Note 1: Description of the Plan

General

The following description of Cardiovascular Consultants of Kansas, P.A. 401(k) Profit Sharing Plan (Plan) provides only general information. Participants should refer to the Plan Document for a more complete description of the Plan's provisions.

The Plan is a defined contribution plan sponsored by Cardiovascular Consultants of Kansas, P.A. (Company) for the benefit of its employees who are age 21 or older and have completed one year of service (1,000 hours). The Plan is subject to the provisions of the *Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974* (ERISA). Principal Trust Company (Principal) serve as Plan custodian.

Contributions

The Plan permits eligible employees through a salary deferral election to have the Company make annual contributions of up to 25 percent of their eligible compensation. Employee rollover contributions are also permitted. Participants who have attained age 50 before the end of the plan year are eligible to make catch-up contributions. The Company makes safe harbor nonelective contributions equal to 3% of the participant's compensation. In addition, the Company may make a discretionary nonelective contribution. Contributions are subject to certain limitations.

Participant Investment Account Options

Participants have the option of directing their contributions into any of the various investment options offered by the Plan and may change the allocation daily.

Participant Accounts

Each participant's account is credited with the participant's contribution, the Company's nonelective contribution and plan earnings (losses) and is charged with an allocation of administrative expenses and forfeitures of nonvested accounts. Allocations are based on participant earnings (losses), compensation or account balances, as defined. The benefits to which a participant is entitled is the benefit that can be provided from the participant's vested account.

Vesting

Participants are immediately vested in their voluntary contributions plus earnings (losses) thereon and in their employer safe harbor nonelective contribution. Vesting in the Company's discretionary nonelective contribution is based on years of continuous service. A participant is fully vested after six years of continuous service. The nonvested balance is forfeited upon termination of service.

Payment of Benefits

Upon termination of service, a participant may elect to receive either a lump-sum amount equal to the value of the vested interest in their account or installments. Certain in-service withdrawals, including financial hardship withdrawals, are also available.

Forfeited Accounts

At both March 31, 2023 and 2022, forfeited nonvested accounts totaled \$2,643 and \$0, respectively. These accounts will be used to reduce employer contributions or pay administrative expenses.

Note 2: Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

Basis of Accounting

The accompanying financial statements are prepared on the accrual basis of accounting.

Use of Estimates

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts of net assets and changes in net assets and disclosure of contingent assets and liabilities at the date of the financial statements. Actual results could differ from those estimates.

Investment Valuation and Income Recognition

Investments are reported at fair value. Quoted market prices, if available, are used to value investments. Mutual funds are valued at the net asset value (NAV) of shares held by the Plan at year-end.

Pooled separate accounts are valued at estimated fair value as provided by Principal Life Insurance Company.

Effective March 20, 2020, the Plan's investment in the Principal U.S. Property Separate Account was subject to certain restrictions including delaying the payment of most withdrawal or transfer requests, but for no more than three years from the effective date. In accordance with the terms of the plan's group annuity contract, delayed payment requests will be honored proportionately. This means transactions may be processed in a series of payments until enough cash is available to pay obligations. These restrictions were lifted effective July 15, 2021, and standard processing of withdrawal and transfer requests resumed until July 1, 2022, when Principal Life again applied the withdrawal limitation. As of March 31, 2023, participant distribution requests totaling \$5,730 were pending due to withdrawal limitations.

The Plan's interest in the collective trust is valued based on information reported by the investment advisor using the audited financial statements of the collective trust at year end.

Purchases and sales of securities are recorded on a trade-date basis. Interest income is recorded on the accrual basis. Dividends are recorded on the ex-dividend date. Net appreciation (depreciation) includes the Plan's gains and losses on investments bought and sold as well as held during the year.

Payment of Benefits

Benefit payments to participants are recorded upon distribution.

Administrative Expenses

Administrative expenses may be paid by the Company at the Company's discretion.

Note 3: Certification of Plan Custodian

The Plan Administrator has elected the method of annual reporting compliance permitted by ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(c) pursuant to 29 CFR 2520.103-8 of the Department of Labor's Rules and Regulations for Reporting and Disclosure under ERISA. Accordingly, Delaware Charter Guarantee and Trust Company d/b/a Principal Trust Company, a qualified institution, has certified the following investment information included in the accompanying financial statements and supplemental schedule is complete and accurate:

- Investments as shown in the statements of net assets available for benefits as of March 31, 2023 and 2022.
- Investment income (loss) as shown in the statements of changes in net assets available for benefits for the years ended March 31, 2023 and 2022.
- Investment information included in the accompanying schedule of assets (held at year-end) as of March 31, 2023.

