Opinion

NOTES TO FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

June 30, 2024 and 2023

NOTE 1 - DESCRIPTION OF THE PLAN

The following description of The H.T. Hackney Co. Flexible Benefits Plan (the "Plan") provides only general information. Participants should refer to the Plan Agreement for a more complete description of the Plan's provisions.

General - The Plan was established to provide health care benefits for eligible, full-time employees of The H.T. Hackney Co. and its subsidiaries (collectively, the Company or Plan Sponsor) and covered dependents. The Plan does not provide coverage for post-retirement benefits. For previous participants who are no longer employed, benefits may continue as required under federal law.

Certain plan assets are held in a voluntary employees' beneficiary association (VEBA) trust. The Plan is subject to the provisions of the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974, as amended (ERISA).

Contributions - In addition to deductibles and copayments, participants contribute specified amounts based on applicable monthly premiums for their respective benefit elections. The Company makes contributions to the Plan as needed to fund claims in excess of participants' contributions. Any deficiency of the Plan's net assets over benefit obligations is funded by the Company on a pay-as-you-go basis.

As permitted under Section 125 of the Internal Revenue Code, the Company offers a flexible benefits plan which allows participating employees to pay a designated amount of their plan contributions with pre-tax dollars.

Deposits - The Plan keeps an amount in an imprest bank account to be used to pay claims by the third-party processors.

Benefits - The Plan provides health care benefits (medical and prescription drugs). The Plan also provides continuation of certain benefits upon termination of employment through the Consolidated Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act (COBRA).

Self-Insured Benefits - All plan benefits are self-insured. The claims for self-insured benefits are processed by United Healthcare and OptumRx, the Plan's third-party claim processors under an administrative service only (ASO) arrangement. The claims processors pay claims directly to or on behalf of participants and are reimbursed by the Plan's VEBA trust. Despite the Plan's utilization of third-party claims processors, ultimate responsibility for payments to providers and participants is retained by the Plan. Claim payments are recorded when paid.

The Plan utilizes a pharmacy benefit manager (PBM) which periodically makes refunds to the Plan based on the Plan's actual utilization pattern of specific drugs.

Stop-Loss Coverage - The Plan has entered into a stop-loss insurance arrangement in an effort to limit its exposure for self-insured benefits for medical, including prescription drugs, for individual participant claims over \$300,000.

Administrative Expenses - The Plan pays administrative expenses that consist primarily of administrative fees paid to the third-party claims administrators and the trustee. These expenses are reported on the statements of changes in benefit obligations and net assets available for benefits as administrative expenses. Certain administrative expenses are paid by the Company on behalf of the Plan.

NOTE 2 - SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The following are the significant accounting policies followed by the Plan:

Basis of Accounting and Use of Estimates - The accompanying financial statements of the Plan have been prepared using the accrual basis of accounting. The preparation of financial statements in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America (GAAP) requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts of assets, liabilities, benefit obligations and changes therein, and disclosure of contingent assets and liabilities. Actual results could differ from those estimates.

Payment of Benefits - Premiums paid by either the Company or the VEBA trust are recorded as premium payments in the accompanying statement of changes in net assets available for benefits. Claim payments are recorded when paid. Amounts due that have yet to be reimbursed by the Plan are recorded as a payable in the accompanying statements of net assets available for benefits.

Income Recognition - Interest income is recorded on the accrual basis.

Benefit Obligations - Benefit obligations for incurred but not reported medical claims are estimated by the Plan's management based on historical information. The liability is based on estimates and while management believes that the amount is adequate, the ultimate obligation may be in excess or less than the amounts disclosed. Such amounts are reported at an undiscounted amount because the amounts are payable within one year. Any differences in the amounts estimated and actual amounts paid will be reported in future years.

Stop Loss - Premiums for stop loss insurance are included in excess loss insurance premiums in the accompanying statement of changes in net assets available for benefits. Stop loss reimbursement for claims in excess totaling \$4,648,923 (including the receivable of \$316,757) have been netted with claims paid in the accompanying statement of changes in benefit obligations and net assets available for benefits.

