## Independent Auditors' Report

***Scope and Nature of the ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) Audit***

We have performed audits of the financial statements of Manhattanville College 403(b) Retirement Plan (the "Plan"), an employee benefit plan subject to the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 ("ERISA"), as permitted by ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) ("ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) audit"). The financial statements comprise the statements of net assets available for benefits (modified cash basis) as of December 31, 2024 and 2023, and the related statement of changes in net assets available for benefits (modified cash basis) for the year ended December 31, 2024, and the related notes to the financial statements.

Management, having determined it is permissible in the circumstances, has elected to have the audits of the Plan's financial statements performed in accordance with ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) pursuant to 29 CFR 2520.103-8 of the Department of Labor's ("DOL") Rules and Regulations for Reporting and Disclosure under ERISA. As permitted by ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C), our audits need not extend to any statements or information related to assets held for investment of the Plan (investment information) by a bank or similar institution or insurance carrier that is regulated, supervised, and subject to periodic examination by a state or federal agency, provided that the statements or information regarding assets so held are prepared and certified to by the bank or similar institution or insurance carrier in accordance with 29 CFR 2520.103-5 of the Department of Labor's Rules and Regulations for Reporting and Disclosure under ERISA (qualified institutions).

Management has obtained certifications from qualified institutions as of December 31, 2024 and 2023, and for the year ended December 31, 2024, stating that the certified investment information, as described in Note 3 to the financial statements, is complete and accurate.

### ***Opinion***

In our opinion, based on our audits and on the procedures performed as described in the Auditors' Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements section:

- The amounts and disclosures in the financial statements referred to above, other than those agreed to or derived from the certified investment information, are presented fairly, in all material respects, in accordance with the modified cash basis of accounting described in Note 2.
- The information in the financial statements referred to above related to assets held by and certified to by the qualified institutions agree to, or is derived from, in all material respects, the information prepared and certified by institutions that management determined meets the requirements of ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C).

***Basis for Opinion***

We conducted our audits in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America (“GAAS”). Our responsibilities under those standards are further described in the Auditors’ Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements section of our report. We are required to be independent of the Plan and to meet our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with the relevant ethical requirements relating to our audits. We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) audit opinion.

***Emphasis of Matter - Basis of Accounting***

We draw attention to Note 2 of the financial statements, which describes the basis of accounting. The financial statements are prepared on the modified cash basis of accounting, which is a basis of accounting other than accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America. Our opinion is not modified with respect to this matter.

***Responsibilities of Management for the Financial Statements***

Management is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of the financial statements in accordance with the modified cash basis of accounting described in Note 2, and for determining that the modified cash basis of accounting is an acceptable basis for the preparation of financial statements in the circumstances. Management is also responsible for the design, implementation, and maintenance of internal control relevant to the preparation and fair presentation of financial statements that are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error. Management’s election of the ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) audit does not affect management’s responsibility for the financial statements.

Management is also responsible for maintaining a current Plan instrument, including all Plan amendments; administering the Plan; and determining that the Plan’s transactions that are presented and disclosed in the financial statements are in conformity with the Plan’s provisions, including maintaining sufficient records with respect to each of the participants, to determine the benefits due or which may become due to such participants.

***Auditors’ Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements***

Accordingly, the objective of an ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) audit is not to express an opinion about whether the financial statements as a whole are presented fairly, in all material respects, in accordance with the modified cash basis of accounting.

We are required to communicate with those charged with governance regarding, among other matters, the planned scope and timing of the audit, significant audit findings, and certain internal control-related matters that we identified during the audit.

**1. Description of Plan**

The following description of the Manhattanville College 403(b) Retirement Plan (the "Plan") provides only general information. Participants should refer to the Plan agreement for a more complete description of the Plan's provisions.

***General***

The Plan is a defined contribution plan covering substantially all employees of Manhattanville College (the "College" or "Employer"). An employee will be eligible to make employee elective deferrals to the Plan as soon as administratively feasible following their date of hire. After completing one year of service and attainment of at least 1,000 hours of service the employee becomes eligible to receive Employer contributions. Employees that are students enrolled and attending classes offered by the College are not eligible to participate in the Plan. The Plan is subject to the provisions of the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 ("ERISA").

Effective July 1, 2025, the Plan was amended to change the name of the plan sponsor from Manhattanville College to Manhattanville University. In addition, effective on the same date, the Plan name will change from Manhattanville College 403(b) Retirement Plan to Manhattanville University 403(b) Retirement Plan.

