### Scope and Nature of the ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) Audit

We have performed audits of the financial statements of Barry Isett & Associates, Inc. 401(k) Profit Sharing Plan (the Plan), an employee benefit plan subject to the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA), as permitted by ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) (ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) audit). The financial statements comprise the statements of net assets available for benefits as of December 31, 2024 and 2023, and the related statement of changes in net assets available for benefits for the year ended December 31, 2024, and the related notes to the financial statements.

### **NOTE A - DESCRIPTION OF PLAN**

The following description of the Barry Isett & Associates, Inc. 401(k) Profit Sharing Plan (the Plan) provides only general information. Participants should refer to the plan document for a more complete description of the Plan's provisions.

#### General

The Plan is a defined contribution plan covering all employees of Barry Isett & Associates, Inc. (the Company) who have completed three months of service, attained 400 hours of service, and reached the age of 21. The Plan is subject to the provisions of the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

#### Contributions

Each year, participants may contribute up to 90% of their compensation, not to exceed the annual maximum deferral amount as defined by law. Catch-up contributions are permitted for eligible participants age 50 or older by the end of a calendar year. Participants are permitted to designate all or a portion of their contributions as Roth contributions that are includable in the participant's gross income at the time of deferral. Participants may also contribute amounts representing distributions from other qualified defined benefit or defined contribution plans (rollover).

The Plan includes an auto-enrollment provision whereby all newly eligible employees are automatically enrolled in the Plan unless they affirmatively elect not to participate in the Plan. Automatically enrolled participants have their deferral rate set at 3% of eligible compensation and their contributions are invested in a designated balanced fund until changed by the participant. The Plan also includes an auto-escalation provision whereby deferral rates will increase 1% each year, up to a maximum of 6%, unless the participant elects otherwise.

The Company may make discretionary matching contributions to be determined each year. For the year ended December 31, 2024, the matching contribution was 50% of the participant's contributions that do not exceed 6% of their eligible compensation.

The Company may make discretionary profit-sharing contributions. A participant must complete 1,000 hours throughout the year to be eligible for the profit-sharing contribution, with the exception of death, permanent disability, and retirement. There were no profit-sharing contributions for 2024.

Contributions are subject to certain Internal Revenue Service (IRS) limitations.

#### Participant Accounts

Each participant's account is credited with the participant's contribution and the participant's share of (a) the employer contributions, (b) an allocation of investment earnings or losses based on the participant's directed investment accounts and (c) charged with an allocation of administrative expenses. Allocations are based on participant earnings, account balances, or specific participant transactions, as defined by the plan document. The benefit to which a participant is entitled is the benefit that can be provided from the participant's vested account. Each participant directs the investments for their account.

### NOTE A - DESCRIPTION OF PLAN - continued

#### Vesting and Forfeitures

A participant is 100% vested at all times in the participant's salary deferral amounts, rollover contributions, and any earnings thereon regardless of the number of years of service. If a participant ceases participation except by retirement, death or permanent disability, the vested interest in employer contributions and earnings thereon is dependent upon the years of credited service.

Each participant is vested in the discretionary matching and profit-sharing contributions according to the following schedule based upon years of service:

| 2 years                         | 20%  |
| 3 years                         | 40%  |
| 4 years                         | 60%  |

Forfeitures shall be used for payment of plan expenses. At December 31, 2024 and 2023, forfeited non-vested accounts totaled \$11,955 and \$5,738, respectively. During the year ended December 31, 2024, \$19,915 of forfeitures were applied toward plan expenses.

#### Payment of Benefits

Upon termination of employment, if a participant's vested interest in their account exceeds \$5,000, no distribution shall be made to the participant before they reach the age of normal retirement or receipt of consent to pay out by the participant and their spouse, if applicable.

If the participant's vested account is less than \$5,000, the vested account balance is paid out in the form of a lump sum distribution. In the event of a mandatory distribution greater than \$1,000, the Plan Administrator will pay the distribution in a direct rollover to an individual retirement arrangement designated by the Plan Administrator if the participant does not elect a direct rollover or lump sum distribution.

