Note 1. Description of the Plan

The following description of SoBran, Inc. 401(k) Profit Sharing Plan (the Plan) provides only general information. Participants should refer to the Summary Plan Description or the Plan Document for a more complete description of the Plan's provisions.

General

The Plan is a defined contribution plan that covers substantially all employees of SoBran, Inc. (the Company and Plan sponsor) who have completed six months of service and are at least 21 years of age. The Plan is subject to the provisions of the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Contributions

Participants may contribute up to 30% of their compensation, as defined in the Summary Plan Description. Contributions are subject to certain limitations. Catch-up contributions are also permitted by the Plan.

The Employer makes a discretionary matching contribution which is equal to 50% of the first 8% deferred by a participant. The Employer match is available to employees who have completed six months of service and are at least 21 years of age.

Participant accounts

Each participant's account is credited with the participant's contributions, Company contributions, and actual earnings thereon. Each participant's account is charged with his or her withdrawals and an allocation of administrative expenses. The benefit to which a participant is entitled is the benefit that can be provided from the participant's vested account.

Vesting

Participants are immediately vested in their contributions plus earnings thereon. Vesting in the Employer's discretionary matching contributions plus earnings thereon is based on years of continuous service. Participants vest 25% per year of service, starting after two years of credited service and are 100% vested after five years of credited service. Earlier vesting may occur upon death or disability.

Forfeitures

Forfeited, non-vested accounts totaled \$117,138 and \$107,922 at December 31, 2022 and 2021, respectively. Forfeited amounts can be used to pay administrative expenses or to offset future employer contributions. During 2022 forfeited, non-vested accounts of \$7,200 were used to pay administrative fees.

Payment of benefits

Upon termination of service due to disability or death, a participant will become fully vested. Upon retirement or termination of service, a participant receives a lump-sum payment equal to the value of the participant's vested interest in their account.

Investment options

Participants may direct the investment of their accounts into various investment options offered under the Plan. Participants may change their investment choices on a daily basis.

Note 2. Significant Accounting Policies

Basis of accounting

The financial statements of the Plan are prepared on the accrual basis of accounting in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America (U.S. GAAP). The Accounting Standards Codification (ASC) as produced by the Financial Accounting Standards Board (FASB) is the sole source of authoritative U.S. GAAP.

Use of estimates

The preparation of financial statements in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America requires the plan administrator to make estimates and assumptions that affect certain reported amounts and disclosures. Actual results could differ from estimates as additional information becomes available in the future.

Investment Valuation and Income Recognition

Investments held by the Plan are reported at fair value, with the exception of the stable value fund which is reported at contract value. Fair value is the price that would be received to sell an asset or paid to transfer a liability in an orderly transaction between market participants at the measurement date. Contract value reflects the amount participants would receive if they were to initiate permitted transactions under the terms of the Plan and is the relevant measure for the portion of assets attributable to fully benefit-responsive investment contracts such as the stable value fund.

Purchases and sales of securities are recorded on a trade-date basis. Interest income is recorded on the accrual basis. Dividends are recorded on the ex-dividend date. Net depreciation includes the Plan's gains and losses on investments bought and sold as well as held during the Plan year.

Payment of benefits

Benefits are recorded when paid.

Administrative expenses

Administrative expenses of the Plan are paid by the Company or Plan participants, as defined in the Plan agreement.

Date of Management's Review

Subsequent events have been evaluated by management through July 21, 2023, the date the statements were available to be issued.

Note 3. Information Certified by the Plan's Trustee

The plan administrator has elected the method of compliance permitted by 29 CFR 2520.103-8 of the Department of Labor's Rules and Regulations for Reporting and Disclosure under ERISA. Accordingly, John Hancock Trust Company LLC, the trustee of the Plan, has certified to the completeness and accuracy of all investment information reflected on the accompanying Statements of Net Assets Available for Benefits as of December 31, 2022 and 2021, the Schedule of Assets (Held at End of Year) at December 31, 2022, and the related interest and dividends and net depreciation in fair value of investments information reflected in the Statement of Changes in Net Assets Available for Benefits for the year ended December 31, 2022.

Note 4. Fair Value Measurement

FASB ASC 820, Fair Value Measurements and Disclosures, provides the framework for measuring fair value. That framework provides a fair value hierarchy that prioritizes the inputs to valuation techniques used to measure fair value. The hierarchy gives the highest priority to unadjusted quoted prices in active markets for identical assets or liabilities (level 1 measurements) and the lowest priority to unobservable inputs (level 3 measurements). The three levels of the fair value hierarchy under FASB ASC 820 are described as follows:

The asset or liability's fair value measurement level within the fair value hierarchy is based on the lowest level of any input that is significant to the fair value measurement. Valuation techniques used need to maximize the use of observable inputs and minimize the use of unobservable inputs.

