### Notes to Financial Statements

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#### Note 1. Description of the Plan

The following description of United Bankers' Bancorporation, Inc. 401(k) Savings Plan (the Plan) provides only general information. Participants should refer to the Plan document for a more complete description of the Plan's provisions.

**General:** The Plan is a defined contribution plan covering substantially all employees of United Bankers' Bancorporation, Inc. and its wholly owned subsidiary, United Bankers' Bank (collectively referred to as the Company), except those who do not qualify for participation. The Plan is subject to the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA). The Plan is administered by the Company, which appointed a third-party administrator to process and maintain the records of the participant data, and with Empower Retirement, LLC to act as the custodian of the Plan. The Board of Trustees is responsible for oversight of the Plan and also determines the appropriateness of the Plan's investment offerings and monitors investment performance.

**Eligibility:** Employees who have attained the age of 18 and are considered part of an eligible class of full-time employees are eligible to participate in the Plan.

**Contributions:** Participants may defer a portion of their eligible compensation, as defined in the Plan, in whole percentages up to 100%, subject to the maximum amounts allowed by the Internal Revenue Code (IRC). Participants who attain age 50 or older are also eligible to make catch-up contributions, subject to the maximum amounts allowed by the IRC. Under provisions of the IRC, the Plan also allows participants to roll over funds from other qualified plans. Additionally, the Plan allows for participants to defer pretax Roth elective contributions.

The Plan also allows for safe harbor nonelective contributions. Participants are eligible to receive Company safe harbor nonelective contributions upon the completion of the eligibility requirements, as defined above. The Company provides safe harbor nonelective contributions to eligible employees of 3% of the participant's eligible compensation.

Discretionary nonelective contributions may be made by the Company to participants of the Plan. These contributions can be either a uniform percentage of each eligible individual's compensation or an amount to be allocated to each participant. There were no discretionary nonelective contributions for the year ended December 31, 2022.

**Participant accounts:** Each participant's account is credited with the participant's contributions, the Company's contributions and allocations of the Plan's investment results. Participant accounts are also charged with an allocation of administrative expenses that are paid by the Plan. Allocations are based on participants' earnings, account balances, or specific transactions, as defined in the Plan. The benefit to which the participant is entitled is the benefit that can be provided from the participant's vested account.

**Vesting:** Participants are immediately 100% vested in their own contributions, safe harbor contributions, and related earning thereon. Balances attributable to discretionary employer nonelective contributions shall vest based on the participant's years of service according to the table below. A year of service is defined as 1,000 hours of service during the Plan year.

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#### Note 1. Description of the Plan (Continued)

**Investment options:** Participants are allowed to invest in a variety of investment choices as more fully described in the Plan's literature. All choices vary in types of investments, expected rates of return and investment risk. Participants may elect to have all or part of their account balances and future contributions transferred from one fund to another or in any combination daily.

**Notes receivable from participants:** Participants may borrow from their fund accounts a minimum of \$1,000 up to a maximum equal to the lesser of \$50,000 or 50% of their vested account balance. The loans have terms ranging from one to five years, or up to 15 years for the purchase of a primary residence, and are secured by the balance in the participant's account. The loan interest rate is set at 1.00% above the prime rate. At December 31, 2022, interest rates on loans ranged from 4.25% to 7.25% and are due in various amounts through April 2031. Principal and interest are paid ratably through biweekly payroll deductions.

**Payment of benefits:** On termination of service, death, permanent disability, or retirement, a participant may elect to receive either a lump-sum amount equal to the value of the participant's interest in his or her account, or installments over varying periods, as permitted by the Plan. The Plan allows in-service withdrawals after age 59 1/2 for any reason and financial hardship withdrawals before age 59 1/2, as defined. Participants with an account balance of \$5,000 or less will be distributed through a lump-sum payment. Participants with an account balance in excess of \$5,000 also have the option of keeping their account balance in the Plan. Participants attaining the age of 72 must receive a required minimum distribution no later than April 1 following the calendar year in which they turn 72, unless the participant is still employed by the Company, in which case they can defer receiving their benefit until they are terminated or retire.