#### Legislative Changes

President Biden signed into law the Setting Every Community Up for Retirement Enhancement 2.0 (SECURE 2.0) Act on December 29, 2022. The SECURE 2.0 Act provisions aim to enhance retirement savings access and flexibility while helping participants manage financial needs. Plan management evaluated the key provisions available under the SECURE 2.0 Act, including: eliminating required minimum distributions for Roth accounts during a participant's lifetime, permitting penalty-free emergency withdrawals of up to \$1,000 per year with repayment options, allowing employer matching contributions for qualified student loan payments, offering non-highly compensated employees a Roth emergency savings account with a \$2,500 annual contribution limit and limited tax-free withdrawals, and continuing eligibility for long-term part-time employees with at least 500 hours of service for three consecutive years and age 21. The Plan Document is required to be amended by December 31, 2026, per IRS Notice 2024-2, to reflect the applicable provisions.

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### **NOTE B - SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES**

#### Basis of Accounting

The financial statements are prepared on the accrual basis of accounting.

#### Payment of Benefits

Benefits payments to participants and beneficiaries are recorded when paid.

#### Investment Valuation and Income Recognition

The Plan's investments are reported at fair value. Fair value is the price that would be received to sell an asset or paid to transfer a liability in an orderly transaction between market participants at the measurement date. Fair value measurements are discussed in Note D. Purchases and sales are recorded on a trade date basis. Net appreciation includes the Plan's gains and losses on investments bought and sold as well as those held during the year. Dividends are recorded on the ex-dividend date. Interest income is recorded on the accrual basis.

#### Risks and Uncertainties

The Plan provides various investment options. Investment securities of the Plan are exposed to various risks, such as interest rate, market, and credit. Due to the level of risk associated with certain investment securities and the level of uncertainty related to changes in value of investment securities, it is at least reasonably possible that changes in risks in the near-term would materially affect participants' account balances and the amounts reported in the statements of net assets available for benefits and the statement of changes in net assets available for benefits. As of December 31, 2024 and 2023, two investment funds represent approximately 24% and 23% of the total investments, respectively.

#### Estimates

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America (U.S. GAAP), requires the Plan Administrator to make estimates and assumptions that affect certain reported amounts and disclosures. Accordingly, actual results may differ from those estimates.

### **NOTE C - INVESTMENTS**

The Plan's investments are held in trust and administered by Ascensus Trust Company, the trustee, as of December 31, 2024 and 2023 and for the year ended December 31, 2024. The investments, investment income, notes receivable from participants, and interest income on notes receivable from participants disclosed in the accompanying financial statements and supplemental schedule were obtained or derived from information supplied to the Plan Administrator and certified as complete and accurate by Ascensus, LLC, an agent on behalf of the trustee.

**NOTE D - FAIR VALUE MEASUREMENTS**

Financial Accounting Standards Board Accounting Standards Codification 820, *Fair Value Measurements and Disclosures*, establishes a fair value hierarchy that prioritizes the inputs to valuation techniques used to measure fair value. This hierarchy consists of three levels: Level 1 inputs consist of unadjusted quoted prices in active markets for identical assets and have the highest priority, Level 2 inputs consist of observable inputs other than quoted prices for identical assets, and Level 3 inputs consist of unobservable inputs for identical assets and have the lowest priority. The Plan uses valuation techniques based on the available inputs to measure the fair value of its investment. When available, the Plan measures fair value using Level 1 inputs because they provide the most reliable evidence of fair value. Level 3 inputs are used only when Level 1 and Level 2 inputs are not available.

Gains and losses (realized and unrealized) are reported in net appreciation in fair value of investments in the statement of changes in net assets available for benefits.

The following is a description of the valuation methodologies used for investments measured at fair value. There have been no changes to the methodologies used at December 31, 2024 and 2023.

