### **NOTE 1 – DESCRIPTION OF THE PLAN**

The following description of WCBF/Argifrost Employee Benefit Plan (the Plan) provides only general information. Participants should refer to the plan document for a more complete description of the Plan's provisions.

#### **General**

The Plan was formed on January 1, 2022, to provide benefits to eligible employees of WCBF/Argifrost Employee Benefit Plan (the Company), as defined, and covered dependents. Certain plan assets are held in a trust. The Plan is subject to the provisions of the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974, as amended (ERISA).

#### **Contributions**

In addition to deductibles and co-payments, participants contribute specified amounts based on applicable monthly premiums for their respective benefit elections. The Company contributions, after consideration of contributions by participants, are intended to fund plan obligations, participant benefits, and certain administrative costs of the Plan. Any deficiency of the Plan's net assets over benefit obligations is funded by the Company on a pay-as-you-go basis.

#### **Benefits**

The Plan provides for medical and prescription drug benefits for eligible members and their dependents, where applicable, on a self-insured basis, as specified in the Plan document. The Plan also provides continuation of certain benefits upon termination of employment through the Consolidated Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act (COBRA). The claims for self-insured benefits are processed by the Plan's third-party claims processor under an administrative service only (ASO) agreement. The claims processor pays the claims directly to or on behalf of participants and are reimbursed by the Plan's trust and the Company. Ultimate responsibility for payments to providers and participants is retained by the Plan.

#### **Stop-Loss Coverage**

The Plan has entered into a stop-loss insurance arrangement in an effort to limit its exposure for self-insured benefits (individual participant claims over a specific dollar amount, as well as its aggregate exposure for all claims).

#### **Plan Termination**

Although it has not expressed any intent to do so, the Company has the right under the Plan to discontinue its contributions at any time and to terminate the Plan subject to the provisions of ERISA. In the event of Plan termination, remaining assets will be applied in a uniform and non-discriminatory manner toward the payment of benefits for or on account of the participants. No assets of the Plan may revert back to the Company or be used for purposes other than for the exclusive benefit of the Plan's participants.

### NOTE 2 – SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

#### **Basis of Accounting and Use of Estimates**

The financial statements of the Plan are prepared using the accrual method of accounting in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America (GAAP), which requires the plan administrator to make estimates and assumptions that affect certain reported amounts and disclosures. Accordingly, actual results may differ from those estimates.

The Financial Accounting Standards Board (FASB) has adopted Accounting Standards Codification (ASC) as the sole source of authoritative GAAP. The FASB will issue Accounting Standards Updates (ASU) from time to time to make adjustments to GAAP.

#### **Payment of Benefits**

Claim payments to participants are recorded when payment is made by the Plan or when the third-party claims processor is reimbursed by the Plan. Amounts due to claims processors that have yet to be reimbursed by the Plan are recorded as claims payable in the accompanying statements of benefit obligations and net assets available for benefits. Premiums paid by the trust are recorded as administrative expenses in the accompanying statement of changes in benefit obligations and net assets available for benefits.

#### **Stop-Loss Insurance**

Premiums for stop-loss insurance are included in employer contributions in the accompanying statement of changes in benefit obligations and net assets available for benefits. There were no stop-loss reimbursements for the year ended December 31, 2024.

#### **Benefit Obligations**

Benefit obligations at December 31, 2024 for claims incurred but not reported are estimated by the Plan's management based on claims data provided by the Plan's third-party claims processor. These amounts are paid by the Plan only if claims are submitted and approved for payment.

### NOTE 3 – ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSES

The Plan pays administrative expenses that consist of fees paid to a third-party for claims processing and stop-loss insurance premiums. These expenses are reported on the accompanying statement of changes in benefit obligations and net assets available for benefits as administrative expenses; all other administrative expenses are paid by the Company on behalf of the Plan and are excluded from the financial statements.

### NOTE 4 – PARTY-IN-INTEREST TRANSACTIONS

Certain plan administrative expenses described in Note 1 and Note 3 are paid to parties-in-interest. During 2024, there were no prohibited transactions concerning parties-in-interest.

**NOTE 5 – INCOME TAX STATUS AND UNCERTAIN TAX POSITIONS**

The plan administrator believes that the Plan is designed, and is currently being operated, in compliance with the applicable requirements of the Internal Revenue Code and, therefore, believes that the Plan is qualified, and the related trust is tax-exempt. The Plan has not received a determination letter from the Internal Revenue Service.

The Plan follows the accounting guidance for uncertainty in income taxes using the provisions of FASB ASC Topic 740, Income Taxes. The plan administrator has concluded that there are no significant uncertain tax positions requiring disclosure, and there are no material amounts of unrecognized tax benefits. The Plan's evaluation was performed for tax year ended December 31, 2024, the year that remains subject to examination by major tax jurisdictions as of December 31, 2024.

**NOTE 6 – SUBSEQUENT EVENTS**

The plan administrator evaluated events and transactions subsequent to December 31, 2024, through July 18, 2025, (the date the financial statements were available to be issued) for potential recognition or disclosure in the financial statements. The plan administrator has not identified any items requiring disclosure.

**NOTE 7 – RECONCILIATION OF FINANCIAL STATEMENTS TO FORM 5500**
