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## INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT

To the Board of Trustees of  
Northern California Plasterers Health and Welfare Trust Fund:

### Report on the Audit of the Financial Statements

#### Opinion

We have audited the financial statements of Northern California Plasterers Health and Welfare Trust Fund, an employee benefit plan subject to the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 ("ERISA"), which comprise the statements of net assets available for benefits and benefit obligations as of June 30, 2024 and 2023, and the related statements of changes in net assets available for benefits and changes in benefit obligations for the years then ended, and the related notes to the financial statements.

### June 30, 2024 and 2023

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#### 1. SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

##### **Basis of Accounting**

The accompanying financial statements of Northern California Plasterers Health and Welfare Trust Fund (the "Plan") are prepared using the accrual basis of accounting in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America.

##### **Investment Valuation, Transactions and Income Recognition**

###### *General*

Investments are carried at fair value, which is determined, presented and disclosed in accordance with Financial Accounting Standards Board Accounting Standards Codification ("FASB ASC") 820, *Fair Value Measurements and Disclosures*. Under FASB ASC 820, fair value is defined as the price that would be received to sell an asset or paid to transfer a liability (i.e., the "exit price") in an orderly transaction between market participants at the measurement date.

FASB ASC 820 establishes a fair value hierarchy for inputs used in measuring fair value that maximizes the use of observable inputs and minimizes the use of unobservable inputs by requiring that the most observable inputs be used when available. Observable inputs are those that market participants would use in pricing the asset or liability based on market data obtained from sources independent of the Plan. Unobservable inputs reflect the Plan's assumptions about inputs that market participants would use in pricing the investments developed based on the best information available in the circumstances. The fair value hierarchy is categorized into three levels, based on the inputs, as follows:

*Level 1* - Valuations based on quoted prices in active markets for identical assets or liabilities that the Plan has the ability to access.

*Level 2* - Valuations based on quoted prices in markets that are not active, quoted prices for similar investments in active markets or model-based valuations for which all significant assumptions are observable and can be corroborated by observable market data.

*Level 3* - Valuations based on unobservable inputs that are supported by little or no market activity and are significant to the overall fair value measurement. Values are determined using proprietary pricing models, discounted cash flow models that include the investment entities' own judgments and estimations or some other pricing method using unobservable inputs.

###### *Inputs and Valuation Methods*

In determining fair value, FASB ASC 820 allows various valuation approaches. The specific method used for the Plan's investment class is presented below.

Mutual Funds: The fair value of mutual funds and cash equivalents is generally based on quoted prices in active markets (*Level 1*).

###### *Valuation Methods, Consistency*

The valuation techniques used in the accompanying financial statements have been consistently applied.

###### *Transactions and Income Recognition*

Purchases and sales of securities are recorded on a trade-date basis. Dividends are recorded on the ex-dividend rate. Net appreciation (depreciation) includes the Plan's gains and losses on investments bought and sold as well as held during the year. In addition, certain investment-related expenses have been included in net investment income and are not readily determinable.

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#### **Employer Contributions**

Employer contributions due and not paid prior to year-end are recorded as employer contributions receivable. Allowance for credit losses is considered unnecessary and is not provided. Contributions due as a result of payroll audits have not been recorded as collectability is uncertain. Therefore, delinquent contributions are recorded when received.

#### **Participant Contributions**

Contributions from participants are recognized as income as of the end of the month in which they are due.

#### **Current Benefit Obligations**

Current benefit obligations include claims currently payable, claims incurred but not yet reported and premiums payable. Claims paid by the claims processor prior to year-end that are not reimbursed by the Plan as of year-end are recorded as claims payable and included in claims payable and claims incurred but not reported on the statements of benefit obligations. Premiums not yet paid by the Plan related to coverage at or before year-end are included in premiums due to insurers in the statement of benefit obligations. Claims incurred but not yet reported are estimated by the Plan's administrator based on claims experience. These amounts are paid by the Plan only if claims are submitted and approved for payment.

#### **Accumulated Eligibility Credits**

Accumulated eligibility credits include the Plan's estimated liability as of June 30, 2024 and 2023, for group insurance premiums and self-funded claims. The liability is based on actual premiums, claims and related administrative expenses for eligibility earned as of June 30, 2024 and 2023, to provide coverage for July through September.

Accumulated eligibility credits also include the Plan's estimated "bank" liability as of June 30, 2024 and 2023, which was based upon the total number of months of eligibility banked as of June 30, multiplied by the estimated monthly cost to provide benefits.

#### **Estimates**

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect certain reported amounts and disclosures in the financial statements. Actual results could differ from those estimates.

#### **Accounting Pronouncements Currently Adopted**

In June 2016, the FASB issued an Accounting Standards Update ("ASU") amending the accounting for credit losses on financial statements. This methodology replaced the incurred loss methodology with the expected credit losses using a wide range of reasonable and supportable information. The amendment affects loans, debt securities, trade receivables, net investments in leases, off-balance-sheet credit exposure and other financial instruments recorded at amortized cost.

