## **Note 1. Description of the Plan**

### **General**

The following description of InfuCare Rx, Inc. 401(k) Plan (the Plan) is provided for general information purposes only. Participants should refer to the Plan Document for a more complete description of the Plan's provisions.

The Plan is a defined contribution plan covering all full-time employees of the below listed companies (collectively, Company) who are not subject to a collective bargaining agreement:

- InfuCare Rx LLC
- Homecare Rx Inc.
- DM Clinical Collaborations Inc.
- Factor One Source Pharmacy LLC
- InfuCare Rx Health, LLC
- InfuCare Rx PA Inc.
- Pharmacy Health Alliance LLC
- Fast Access Specialty Pharmacy LLC

The Plan is subject to the provisions of the *Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974* (ERISA), as restated.

### **Eligibility**

All employees are eligible to participate in the Plan, except for union, nonresident aliens, part-time, temporary, and seasonal employees. The Plan has a minimum age requirement of at least 21 by the next Plan entry date and requires a minimum of 3 months of service to make voluntary contributions into the Plan. 12 consecutive months of employment is required to be eligible for employer contributions.

### **Contributions**

The Plan permits eligible employees through a salary deferral election to have the Company make annual contributions of up to 90% of their eligible compensation. Employee rollover contributions are also permitted. Participants who have attained age 50 before the end of the Plan year are eligible to make catch-up contributions. The Company makes discretionary matching contributions of up to 4% of employees' salary deferral amounts and discretionary nonelective contributions. For each of the 2024 and 2023 plan years, the Company elected to make the matching contributions and no nonelective contributions. Contributions are subject to certain limitations.

### **Participant Investment Account Options**

Each participant has the option of directing their contributions into any of the various investment options offered by the Plan and may change the allocation daily.

### **Participant Accounts**

Each participant's account is credited with the participant's contribution, the Company's contributions and plan earnings and is charged with an allocation of administrative expenses. Allocations are based on participant earnings or account balances, as defined. The benefit to which a participant is entitled is the benefit that can be provided from the participant's vested account.

### **Vesting**

Participants are immediately vested in their voluntary contributions, plus earnings thereon. Vesting in the Company's contribution portion of their accounts plus earnings thereon is based on years of continuous service. A participant is fully vested after four years of continuous service. Participants also become fully vested upon death or disability.

### ***Payment of Benefits***

Upon termination of service due to death, disability or retirement, a participant may elect to receive either a lump-sum or partial withdrawals. Upon termination of service for other reasons, a participant may receive the value of the vested interest in their account only as a lump-sum distribution.

### ***Forfeitures***

At December 31, 2024 and 2023, forfeited nonvested accounts totaled \$85 and \$129, respectively. These accounts may be used to reduce future employer contributions or plan administrative expenses. Also, the 2024 and 2023 employer contributions were reduced by approximately \$54,000 and \$37,000, respectively, from forfeited nonvested accounts.

## **Note 2. Summary of Significant Accounting Policies**

### ***Basis of Accounting***

The accompanying financial statements are prepared on the accrual basis of accounting.

Investments held by a defined contribution plan are required to be reported at fair value, except for fully benefit-responsive investment contracts. Contract value is the relevant measure for the portion of net assets available for benefits attributable to fully benefit-responsive investment contracts because contract value is the amount participants normally would receive if they were to initiate permitted transactions under the terms of the Plan.

### ***Use of Estimates***

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts of net assets, changes in net assets and the disclosure of contingent assets and liabilities at the date of the financial statements. Actual results could differ from those estimates.

### ***Investment Valuation and Income Recognition***

Investments are reported at fair value (except for fully benefit-responsive investment contracts, which are reported at contract value). Quoted market prices, if available, are used to value investments. Mutual funds are valued at the net asset value (NAV) of shares held by the Plan at year-end.

The Plan's interest in the collective trust is valued based on information reported by the investment advisor using the audited financial statements of the collective trust at year-end.

Fully benefit-responsive investment contracts are valued at contract value. Contract value represents contributions made under the contract, plus interest at the contract rate, less participant withdrawals and administration expenses.

Purchases and sales of securities are recorded on a trade-date basis. Interest income is recorded on the accrual basis. Dividends are recorded on the ex-dividend date. Net appreciation in the fair value of investments includes the Plan's gains and losses on investments bought and sold as well as held during the year.

### ***Excess Contributions Payable***

Amounts payable to participants for contributions in excess of amounts allowed by the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) are recorded as a liability with a corresponding reduction to contributions. The Plan distributed the 2023 and 2024 excess contributions to the applicable participants before March 30, 2024 and March 30, 2025, respectively.

### ***Payment of Benefits***

Benefit payments to participants are recorded upon distribution.

### ***Administrative Expenses***

Administrative expenses may be paid by the Company or the Plan, at the Company's discretion.

### **Note 3. Certification of the Plan Custodian**

The Plan Administrator has elected the method of annual reporting compliance permitted by ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) pursuant to 29 CFR 2520.103-8 of the Department of Labor's Rules and Regulations for Reporting and Disclosure under ERISA. Accordingly, Reliance Trust Company, a qualified institution, has certified the following investment information included in the accompanying financial statements and ERISA-required supplemental schedule is complete and accurate:

- Investments as shown in the statements of net assets available for benefits as of December 31, 2024 and 2023
- Investment income as shown in the statements of changes in net assets available for benefits for the years ended December 31, 2024 and 2023
- Investment information included in the accompanying schedule of assets (held at end of year) as of December 31, 2024

The Plan's independent auditors did not perform auditing procedures with respect to this certified investment information, except for comparing such certified information to the related investment information included in the financial statements and ERISA-required supplemental schedule.