*Mutual Funds:* Valued at the daily closing price as reported by the fund. Funds held by the Plan are open-end mutual funds that are registered with the Securities and Exchange Commission. These funds are required to publish their daily net asset value and to transact at that price. The funds held by the Plan are deemed to be actively traded.

*Money Market Account:* The money market account in this Plan is valued at its principal investment plus interest earned at contracted rates.

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### **NOTE E - PLAN TERMINATION**

Although it has not expressed any intent to do so, the Company has the right under the Plan to discontinue its contributions at any time and to terminate the Plan subject to the provisions of ERISA. Should the Plan terminate at some future time, participants would become fully vested in their employer contributions.

### **NOTE F - PLAN TAX STATUS**

The Plan's prototype non-standardized document obtained its latest advisory letter on January 1, 2018, in which the IRS stated that the Plan, as then designed, was in compliance with the applicable sections of the Internal Revenue Code (IRC). The prototype has been amended since receiving the determination letter for various amendments. However, the Plan Administrator believes that the Plan is currently designed and operated in compliance with the applicable sections of the IRC. Therefore, no provision for income taxes has been included in the Plan's financial statements.

U.S. GAAP requires plan management to evaluate tax positions taken by the Plan and recognize a tax liability if the Plan has taken an uncertain position that more likely than not would not be sustained upon examination by applicable taxing authorities. The Plan is subject to routine audits by taxing jurisdictions; however, there are currently no audits for any tax periods in progress. The Plan Administrator believes the Plan is no longer subject to income tax examinations for years prior to 2021.

### **NOTE G - TRANSACTIONS WITH PARTIES-IN-INTEREST**

Certain plan investments are managed by Vanguard Retirement Plan Services, the recordkeeper, and certain plan investments are managed by Ascensus Trust Company, the trustee of the Plan and, therefore, these transactions qualify as party-in-interest transactions. Transactions resulting in plan assets being transferred to or used by a related party are prohibited under ERISA unless a specific exemption exists. Ascensus Trust and Vanguard are parties-in-interest as defined by ERISA as a result of investing plan assets in its funds and accounts and providing investment management services. However, these transactions are exempt under Section 408(b)(8) and are not prohibited by ERISA.

Certain expenses of maintaining the Plan are paid by the Plan, unless otherwise paid by the Company. Expenses that are paid by the Company are excluded from these financial statements. Fees related to the administration of notes receivable from participants are charged directly to the participant's account and are included in administrative expenses. Recordkeeping fees are included in administrative expenses. Investment-related expenses are included in net appreciation of fair value of investments.

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### **NOTE H - NOTES RECEIVABLE FROM PARTICIPANTS**

Notes receivable from participants are reported at unpaid balances plus any unpaid accrued interest. Participants may borrow a minimum of \$1,000 up to a maximum of \$50,000 under the Plan's loan provision. The loans may not exceed one-half of the employee's vested account balance and are generally limited to five years. Interest rates are determined by the Plan Administrator in accordance with the Plan's loan provisions. Loan repayments are made through payroll deductions. There is no credit risk involved with these loans as any defaults are then deemed taxable distributions to the participant. Loans are considered in default when they are not paid within the terms stated on the agreement, typically within 90 days. No allowance for credit losses has been recorded as of December 31, 2024 and 2023. These loans satisfy the statutory exemption from the prohibited transaction rules.

### **NOTE I - CONCENTRATION OF CASH AND SECURITIES RISK**

The Plan maintains its balances in a brokerage institution, which at times may exceed the Securities Investor Protection Corporation limits up to \$500,000 for balances (with a limit of \$250,000 for cash). The Plan has not experienced any losses in such accounts and believes it is not exposed to any significant credit risk on cash and securities.

### **NOTE J - SUBSEQUENT EVENTS**

Management has evaluated subsequent events through the date of the independent auditors' report, and the date the financial statements were available to be issued.
