1. DESCRIPTION OF THE HEALTH AND WELFARE PLAN

The following description of the Plumbers' and Pipefitters' Local No. 104 Health and Welfare Plan (the Plan) provides only general information. Participants should refer to the Plan agreement for a more complete description of the Plan's provisions.

- * General – The Plan was formed under a collectively bargained agreement between the New England Mechanical Contractors Association, Inc. and the Plumbers' and Pipefitters' Union Local No. 104. The Plan provides health and welfare benefits covering employees of contractors who are affiliated with Local No. 104 Plumbers' and Pipefitters' Union. It is subject to the provisions of the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).
- * Benefits – The Plan provides health benefits (hospital, surgical, major medical, dental, vision and long-term disability benefits) to participants employed by an affiliated contractor who have worked a minimum of 1,400 hours of service each year. The Plan also provides health benefits to eligible active and retired employees who have either accrued hours (Bank of Hours) or are entitled to premium hours to maintain coverage. Current health claims of active participants are provided under group administrative contracts with Blue Cross Blue Shield of Massachusetts. Health claims of retired participants, up to the age of 65 years, are provided under the same insurance contracts. There are no post-retirement benefit obligations under the Plan. The Plan is self-funded and pays an administration fee for processing of claims.
- * Contributions – The Plan agreement provides that the affiliated contractors of Local No. 104 Plumbers' and Pipefitters' Union make monthly contributions to the Plan of a specified amount for each hour worked to provide benefits for employees. Participants who fail to work 1,400 hours annually must contribute the difference to continue participation. The employer's contribution rate is determined by the collective bargaining agreement between the contractors and the Plumbers' and Pipefitters' Local No. 104 Union members and varies each year.
- * Insurance – The Plan maintains an excess risk group insurance contract which limits the annual liability to the plan for any individual to \$150,000 in claims. There is also an aggregate risk group health insurance clause in force, whereby Blue Cross Blue Shield of Massachusetts will become liable for claims that exceed a certain total in any plan year.
- * Priorities Upon Termination of the Plan – In the event of a termination of the Plan, the participants have certain specific rights. Participants should refer to the plan agreement for a complete description of the plan provisions covering the priorities upon the termination of the Plan.
- * Prescription Insurance Refunds – The Plan has an arrangement with its prescription claims provider to receive various rebates and refunds as a result of the cost savings the provider is able to obtain in the marketplace. These refunds and rebates are recorded as received and offsets the cost of group insurance and claims expense on the statement of changes in net assets available for benefits.

2. **SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES**

Business activity

The Plan is responsible for administering health and welfare benefits for employees of contractors who are affiliated with the Local No. 104 Plumbers' and Pipefitters' Union. The Plan collects funds from the affiliated contractors to cover claims and premium cost.

The Plan's primary geographic area of coverage includes Western Massachusetts, from the Connecticut border to Berkshire County, and east to Worcester. Also covered is Windham County in Vermont.

Basis of accounting

The Plan uses the accrual basis of accounting. Under the accrual basis of accounting, revenues are recognized when earned and expenditures are recognized when incurred rather than when collected or paid.

Cash equivalents

The Plan considers all highly liquid debt instruments with original maturities of three months or less to be cash equivalents. This includes all bank accounts, bank deposit sweep accounts held in various investment funds, and U.S. Treasury Funds.

Valuation of investments

The Plan's investments are stated at fair value, as determined by quoted market price, with the exception of the Guaranteed Deposit Account, which is presented at contract value. See also Note 4.

Fair value

Accounting Standards Codification provides the framework for measuring fair value. That framework provides a fair value hierarchy that prioritizes the inputs to valuation techniques used to measure fair value. The hierarchy gives the highest priority to unadjusted quoted prices in active markets for identical assets or liabilities (level 1 measurements) and the lowest priority to unobservable inputs (level 3 measurements).

The three levels of the fair value hierarchy under Accounting Standards Codification are described as follows:

- Level 1 valuations reflect quoted market or exchange prices for the actual or identical assets or liabilities in active markets.
- Level 2 valuations reflect inputs other than quoted prices in Level 1 which are observable. The inputs can include some or all of the following into a valuation model:
 - quoted prices on similar assets in active markets
 - quoted prices on actual assets that are not active
 - inputs other than quoted prices such as yield curves, volatilities, prepayments speeds
 - inputs derived from market data
- Level 3 valuations reflect valuations in which one or more of the significant valuation inputs are not observable in an active market, there is limited if any market activity, and/or are based on management inputs into valuation model.

Contributions and contributions receivable

Contributions are recorded at net realizable value consisting of the carrying amount. As of June 30, 2024 and 2023, no amounts were deemed uncollectible; accordingly, no provision has been made for an allowance for doubtful accounts.

Insurance contracts

The Plan purchases insurance contracts, that are excluded from plan assets, for the purpose of paying for certain death, accidental death and dismemberment, major medical, disability, and dental claims incurred under the terms of the plan.