The following is a description of the valuation methodology used for assets measured at fair value. There have been no changes in the methodologies used at December 31, 2022 and 2021.

Mutual funds: Valued at the closing price reported on the active market on which the individual securities are traded.

The preceding method described may produce a fair value calculation that may not be indicative of net realizable value or reflective of future fair values. Furthermore, although the Plan believes its valuation methods are appropriate and consistent with other market participants, the use of different methodologies or assumptions to determine the fair value of certain financial instruments could result in a different fair value measurement at the reporting date.

Note 5. Investment Contract

The Plan holds an interest in the New York Life Anchor Account IV Fund (the Fund), a stable value fund that is a pooled separate account with New York Life Insurance Company (New York Life), made available to participating plans through a group annuity contract. Contributions to the fund are directed to a New York Life pooled separate account that invests primarily in a diversified portfolio of high-quality, fixed income securities, which are owned by New York Life. The fund is credited with earnings on the underlying investments and charged for participant withdrawals and administrative expenses. The investment contract issuer, New York Life, is contractually obligated to repay the principal and a specified interest rate that is guaranteed to the Plan.

The Fund is a fully benefit-responsive investment contract and is reported at contract value in the statements of net assets available for benefits. The statement of changes in net assets available for benefits is also prepared on a contract value basis. Benefit responsiveness is defined as the extent to which a contract's terms and the Plan permit or require participant-initiated withdrawals at contract value. Contract value is the relevant measure for fully benefit-responsive investment contracts because this is the amount received by participants if they were to initiate permitted transactions under the terms of the Plan. Contract value, as reported to the Plan by New York Life represents contributions made under each contract, plus earnings, less participant withdrawals and administrative expenses.

Participants may ordinarily direct the withdrawal or transfer of all or a portion of their investments at contract value. There are no reserves against contract value for credit risk of the contract issuer or otherwise. The contract value of the investment contract at December 31, 2022 and 2021 was \$1,333,298 and \$1,452,400, respectively. The crediting interest rate for the fund is reset daily by the issuer but cannot be less than 1%. The crediting interest rate is based upon a formula and is a function of timing of the cash flow activity, overall interest rates, the reinvestment of maturing proceeds and the impact of credit losses and impairments.

Certain events limit the ability of the Plan to transact at contract value with the issuer of the fund. Such events include employer-initiated events such as Fund termination, merger, spin-off, lay-offs, or early retirement incentives. However, the plan administrator is not aware of the occurrence or likely occurrence of any such events, which would limit the Plan's ability to transact at contract value with participants.

Note 6. Related Party Transactions

Certain administrative services are provided by the Company at no cost to the Plan and certain administrative costs incurred by the Plan are paid by the Company.

The Plan's administrative fees result from services rendered by parties-in-interest.

Certain Plan investments are managed by New York Life. New York Life is affiliated with John Hancock Trust Company LLC, the trustee as defined by the Plan, and therefore, these transactions qualify as party-in-interest transactions.

Note 7. Tax Status

The Internal Revenue Service has determined and informed the Company by a letter dated May 18, 2016, that the Plan and related trust are designed in accordance with the applicable sections of the Internal Revenue Code (IRC) for use by employers for the benefit of their employees. Although the Plan has been amended since receiving the determination letter, the plan administrator believes that the Plan is designed and is currently being operated in compliance with the applicable requirements of the IRC and therefore believes that the Plan is qualified and the related trust is tax-exempt.

Note 7. Tax Status (Continued)

U.S. GAAP requires Plan management to evaluate tax positions taken by the Plan and recognize a tax liability (or asset) if the Plan has taken an uncertain position that more likely than not would not be sustained upon examination by the IRS. The plan administrator has analyzed the tax positions taken by the Plan, and has concluded that as of December 31, 2022 and 2021, there are no uncertain tax positions taken or expected to be taken that would require recognition of a liability (or asset) or disclosure in the financial statements. The Plan is subject to routine audits by taxing jurisdictions; however, there are currently no audits for any tax periods in progress.

Note 8. Plan Termination

Although it has not expressed any intent to do so, the Company has the right under the Plan to discontinue its contributions at any time and to terminate the Plan subject to the provisions of ERISA and its related regulations. In the event of Plan termination, participants will become 100% vested in their accounts.

Note 9. Risks and Uncertainties

The Plan invests in various investment securities. Investment securities are exposed to various risks such as interest rate, market, and credit risks. Due to the level of risk associated with certain investment securities, it is at least reasonably possible that changes in the values of investment securities will occur in the near term and that such changes could materially affect participants' account balances and the amounts reported in the statements of net assets available for benefits.
