Opinion

We have audited the financial statements of The Clorox Company Group Insurance Plan for Retirees, an employee benefit plan subject to the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA), which comprise the statements of net assets available for benefits as of June 30, 2024 and 2023, and the related statements of changes in net assets available for benefits for the years then ended, and the related notes to the financial statements.

In our opinion, the accompanying financial statements present fairly, in all material respects, the net assets available for benefits of The Clorox Company Group Insurance Plan for Retirees as of June 30, 2024 and 2023, and the changes in its net assets available for benefits for the years then ended, in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America (GAAP).

Basis for Opinion

We conducted our audits in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America (GAAS). Our responsibilities under those standards are further described in the Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements section of our report. 1. Description of the Plan

General

The Clorox Company Group Insurance Plan for Retirees (“the Plan”) was established effective July 1, 2018, to provide benefits for eligible former employees (also referred to as “participants”) of The Clorox Company (“the Company”). Plan assets are held in a voluntary employees’ beneficiary association (“VEBA”) trust.

The following description of the Plan provides only general information. Participants should refer to the Plan document and the Summary Plan Descriptions (“SPDs”) for a complete description of the Plan’s provisions. The Plan is subject to the provisions of the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974, as amended (“ERISA”). The Employee Benefits Committee is established by the Company’s Board of Directors to be the plan administrator for the purpose of managing the operation and administration of the Plan.

Eligible Participants

The Plan provides health and life insurance benefits for certain retired former employees of the Company and their eligible dependents. In general, employees are eligible to participate in medical, prescription drug, dental, and vision (collectively, health insurance benefits) if they:

- are under age 65;
- were enrolled in one of the Company-sponsored plans immediately before retirement; and
- are at least 55 years old with 10 years of service or have a combined age and years of service (when added together) equaling at least 75 at the time of retirement.

Certain retired employees covered by a collective bargaining agreement, previously employed at the Company’s Cartersville location who met certain age and service requirements set forth in the collective bargaining agreement, can also participate in the Plan.

An eligible employee who retired could qualify for coverage under the retiree group basic life insurance, if such person was hired prior to January 1, 2001, and (1) was (i) at least 55 years old with at least 20 years of service or (ii) at least 65 years old with at least ten years of service; (2) attained age 65 on or before April 30, 2013; and (3) was enrolled in a Company-sponsored, post-65 group health plan as of April 30, 2013.

Effective May 1, 2013, the Plan's life insurance benefits included certain eligible retirees aged 65 and over.

Plan Benefits

The Plan provides health insurance benefits to eligible participants and their dependents and beneficiaries. The Plan also provides life insurance benefits to certain eligible employees.

Contributions

Participants contribute to the Plan in the form of monthly premiums, as determined by the Company, based on their elected benefits.

The Company subsidizes a specific portion of the monthly contributions for medical coverage for certain retired employees who meet the following conditions:

- have a most recent hire date prior to January 1, 2001
- are at least 55 years old
- have at least 20 years of service

All other benefit costs not funded by participant contributions are funded by contributions from the Company.

The Plan's benefit obligations exceeded net assets at June 30, 2024 and 2023 (see Note 3). It is expected that the net obligation will be funded through future increases in contributions from the Company and participants.

Payment of Benefits and Administrative Expenses

The payment of benefits is based on predetermined amounts and percentages as specified in the contracts with the service providers.

Benefits paid take into consideration any payments made by Medicare. Certain health insurance benefits and administrative service fees are paid from the assets held in the VEBA Trust (see below for detail). Administrative expenses, when not paid from VEBA Trust assets, are paid by the Company and are not considered to be plan expenses.

Stop-Loss Coverage

The Company has a stop-loss arrangement to limit its exposure for self-insured medical and prescription drug benefits provided under the Plan and other plans sponsored by the Company. Consequently, the Plan does not recognize stop-loss activity, and no amounts related to the arrangement are included in the financial statements.

Plan Trustee

US Bank (the “Trustee”) serves as the trustee and custodian of the VEBA Trust.

2. Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

Basis of Accounting

The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America.

The Plan’s financial statements were evaluated for subsequent events from the date after the financial statement date through March 21, 2025, the date the financial statements were available to be issued.

Investment Valuation and Income Recognition

Assets held in the VEBA Trust consist of interest-bearing cash that is held by the Trustee in a money market deposit account, which is insured by the FDIC up to coverage limits set by law. Balance at times exceeded the FDIC limit, but the Plan has not experienced any losses thereon. Interest income is recognized when earned.

Payment of Benefits

Benefits are recognized when paid.

