If the Plan is terminated, amounts allocated to a participant's account become fully vested.

Note 9 – Reconciliation to Form 5500

The Form 5500 has certain items that differ from amounts shown on the accompanying financial statements. These differences relate to classification only and have no effect upon net assets available for benefits for either period.
