Scope and Nature of the ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) Audit

We have performed audits of the accompanying financial statements of Saint Francis Medical Center Tax Deferred Annuity Plan, an employee benefit plan subject to the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA), as permitted by ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) (ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) audit). The financial statements comprise the statements of net assets available for benefits as of December 31, 2023 and 2022, and the related statements of changes in net assets available for benefits for the years then ended, and the related notes to the financial statements.

Management, having determined it is permissible in the circumstances, has elected to have the audits of Saint Francis Medical Center Tax Deferred Annuity Plan's financial statements performed in accordance with ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) pursuant to 29 CFR 2520.103-8 of the Department of Labor's Rules and Regulations for Reporting and Disclosure under ERISA. As permitted by ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C), our audits need not extend to any statements or information related to assets held for investment of the plan (investment information) by a bank or similar institution or insurance carrier that is regulated, supervised, and subject to periodic examination by a state or federal agency, provided that the statements or information regarding assets so held are prepared and certified to by the bank or similar institution or insurance carrier in accordance with 29 CFR 2520.103-5 of the Department of Labor's Rules and Regulations for Reporting and Disclosure under ERISA (qualified institution).

Management has obtained certifications from qualified institutions as of and for the years ended December 31, 2023 and 2022, stating that the certified investment information, as described in Note 3 to the financial statements, is complete and accurate.

Opinion

In our opinion, based on our audits and on the procedures performed as described in the Auditors' Responsibilities for the Audits of the Financial Statements section:

Basis for Opinion

1. Plan Description

The following description of Saint Francis Medical Center Tax Deferred Annuity Plan (the "Plan") is provided for financial reporting purposes only. Participants of the Plan should refer to the plan document and summary plan description for a more complete description of the Plan's provisions.

General

The Plan was established July 1989, amended and restated as of July 1, 2023, and is a defined contribution plan as defined by Section 403 of the Internal Revenue Code ("IRC") covering all eligible employees of Saint Francis Medical Center (the "Plan Sponsor"). The Plan is subject to the provisions of the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 ("ERISA"), as amended.

Eligibility

Employees may become participants for purposes of elective deferrals on the first day of employment. Employees may become participants for purposes of matching contributions following attainment of 21 years of age. Plan entry dates for elective deferrals are the date of hire. Plan entry dates for matching contributions are the first day of the month following eligibility.

Contributions

Participants may contribute up to 100 percent of pre-tax or after-tax eligible annual compensation, as defined in the plan document, not to exceed certain dollar limits established by the IRC. Certain participants, as defined in the plan document, are automatically enrolled at 3 percent of eligible compensation. Participants who have attained age 50 before the end of the Plan year are eligible to make catch-up contributions. Participants may also contribute amounts representing distributions from other qualified defined benefit or defined contribution plans.

The Plan Sponsor matches the participants' contribution with an amount equal to 100 percent of the first 2 percent and 50 percent of the next 4 percent of the amount contributed by each participant, up to a maximum of 4 percent of eligible compensation.

The Plan Sponsor may also make discretionary nonelective contributions to the Plan. Contributions are allocated to eligible participants' accounts based upon completion of one (1) year of service and attainment of 21 years of age. For 2023 and 2022, the Plan Sponsor made a discretionary contribution of two percent of eligible compensation.

Participant Accounts

Each participant's account is credited with the participant's contribution and allocations of the Plan Sponsor's contributions and Plan earnings, and charged with an allocation of administrative expenses. Allocations are based on participant earnings or account balances, as defined in the plan document. The benefit to which a participant is entitled is the benefit that can be provided from the participant's vested account.

Vesting and Forfeitures

Participants are vested immediately in their contributions plus actual earnings thereon. Vesting in the Plan Sponsor's contribution portion of their account plus earnings is based on years of service, as defined in the plan document, in accordance with the following schedule:

The nonvested balance is forfeited upon termination of service. Participants become fully vested upon death, termination of the Plan, normal retirement age, or total disability.

At December 31, 2023 and 2022, forfeited nonvested accounts totaled \$159,093 and \$311,973, respectively. These accounts will be used to reduce future employer contributions. For the years ended December 31, 2023 and 2022, employer contributions were reduced by \$197,003 and \$20,931 from forfeited nonvested accounts, respectively.

Notes Receivable from Participants

The plan document includes provisions authorizing loans from the Plan, made directly with the insurance company, to active eligible participants. Participants may borrow from their accounts a minimum of \$1,000 up to the maximum equal to the lesser of \$50,000 or 50 percent of their vested account balance. The maximum number of loans available to any participant is one. The loans are secured by the balance in the participant's account and bear interest at rates that range from 2.71 percent to 9.50 percent, which is determined by the plan administrator and is based on 1 percent over the Prime Rate published in the Wall Street Journal on the first business day of the month the loan is originated. The loan repayment period is dictated by the plan document based on the original use of the funds. Principal and interest are paid ratably through payroll deductions. No allowance for credit losses has been recorded as of December 31, 2023 and 2022.