#### Note 2. Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

**Basis of presentation:** The accompanying financial statements are prepared using the accrual basis of accounting.

**Use of estimates:** The preparation of financial statements in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America (U.S. GAAP) requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts of assets, liabilities and changes therein, and disclosure of contingent assets and liabilities. Actual results could differ from those estimates.

**Investment valuation and revenue recognition:** Investments are reported at fair value (except for the fully benefit-responsive investment contract, which is reported at contract value). Fair value is the amount that would be received to sell an asset or paid to transfer a liability in an orderly transaction between market participants at the measurement date. The Plan's Board of Trustees determines the appropriateness of the Plan's investment offerings and monitors investment performance. See Note 4 for a discussion of fair value measurements.

Purchases and sales of securities are recorded on a trade-date basis. Interest income is recorded on the accrual basis. Net depreciation includes the Plan's gains and losses on investments bought and sold, as well as held, during the year.

**Notes receivable from participants:** Notes receivable from participants are measured at their unpaid principal balance plus any accrued but unpaid interest. Interest income is recorded on the accrual basis. Related fees are recorded as administrative expenses and are expensed when they are incurred. No allowance for credit losses has been recorded as of December 31, 2022 or 2021.

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#### Note 2. Summary of Significant Accounting Policies (Continued)

Notes receivable from participants have been classified as an investment asset for Form 5500 reporting purposes and, accordingly, have been included as an investment in the supplemental schedule, Schedule H, Line 4i—Schedule of assets (held at end of year).

**Risks and uncertainties:** The Plan provides for investment in a variety of investment securities. Investment securities, in general, are exposed to various risks, such as interest rate, credit and overall market volatility. Due to the level of risk associated with certain investment securities, it is at least reasonably possible that changes in the values of investment securities will occur in the near term and that such changes could materially affect participants' account balances and the amounts reported in the 2022 statement of net assets available for benefits.

**Payment of benefits:** Benefit payments to participants are recorded when paid.

**Administrative expenses:** Administrative expenses are paid by the Plan unless paid by the Company. Expenses that are paid by the Company are excluded from these financial statements. Fees related to the administration of notes receivable from participants are charged directly to the participant's account and are included in administrative expenses. Investment-related expenses are included in net depreciation in fair value of investments.

**Subsequent events:** Plan management, in preparing the financial statements and notes thereto, has considered subsequent events through October 5, 2023, the date the financial statements were available to be issued.

#### Note 3. Information Certified or Provided by the Plan Custodian

The following is a summary of the Plan's asset information as of December 31, 2022 and 2021, and for the year ended December 31, 2022, included throughout the Plan's financial statements and ERISA-required supplemental schedule, obtained by management and agreed to or derived from information certified by Empower Retirement, LLC, the custodian of the Plan. The Plan Administrator has obtained a certification from the custodian that the information provided to the Plan Administrator by the custodian related to the following assets is complete and accurate. Accordingly, as permitted by 29 CFR 2520.103-8 of the Department of Labor's Rules and Regulations for Reporting and Disclosure under ERISA, the Plan Administrator instructed the Plan's independent auditors not to perform any auditing procedures with respect to information that appears throughout the financial statements and ERISA-required supplemental schedule, related to the following assets certified by the custodian:

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#### Note 4. Fair Value Measurements

The framework for measuring fair value provides a fair value hierarchy that prioritizes the inputs to valuation techniques used to measure fair value in accordance with Accounting Standards Codification (ASC) Topic 820. The hierarchy gives the highest priority to unadjusted quoted prices in active markets for identical assets or liabilities (Level 1) and the lowest priority to unobservable inputs (Level 3). The three levels of the fair value hierarchy are described below:

**Level 1:** Inputs to the valuation methodology are unadjusted quoted prices for identical assets or liabilities in active markets that the Plan has the ability to access.

**Level 2:** Inputs to the valuation methodology include:

- Quoted prices for similar assets or liabilities in active markets
- Quoted prices for identical or similar assets or liabilities in inactive markets
- Inputs other than quoted prices that are observable for the asset or liability
- Inputs that are derived principally from or corroborated by observable market data by correlation or other means

If the asset or liability has a specific (contractual) term, the Level 2 input must be observable for substantially the full term of the asset or liability.

