In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers internal control relevant to the Plan's preparation and fair presentation of the financial statements in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the Plan's internal control. Accordingly, we express no such opinion. An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of significant accounting estimates made by management, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of the financial statements.

We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our audit opinion on the 2020 financial statements.

### **Auditors' Responsibility for the 2019 Financial Statements**

Our responsibility is to express an opinion on the 2019 financial statements based on conducting the audit in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America. Because of the matter described in the Basis for Disclaimer of Opinion on the 2019 financial statements paragraph, however, we were not able to obtain sufficient appropriate audit evidence to provide a basis for an audit opinion.

### **Basis for Disclaimer of Opinion on the 2019 Financial Statements**

As permitted by 29 CFR 2520.103-8 of the Department of Labor's Rules and Regulations for Reporting and Disclosure under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974, the investment assets held by Principal Trust Company, the trustee of the Plan, and transactions in those assets were excluded from the scope of our audit of the Plan's 2019 financial statements, except for comparing the information provided by the trustee, which is summarized in Note 3, with the related information included in the financial statements..

### **Disclaimer of Opinion on the 2019 Financial Statements**

Because of the significance of the matter described in the Basis for Disclaimer of Opinion on the 2019 Financial Statements paragraph, we have not been able to obtain sufficient, appropriate audit evidence to provide a basis for an audit opinion. Accordingly, we do not express an opinion on the 2019 financial statements.

### **Opinion on the 2020 Financial Statements**

In our opinion, the financial statements referred to in the first paragraph of Oilgear Savings Plus Plan as of October 14, 2020, and for the period then ended, present fairly, in all material respects, the financial status of Oilgear Savings Plus Plan as of October 14, 2020, and changes in its financial status for the period then ended in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United State of America.

### **Report on Supplemental Information**

Our audit of the Plan's financial statements as of and for the period ended October 14, 2020, was conducted for the purpose of forming an opinion on the financial statements as a whole. The supplementary schedule of delinquent participant contributions referred to as "supplemental information", as of and for the period ended October 14, 2020 is presented for the purpose of additional analysis and is not a required part of the financial statements but is supplementary information required by the Department of Labor's Rules and Regulations for Reporting and Disclosure under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974. Such information is the responsibility of the Plan's management and was derived from and relates directly to the underlying accounting and other records used to prepare the financial statements. The information has been subjected to the auditing procedures applied in the audit of the 2020 financial statements and certain additional procedures, including comparing and reconciling such information directly to the underlying accounting and other records used to prepare the financial statements or to the financial statements themselves, and other additional procedures in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America. In our opinion, the information is fairly stated in all material respects in relation to the financial statements as a whole.



As described in Note 5 to the financial statements, the governing body of Oilgear Savings Plus Plan approved a plan of liquidation on August 20, 2019, and management determined liquidation is imminent. As a result, the Plan has changed its basis of accounting from the going concern basis to the liquidation basis used in presenting the 2020 and 2019 financial statements. Our opinion is not modified with respect to that matter.

As described in Note 1, there are pending transactions totaling \$ 44,143 which are comprised of excess contribution refunds due from the 2019 compliance testing.

### **1. Description of Plan**

The following description of the Oilgear Savings Plus Plan (the Plan) provides only general information. Participants should refer to the Plan agreement for a more complete description of the Plan's provisions.

#### ***General***

The Plan is a defined contribution plan established by the Oilgear Company (the Company). The Plan is subject to the provisions of the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 as amended (ERISA). With the exception of certain employees at the Company's Fremont, Nebraska location who are covered by a collective bargaining agreement, all employees who have completed at least 30 days of service with the Company and are age 21 or older will be automatically enrolled at 6% unless otherwise indicated.

#### ***Contributions***

Participants may elect to contribute up to 100% of their pre-tax compensation to the Plan subject to annual statutory limitations. Participants who have attained age 50 before the end of the Plan year are eligible to make catch-up contributions. Participants may also contribute amounts representing distributions from other qualified defined benefit or defined contribution plans (rollover). Additionally, the Company has the option of making a discretionary match up to a percentage of pay determined by the Company. Participants covered by the Fremont, Nebraska collective bargaining agreement are not eligible to receive Company matching contributions. Instead, beginning December 1, 2018 those covered by the collective bargaining agreement received matching contributions of 50% of the first 2%. These employees also receive an additional 5% company contribution. The Company may also elect to make addition annual discretionary contributions. Contributions are subject to maximum annual dollar contribution restrictions of ERISA and the Internal Revenue Service. Participants direct the investment of the contributions into various investment options offered by the Plan. During the period ended October 14, 2020, there were no participant or company contributions to the Plan.

