INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT

To the Administrator of the
Brentwood Academy 403(b) Defined Contribution Plan

Scope and Nature of the ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) Audit

We have performed an audit of the financial statements of the Brentwood Academy 403(b) Defined Contribution Plan, an employee benefit plan subject to the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA), as permitted by ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) (ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) audit). The financial statements comprise the statements of net assets available for benefits (modified cash basis) as of June 30, 2024 and 2023, and the related statement of changes in net assets available for benefits (modified cash basis) for the year ended June 30, 2024, and the related notes to the financial statements.

Management, having determined it is permissible in the circumstances, has elected to have the audits of the Brentwood Academy 403(b) Defined Contribution Plan's financial statements performed in accordance with ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) pursuant to 29 CFR 2520.103-8 of the Department of Labor's Rules and Regulations for Reporting and Disclosure under ERISA. As permitted by ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C), our audits need not extend to any statements or information related to assets held for investment of the plan (investment information) by a bank or similar institution or insurance carrier that is regulated, supervised, and subject to periodic examination by a state or federal agency, provided that the statements or information regarding assets so held are prepared and certified to by the bank or similar institution or insurance carrier in accordance with 29 CFR 2520.103-5 of the Department of Labor's Rules and Regulations for Reporting and Disclosure under ERISA (qualified institution).

Management has obtained certifications from qualified institutions as of and for the years ended June 30, 2024 and 2023, stating that the certified investment information, as described in Note 7 to the financial statements, is complete and accurate.

Opinion

In our opinion, based on our audits and on the procedures performed as described in the Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements section -

- the information in the financial statements related to assets held by and certified to by a qualified institution agrees to, or is derived from, in all material respects, the information prepared and certified by an institution that management determined meets the requirements of ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C).

Basis for Opinion

We conducted our audits in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America (GAAS). Our responsibilities under those standards are further described in the Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements section of our report. We are required to be independent of the Brentwood Academy 403(b) Defined Contribution Plan and to meet our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with the relevant ethical requirements relating to our audit. We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) audit opinion.

Basis of Accounting

We draw attention to Note 2 of the financial statements, which describes the basis of accounting. The financial statements and supplemental schedule are prepared on the modified cash basis of accounting, which is a basis of accounting other than accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America. Our opinion is not modified with respect to that matter.

Responsibilities of Management for the Financial Statements

Management is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of these financial statements in accordance with the modified cash basis of accounting described in Note 2, and for the design, implementation, and maintenance of internal control relevant to the preparation and fair presentation of financial statements that are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error. Management's election of the ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) audit does not affect management's responsibility for the financial statements.

Notes to Financial Statements (Modified Cash Basis)

June 30, 2024 and 2023

(1) Description of Plan

The following description of the Brentwood Academy (“the Academy”) 403(b) Retirement Plan (“the Plan”) provides only general information. Participants should refer to the Plan agreement for a more complete description of the Plan's provisions.

(a) General

The Plan is a defined contribution 403(b) plan covering all employees of the Academy who are age twenty-one or older and employed to work 1,000 hours or more each year.

(b) Contributions

Participants may contribute a percentage of their annual wages up to the legal limit. Contributions are subject to certain limitations. The Academy may make matching and/or basic contributions to the Plan. The amount of contributions made by the Academy is within the Academy’s discretion and may vary. The Academy has elected to match 100% of salary deferrals that do not exceed 3% of compensation.

(c) Participant Accounts

Each participant’s account is credited with the participant’s contribution and an allocation of the Academy’s contribution, forfeitures of terminated participants’ non-vested accounts, and plan earnings. All assets in the Plan are subject to participant investment direction.

(d) Vesting

Vesting in the Academy’s contribution to participants’ accounts plus earnings thereon is based on a participant’s years of continuous service as follows:

(f) Forfeitures

If participants end employment before they are 100% vested in their account, the non-vested portion of the account is forfeited. Forfeitures are used to offset part of the Academy's required contributions to the Plan.