***Contributions***

Participants may elect to have a percentage or specified dollar amount deducted from their compensation as defined by the Plan. The money that is deducted is "pre-tax" dollars. Effective July 1, 2015, the Plan was amended to allow participants to make Roth contributions to the Plan, which are made with post-tax contributions. Effective August 1, 2015, each eligible employee is required to make mandatory participant contributions to the Plan as a condition of employment. The mandatory contribution amount is 2.5% of a participant's eligible compensation, which will be withheld on a pre-tax basis. A participant may elect to increase, decrease or suspend deductions according to procedures established by the College. There is an annual limit as to the amount that can be deducted from compensation that is determined by the Internal Revenue Code ("IRC"). Participants may also contribute amounts representing distributions from other qualified plans.

For each year that a participant makes participant contributions, the College will make a matching contribution. The College will make a matching contribution equal to 3.5% of the participant's qualifying compensation if the participant makes a contribution of 2.5% or more of their qualifying compensation.

The Plan permits a discretionary Employer matching contribution in an amount to be determined annually. For 2024, the College did not make a discretionary Employer matching contribution to the Plan.

***Vesting***

A participant is 100% vested in their contributions and Employer contributions including allocated earnings thereon at all times.

Allocations are based on a participant's earnings, account balances, or specific participant transactions, as defined. All investments are participant directed.

***Payment of Benefits***

Upon termination of service due to death, disability, retirement or other reason, or due to financial hardship a participant is entitled to receive a distribution in the amount equal to the value of the participant's vested interest in his or her account.

***Notes Receivable from Participants***

The Plan offers a loan feature whereby a participant (borrower) enrolled in the Plan may borrow a minimum amount of \$1,000 up to a maximum amount of 50% of their vested account balance or \$50,000 (whichever is less). Participants may not have more than three outstanding loans at a time. The interest rate is based on the prime rate plus 1%. Loans must be repaid within five years, unless the loan is used to purchase a participant's principal residence or the participant is on authorized leave for military service for a period which extends the maturity date of the loan beyond five years.

***Loans to Participants/Collateralized Assets***

Loans with Teachers Insurance and Annuity Association of America ("TIAA") are issued directly from funds owned by TIAA and not directly from a participant's account. Interest and principal are paid by the participant directly to TIAA. The loans are not considered assets of the Plan and, therefore, are not reported in the statements of net assets available for benefits. Adequate security is required and a portion of the participant's account is reserved, or held as collateral, to cover 110% of the outstanding loan in case of default. The collateral for the loan is maintained as part of the participant's TIAA Traditional Annuity account. The collateral securing the loan continues to earn interest. The collateralized balance is not available for transfer, withdrawal, retirement income benefits or survivor benefits.

The loan interest rate for these loans may be fixed or variable and the initial rate is determined by the terms of the controlling contract, as are the rate adjustment details and frequency. Principal repayments are transferred to the investment options chosen under the terms of the Plan.

***Loans to Participants/Collateralized Assets (continued)***

At December 31, 2024 and 2023, there were 23 and 44 loans outstanding with total principal balances due of \$140,409 and \$218,771 which also represents a collateralization of participant accounts. Of these loan balances, 9 and 10 of them amounting to \$110,480 and \$141,838 were in default as of December 31, 2024 and 2023. Interest rates on these loans ranged from 4.00% to 5.73% with maturities through 2028 at December 31, 2024 and 2023.

***Other Income - Revenue Credit Account***

The Plan and TIAA entered into a revenue sharing arrangement whereby a portion of the revenue earned from certain funds is passed through to the Plan for payment of permitted plan expenses. In order for the Plan to receive credits as a result of this revenue sharing arrangement, and to use this credit to pay Plan expenses, the Plan created the Revenue Credit Account under the Plan. The Revenue Credit Account is an account within the Plan and is used to record the redistribution of Plan-generated fund revenue that exceeds the costs associated with Plan administration. The Revenue Credit Account balance was \$11,094 and \$2,721 at December 31, 2024 and 2023. During 2024, \$26,000 was used to pay Plan expenses and no amounts were allocated from the Revenue Credit Account to participants of the Plan.

**2. Summary of Significant Accounting Policies**

***Basis of Accounting***

The accounts of the Plan are maintained, and the accompanying financial statements have been prepared, on the modified cash basis; investment income is recognized when received and disbursements are recognized when made, except for investments which are reflected at fair value. Accordingly, the financial statements are not intended to present the net assets available for benefits and changes in net assets available for benefits of the Plan in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America ("U.S. GAAP").

***Use of Estimates***

The preparation of financial statements requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts of assets and liabilities and changes therein, and disclosure of contingent assets and liabilities. Actual results could differ from those estimates.