#### ***Excess Contributions***

For the period ended October 14, 2020 and the year ended December 31, 2019, amounts payable to participants totaling \$ -0- and \$ 44,143, respectively, for contributions in excess of amounts allowed by IRS are recorded as a liability with a corresponding reduction in contributions. The Plan did not distribute the 2019 excess contributions to the applicable participants. These amounts are included in corrective distributions as of October 14, 2020 and corrective distributions were made on August 15, 2024.

#### ***Participant Accounts***

Each participant account is credited with the participant's contributions and allocations of (a) Company contributions, (b) Plan earnings, and (c) charged with an allocation of administrative expenses. Allocations of earnings are based on account balances, as defined. The benefit to which a participant is entitled is the benefit that can be provided from the participants' vested account.

***Vesting***

Participants are immediately vested in their voluntary contributions plus actual earnings thereon. Vesting in the Company contributions portion of their accounts plus earnings thereon is based on years of continuous service. A participant is 100% vested after three years of credited service. A participant receives credit for a year of service if they complete at least 1,000 hours of service at any time during the twelve consecutive month computation period. Employees are vested according to the following schedule:

Participants reaching retirement age or who die or become disabled will automatically be 100% vested.

***Investment Options***

The Plan allows participants to direct the investment of all contributions and related earnings among various mutual funds, pooled separate accounts and a common collective trust fund maintained by Principal Global Investors Trust Company, a related entity to Principal Trust Company, trustee of the Plan.

***Notes Receivable from Participants***

Participants may borrow from their fund accounts a minimum of \$ 1,000 up to a maximum equal to the lesser of \$ 50,000 or 50% of their vested account balance. Loan transactions are treated as a transfer to (from) the investment fund from (to) the participant loans fund. The loans are secured by the balance in the participant's account and bear interest at a rate based on the rates available for similar loans at commercial lending institution. Principal and interest is paid ratably through payroll deductions.

***Forfeited Accounts***

At October 14, 2020 and December 31, 2019, forfeited nonvested accounts totaled \$ -0- and \$ -0-, respectively.

***Payment of Benefit***

On termination of service due to death, disability, retirement or other reasons, a participant may receive the value of the vested interest in his or her account as a lump-sum distribution. Installment payments are allowed only if the participant is subject to lifetime required minimum distributions. The Plan also allows for in-service withdrawal once the participant has attained age 59 ½ and for hardship and disability requests, limited to the participant's vested account balance. Participant consent is required for distribution over \$ 5,000.

**2. Summary of Significant Accounting Policies**

***Basis of Accounting***

The financial statements of the Plan are prepared using the accrual basis of accounting.

***Use of Estimates***

The preparation of financial statements in accordance with U. S. generally accepted accounting principles requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect certain reported amounts and disclosures. Accordingly, actual results may differ from those estimates.

***Investment Valuation and Income Recognition***

Investments are reported at fair value, including the fully benefit-responsive investment contract, since this is considered the liquidation value. Fair value is the price that would be received to sell an asset or paid to transfer a liability in an orderly transaction between market participants at the measurement date. See Note 4 for discussion of fair value measurements.

Purchases and sales of securities are recorded on a trade-date basis. Interest income is recorded on the accrual basis. Dividends are recorded on the ex-dividend date. Net appreciation includes the Plan's gains and losses on investments bought and sold as well as held during the year.

***Notes Receivable from Participants***

Loans to participants are measured at their unpaid principal balance plus any accrued but unpaid interest. Interest income is recorded on the accrual basis. Related fees are recorded as administrative expenses and are expensed when they are incurred. No allowance for credit losses has been recorded as of October 14, 2020 or December 31, 2019.

***Payment of Benefits***

Benefits are recorded when paid.

***Plan Expenses***

Administrative expenses other than trustee fees of the Plan were absorbed by the company sponsor of the Plan. Expenses that are paid by the Company are excluded from these financial statements. Fees related to the administration of notes receivable from participants and other member requested services are charged directly to the participants account and are included in administrative expenses. Investment related expenses are included in net appreciation of fair value of investments.