Payment of Benefits

Prior to separation from service with the Plan Sponsor, a participant may request a distribution of rollover contributions. In the event of a financial hardship, certain participant funds, as defined in the plan document, may be requested for distribution. In-service distributions may also be requested by participants who are at least age 59 1/2.

Upon attainment of normal retirement age, total disability, or death, the amount credited to a participant's account is payable in a lump sum or installments. Upon termination of employment for reasons other than retirement, total disability, or death, the participant's account balance will be distributed in a manner based on the value of the account. If a separated participant's account does not exceed \$5,000, the benefit will be distributed in a lump sum within a reasonable time after termination of employment. If the participant's account balance exceeds \$5,000, the participant may elect to receive the benefit in a lump sum or installments in accordance with the plan document.

2. Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

Basis of Presentation

The financial statements of the Plan have been prepared in accordance with the provisions of the Financial Accounting Standards Board ("FASB"), Accounting Standards Codification (the "FASB ASC"), which is the source of authoritative, non-governmental accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America ("GAAP"). All references to authoritative accounting guidance contained in our disclosures are based on the general accounting topics within the FASB ASC.

Use of Estimates

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with GAAP requires the Plan's management to make estimates and assumptions that affect certain reported amounts of assets and liabilities and changes therein, and disclosures of contingent assets and liabilities. Accordingly, actual results could differ from those estimates.

Investment Valuation and Income Recognition

Investments, other than fully benefit responsive investment contracts, are reported at fair value. Fully benefit responsive investment contracts are reported at contract value. Fair value is the price that would be received to sell an asset or paid to transfer a liability in an orderly transaction between market participants at the measurement date. Contract value is the amount that would be received from permitted transactions under the terms of the Plan.

Purchases and sales of securities are recorded on a trade-date basis. Interest income is recorded on the accrual basis. Dividends are recorded on the ex-dividend date. Net appreciation (depreciation) includes the Plan's gains and losses on investments bought and sold as well as held during the year.

Fair Value Measurements

The Plan follows guidance issued by the FASB on fair value measurements, which establishes a framework for measuring fair value, clarifies the definition of fair value within that framework, and expands disclosures about the use of fair value measurements. This guidance applies whenever fair value is the applicable measurement. The three general valuation techniques used to measure fair value are the market approach, cost approach, and income approach.

Notes Receivable from Participants

Notes receivable from participants are measured at their unpaid principal balance plus any accrued but unpaid interest. Interest income is recorded on the accrual basis. Related fees are recorded as administrative expenses and are expensed when incurred. No allowance for credit losses has been recorded as of December 31, 2023 and 2022. Delinquent loans are treated as distributions based upon the terms of the plan document.

Payment of Benefits

Benefits are recorded when paid.

Administrative Expenses

The Plan permits the payment of Plan expenses from Plan assets. If the Plan Sponsor does not pay these expenses from its own assets, then the expenses paid using Plan assets will generally be allocated among the accounts of all participants in the Plan. These expenses will be allocated either proportionately based on the value of the account balances or as an equal dollar amount based on the number of participants in the Plan. The method of allocating the expenses depends on the nature of the expense. Fees related to the administration of notes receivable from participants are charged directly to the participant's account and are included in administrative expenses. Investment related expenses are included in the net appreciation (depreciation) in fair value of investments.

Subsequent Events

The Plan has evaluated subsequent events through October 14, 2024, the date the financial statements were available to be issued.

3. Information Certified by the Custodian

At December 31, 2023 and 2022, the Plan's investments, including notes receivable from participants, are held by Empower Retirement, LLC ("Empower") and Voya Retirement Insurance and Annuity Company ("Voya"). Empower and Voya are the custodians of the Plan. Financial information relating to those investments is included in the accompanying financial statements and supplemental schedule based on information provided by the custodians. That information has been prepared and certified to as complete and accurate by Empower and Voya.

4. Fair Value Measurements

The framework for measuring fair value establishes a fair value hierarchy which prioritizes the inputs to valuation techniques used to measure fair value into Levels 1, 2, and 3. The hierarchy gives the highest priority to unadjusted quoted prices in active markets for identical assets or liabilities (Level 1) and the lowest priority to unobservable inputs (Level 3). The three levels of the fair value hierarchy are described as follows:

The instruments' fair value measurement level within the fair value hierarchy is based on the lowest level of any input that is significant to the fair value measurement. Valuation techniques maximize the use of relevant observable inputs and minimize the use of unobservable inputs.

Following is a description of the valuation methodologies used for instruments measured at fair value.