Risks and Uncertainties

The actuarial present value of postretirement benefit obligations is reported based on certain assumptions pertaining to interest rates, health care inflation rates, and employee demographics, all of which are subject to change. Due to uncertainties inherent in the estimations and assumptions process, it is at least reasonably possible that changes in these estimates and assumptions in the near term could be material to the financial statements.

Postretirement Benefit Obligation

The postretirement benefit obligation represents the actuarial present value of those estimated future benefits that are attributed to employees' service rendered to the date of the financial statements, reduced by the actuarial present value of contributions expected to be received in the future from the current Plan participants. Postretirement benefits include future benefits expected to be paid to currently retired employees and their dependents and beneficiaries and to eligible active employees and their beneficiaries and dependents after retirement from service with the Company. Prior to an active employee's full eligibility date, the postretirement benefit obligation is the portion of the expected postretirement benefit obligation that is attributed to that employee's service rendered as of the valuation date.

The Plan's postretirement benefit obligation does not reflect an amount associated with the Medicare subsidy allowed under the Medicare Prescription Drug Improvement and Modernization Act of 2003 because neither the Plan nor the Company is entitled to the Medicare subsidy.

The actuarial present value of the expected postretirement obligation is determined by an actuary and is the amount resulting from applying actuarial assumptions to historical claims cost data to estimate future annual incurred claims costs per participant and to adjust such estimates for the time value of money (through discounts for interest) and the probability of payments (by means of

decrements such as those for death, withdrawal, or retirement) between the valuation date and the expected date of payment, and to reflect the portion of those costs expected to be borne by the retired participants, and other providers.

The postretirement benefit obligation is determined by an actuary for the aggregate pre-65 and post-65 retirees using assumptions noted below for Plan years ended June 30, 2024 and 2023.

Amounts disclosed in Note 3 pertain to both pre-65 and post-65 retiree life insurance but only the pre-65 portion of health benefits.

Future retirees that will be eligible for the Company-subsidized benefits are assumed to elect coverage at 50% for June 30, 2024 and June 30, 2023. The rate of participation is assumed to decrease each year following retirement; 85% of current and future retirees who have elected coverage in the prior year are assumed to continue participation in the next year (i.e., 15% are assumed to drop participation each year after retirement).

The foregoing assumptions are based on the presumption that the Plan will continue. If the Plan was to terminate, different actuarial assumptions and other factors would be applicable in determining the actuarial present value of the postretirement benefit obligation.

Claims Payable and Claims Incurred but Not Reported

Claims payable represent claims that are processed but unpaid at fiscal year end. Claims incurred but not reported are estimated by the Plan's actuary based on financial data provided by the service providers and the Plan's historical lag time between the date of incurrence and the date the claim is paid.

Use of Estimates

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect the amounts reported in the financial statements. Actual results could differ from those estimates.

4. Plan Termination

Although the Company has not expressed any intention to do so, it has the right under the Plan to modify the benefits provided to participants, to discontinue contributions at any time, and to terminate the Plan subject to the provisions set forth in ERISA. If the Company terminates or partially terminates the Plan, the Plan will pay benefits that participants would be entitled to receive under the terms of the Plan prior to such termination date.

5. Income Tax Status

The VEBA Trust has received a tax exemption letter from the Internal Revenue Service (the “IRS”) dated March 18, 2002, stating that the VEBA Trust is qualified under the Section 501(c)(9) of the Internal Revenue Code (the “Code”) and, therefore, the VEBA Trust’s interest income was exempt from income taxes. Subsequent to the receipt of the tax exemption letter, the VEBA Trust had various amendments. Effective July 2018, the VEBA Trust has been used solely to fund the benefits of the Plan. The Company believes that the VEBA Trust is designed and operated in accordance with the applicable requirements of the Code Section 501(c)(9).

Accounting principles generally accepted in the United States require Plan management to evaluate uncertain tax positions taken by the Plan. The financial statement effects of a tax position are recognized when the position is more likely than not, based on the technical merits, to be sustained upon examination by the IRS. The plan administrator has analyzed the tax positions taken by the Plan and has concluded that as of June 30, 2024, there are no uncertain positions taken or expected to be taken. The Plan has recognized no interest or penalties related to uncertain tax positions. The Plan is subject to routine audits by taxing jurisdictions; however, there are currently no audits for any tax periods in progress.

6. Other Contingencies

The Plan is subject to various lawsuits and claims relating to issues such as claim disputes and other matters. Although the results of claims and litigation cannot be predicted with certainty, it is the opinion of management that the ultimate disposition of these matters, to the extent not previously provided for, will not have a material adverse effect, individually or in the aggregate, on the Plan’s financial statements taken as a whole.

7. Party-in-Interest Transactions

Interest bearing cash is invested with the Trustee. Consequently, transactions with the Trustee qualify as party-in-interest transactions for which a statutory exemption exists.
