## Notes to Financial Statements

December 31, 2024

### **1. Description of the Plan**

The following description of RPS Composites Retirement Savings Plan (the Plan) provides only general information. Participants should refer to the Plan document for a complete description of the Plan's provisions.

#### **General**

The Plan is a defined contribution plan covering all full-time employees of RPS Holdings, Inc. and subsidiaries (collectively, the Company) who are age 20 or older and have 60 days of service. The Plan is subject to the provisions of the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

#### **Contributions**

Each year, participants may contribute up to 100 percent of pretax annual compensation and Roth contributions, not to exceed federal limits. Participants who have attained age 50 before the end of the Plan year are eligible to make catch-up contributions. Participants may also contribute amounts representing distributions from other qualified defined benefit or defined contribution plans.

The Company makes a safe-harbor matching contribution to each participant based on his or her elective deferrals in an amount set by the Company. For 2024, the Company contributed 100 percent of the first three percent and 50 percent of the next two percent of eligible compensation that a participant contributed to the Plan. Additional discretionary contributions may be made as determined by the Company. No such contribution was made in 2024. Contributions are subject to certain limitations.

Participants direct the investment of their contributions and Company contributions into various investment options offered by the Plan.

#### **Participant Accounts**

Each participant's account is credited with the participant's contribution, the Company's contribution, and Plan earnings or losses from that account's investment activity. The benefit to which a participant is entitled is the benefit that can be provided from the participant's vested account.

## RPS Composites Retirement Savings Plan

### Notes to Financial Statements (continued)

#### **1. Description of the Plan (continued)**

##### **Benefit Payments**

On termination of service due to death, disability, retirement, or separation of service, a participant may elect to receive a full or partial lump-sum amount equal to the value of the participant's vested interest in his or her account or annual installments over a fixed period of time. In-service withdrawals, including hardship withdrawals from elective contributions only, may be available as defined in the Plan document.

##### **Vesting**

Participants are vested immediately in their contributions and Company safe-harbor matching contributions plus actual earnings thereon. Vesting in the Company's discretionary contribution portion of their accounts is based on years of continuous service. A participant is 100 percent vested after six years of credited service.

##### **Administrative Expenses**

Certain administrative expenses of the Plan, including custodial and accounting fees, have been paid by the Company. Participant initiated distribution fees are charged directly to the participant's account. All other administrative expenses and investment transaction fees (including investment-related expenses which are included in net appreciation in fair value of investments) are paid by the Plan.

##### **Forfeitures**

Forfeitures of terminated participants' nonvested accounts are used to pay Plan expenses or to reduce Company contributions.

##### **Plan Termination**

Although it has not expressed any intent to do so, the Company has the right under the Plan to discontinue its contributions at any time, and to terminate the Plan subject to the provisions set forth in ERISA. In the event of Plan termination, participants would become 100 percent vested in their Company discretionary contributions.

### Notes to Financial Statements (continued)

#### **2. Summary of Significant Accounting Policies**

##### **Basis of Presentation**

The financial statements of the Plan have been prepared on the accrual basis of accounting.

##### **Investment Valuation and Income Recognition**

Investments are reported at fair value. Fair value is the price that would be received to sell an asset or paid to transfer a liability in an orderly transaction between market participants at the measurement date. Management of the Company determines the Plan's valuation policies utilizing information provided by the investment advisor and custodian. See Note 4 for discussion of fair value measurements.

Purchases and sales of securities are recorded on a trade-date basis. Interest income is recorded on the accrual basis. Net appreciation includes the Plan's gains and losses on investments bought and sold as well as held during the year and any investment-related expenses.

The Plan provides for investments in various investment securities that in general are exposed to various risks, such as interest rate, credit, and overall market volatility. Due to the level of risk associated with certain investment securities, it is at least reasonably possible that changes in the values of investment securities will occur in the near term and that such changes could materially affect the amounts reported in the statements of net assets available for benefits.

##### **Use of Estimates**

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America requires management to make estimates that affect the amounts reported in the financial statements and accompanying notes. Actual results could differ from those estimates.

#### **3. Investment Information**

All investment information disclosed in the accompanying financial statements and supplemental schedules, including investments held at December 31, 2024 and 2023, and net appreciation in fair value of investments and interest for the year ended December 31, 2024, was obtained or derived from information provided to the plan administrator and certified as complete and accurate by VOYA Retirement Insurance and Annuity Company, the custodian.

## RPS Composites Retirement Savings Plan

### Notes to Financial Statements (continued)

#### 4. Fair Value Measurements

The framework for measuring fair value provides a fair value hierarchy that prioritizes the inputs to valuation techniques used to measure fair value. The hierarchy gives the highest priority to unadjusted quoted prices in active markets for identical assets or liabilities (level 1) and the lowest priority to unobservable inputs (level 3).

The three levels of the fair value hierarchy under FASB ASC 820 are described below:

The asset's or liability's fair value measurement level within the fair value hierarchy is based on the lowest level of any input that is significant to the fair value measurement. Valuation techniques used need to maximize the use of observable inputs and minimize the use of unobservable inputs.

Following is a description of the valuation methodologies used for assets measured at fair value. There have been no changes in the methodologies used at December 31, 2024 and 2023.

Investment contract: stated at fair value, as it is not considered benefit responsive and is issued by the custodian with the backing of their general account. Fair value is the amount that Plan participants would receive currently if they were to withdraw or transfer funds within the Plan prior to their maturity for an event other than death, disability, termination or retirement. This fair value represents contract value adjusted to reflect current market interest rates only to the extent such market rates exceed crediting rates.

#### 4. Fair Value Measurements (continued)

Pooled separate accounts: stated at fair value based on prices quoted and published by the investment advisor of the accounts. Quoted prices are determined daily based on the net asset value of the underlying mutual funds and other securities in the accounts. Net change in fair value of the accounts includes interest, dividends and realized and unrealized gains and losses on investments in the accounts and any separate account charges.

The plan administrator believes that the Plan is designed and is currently being operated in compliance with the applicable requirements of the IRC and has no income subject to unrelated business income tax.