### **Note 4. Related-Party and Party-in-Interest Transactions**

Party-in-interest transactions include those with fiduciaries or employees of the Plan, any person who provides services to the Plan, an employer whose employees are covered by the Plan, an employee organization whose members are covered by the Plan, a person who owns 50% or more of such an employer or employee association, or relatives of such persons.

The Plan paid \$59,013 and \$45,338 of fees to ADP, Inc. and its affiliates during the years ended December 31, 2024 and 2023, respectively. The Company provides certain administrative services at no cost to the Plan.

### **Note 5. Disclosures About Fair Value of Plan Assets and Liabilities**

Fair value is the price that would be received to sell an asset or paid to transfer a liability in an orderly transaction between market participants at the measurement date. Fair value measurements must maximize the use of observable inputs and minimize the use of unobservable inputs. The hierarchy comprises three levels of inputs that may be used to measure fair value:

**Level 1** Quoted prices in active markets for identical assets or liabilities

**Level 2** Prices are determined using other significant observable inputs. Observable inputs are inputs that other market participants may use in pricing a security. These may include quoted prices for similar securities, interest rates, prepayment speeds, credit risk, yield curves, loss severities, default rates, discount rates, volatilities, and others.

**Level 3** Prices are determined using significant unobservable inputs. In situations where quoted prices or observable inputs are unavailable (for example, when there is little or no market activity for an investment at the end of the year), unobservable inputs may be used. Unobservable inputs reflect the Trust's own assumptions about the factors market participants would use in determining fair value of the securities or instruments and would be based on the best available information.

Following is a description of the valuation methodologies and inputs used for assets measured at fair value on a recurring basis and recognized in the accompanying statements of net assets available for benefits, as well as the general classification of such assets pursuant to the valuation hierarchy. There have been no significant changes in the valuation techniques during the years ended December 31, 2024 and 2023. The Plan had no liabilities measured at fair value on a recurring basis. In addition, the Plan had no assets or liabilities measured at fair value on a nonrecurring basis.

### ***Investments***

Where quoted market prices are available in an active market, securities are classified within Level 1 of the valuation hierarchy. If quoted market prices are not available, then fair values are estimated by using quoted prices of securities with similar characteristics or independent asset pricing services and pricing models, the inputs of which are market-based or independently sourced market parameters, including, but not limited to, yield curves, interest rates, volatilities, prepayments, defaults, cumulative loss projections, and cash flows. Such securities are classified in Level 2 of the valuation hierarchy. In certain cases where Level 1 or Level 2 inputs are not available, securities are classified within Level 3 of the hierarchy.

### **Note 6. Investment Contract with Insurance Company**

The Plan has a fully benefit-responsive investment contract with Invesco Trust Company. Invesco Trust Company maintains the contributions in a general account. The account is credited with earnings on the underlying investments and charged for participant withdrawals and administrative expenses. The guaranteed investment contract issuer is contractually obligated to repay the principal and a specified interest rate guaranteed to the Plan.

The guaranteed investment contract is fully benefit responsive; therefore, contract value is the relevant measurement. Contract value, as reported to the Plan by Invesco Trust Company, represents contributions made under the contract, plus earnings, less participant withdrawals and administrative expenses. Participants may ordinarily direct the withdrawal or transfer of all or a portion of their investment at contract value.

There are no reserves against the contract value for credit risk of the contract issuer or otherwise.

Certain events limit the ability of the Plan to transact at contract value with the issuer. Such events include the following: (1) amendments to the Plan Documents (including complete or partial plan termination or merger with another plan), (2) changes to the Plan's prohibition on competing investment options or deletion of equity wash provisions, (3) bankruptcy of the Company or other Company events (for example, divestitures or spin-offs of a subsidiary) that cause a significant withdrawal from the Plan, or (4) the failure of the trust to qualify for exemption from federal income taxes or any required prohibited transaction exemption under ERISA. The Plan Administrator does not believe the occurrence of any such value event, which would limit the Plan's ability to transact at contract value with participants, is probable.

The guaranteed investment contract does not permit the insurance company to terminate the agreement prior to the scheduled maturity date.

The Plan held an investment contract with contract values of \$99,568 and \$65,009 as of December 31, 2024 and 2023, respectively.

### **Note 7. Plan Termination**

Although it has not expressed any intent to do so, the Company has the right under the Plan to discontinue its contributions at any time and to terminate the Plan subject to the provisions of ERISA. In the event of Plan termination, participants would become 100% vested in their employer contributions.

## **Note 8. Tax Status**

The Plan operates under a nonstandardized adoption agreement in connection with a prototype retirement plan and trust/custodial document sponsored by ADP, LLC. This prototype plan document has been filed with the appropriate agency. The Plan has not obtained or requested a determination letter. However, the Plan Administrator believes that the Plan is currently designed and being operated in compliance with the applicable requirements of the Internal Revenue Code and that the Plan was qualified, and the related trust was tax exempt as of the financial statement date.

Accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America require Plan management to evaluate tax positions taken by the Plan and recognize a tax liability if the Plan has taken an uncertain position that more likely than not would not be sustained upon examination by the IRS. The Plan is subject to routine audits by taxing jurisdictions; however, there are currently no audits for any tax periods in progress.

## **Note 9. Risks and Uncertainties**

The Plan invests in various investment securities. Investment securities are exposed to various risks such as interest rate, market, and credit risks. Due to the level of risk associated with certain investment securities, it is at least reasonably possible that changes in the values of investment securities will occur in the near term and that such changes could materially affect the participants' account balances and the amounts reported in the statements of net assets available for benefits.
