A. ACTUARIAL METHODS

1. Unit Credit Cost Method

The actuarial accrued liabilities for active and deferred vested participants are determined as the actuarial present value of their accrued benefits. The actuarial accrued liabilities for retired participants and beneficiaries are determined as the actuarial present value of their annuity benefits.

The normal cost for the plan is the actuarial present value of benefits expected to be earned during the year.

2. Actuarial Value of Assets

Valuation assets are equal to the market value of assets as of the valuation date.

1. The annual interest discount to the valuation date for each benefit distribution is based on the year of distribution using the table below:

2. Mortality rates are based on the Static Mortality Table applicable to this year as defined in Regulations 1.430(h)(3)-1(a)(3) using annuitant and non-annuitant rates.
3. No termination of employment is assumed.
4. Retirement is assumed to occur at age 65.
5. It is assumed that all participants will elect lump sum distributions.

C. BASIS FOR ACTUARIAL ASSUMPTIONS

The interest discount is based on the Segment Rates shown in Item 1. These Segment Rates are required by law and regulations. We do not choose these interest rates.

The mortality table used in this valuation, indicated in Item 2 is required by law and regulations. We did not choose this table.

Actuarial assumptions other than shown in Item 1 and 2 were chosen by us based on experience of this plan.

The interest discount and the mortality table were changed as required by the Pension Protection Act.

A. PLAN PROVISIONS AS OF JANUARY 1, 2024

1. Effective date

January 1, 2022.

2. Definitions

(a) Actuarial Equivalent

The actuarial equivalent value for an annuity form of distribution is determined based on interest of 4.5% annually preretirement and postretirement.

(b) Compensation

Compensation is the amount reported on Form W-2 or K-1.

(c) Interest Crediting Rate

The Interest Crediting Rate is 4.5% annually.

(d) Normal Retirement Age

The later of attainment of age 62 and the fifth anniversary of plan participation.

(e) Plan Year

January 1 to December 31.

3. Plan Participation

Employees commence participation on the first day of the Plan Year nearest completion of 1 year of Eligibility Service and attainment of age 21.

4. Service

(a) Eligibility Service

A 12 consecutive-month period of employment during which an employee completes at least 1,000 Hours of Service. The first period begins on the date of employment. Subsequent periods begin at the beginning of Plan Years.

(b) Vesting Service

A plan year during which an employee completes at least 1,000 Hours of Service.

5. Pension Account

(a) Employer Credits

Participants who complete at least 500 Hours of Service in a Plan Year will be credited with the amount determined by the Plan for Members of their Group. Credits will be limited by IRC Section 415.

(b) Interest Credits

Interest Credits are determined by multiplying the Participant's Cash Balance Account on the last day of the prior Plan Year times the Interest Crediting Rate. The Interest Crediting Rate is prorated for determination periods of less than one year.

6. Benefits

(a) Vesting

Participant's Pension Account is fully vested after 3 Years of Vesting Service.

(b) Distributions

Participants are eligible for benefit distributions on termination or retirement. A distribution may be taken under any Form of Benefit provided by the plan.

7. Pre-Retirement Death Benefit

(a) Eligibility

All vested participants are covered.

(b) Amount

Participant's Pension Account is payable to the beneficiary. The surviving spouse will receive at least the actuarial equivalent of the Qualified Pre-retirement Survivor Annuity unless this is waived by the spouse.

8. Form of Benefit

(a) Lump Sum Payment

A lump sum payment is a distribution of the Pension Account at that time.

(b) Annuity Forms of Benefit

Income under an annuity form of benefit is the actuarial equivalent of the Pension Account. Joint and survivor forms of benefit provide for 50%, 66 2/3%, 75% or 100% continuation to the contingent annuitant. Term certain and life forms of benefit provide for a guarantee of 60, 120 monthly payments.

(c) Spouse Consent Requirement

A participant who is married at the time when his benefits commence is deemed to have elected the contingent annuitant option with 50% continuation to his surviving spouse unless he declines this form of benefit with the consent of his spouse in the manner specified in the Plan.
