Asset Data

Asset data as of the Valuation Date and contribution amounts and dates were supplied by the Company. We did not audit the asset data.

Changes in Actuarial Assumption or Methods

The valuation interest rates are the rates required per IRC Section 430, and the cash balance interest credit rate is the 30-year treasury rate for the third full month immediately preceding the first month of the Plan Year. This year the credit rate is 4.94% compared to 4.02% last year.

The mortality assumptions used are those mandated by the Internal Revenue Service for this valuation, per IRC Section 430. Because this plan has fewer than 500 participants, we use the unisex assumptions.

Events and Trends Which Have Not Been Taken into Consideration

To the best of our knowledge, there has been no event or trend which has not been taken into consideration and which may require a material change in plan costs or required contribution rates. In addition, no Plan amendments adopted and effective after the valuation date of December 31, 2024 were considered for this Valuation, nor do any exist of which we are aware except statutory CPI increases in maximum benefits and considered compensation.



