Explanation for Late Filing of Form 5500

To Whom It May Concern,

We respectfully request relief from penalties associated with the late filing of Form 5500 for Metro Services LLC, EIN 32-0481354, for the plan year ending December 31, 2023. The delay was due to extraordinary circumstances beyond our control, specifically the impact of Hurricane Helene, a concurrent transition in payroll and 401(k) service providers, and the departure of our employee that was primarily responsible for payroll.

In September and October 2024, Hurricanes Helene and Milton caused severe disruptions in Tampa, Florida, where our business and plan administration are based. The storm resulted in widespread power outages, office closures, evacuations and disruption to our staff and payroll partners, significantly hindering our ability to access critical plan data and meet the filing deadline of October 15, 2024. These conditions disrupted our transition to our new payroll and 401k providers, delaying our ability to compile and submit the required information.

In addition, our company underwent a planned transition to a new payroll and 401(k) provider that began in June and ended in October 2024. We also lost our payroll employee in November 2024. The transition required significant time to transfer plan data, reconcile records, and train staff on new systems, further complicating timely compliance. While we exercised due diligence in managing the transition, the combination of these events with the natural disaster created unavoidable delays.

Upon identification of missing the filing deadline from our new provider, we promptly filed the delinquent Form 5500-SF through the EFAST2 system and are participating in the Department of Labor's Delinquent Filer Voluntary Compliance Program (DFVCP) to address penalties. We have also implemented measures to ensure future filings are timely, including enhanced coordination with our new provider.

We respectfully request that penalties be waived due to these extraordinary circumstances. Supporting documentation, such as Hurricane Helene's impact, correspondence with the previous/new provider is available upon request.