Investments at fair value consist of pooled separate accounts which are directly invested in mutual funds, equity securities, or fixed maturity securities. These securities are valued at the net asset value ("NAV") based on the observable underlying investments. The NAV is used as a practical expedient to estimate fair value. Investments that were measured at NAV per share (or its equivalent) have not been classified in the fair value hierarchy. The NAV is used as a practical expedient to estimate fair value.

The preceding methods described may produce a fair value calculation that may not be indicative of net realizable value or reflective of future fair values. Furthermore, although the Plan believes its valuation methods are appropriate and consistent with other market participants, the use of different methodologies or assumptions to determine the fair value of certain financial instruments could result in a different fair value measurement at the reporting date.

5. Guaranteed Investment Contracts

The Plan holds a traditional investment contract. This contract meets the fully benefit responsive investment contract criteria and therefore is reported at contract value. Contract value is the relevant measure for fully benefit responsive investment contracts because this is the amount received by participants if they were to initiate permitted transactions under the terms of the Plan. Contract value represents contributions made under each contract, plus earnings, less participant withdrawals, and administrative expenses. The following represents the disaggregation of contract value between types of investment contracts held by the Plan.

The Plan does not own the underlying assets of a traditional investment contract. With traditional investment contracts, the Plan owns only the contract itself. Traditional investment contracts are designed to accrue interest based on crediting rates established by the contract issuers.

The guaranteed investment contract does not permit Voya to terminate the agreement prior to the scheduled maturity date.

6. Related Party and Party-in-Interest Transactions

At December 31, 2023 and 2022, certain Plan investments are pooled separate accounts of Empower and Voya. Empower and Voya provide trustee, reporting, and related services to the Plan and, therefore, these transactions qualify as party-in-interest transactions. Fees paid by the Plan for the investment management services are included in net appreciation (depreciation) in fair value of investments.

During 2023 and 2022, the Plan Sponsor paid certain administrative and other operating expenses of the Plan.

7. Plan Termination

Although it has not expressed any intent to do so, the Plan Sponsor has the right under the Plan to discontinue its contributions at any time and to terminate the Plan subject to the provisions of ERISA. In the event of Plan termination, participants would become 100 percent vested in the Plan Sponsor contribution portion of their account.

8. Tax Status of Plan

The Internal Revenue Service has determined and informed the Plan Sponsor by a letter dated March 31, 2017, that the Plan and related trust are designed in accordance with the applicable sections of the IRC. The Plan has been amended since receiving the determination letter. The Plan Sponsor believes that the Plan is designed and is currently being operated in compliance with the applicable requirements of the IRC and therefore believes that the Plan is qualified and the related trust is tax-exempt.

In accordance with GAAP, the Plan Sponsor is required to evaluate tax positions taken by the Plan and recognize a tax liability if the Plan has taken an uncertain position that more likely than not would not be sustained upon examination by the applicable taxing authorities. The Plan Sponsor has analyzed the tax positions taken by the Plan and has concluded that as of December 31, 2023 and 2022, there are no uncertain positions taken, or expected to be taken, that would require recognition of a liability or disclosure in the financial statements. The Plan Sponsor believes the Plan is no longer subject to income tax examinations for years prior to 2020. The Plan is also subject to routine audits by the Department of Labor, generally for six years after the statutory due date of the annual information return. There are currently no audits in progress for any tax periods.

9. Risks and Uncertainties

The Plan invests in various investment securities. Investment securities are exposed to various risks such as interest rate, market, and credit risks. Due to the level of risk associated with certain investment securities, it is at least reasonably possible that changes in the values of investment securities will occur in the near term and that such changes could materially affect participants' account balances and the amounts reported in the statements of net assets available for benefits.

10. Corrective Employer Contributions

For the year ended December 31, 2021, the Plan Sponsor failed to allow participants to defer on a portion of their compensation resulting in a receivable totaling \$13,797,975 to the Plan. For the year ended December 31, 2023, the updated receivable amount including lost earnings totaled \$14,809,004. The Plan Sponsor submitted a request to the Internal Revenue Service, under the Employee Plans Compliance Resolution System (EPCRS) for approval of corrections related to these contributions. Related lost earnings have not yet been paid by the Plan Sponsor.

For the year ended December 31, 2022, the Plan Sponsor failed to properly allow participants to defer and failed to match on those deferrals resulting in a receivable totaling \$513,008 to the Plan. These contributions and the related lost earnings were paid into the Plan by the Plan Sponsor in fiscal year 2023.

For the year ended December 31, 2023, the Plan Sponsor failed to properly allow participants to defer on a portion of their compensation and failed to match on those deferrals resulting in a receivable totaling \$377,017 to the Plan. These contributions and the related lost earnings have not yet been paid by the Plan Sponsor.
