The mortality assumptions used are those mandated by the Internal Revenue Service for this valuation, per IRC Section 430. Because this plan has fewer than 500 participants, we use the unisex assumptions.

Events and Trends Which Have Not Been Taken into Consideration

To the best of our knowledge, there has been no event or trend which has not been taken into consideration and which may require a material change in plan costs or required contribution rates. In addition, no Plan amendments adopted and effective after the valuation date of December 31, 2022 were considered for this Valuation, nor do any exist of which we are aware except statutory CPI increases in maximum benefits and considered compensation.
