

NOTES TO FINANCIAL STATEMENTS YEAR ENDED DECEMBER 31, 2020

1. PLAN DESCRIPTION

The following brief description of Valley Unique Electric, Inc. 401(K) & Prevailing Wage Plan (the "Plan") is provided for general information purposes only. Participants should refer to the Summary Plan Description for more complete information.

General – The Plan was restated from an existing Plan on January 1, 2015, and covers all employees who are twenty-one years of age or older. The Plan is subject to the Employee Retirement Income Securities Act of 1974 ("ERISA") and is exempt from Federal and California taxes on income under the current provisions of the Internal Revenue Code and the California Revenue and Taxation Code, respectively. There were 157 and 158 participants in the Plan as of December 31, 2020 and 2019 respectively.

Administration – The Plan is administered by Valley Unique Electric, Inc. (the "Company").

Contributions – Participants may contribute up to the maximum dollar amount determined by the Federal Government. The maximum dollar amount for salary deferrals in 2020 and 2019 was \$19,000. Participants that have reached the age of 50 may have additional salary deferrals in 2020 and 2019 of \$6,500. Participants may also contribute amounts representing distributions from other qualified plans. Participants direct the investment of their contributions into various investment options offered by the Plan. The Plan provides for employer service-based contributions of \$0.10 for each hour of service that is not subject to prevailing wage. The employer will also make a contribution for each participant's prevailing wage service based on the hourly contribution rate for the participants' employment classification. The Plan provides for any additional contributions at the discretion of the employer.

Forfeitures – Forfeitures of non-vested participant accounts totaled \$0 at December 31, 2020 and 2019.

Participant Accounts – Each participant's account is credited with the participant's contribution and allocations of the Company's contribution and the Plan earnings, and charged with an allocation of investment expenses. Allocations are based on participant earnings or account balances, as defined. The benefit to which a participant is entitled is the benefit that can be provided from the participant's vested account.

NOTES TO FINANCIAL STATEMENTS (Continued) YEAR ENDED DECEMBER 31, 2020

Vesting – Participants are immediately vested in their elective deferral contributions and actual earnings at all times. Participants are immediately vested in the employer contribution of \$0.10 for each hour of service and any contributions related to prevailing wages. Participants are vested in any employer discretionary contributions in accordance with the following schedule:

Payment of Benefits – Upon termination of service (retirement, termination of employment, disability or death), a qualified participant’s vested account balance can be distributed in a lump sum in accordance with Plan provisions.

Notes Receivable from Participant – The Plan was amended in 2018 removing the restriction of participants from borrowing from the Plan. At December 31, 2020 and 2019 the outstanding loan balances were \$72,887 and \$107,631, respectfully.

2. SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Method of Accounting – The Plan’s financial statements are prepared using the accrual method of accounting in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America.

Estimates – The preparation of financial statements in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America requires the Plan administrator to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts and disclosures. Accordingly, actual results could differ from those estimates.

Investment Valuation and Income Recognition – The Plan’s investments are reported at fair value. The fair values of the investments are stated at quoted market prices as determined by the custodian, Principal Financial (Note 4).

Purchases and sales of securities are recorded on a trade-date basis. Interest income is recorded on the accrual basis. Dividends are recorded on the ex-dividend date. Net appreciation includes the Plan’s gains and losses on investments bought and sold as well as held during the year.

Expenses – Certain expenses of maintaining the Plan are paid by the Plan, unless otherwise paid by the Company. Expenses that are paid by the Company are excluded from these financial statements. Fees related to the administration of distributions to participants are charged directly to the participant's account and are included in administrative expenses. Investment related expenses are included in net appreciation (depreciation) in fair value of investments.

3. INFORMATION CERTIFIED BY CUSTODIAN (UNAUDITED)

Certain information related to investments and notes receivable from participants disclosed in the accompanying financial statements and supplemental schedule, including investments and notes receivable from participants held at December 31, 2020 and 2019, and net appreciation in fair value of investments and dividends for the year ended December 31, 2020 was obtained or derived from information supplied to the Plan administrator and certified as complete and accurate by Principal Financial (the custodian of the Plan).

4. FAIR VALUE MEASUREMENTS

The framework for measuring fair value provides as a fair value hierarchy that prioritizes the inputs to valuation techniques used to measure fair value. The hierarchy gives the highest priority to unadjusted quoted prices in active markets for identical assets or liabilities (Level 1) and the lowest priority to unobservable inputs (Level 3). Valuation techniques maximize the use of relevant observable inputs and minimize the use of unobservable inputs. The three levels of the fair value hierarchy under Topic 820 are described as follows:

Level 1 – Inputs to the valuation methodology are unadjusted quoted prices for identical assets or liabilities in active markets that the Plan has the ability to access at the measurement date.

Level 2 – Inputs other than quoted prices included within Level 1 that are observable for the asset or liability, either directly or indirectly, such as:

- Quoted prices for similar assets or liabilities in active markets;
- Quoted prices for identical or similar assets or liabilities in inactive markets;
- Inputs other than quoted prices that are observable for the asset or liability;
- Inputs that are derived principally from or corroborated by observable market data by correlation or other means.

If the asset or liability has a specified (contractual) term, the Level 2 input must be observable for substantially the full term of the asset or liability.

Level 3 – Inputs to the valuation methodology are unobservable and significant to the fair value measurement.

Mutual Funds/Mutual Funds (pooled separate accounts): Valued at the daily closing price as reported by the fund. These funds are required to publish their daily net asset value ("NAV") and to transact at that price. The mutual funds held by the Plan are deemed to be actively traded.

Although it has not expressed any intent to do so, the Company has the right under the Plan to discontinue contributions at any time and to terminate the Plan subject to the provisions of ERISA. In the event of plan termination, amounts credited to participant accounts will continue to be 100% vested and nonforfeitable.

7. NON-EXEMPT TRANSACTIONS

Certain of the participant contributions were not remitted within the maximum period of time permitted by the Department of Labor's Rules and Regulations and, therefore, constitute the lending of monies from the Plan to the Company. These non-exempt transactions are detailed in the attached supplemental schedule, Schedule H, line 4a – Schedule of Delinquent Participant Contributions for the Year Ended December 31, 2020.

8. ADP/ACP NONDISCRIMINATION TEST

The Plan passed the nondiscrimination test performed by the Plan administrator for plan years ended December 31, 2020 and 2019.

9. RELATED PARTY TRANSACTIONS

Certain Plan investments are managed by Principal Financial. Principal Financial is the custodian of the Plan's investments as defined by the Plan and, therefore, these transactions qualify as party-in-interest transactions.

10. RISKS AND UNCERTAINTIES

The Plan invests in various investment securities. Investment securities are exposed to various risks such as interest rate, market, and credit risks. Due to the level of risk associated with certain investment securities, it is at least reasonably possible that changes in the values of investment securities will occur in the near term and that such changes could materially affect participants' account balances and the amounts reported in the statements of net assets available for benefits.

11. SUBSEQUENT EVENTS

The Plan administrator has evaluated subsequent events through November 22, 2023, the date at which the financial statements were available to be used and no other events occurred which would require financial statement disclosure.