Tax status

The Plumbers' and Pipefitters' Local No. 104 Health and Welfare Plan is a tax-exempt entity under Section 501(c)9 of the Internal Revenue Code. Accordingly, the Plan's net investment income is exempt from income taxes. The Trust has obtained a favorable determination letter from the Internal Revenue Service, and the Plan sponsor believes that the Trust, as amended, continues to qualify and to operate in accordance with applicable provisions of the Internal Revenue Code.

The Plan has adopted Accounting Standards Codification, "Accounting for Uncertainty in Income Taxes." Accounting Standards Codification prescribes a comprehensive model for the financial statement recognition, measurement, classification and disclosure of uncertain tax positions. Management has not identified any uncertain tax positions and, therefore, no liability has been recorded in the financial statements.

The Plan's annual tax filings are subject to audit by the Department of Labor and the Internal Revenue Service.

Use of estimates

The preparation of financial statements requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect certain reported amounts and disclosures. Accordingly, actual results could differ from those estimates.

Reclassifications

Certain balances in the prior year financial statements have been reclassified for comparative purposes to conform to the presentation in the current year financial statements. These reclassifications have not had any impact on net assets available for benefits.

Subsequent events

Management has evaluated subsequent events through March 24, 2025, the date which the financial statements were available to be issued.

3. PREMIUM FUND

As of August 1, 1995, 15 cents per hour worked is to be taken from the Health and Welfare Regular Account and set aside in an Escrow Account. This Premium Fund would help members who, through no fault of their own, exhausted their health and welfare benefits, and the premium fund provides a maximum of 350 hours of credit toward a reduced policy. For retirees between the ages of 62 and 65, a maximum credit of 50% of the current COBRA rate is available. In order to ensure full coverage, a member would be given the opportunity to pay the remaining balance.

4. INVESTMENTS

The following section describes the valuation methodologies the Plan uses to measure the financial instruments at fair value:

Mutual funds

Exchange-traded direct equity investments that are actively traded are generally valued based on quoted process from the exchange making them Level 1 on the fair value hierarchy.

The Plan maintains policies and procedures to value instruments using the best and most relevant data available. In addition, the Plan has an investment management team that reviews valuation, including independent price validation for certain instruments. Further, in most instances, management develops internal valuations of the assets and instruments held in the Plan.

Guaranteed deposit account

The Prudential Fixed Rate Fund is a funding agreement issued by Empower Annuity Insurance Company. Amounts contributed to the contract are deposited in a general account. Payment obligations and the fulfillment of any guarantees specified in the funding agreement contract are insurance claims supported by the full faith and credit of the insurance company. Contract Value represent contributions plus credited interest less Plan withdrawals and fees. Because the guaranteed deposit contract is fully benefit-responsive, contract value is the relevant fair value measurement attribute for that portion of the net assets available for benefits and not included in Accounting Standards Codifications investment levels.

5. RETIREMENT PLAN

The Plan maintains a simplified employee plan (SEP) for its eligible employees. The total cost voted upon by the Trustees was 15% of those eligible employees' base annual salaries. The contributions for the years ended June 30, 2024 and 2023 amounted to \$4,849 and \$4,817, respectively.

6. RELATED PARTY AND PARTY-IN-INTEREST TRANSACTIONS

The Plan rents space for its operations from the Plumbers' and Pipefitters' Local No. 104 Joint Apprenticeship and Training Fund, a related party. The Plan pays \$278 - \$310 per month under a monthly rental agreement. Total rent expense for each of the years ended June 30, 2024 and 2023 was \$3,720. The rental agreement is not considered a prohibited transaction as defined by ERISA.

Payroll, payroll taxes, and employee benefits are reported and paid by the Health and Welfare Fund for the Health and Welfare, the Annuity Plan, and the Pension Fund. A monthly allocation is made, and funds are transferred to apportion these costs based on the time spent working on each Fund. During 2024 and 2023, the Plan had expenses of \$39,148 and \$72,637 for payroll, payroll taxes, and employee benefits and reimbursements of \$21,611 and 23,785, respectively.

Plan assets are managed by various investment firms. Fees paid by the Plan for investment management services total \$10,238 and \$9,582 in 2024 and 2023, respectively, and are included in investment expenses.

During the normal course of business, the Plan has several arrangements with service providers. These transactions are party-in-interest transactions under ERISA.

7. COMMITMENTS

Claims incurred but not reported

The Plan is self-funded for its benefits except for a stop loss policy for medical and life insurance. Under a self-funded plan, a commitment must be disclosed for claims incurred but not reported. The commitment is estimated at \$117,766 at June 30, 2024 and \$115,583 at June 30, 2023.

Other obligations for current benefits

The Fund has other benefit obligations, comprising of members banked hours, of \$4,233,052 and \$4,074,032 as of June 30, 2024 and 2023, respectively.

8. RISKS AND UNCERTAINTIES

The Plan invests in various investment securities. Investment securities are exposed to various risks such as interest rate, market, and credit risks. Due to the level of risk associated with certain investment securities, it is at least reasonably possible that changes in the values of investment securities will occur in the near term and that such changes could materially affect the amounts reported in the statement of net assets available for benefits.