***Fair Value Measurements***

The Plan follows U.S. GAAP guidance on *Fair Value Measurements* which defines fair value and establishes a fair value hierarchy organized into three levels based upon the input assumptions used in pricing assets. Level 1 inputs have the highest reliability and are related to assets with unadjusted quoted prices in active markets. Level 2 inputs relate to assets with other than quoted prices in active markets which may include quoted prices for similar assets or liabilities or other inputs which can be corroborated by observable market data. Level 3 inputs are unobservable and are used to the extent that observable inputs do not exist.

***Fair Value Measurements (continued)***

Pursuant to U.S. GAAP guidance, alternative investments where fair value is measured using the Net Asset Value (“NAV”) per share as a practical expedient are not categorized within the fair value hierarchy.

***Notes Receivable from Participants***

Notes receivable from participants are measured at their unpaid principal balance plus any accrued but unpaid interest. If a participant ceases to make loan repayments and a distributable event occurs (retirement, termination, death), the participant loan balance is reduced and a benefit payment is recorded. Until a distributable event occurs, the loan will continue to have a balance and accrue interest.

***Investment Valuation and Income Recognition***

The TIAA Traditional Annuity Account is an unallocated contract. Contract value equals the accumulated cash contributions, interest credited to the Plan’s contracts, and transfers in (if any), less any withdrawals and transfers out (if any). The contract value, which is derived from a discounted cash flow analysis and other factors, approximates fair value. The TIAA Stable Value is a group annuity product issued by TIAA and is valued at contract value less any withdrawals and transfers out (if any). Investments in registered investment companies are stated at fair value as determined by quoted market prices, which represents the net asset value of shares held by the Plan at year end. The pooled separate account is valued at the NAV of units held by the Plan. The NAV, as provided by TIAA, is used as a practical expedient to estimate fair value. The NAV based on the fair value of the underlying investments held by the fund less its liabilities. The practical expedient is not used when it is determined to be probable that the fund will sell the investment for an amount different than the reported NAV.

Purchase and sales of securities are recorded on a trade-date basis. Interest and dividends are recorded when received. Net appreciation in value of investments includes the Plan’s gains and losses on investments bought and sold as well as held during the year.

***Payment of Benefits***

Benefits are recorded when paid.

***Expenses***

Expenses relating to investment management are paid directly by the respective investment vehicle and are included as a reduction to net appreciation in value of investments. Other administrative expenses of the Plan are generally paid by the College.

***Subsequent Events Evaluation by Management***

Management has evaluated subsequent events for disclosure and/or recognition in the financial statements through the date that the financial statements were available to be issued, which date is June 16, 2025.

**3. Information Certified (Unaudited)**

Certain information related to investments and notes receivable from participants disclosed in the accompanying financial statements (modified cash basis) and ERISA-required Schedule H, Part IV, Line 4i – Schedule of Assets (Held at End of Year) (modified cash basis), including investments and notes receivable from participants held at December 31, 2024 and 2023, and interest and dividends, net appreciation in value of investments, and interest on notes receivable from participants for the year ended December 31, 2024, was obtained by management and agreed to or derived from information certified as complete and accurate by TIAA and the College Retirement Equities Fund (“CREF”), qualified institutions.

TIAA has been authorized by TIAA Trust, N.A. to certify the investments and investment information for which TIAA Trust, N.A. held as directed trustee and custodian.

***TIAA Traditional Annuity Account***

The TIAA Traditional Annuity Account is comprised of six types of contracts. The fully benefit responsive contracts are: the Group Supplemental Retirement Annuity ("GSRA"), the Supplemental Retirement Annuity ("SRA"), and the Retirement Choice Plus ("RCP") contracts. The non benefit responsive contracts are: the Group Retirement Annuity, the Retirement Annuity ("RA") and the Retirement Choice contracts. The Plan utilizes the GSRA, SRA and RCP contracts, which are reported at contract value, and the RA contracts, which are reported at fair value. Contract value approximates a discounted cash flow value calculated using a risk-adjusted market discount rate which correlates closely with the TIAA Traditional Annuity Account's historical crediting rates. Unobservable inputs include the risk-adjusted discount rate applied and the range of significant input values are as follows: GSRA – 3.00%-5.75%; SRA – 3.00%-5.75%; RCP – 3.15%-6.00%; and RA – 3.65%-6.50%.

Under GSRA and SRA contracts, withdrawals and transfers are allowed at any time without any restrictions or charges. Under RCP contracts, lump-sum withdrawals and transfers are allowed at any time without any surrender charges. Certain RCP contracts impose a 90-day equity wash rule. Under RA contracts, lump-sum withdrawals are not allowed and all withdrawals and transfers must be paid in ten annual installments.