***Reclassifications***

Certain balances and activities have been reclassified in the 2019 financial statements to be consistent with the 2020 financial statement presentation. Amounts shown as investments in the 2019 financial statements were reclassified to noninterest bearing cash.

### 3. Information Prepared and Certified by the Trustee

Certain information related to investments and notes receivable from participants disclosed in the accompanying financial statements and supplemental schedule, including investments and notes receivable from participants held at December 31, 2019, was obtained or derived from information supplied to the plan administrator and certified as complete and accurate by Principal Trust Company (the trustee of the Plan). The fair value of the guaranteed investment contract was certified by the trustee.

### 4. Fair Value Measurements

The framework for measuring fair value provides a fair value hierarchy that prioritizes the inputs to valuation techniques used to measure fair value. The hierarchy gives the highest priority to unadjusted quoted prices in active markets for identical assets or liabilities (level 1) and the lowest priority to unobservable inputs (level 3). The three levels of the fair value hierarchy under FASB ASC 820 are described as follows:

Level 1      Inputs to the valuation methodology are unadjusted quoted prices for identical assets or liabilities in active markets that the Plan has the ability to access.

Level 2      Inputs to the valuation methodology include

- quoted prices for similar assets or liabilities in active markets;
- quoted prices for identical or similar assets or liabilities in inactive markets;
- inputs other than quoted prices that are observable for the asset or liability;
- inputs that are derived principally from or corroborated by observable market data by correlation or other means.

If the asset or liability has a specified (contractual) term, the level 2 input must be observable for substantially the full term of the asset or liability.

Level 3      Inputs to the valuation methodology are unobservable and significant to the fair value measurement.

The asset or liability's fair value measurement level within the fair value hierarchy is based on the lowest level of any input that is significant to the fair value measurement. Valuation techniques maximize the use of relevant observable inputs and minimize the use of unobservable inputs.

Following is a description of the valuation methodologies used for assets measured at fair value. There have been no changes in the methodologies used at October 14, 2020 and December 31, 2019.

Common Collective Trusts: Valued at the net asset value ("NAV") of its underlying investments, which include mutual funds, stocks, bonds and securities in varying proportions. The majority of the underlying investments have observable level 1 pricing inputs, including quoted prices for similar assets in active or non-active markets.

**5. Plan Termination**

The Company has the right to discontinue its contributions at any time and to terminate the Plan subject to the provisions of ERISA. In the event of termination, participants will become 100% vested in their accounts. On August 20, 2019, the Company's Board of Directors approved the termination of Oilgear Savings Plus Plan. As a result, all participant balances were merged into the Texas Hydraulics Newco, Inc. 401k Plan administered by Fidelity Investments. All assets were transferred from the plan as of October 14, 2020.

**6. Tax Status**

The Plan is using a Volume Submitter profit sharing plan with CODA document. The Internal Revenue Service (IRS) has determined and informed the Company in a letter dated August 8, 2014 that the form of plan is acceptable under Section 401 of the Internal Revenue Code. The IRS's opinion on the acceptability of the form of the Plan is not a ruling or determination as to whether the Plan qualifies under Code section 401(a). However, the Plan administrator believes the Plan is currently designed and operated in compliance with the applicable requirements of the Internal Revenue Code. Therefore, no provision for income taxes has been included in the Plan's financial statements.

**7. Risks and Uncertainties**

The Plan invests in various investment securities. Investment securities are exposed to various risks such as interest rate, market, and credit risks. Due to the level of risk associated with certain investment securities, it is at least reasonably possible that changes in the values of investment securities will occur in the near term that such changes could materially affect participant's account balances, and the amounts reported in the statement of net assets available for benefits.

**8. Party-In-Interest Transactions**

The Plan has not considered Company contributions to the Plan or benefits paid by the Plan to participants as party-in-interest transactions. The Plan holds investments in pooled separate accounts of the trustee. Some fees incurred by the Plan for investment management services by the trustee of the Plan were paid for by the Company.

During the period ended October 14, 2020 and year ended December 31, 2019, the Plan incurred administrative expenses totaling \$ 250 and \$ 88,734, respectively. These amounts were paid to the contract administrator of the Plan.

**9. Subsequent Events**

Management has evaluated subsequent events through October 28, 2024, which is the date the financial statements were available to be issued.
