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Independent Auditor's Report

Scope and Nature of the ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) Audit

We have performed audit of the accompanying financial statements of Norman International, Inc. 401(k) Profit Sharing Plan, (the "Plan") an employee benefit plan subject to the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA), as permitted by ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C). The financial statements comprise the statements of net assets available for benefits as of December 31, 2024, and the related statement of changes in net assets available for benefits for the year ended December 31, 2024, and the related notes to the financial statements.

Management, having determined it is permissible in the circumstances, has elected to have the audit of Norman International, Inc. 401(k) Profit Sharing Plan's financial statements performed in accordance with ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) pursuant to 29 CFR 2520.103-8 of the Department of Labor's Rules and Regulations for Reporting and Disclosure under ERISA. NOTE 1: PLAN DESCRIPTION

The following description of the Norman International, Inc. 401(k) Profit Sharing Plan (the "Plan") provides only general information. Participants should refer to the Plan agreement for a complete description of the Plan's provisions.

General

The Plan was adopted by Norman International, Inc. (the "Company") as of June 1, 2001. The Plan is a defined contribution plan covering substantially all employees of the Company who have completed 1 year of continuous service and attained age 21. On May 1, 2024, the Company amended the plan to consolidate the Plans of Norman International South Carolina, LLC. The Plan covers the eligible employees of the following companies:

Plan Administration

The Plan is subject to the provisions of the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 ("ERISA") and is administered by the 401(k) Plan Administrative Committee (the "Administrative Committee") of the Companies. Plan assets were held under the direction of the Administrative Committee, by Principal Trust Company (Principal).

Contributions

Participants may elect to contribute up to 100% of his or her compensation, as defined in the Plan. Participants who have attained age 50 before the end of the plan year are eligible to make catch-up contributions. However, the contribution may not exceed the maximum deferral as defined under Section 402(g) of the Internal Revenue Code (the "IRC"). Participants may also contribute amounts representing distributions from other qualified defined benefit or defined contribution plans (rollover). The Companies have adopted the following safe harbor match:

Contributions are made by the Companies for their respective participants. Upon termination of employment, participants are allowed to defer receiving their vested benefits.

Participant Accounts

Each participant's account is credited with: (a) the participant's contribution, (b) the Companies' matching contribution and (c) an allocation of Plan earnings, net of certain administrative expenses. Allocations are based on participant account balances, as defined.

Vesting

Effective January 1, 2006 the Companies makes a Safe Harbor Matching election, Participant and Companies contributions and related earnings are fully vested immediately.

Participant Loans

Participants may borrow from their fund accounts a minimum of \$1,000, up to a maximum equal to the lesser of \$50,000 or 50% of their vested account balance. Terms of the loans range from one to five years and bear interest at 2% over the prime rate. A loan may be repaid over a period of thirty years if it is for the purchase of a principal residence.

Payment of Benefits

On termination of service or otherwise becoming eligible to receive benefits, a participant may elect to receive a lump-sum payment or periodic installment payments or transfer the balance in his or her account to another qualified plan. Vested accounts of \$5,000 or less will be automatically paid in a lump-sum amount.

A participant may make withdrawals from his or her account (except as provided in the Plan agreement) upon reaching age 59 ½. Withdrawals may also be made for financial hardship, which is determined pursuant to the provisions of the IRC.

Administrative Expenses

Certain expenses incurred in connection with the general administration of the Plan are paid by the Plan and are recorded in the accompanying Statement of Changes in Net Assets Available for Benefits as Administrative Expenses. Total Administrative Expenses for the year ended December 31, 2024 was \$107,380.

Forfeitures

A participant's non-vested account balance is forfeited at the time of termination of employment. These forfeitures will be used first to offset Plan administrative expenses. Any remaining forfeitures will be used to reduce Employer

Contributions under the Plan. Finally, any remaining forfeitures will be allocated to Participants.