(g) Notes Receivable from Participants

Participants may borrow from their accounts a minimum of \$1,000 up to a maximum equal to the lesser of 50% of the participant's vested account value or \$50,000, reduced by any outstanding loan balance, if any, in the previous 12-month period ending on the day before the new loan is made, if less. Participants are limited to three or fewer outstanding loans at a time. An initial loan origination fee of \$75 is charged to the participant's account when the loan is originated. General purpose loans range from 1 to 5 years or up to 10 years for the purchase of a principal residence. Principal and interest are paid ratably through payroll deductions or through ACH payments. Participant loans are secured by the vested balances in the participants' accounts and are interest bearing at rates commensurate with prevailing rates available for similar loans from commercial lending institutions. At June 30, 2024, interest rates on outstanding participant loans range from 4.25% to 9.50% with maturities through June, 2028.

(2) Summary of Accounting Policies

(a) Basis of Accounting

The financial statements of the Plan are prepared under the modified cash basis method of accounting.

(b) Investment Valuation

The Plan's investments are stated at fair value. If available, quoted market prices are used to value investments.

(c) Date of Management's Review

Subsequent events were evaluated through April 14, 2025, which is the date the financial statements were available to be issued.

(3) Disclosures about Fair Value of Financial Instruments

The Plan's investments are reported at fair value in the accompanying statement of net assets available for benefits. The methods used to measure fair value may produce an amount that may not be indicative of net realizable value or reflective of future values. Furthermore, although the Plan believes its valuation methods are appropriate and consistent with other market participants, the use of different methodologies or assumptions to determine the fair value of certain financial instruments could result in a different fair value measurement at the reporting date.

The fair value measurement accounting literature establishes a fair value hierarchy that prioritizes the inputs to valuation techniques used to measure fair value. This hierarchy consists of three broad levels:

- Level 1:** Quoted price (unadjusted) for identical assets or liabilities in active markets that the entity has the ability to access as of the measurement date.
- Level 2:** Observable inputs other than Level 1 prices such as quoted prices for similar assets or liabilities; quoted prices in markets that are not active; or other inputs that are observable or can be corroborated by observable market data for substantially the full term of the assets or liabilities.
- Level 3:** Unobservable inputs that reflect a reporting entity's own assumptions about the assumptions that market participants would use in pricing an asset or liability.

(3) Disclosures about Fair Value of Financial Instruments, Continued

Fully benefit-responsive investment contracts are reported at contract value on the statements of net assets available for benefits. Benefit responsiveness is defined as the extent to which a contract's terms and the Plan permit or require participant initiated withdrawals at contract value. Contract value is the relevant measure for fully benefit-responsive investment contracts because this is the amount received by participants if they were to initiate permitted transactions under the terms of the Plan. Contract value represents participant contributions, plus earnings at guaranteed crediting rates, less participant withdrawals and administrative expenses.

(4) Plan Termination

Although it has not expressed any intent to do so, the Academy has the right under the Plan to discontinue its contributions at any time and to terminate the Plan subject to the provisions of ERISA. In the event of Plan termination, each participant becomes 100% vested in the aggregate value of his or her account regardless of each participants current vesting percentage.

(5) Reconciliation of Financial Statements to Form 5500

There are no differences between the reported amounts per the Form 5500 and the financial statements.

(6) Tax Status

The “Basic Plan Document” was developed by the Plan’s trustees and submitted to the Internal Revenue Service for qualification as a “prototype” qualified money purchase pension plan and trust. Although a determination letter has not been requested specifically for this Plan, the Plan’s trustees believe that the Plan is currently designed and operated in compliance with the applicable requirements of the Internal Revenue Code. The “prototype” plan is subject to periodic restatement in order to incorporate language associated with legislative pronouncements.

The Plan’s tax submissions are generally subject to federal authority examinations within three years of the date they are filed.

(8) Risks and Uncertainties

The Plan invests in various investment securities. Investment securities are exposed to various risks such as interest rate, market, and credit risks. Due to the level of risk associated with certain investment securities, it is at least reasonably possible that changes in the values of investment securities will occur in the near term and that such changes could materially affect participants' account balances and the amounts reported in the statement of net assets available for benefits.

(9) Related Party Transactions

Certain of the Plan's investments are represented by various funds managed by TIAA, VALIC and AUL. As TIAA, VALIC and AUL are trustees as defined by the Plan, transactions between the Plan and the trustees qualify as party-in-interest transactions.

All identified party-in-interest transactions are exempt from the prohibited transactions rules of ERISA.
