



SUMMARY OF PLAN PROVISIONS

EFFECTIVE AND ANNIVERSARY DATES: This plan was effective January 1, 2021. The anniversary date is the 31st day of December.

ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY DATES: In order to be eligible to participate, an employee must have completed one (1) Year of Service and have attained age twenty-one (21). Any employee not meeting these requirements as of the Effective Date will be eligible to participate thereafter on the January 1st or July 1st coinciding with or next following the completion of these requirements. Employees whose employment is the subject of Collective Bargaining, non-resident aliens with no US Income, and leased employees are excluded from participation in the Plan.

All employees in the employ of the Employer as of January 1, 2021 were allowed into the Plan as of that date, regardless of age or service.

HYPOTHETICAL ACCOUNT: The account maintained on behalf of a participant which shall receive their Principal Credits and Interest Credits.

PRINCIPAL CREDITS: A participant who has completed at least 1,000 Hours of Service during a Plan Year (Highly Compensated Employees only) shall receive the following amount credited to his Hypothetical Account for the plan year:

INTEREST CREDIT: At the close of each plan year, a participant's Hypothetical Account shall be credited with interest based upon the balance of their Hypothetical Account less any distributions that occurred during the year. Interest shall be credited for the year based upon the lesser of 5.00% and the average of the 30 Year US Treasury Rate as released by the IRS for October, November, and December preceding the beginning of the plan year, but not less than 3.50%.

NORMAL FORM OF PENSION BENEFIT: A monthly benefit for Life.

NORMAL RETIREMENT DATE: Normal Retirement Date is the first day of the month coincident with or next following the participant's 62nd birthday.

ACTUARIAL EQUIVALENT: The term "Actuarial Equivalent" shall mean equality in value of aggregate amounts expected to be received under different forms or to different payees, computed using the Applicable Mortality Table for IRC 417 purposes and the Interest Crediting rate in effect for the Plan Year.

DEATH PRIOR TO RETIREMENT: If a participant dies prior to retirement, his beneficiary(ies) will receive the actuarial present value of the accrued benefit as of the date of the participant's death.

DISABILITY PRIOR TO RETIREMENT: If a participant becomes totally and permanently disabled, he may retire and receive his accrued benefit as of the date of termination due to such disability actuarially reduced if payments start before Normal Retirement Date.

VESTING UPON TERMINATION OF SERVICE: Should a participant terminate his employment for any reason other than retirement, disability or death, he shall receive that portion of his accrued benefit as of the date of termination, in accordance with the following schedule:

Years of Service prior to the Effective Date of the Plan, January 1, 2021, are excluded from consideration.

COST OF THE PLAN: The employer will bear the entire cost of the plan.

ACTUARIAL CERTIFICATE

We are pleased to submit this report of an actuarial valuation of the Dartmouth Dermatology Cash Balance Plan as of January 1, 2024 for the plan year January 1, 2024 to December 31, 2024. The range of contributions for the 2024 plan year is as follows:

Minimum Required Contribution under IRC 430	\$268,020
Recommended Contribution (Balance less Assets)	\$317,279
Maximum Deductible Contribution under IRC 404(o)	\$759,349

The actuarial assumptions and cost method are unchanged from those employed in the prior year's valuation with the exception of the statutorily required segment interest rates and mortality tables under IRC 430. The Plan Sponsor has elected to utilize the ARPA interest rates commencing with the 2021 plan year and to utilize the 15-Year reestablished Shortfall amortization commencing with the 2022 plan year.

This report has been prepared for the plan sponsor and his/her professional advisors in accordance with generally accepted actuarial principles and practices and, to the best of my knowledge, fairly reflects the actuarial condition of the Dartmouth Dermatology Cash Balance Plan.

The purpose of this report is to communicate the minimum required and maximum deductible contributions for the plan year. Certain assumptions used in the determination of these values and related amounts such as the Adjusted Funding Target Attainment Percentage (AFTAP), are prescribed by the Internal Revenue Code, Regulations and other official guidance, including the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA) and the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act of 2021. The prescribed mortality table and discount rates were applied in accordance with my understanding of the applicable law and regulations. In my opinion, each other assumption is reasonable both individually and in the aggregate, taking into account the experience of the plan and reasonable expectations and, in combination, offers my best estimate of anticipated experience under the plan. This report, and accompanying schedules describing the actuarial assumptions and methods employed and the principal document provisions on which the valuation is based, are complete and accurate to the best of my knowledge.

In preparing this report I have relied upon employee information provided by the Plan Sponsor and plan asset information provided by the Trustee, both as of the valuation date. In accordance with generally accepted actuarial principles and practices, I have reviewed, but not audited, this information and the data has been found to be of acceptable quality for purposes of this actuarial report.

Future actuarial measurements may differ significantly from the measurements presented in this report due to such factors as plan experience differing from that anticipated, changes in economic or demographic assumptions, and changes in plan provisions or applicable law. Due to the limited scope of this actuarial assignment, no analysis was performed of the potential range of such future measurements. In addition, determinations of the condition of the plan for other purposes, such as satisfying the reporting requirements of the Financial Accounting Standards Board, if any, and measuring the level of funding for plan termination, may require different assumptions and methods and the results may differ significantly from those presented here.

The results of this valuation are subject to the precepts of Actuarial Standard of Practice No. 51 (ASOP 51). Certain risks are always inherent in the future outcome of the Plan, including investment risk, potential future changes to pension laws and limitations, as well as the future operation of the plan sponsor. The results of this actuarial valuation prepared under IRC 430 and 404 are primarily based on interest and mortality assumptions proscribed by law on an annual basis and are not subject to material change by the plan sponsor or the actuary preparing the valuation. These rates are adjusted annually, so that there are risk changes that can occur to the Plan based on these annual changes by the IRS. A more detailed risk assessment can be performed upon request; however, such an assessment would not alter the results contained in this current year's actuarial valuation.

To the best of my knowledge, there is no conflict of interest which would impair, or appear to impair, the objectivity of my work on this assignment. If the information contained in this report is provided to others, the report should be provided in its entirety to limit the risk of misinterpretation.