Plan Termination

The Company anticipates and believes the Plan will continue without interruption but reserve the right to terminate the Plan, in part or in whole, at any time. In the event that such discontinuance results in termination of the Plan, participants become 100% vest in their entire account balance and the Plan's net assets will be allocated among the participants in accordance with the terms of the Plan and ERISA.

NOTE 2: SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of Accounting

The financial statements of the Plan have been prepared on the accrual basis in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America. Certain reclassifications have been made to the prior year financial statements to conform to the current year presentation.

Use of Estimates

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect in reported amounts of assets and liabilities and disclosure of contingent assets and liabilities at the date of the financial statements and the reported amounts in the statement of changes in net assets available for benefits during the reporting period. Actual results could differ from those estimates.

Investment Valuation and Income Recognition

Investments in mutual funds and guaranteed investment contracts are presented at fair market value upon quoted prices from recognized securities exchanges.

Participant loans are valued at the outstanding principal balance which approximates fair value.

Investment Valuation and Income Recognition

Investments in mutual funds and guaranteed investment contracts are presented at fair market value upon quoted prices from recognized securities exchanges. Participant loans are valued at the outstanding principal balance which approximates fair value.

Investment income is recorded as earned and is retained by Principal for reinvestment on behalf of the Plan. Dividend income is recorded on the ex-dividend date.

The Plan presents in the statement of changes in net available for benefits the net appreciation (depreciation) in the fair value of its investments, which consists of the realized gains or losses and unrealized appreciation (depreciation) on those investments.

Payment of Benefits

Benefits to participants are recorded when paid.

Risks and Uncertainties

The Plan provides for various investment options in any combination of investment securities. Investment securities are exposed to various risks, such as interest rate, market and credit. Due to the level of risk associated with certain investment securities and the level of uncertainty related to changes in the value of investment securities, it is at least reasonably possible that changes in risks in the near term could materially affect participants' account balances and the amounts reported in the statements of net assets available for benefits and the statement of changes in net assets available for benefits.

NOTE 3: FAIR VALUE MEASUREMENTS

Financial Accounting Standards Board (FASB) *Accounting Standards Codification (ASC) 820, Fair Value Measurements and Disclosures*, provides the framework for measuring fair value. That framework provides a fair value hierarchy that prioritizes the inputs to valuation techniques used to measure fair value. The hierarchy gives the highest priority to unadjusted quoted prices in active markets for identical assets or liabilities (level 1 measurements) and the lowest priority to unobservable inputs (level 3 measurements).

Following is a description of the valuation methodologies used for assets measured at fair value. There have been no changes in the methodologies used at December 31, 2024 and 2023.

Mutual funds: Valued at the net asset value (NAV) of shares held by the plan at year end that are traded in active markets.

Pooled Separate Accounts and Common Collective Trusts: Valued at the net asset value (NAV) of shares held by the plan at year end from inputs that are based on observable market data.

The preceding methods described may produce a fair value calculation that may not be indicative of net realizable value or reflective of future fair values. Furthermore, although the plan believes its valuation methods are appropriate and consistent with other market participants, the use of different methodologies or assumptions to determine the fair value of certain financial instruments could result in a different fair value measurement at the reporting date.

NOTE 4: GUARANTEED INVESTMENT CONTRACTS

The Plan entered into a traditional fully benefit-responsive guaranteed investment contract with Principal Global Investments totaling \$1,035,516 for 2024 and \$1,906,266 for 2023, respectively. Principal Global Investments maintains the contributions in a general account. The account is credited with earnings on the underlying investments and charged for participant withdrawals and administrative expenses. The guaranteed investment contract issuer is contractually obligated to repay the principal and a specified interest rate that is guaranteed to the Plan. As of December 31, 2024 and 2023 the contract values of the Guaranteed Investments Contracts were equal to their fair value.