The Plan's independent auditors did not perform auditing procedures with respect to this certified investment information, except for comparing such certified investment information to the related investment information included in the financial statements and ERISA-required supplemental schedules.

Note 4: Party-in-Interest Transactions

Party-in-interest transactions include those with fiduciaries or employees of the Plan, any person who provides services to the Plan, an employer whose employees are covered by the Plan, an employee organization whose members are covered by the Plan, a person who owns 50 percent or more of such an employer or employee association, or relatives of such persons.

Certain Plan investments are units of pooled separate accounts managed by a related party of the custodian and, therefore, these transactions qualify as party-in-interest transactions. The Plan paid \$23,276 and \$23,781 of recordkeeping fees to Principal during 2023 and 2022, respectively. The Company provides certain administrative services at no cost to the Plan.

Note 5: Disclosures About Fair Value of Plan Assets

Fair value is the price that would be received to sell an asset or paid to transfer a liability in an orderly transaction between market participants at the measurement date. Fair value measurements must maximize the use of observable inputs and minimize the use of unobservable inputs. The hierarchy comprises three levels of inputs that may be used to measure fair value:

- Level 1** Quoted prices in active markets for identical assets or liabilities
- Level 2** Observable inputs other than Level 1 prices, such as quoted prices for similar assets or liabilities; quoted prices in markets that are not active; or other inputs that are observable or can be corroborated by observable market data for substantially the full term of the assets or liabilities
- Level 3** Unobservable inputs supported by little or no market activity and are significant to the fair value of the assets or liabilities

Following is a description of the valuation methodologies and inputs used for assets measured at fair value on a recurring basis and recognized in the accompanying statements of net assets available for benefits, as well as the general classification of such assets pursuant to the valuation hierarchy. There have been no significant changes in the valuation techniques during the years ended March 31, 2023 and 2022. The Plan had no liabilities measured at fair value on a recurring basis. In addition, the Plan had no assets or liabilities measured at fair value on a nonrecurring basis.

Investments

Where quoted market prices are available in an active market, securities are classified within Level 1 of the valuation hierarchy. If quoted market prices are not available, then fair values are estimated by using quoted prices of securities with similar characteristics or independent asset pricing services and pricing models, the inputs of which are market-based or independently sourced market parameters, including, but not limited to, yield curves, interest rates, volatilities, prepayments, defaults, cumulative loss projections and cash flows. Such securities are classified in Level 2 of the valuation hierarchy. In certain cases where Level 1 or Level 2 inputs are not available, securities are classified within Level 3 of the hierarchy.

Note 6: Plan Termination

Although it has not expressed any intent to do so, the Company has the right under the Plan to discontinue its contributions at any time and to terminate the Plan subject to the provisions of ERISA. In the event of Plan termination, participants would become 100 percent vested in their employer contributions.

Note 7: Tax Status

The Plan operates under an adoption agreement in connection with a prototype 401(k) profit-sharing plan and trust sponsored by Bever Dye LC. This prototype plan document has been filed with the appropriate agency and has obtained an opinion letter from the Internal Revenue Service (IRC) stating that the prototype constitutes a qualified plan under Section 401 of the Internal Revenue Code. The Plan has not requested or received a determination letter. Although the Plan has been amended since receiving the opinion letter, the Plan administrator and the Plan's tax counsel believe the Plan is designed, and is currently being operated, in compliance with the applicable requirements of the IRC and, therefore, believe the Plan is qualified, and the related trust is tax exempt.

Note 8: Nonexempt Transactions

Defined contribution plans are required to remit employee contributions to the Plan as soon as they can be reasonably segregated from the employer's general assets, but no later than the 15th business day of the month following the month in which the participant contributions are withheld by the employer. While the Company remitted all employee contributions to the Plan, before the 15th business day of the month following withholding, the contributions can be reasonably remitted sooner. As a result, contributions of \$283,267 and \$244,018 were considered to not be remitted within the required time period for the years ended March 31, 2023 and 2022, respectively.

Note 9: Risks and Uncertainties

The Plan invests in various investment securities. Investment securities are exposed to various risks such as interest rate, market and credit risks. Due to the level of risk associated with certain investment securities, it is at least reasonably possible that changes in the values of investment securities will occur in the near term and that such changes could materially affect the participants' account balances and the amounts reported in the statements of net assets available for benefits.

Note 10: Subsequent Events

Subsequent events have been evaluated through January xx, 2024, which is the date the financial statements were available to be issued.