**Level 3:** Inputs to the valuation methodology are unobservable and significant to the fair value measurement.

The asset's or liability's fair value measurement level within the fair value hierarchy is based on the lowest level of any input that is significant to the fair value measurement. Valuation techniques used need to maximize the use of observable inputs and minimize the use of unobservable inputs.

The following is a description of the valuation methodology used for investments measured at fair value. There have been no changes in the methodology used at December 31, 2022 and 2021.

**Mutual funds:** Mutual funds are valued at the daily closing price as reported by the fund. Mutual funds held by the Plan are open-end mutual funds that are registered with the Securities and Exchange Commission. These funds are required to publish their daily net asset value (NAV) and to transact at that price. The mutual funds held by the Plan are deemed to be actively traded.

**Pooled separate accounts:** Pooled separate accounts are valued at the daily closing price of the shares in each account held by the Plan at year-end. The pooled separate accounts are comprised of mutual funds.

#### Note 5. Investment Contracts With Insurance Companies

The Plan holds a guaranteed investment contract with Empower Retirement, LLC that invests contributions in the guaranteed interest account. This contract meets the fully benefit-responsive investment contract criteria and, therefore, is reported at contract value. Contract value is the relevant measure for fully benefit-responsive investment contracts because this is the amount received by participants if they were to initiate permitted transactions under the terms of the Plan. Contract value represents contributions made under the contract, plus earnings, less participant withdrawals and administrative expenses. The Plan's total investment recorded at contract value was \$8,461,846 and \$9,845,166 as of December 31, 2022 and 2021, respectively.

The contract issuer is contractually obligated to repay the principal and interest at a specified interest rate that is guaranteed to the Plan. The crediting rate is based on a formula established by the contract issuer but may not be less than 3%.

The Plan's ability to receive amounts due is dependent on the issuer's ability to meet its financial obligations. The issuer's ability to meet its contractual obligations may be affected by future economic and regulatory developments.

Certain events might limit the ability of the Plan to transact at contract value with the contract issuer. These events may be different under each contract.

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#### **Note 5. Investment Contracts With Insurance Companies (Continued)**

Examples of such events include the following:

1. The Plan's failure to qualify under section 401(a) of the IRC or the failure of the trust to be tax-exempt under section 501(a) of the IRC
2. Premature termination of the contracts
3. Plan termination or merger
4. Changes to the Plan's prohibition on competing investment options
5. Bankruptcy of the Plan Sponsor or other Plan Sponsor events (for example, divestitures or spin-offs of a subsidiary) that significantly affect the Plan's normal operations

No events are probable of occurring that might limit the ability of the Plan to transact at contract value with the contract issuers and that also would limit the ability of the Plan to transact at contract value with the participants.

In addition, certain events allow the issuer to terminate the contract with the Plan and settle at an amount different from contract value. Those events may be different under each contract. Examples of such events include the following:

1. An uncured violation of the Plan's investment guidelines
2. A breach of material obligation under the contract
3. A material misrepresentation
4. A material amendment to the agreement without the consent of the issuer

#### **Note 6. Plan Termination**

Although it has not expressed any intent to do so, the Company has the right, under the Plan, to discontinue its contributions at any time and to terminate the Plan subject to the provisions of ERISA. In the event of Plan termination, the accounts of all participants shall become 100% vested and shall be distributed to the participants or their beneficiaries.

#### **Note 7. Tax Status**

The Internal Revenue Services (IRS) has determined and informed the Plan Sponsor, by a letter dated June 30, 2020, that the Plan is qualified and the trust established under the Plan is tax-exempt under the appropriate section(s) of the IRC. The Plan has been amended subsequent to the date of the determination letter. However, the Plan Administrator believes the Plan is designed and is being operated in compliance with the applicable provisions of the IRC.

Accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America require Plan management to evaluate tax positions taken by the Plan and recognize a tax liability (or asset) if the Plan has taken an uncertain position that more likely than not would not be sustained upon examination by the IRS. The Plan is subject to routine audits by taxing jurisdictions; however, there are currently no audits for any tax periods in progress.