Refunds - Refunds due from the Plan's PBM which totaled \$4,583,789 are recorded when received and have been netted with claims paid on the accompanying statement of changes in benefit obligations and net assets available for benefits for the year ended June 30, 2024.

Subsequent Events - The Plan's management has evaluated subsequent events for the Plan through April 9, 2025, which is the date the financial statements were available to be issued, and has determined that there are no subsequent events that require disclosure.

NOTE 3 - CONCENTRATION OF CREDIT RISK

At various times during the year, the Plan has cash balances at a bank in excess of the FDIC federally insured limit of \$250,000. The Plan has not experienced any losses in such accounts, and Plan management believes the Plan is not exposed to any significant credit risk in this regard.

NOTE 4 - MONEY MARKET DEPOSIT ACCOUNT

The Plan has entered into a money market deposit account agreement with Regions Institutional Services ("Regions Bank"). Regions Bank uses the Regions Trust Cash Sweep ("RTCS") to ensure that all cash in the account is invested daily. As investments in the account generate cash, this cash is automatically swept into RTCS each day where the cash earns interest rather than sitting idle before being distributed or reinvested. RTCS pays a standard interest rate based on the average taxable money market 7-day yield as published by iMoneyNet, Inc. The investment objective of RTCS is to produce current income with liquidity and stable principal.

RTCS is an FDIC-insured deposit in Regions Bank. Balances in excess of the standard maximum insured amount (\$250,000 in the current year) are collateralized by marketable securities segregated by Regions Bank for purposes of securing these deposits.

There are no separate management fees associated with RTCS. The account fees based on the total market value of the account will include the RTCS assets in the calculation.

NOTE 5 - ADMINISTRATIVE CONTRACT

Medical and pharmacy claims of the Plan are administered by United Healthcare (UHC) and OptumRx, the Plan's third-party administrators under the terms of administrative contracts. The contracts require performance of services necessary for the operation and conduct of the day-to-day business of the Plan. As compensation for these services, the third parties receive a monthly fee based upon the number of participants in the Plan. During 2024, the fees paid related to these contracts were \$840,673.

NOTE 6 - INCOME TAX STATUS

The VEBA trust has received an exemption letter stating that the trust is tax exempt under the provisions of Section 501©(9) of the Internal Revenue Code (IRC), and, accordingly, the Trust's net investment income is exempt from income taxes. In addition, the Plan and the trust are required to operate in conformity with the IRC to maintain the tax-exempt status of the trust. The Plan Administrator believes that the Plan, as amended, is being operated in compliance with the applicable requirements of the IRC and, therefore, believes that the related trust is tax-exempt.

Accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America require Plan management to evaluate tax positions taken by the Plan and recognize a tax liability if the Plan has taken an uncertain position that more likely than not would not be sustained upon examination by the Internal Revenue Service. The Plan is subject to routine audits by taxing jurisdictions; however, there are currently no audits for any tax periods in progress.

NOTE 8 - RELATED PARTY AND PARTY-IN-INTEREST TRANSACTIONS

Certain Plan assets were invested in a money market deposit account held by the trustee of the Plan, Regions Bank (see Note 4). As described in Notes 1 and 5, the Plan has several arrangements with service providers. These transactions are considered party-in-interest transactions under ERISA regulations.

NOTE 9 - RISKS AND UNCERTAINTIES

The estimated benefit obligations for claims incurred but not reported is based on certain assumptions, all of which are subject to change. Due to uncertainties inherent in the estimations and assumptions process, it is at least reasonably possible that changes in these estimates and assumptions in the near term could be material to the financial statements.

NOTE 10 - PLAN TERMINATION

Although it has not expressed any intent to do so, the Plan Sponsor has the right under the Plan to modify the benefits provided to and contributions required of participants, or to discontinue its contributions at any time and to terminate the Plan subject to the provisions of ERISA. In the event of termination of the Plan, remaining assets will be applied in a uniform and nondiscriminatory manner toward the provisions of benefits for the participants. No assets of the Plan may revert to the Company or be used for purposes other than for the exclusive benefit of the Plan participants.
