This is a summary of the annual report for the CHIEF'S USED BRICK, INC. MONEY PURCHASE PLAN, (Employer Identification No. **-*****, Plan No. 002) for the period January 1, 2022 to December 31, 2022. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

BASIC FINANCIAL STATEMENT

Benefits under the plan are provided by a trust (benefits are provided in whole from trust funds). Plan expenses were \$15,989. These expenses included \$85 in administrative expenses and \$15,904 in benefits paid to participants and beneficiaries. A total of 0 persons were participants in or beneficiaries of the plan at the end of the plan year.

The value of plan assets, after subtracting liabilities of the plan, was \$0 as of December 31, 2022 compared to \$1,069,912 as of January 1, 2022. During the plan year the plan experienced a decrease in its net assets of \$1,069,912. This decrease includes unrealized appreciation or depreciation in the value of plan assets; that is, the difference between the value of the plan's assets at the end of the year and the value of the assets at the beginning of the year, or the cost of assets acquired during the year. The plan had total income of \$-101,139, including and other income of \$-101,139.

MINIMUM FUNDING STANDARDS

Enough money was contributed to the plan to keep it funded in accordance with the minimum funding standards of ERISA.