The Plan adopted the new standard effective July 1, 2023, using the modified retrospective approach. Comparative prior periods were not adjusted upon adoption. Upon adoption, there was no cumulative-effect adjustment to the opening fund balance.

#### **Risks and Uncertainties**

The actuarial present value of post-retirement benefit obligations is calculated based on certain assumptions pertaining to interest rates, participant demographics and other assumptions, all of which are subject to change. Due to the inherent uncertainty of the assumption process, it is at least reasonably possible that changes in these assumptions in the near term would be material to the disclosure to the financial statements of the actuarial present value of post-retirement benefit obligations.

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The Plan invests in mutual fund securities. Such investments are exposed to various risks, such as market and credit risks. Due to the level of risk associated with certain investments and the level of uncertainty with respect to changes in the value of investments, it is at least reasonably possible that changes in risks in the near term would materially affect amounts reported in the statements of net assets available for benefits and the statements of changes in net assets available for benefits.

**2. DESCRIPTION OF THE PLAN**

The Plan was established during 1953, as a result of collective bargaining agreements. The Plan covers the employees in the collective bargaining units represented by the Plasterers and Cement Masons Local Union No. 300 and the Plasterers and Shophands' Local Union No. 66, as well as the Wall and Ceiling Alliance and various associations of employers engaging in the plastering industry in Northern California. The Plan is a multiemployer plan and is subject to the provisions of the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 ("ERISA"), as amended.

The Plan provides health benefits through insured arrangements with Kaiser, Blue Shield, Lincoln National Life Insurance Company and ChiroMetrics. The Plan provides vision and dental benefits through self-funded benefit arrangements with VSP and Delta Dental. Effective July 1, 2023, the Plan no longer provides dental benefits through insured arrangements with Premier Access. The Plan provides benefits to full-time participants who work at least 105 hours in a month. Retirees of the participating unions are entitled to similar health benefits; however, covered retired members retiring before July 1, 2014, are required to reimburse the Plan for the portion of monthly insurance premiums that exceed \$150. Covered retired members retiring on or after July 1, 2014, are required to pay the full premium. The Plan also provides for self-funded benefits for eligible participants for vision, dental and hearing aids.

The Plan provides eligibility on a double skip-month method whereby hours worked in one month are utilized to provide coverage for benefits starting the first day of the following third month. Hours reported in excess of those necessary to provide an active employee with monthly coverage are accumulated in a "bank" to provide eligibility during periods of unemployment or disability. During the years ended June 30, 2024 and 2023, the maximum "bank" allowed under the Plan was four months of eligibility.

Members of the former Plastering Industry Health and Welfare Trust Fund are eligible to participate in the Points Program. This program establishes individual accounts for members, with the primary objective of having the accounts available for retiree premium use or other uncovered expenses. Each participant's account is credited with \$0.50 per hour for each hour worked for employers and allocations of earnings and losses from point account assets. Allocations are based on participant account balances as defined by the Plan document. As of June 30, 2024 and 2023, participant account balances totaled approximately \$4,078,000 and \$3,766,000, respectively. Forfeitures of participant accounts are used to offset Plan expenses or reduce future employer contributions. During the years ended June 30, 2024 and 2023, the participant accounts balance forfeited totaled approximately \$37,000 and \$35,000, respectively. Participants should refer to the Points Program document for a more complete description of provisions.

The trustees have established a self-funded deductible or Health Reimbursement Arrangement ("HRA") for participants enrolled in the Kaiser HMO Plan (the "HRA Plan"). Participants are issued a debit card, and the Plan pays up to \$2,000 per participant or \$4,000 per participant family for amounts charged through Kaiser, including any deductibles or co-pays. Cash held as of June 30, 2024 and 2023, includes \$80,219 and \$65,542, respectively, of amounts held in the HRA account. For the years ended June 30, 2024 and 2023, approximately \$577,000 and \$631,000, respectively, were charged to the HRA account by participants. As of June 30, 2024 and 2023, approximately \$2,041,000 and \$3,035,000, respectively, remain in participant account balances. Any unused balance as of December each year will be forfeited and used to pay the general expenses of the Plan.

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As of June 30, 2024 and 2023, the commitments by the Plan for both the Points Program and HRA Plan totaled approximately \$6,119,000 and \$6,801,000, respectively, which were included in the net assets available for benefits as of June 30, 2024 and 2023.

The cost of the post-retirement benefits is shared by the Plan's participating employers and retirees. In addition to deductibles and co-payments, for the years ended June 30, 2024 and 2023, 44% and 41% respectively, of the estimated costs of providing post-retirement benefits in the current and prior year are through retiree contributions.

Participants should refer to the summary plan description and recent Plan amendments for more complete information.

### **3. PRIORITIES UPON TERMINATION**

It is the intent of the trustees to continue the Plan in full force and effect; however, the right to discontinue the Plan is reserved to the trustees. In the event of termination, the net assets of the Plan will be allocated to pay benefits in priorities as prescribed by ERISA and its related regulations. Termination shall not permit any part of the Plan's assets to be used for, or diverted to, purposes other than the exclusive benefit of the participants.