The crediting rate is based on a formula established by the contract issuer. The crediting rate is reviewed on a quarterly basis for resetting. The guaranteed investment contract does not permit the insurance company to terminate the agreement prior to the scheduled maturity date. This contract meets the fully benefit-responsive investment contract criteria and therefore is reported at contract value. Contract value is the relevant measure for fully benefit-responsive investment contracts because this is the amount received by participants if they were to initiate permitted transactions under the terms of the Plan. Contract value, as reported to the Plan by Principal Global Investments, represents contributions made under the contract, plus earnings, less participant withdrawals, and administrative expenses. Participants may ordinarily direct the withdrawal or transfer of all or a portion of their investment at contract value. The Plan's ability to receive amounts due is dependent on the issuer's ability to meet its financial obligations. The issuer's ability to meet its contractual obligations may be affected by future economic and regulatory developments. Certain events might limit the ability of the Plan to transact at contract value with the issuer. Such events include (1) amendments to the Plan documents (including complete or partial Plan termination or merger with another plan), (2) changes to the Plan's prohibition on competing investment options or deletion of equity wash provisions, (3) bankruptcy of the Plan sponsor or other Plan sponsor events (for example, divestitures or spin-offs of a subsidiary) that cause a significant withdrawal from the Plan, or (4) the failure of the trust to qualify for exemption from federal income taxes or any required prohibited transaction exemption under ERISA (5) premature termination of the contract. No events are probable of occurring that might limit the ability of the Plan to transact at contract value with the contract issuers and that also would limit the ability of the plan to transact at contract value with the participants.

In addition, certain events allow the issuer to terminate the contract with the Plan and settle at an amount different from contract value. Such events include (1) an uncured violation of the Plan's investment guidelines, (2) a breach of material obligation under the contract, (3) a material misrepresentation, (4) a material amendment to the agreement without the consent of the issuer.

NOTE 5: FEDERAL INCOME TAX STATUS

The Internal Revenue Service has determined the Plan qualifies under Section 401 (a) of the IRC and is, therefore, not subject to tax under present income tax law. Once qualified, the Plan is required to operate in conformity with the IRC and Plan provisions to maintain its qualification. The Administrative Committee believes the Plan is currently designed and is being operated in compliance with the applicable requirements of the IRC.

GAAP requires Plan management to evaluate uncertain tax positions taken by the Plan. The financial statement effects of a tax position are recognized when the position, based on technical merits, is more likely than not to be sustained upon examination by the IRS. The Plan administrator concluded that the Plan has maintained its tax-exempt status and that no uncertain tax positions have been taken or are expected to be taken that require adjustment to the financial statements for the year ended December 31, 2024. The Plan has recognized no liability for income taxes, or any interest and penalties related to uncertain tax positions. The Plan is subject to routine audits by taxing jurisdictions; however, there are currently no audits for any tax periods in progress. The Plan Sponsor believes that the Plan is no longer subject to examinations by the IRS that could result in the imposition of income taxes for years prior to 2021.

NOTE 6: PARTY-IN-INTEREST TRANSACTIONS

The Plan allows for transactions with certain parties who may perform services or have fiduciary responsibilities to the plan. Certain Plan investments are managed by Principal, the custodian and record-keeper of the Plan. The custodian receives management and contract administration fees from the plan.

NOTE 7: INFORMATION CERTIFIED BY THE PLAN TRUSTEE

Principal Trust Company acted as trustee at December 31, 2023 and from January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2024. The trustee has custody and control of Plan assets, records transactions and pays withdrawals. The trustee has certified as complete and accurate all financial data of the Plan with respect to the periods in which it acted as trustee.

Amounts included in these financial statements and supplemental schedule relating to investments (including fair values and investment transaction information), interest income, dividend income and net appreciation in fair value of the Plan's investments were derived from financial data certified by the trustee.

NOTE 8: SUBSEQUENT EVENT

Management has evaluated subsequent events through July 3, 2025, (the date of which the financial statements were available to be issued). No other events have occurred subsequent to December 31, 2024 which would have a material events requiring recognition or disclosure.