***TIAA Traditional Annuity Account (continued)***

The contracts use the vintage method to credit interest to the TIAA Traditional Annuity Account. Vintages are time periods that represent when money was initially invested in the TIAA Traditional Annuity Account and corresponding interest rate during that distinct time period. The Vintage method recognizes the fact that the level of prevailing interest rates available on new long-term investments will vary over time and that as the long-term investments in a specific vintage mature, they will be reinvested at different rates. When funds flow into the TIAA Traditional Annuity Account, they are immediately invested at the prevailing pay-in-rate for new money. The funds earn interest at the prevailing vintage rates. The vintage will always consist of two parts: the guaranteed portion and the discretionary portion. The guaranteed portion represents the minimum amount of interest that will be credited to an account, regardless of the economic environment. The discretionary portion represents interest earned over and above the guaranteed rate.

The TIAA Traditional Annuity Account represents approximately 26% and 29% of the Plan's net assets available for benefits as of December 31, 2024 and 2023, and represents an obligation from TIAA to repay as amounts come due. The credit risk of the issuer was evaluated by nationally recognized statistical rating agencies as follows: Moody's Investors Service (Aa1 as of October 2024), Standard and Poor's (AA+ as of May 2024), A.M. Best (A++ as of July 2024), and Fitch Ratings (AAA as of August 2024). The plan administrator does not believe that any events would limit the Plan's ability to transact at contract value.

***TIAA Stable Value***

TIAA Stable Value (the "SV Contract") is a benefit-responsive guaranteed annuity contract issued by TIAA. Participants who are invested in the SV Contract receive a guaranteed minimum rate of interest which will always be between 1% and 3%. Declared crediting rates are reviewed and may be reset every six months (on January 1 or July 1). TIAA guarantees that the declared crediting rate will not decline by more than 0.75% each time it is reset. Since the SV Contract is liquid, withdrawals and transfers are paid without any surrender charges or adjustments based on market fluctuations. During the accumulation phase, the SV Contract is structured as a separate account of TIAA. If the separate account's assets are insufficient to meet the guarantees in the accumulation phase, the TIAA Stable Value is backed by the financial strength and claims-paying ability of TIAA.

***TIAA Real Estate Account***

The TIAA Real Estate Account generally invests in real estate properties and real estate-related investments. The TIAA Real Estate Account's value is principally derived from the market value of the underlying real estate holdings or other real estate-related investments as well as such liquid fixed-income investments. Real estate holdings are valued principally using external appraisals, which are estimates of property values based on a professional's opinion. The fixed income securities are generally priced using quoted prices in active markets or values obtained from independent pricing sources. While redemptions from the TIAA Real Estate Account may occur daily, transfers out are limited to one per calendar quarter.

**5. Plan Termination**

Although it has not expressed any intent to do so, the College has the right under the Plan to discontinue its contributions at any time and to terminate the Plan subject to the provisions of ERISA.

**6. Tax Status**

On August 7, 2017, the Internal Revenue Service (“IRS”) issued an opinion letter to the prototype document preparer indicating that the Plan, as then designed, qualifies under Section 403(b) of the IRC. The College believes that the Plan is currently designed and being operated in compliance with the applicable requirements of the IRC.

U.S. GAAP requires Plan management to evaluate tax positions taken by the Plan and recognize a tax liability if the Plan has taken an uncertain position that more likely than not would not be sustained upon examination by the IRS. The Plan is subject to routine examination by taxing jurisdictions; however, there are currently no examinations for any tax periods in progress.

**7. Party-in-Interest Transactions**

Certain investments are managed by TIAA and CREF. TIAA is the record-keeper and a custodian and CREF is a custodian for the Plan. Therefore, these transactions qualify as exempt party-in-interest transactions under ERISA.

Participants who are active employees may borrow from their accounts and such loans qualify as exempt party-in-interest transactions under ERISA. These loans are recorded as notes receivable from participants in the statements of net assets available for benefits.

**8. Prohibited Transactions**

The College failed to remit to the Plan certain participants’ contributions totaling \$135 for 2024 and \$7,688 for 2023 within the period prescribed by Department of Labor (“DOL”) regulations. During 2024, pursuant to the guidance issued by the DOL, lost earnings were calculated and allocated to affected participants for \$7,783 of the delinquent contributions. The remaining delinquent contributions were corrected in 2025.

**9. Risks and Uncertainties**

The Plan invests in various investment securities. Investment securities are exposed to various risks such as interest rate, market, and credit risks. Due to the level of risk associated with certain investment securities, it is at least reasonably possible that changes in the values of investment securities will occur in the near term and that such changes could materially affect participants’ account balances and the amounts reported in the statements of net assets available for benefits.

Global and domestic economic uncertainty has resulted in significant volatility in financial markets. This volatility has affected, and may continue to affect, the value of the Plan's net assets available for benefits. The effects of economic and market conditions subsequent to December 31, 2024 are not reflected in these financial statements and future effects on the Plan's net assets available for benefits cannot be predicted.