### **4. TAX STATUS**

The Plan obtained its latest determination letter, issued in April 1976, in which the Internal Revenue Service stated that the Plan, as then designed, was in compliance with the applicable requirements under the provisions of Section 501(c)(9) of the Internal Revenue Code and was, therefore, exempt from federal income taxes under the provisions of Section 501(c). The Plan has been amended since receiving the determination letter. However, the Plan's administrator and the Plan's counsel believe that the Plan is currently designed and being operated in compliance with the applicable requirements of the Internal Revenue Code. Therefore, they believe that the Plan and the related trust continue to be tax exempt as of the financial statement date.

The Plan's administrator has analyzed the tax positions taken by the Plan and has concluded that, as of June 30, 2024 and 2023, there are no uncertain positions taken, or expected to be taken, that would require recognition of a liability or disclosure in the financial statements. The Plan is subject to routine audits by the taxing jurisdictions; however, there are currently no audits for any tax periods in progress.

### **5. FUNDING POLICY**

The Plan is financed by contributions from employers and retirees and from members electing COBRA coverage. The contribution rates are established annually by the Board of Trustees based, in part, upon studies and recommendations by the Plan's consultant and on the applicable collective bargaining agreements.

### **6. POST-RETIREMENT BENEFIT OBLIGATIONS**

The amount reported as post-retirement benefit obligations represents the actuarial present value of those estimated future benefits that are attributed by the terms of the Plan to employees' service rendered to the date of the financial statements, reduced by the actuarial present value of contributions expected to be received in the future from current Plan participants. Post-retirement benefits include future benefits expected to be paid to or for (1) currently retired or terminated employees and their beneficiaries and dependents, and (2) active employees and their beneficiaries and dependents after retirement from service with the participating employers. Prior to an active employee's full eligibility date, the post-retirement benefit obligation is the portion of the expected post-retirement benefit obligation that is attributed to that employee's service in the industry rendered to the valuation date.

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The actuarial present value of the expected post-retirement benefit obligation is determined by an actuary and is the amount that results from applying actuarial assumptions to historical claims cost data to estimate future annual incurred claims costs per participant and to adjust such estimates for the time value of money (through discounts for interest) and the probability of payment (by means of decrements such as those for death, disability, withdrawal or retirement) between the valuation date and the expected date of payment.

The trend rate assumption has a significant effect on the amounts reported in the accompanying financial statements. If the assumed rates increased by one percentage point in each year, it would increase the post-retirement benefit obligations as of June 30, 2024 and 2023, by \$501,825 and \$489,177, respectively.

Some of the more significant actuarial assumptions used to calculate the post-retirement benefit obligations at June 30, 2024 and 2023, are as follows:

**Mortality rates**

Healthy participants: 95% of the Pri-2012 Blue Collar Healthy Retiree Headcount-weighted Mortality Tables, projected generationally with the two-dimensional mortality improvement scale MP-2021.

Disabled participants: 95% of the Pri-2012 Disabled Retiree Headcount-weighted Mortality Tables, projected generationally with the two-dimensional mortality improvement scale MP-2021.

**Health care trend rates**

2024: 7.75% graded to 4.50% over thirteen years.  
 2023: 8.00% graded to 4.50% over fourteen years.

**Discount rate**

2024: 5.25% per annum.  
 2023: 4.75% per annum.

The statement of changes in benefit obligations for the year ended June 30, 2024, includes a decrease of approximately \$346,506 for changes in actuarial assumptions. This decrease was primarily the result of an increase in the discount rate from 4.75% to 5.25%. Other changes include updating the retiree contribution rates. The discount rate is reset each year based on the rates of return on high-quality fixed-income investments currently available as of the valuation measurement date whose cash flows match the timing and amount of expected benefit payments.

**7. CASH CONCENTRATIONS**

The Plan places its cash with financial institutions. The balances are insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation for up to \$250,000 per institution. Cash balances regularly exceeded the insured deposit limits. Cash at June 30, 2024 and 2023, consists of the following:

Any loss incurred or a lack of access to such funds could have a significant adverse impact on the Plan's financial condition, result of operation and cash flows.

**8. RELATED-PARTY TRANSACTIONS**

Employer contributions for the various Northern California Plasterers Trust Funds are initially deposited into a transit account held by the Plan. Contributions are then allocated and transferred to the various plans based on hours worked by Plan participants. The Plan is related to the various Northern California Plasterers Trust Funds through common officers and trustees.

As of June 30, 2024 and 2023, contributions allocated but not yet transferred totaled \$1,873,431 and \$1,836,641, respectively, and are included with cash in the statements of net assets available for benefits.

The Plan pays fees for several arrangements with service providers and affiliated entities. These transactions are considered exempt party in interest transactions under ERISA.

During the year ended June 30, 2024, some employer contributions were deposited to the Northern California Plasterers Pension Trust Fund instead of to the transit account held by the Plan. As a result, \$253,972 was due from the Pension Trust as of June 30, 2024.
