Report on the Audit of the Financial Statements

Opinion

NOTE 1 DESCRIPTION OF PLAN

The following description of ABC Nevada Chapter Benefit Trust Fund Welfare Benefit Plan (the Plan) is provided for general information purposes only. Reference should be made to the Plan agreement for a more complete description of the Plan's provisions.

General

The Plan and Trust were established July 1, 2011 to provide health and other benefits to eligible participants and their covered dependents. Contributions are paid by participating employers to the trust fund for the exclusive purpose of creating and administering an employee welfare benefit plan. The Plan is not collectively bargained, and it does not apply to employees covered by a collective bargaining agreement. As required by the Consolidated Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act of 1985 (COBRA), the Plan includes a continuation of coverage option to certain terminated, retired, and totally disabled participants and their covered dependents for a period not to exceed 18 months. The Plan is subject to the provisions of the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Eligibility

Each participating employer may choose to cover all of its employees or only its indentured apprentices.

Member Firm Employees: Employers have the option of covering all or none of their other employees who work between 86 and 129 hours per month. These employees must complete at least one full month of work before coverage will start, although the employer may specify either one or two months as the waiting period before coverage begins. If an employee can show verification of other coverage, he or she need not be covered by the Plan. Coverage ends at midnight on the last day of the month in which eligibility ceases.

Indentured Apprentices: Indentured apprentices, for whom contributions are paid on an hourly basis, are eligible for benefits on the first day of the month following the month in which they reach 260 accumulated hours in their reserve. If an employee works more than 130 hours in a month, the excess is held in reserve. This reserve is available for months in which the employee works less than 130 hours. Coverage continues on a month-to-month basis as long as the participating employee has at least 130 hours remaining in their reserve. Coverage ends at the end of the month in which the ending reserve hours are insufficient to cover the participant for eligibility the following month.

Effective April 1, 2024, if an apprentice employee works more than the required 130 hours each month, the excess contributions will be held in an hour bank reserve up to a maximum of 160 hours. There is no further obligation of employers to make contributions once the 160-hour limit is reached.

NOTE 1 DESCRIPTION OF PLAN (CONTINUED)

Benefits

The Plan provides group medical, prescription drug, dental, and vision benefits to the employees and their dependents of the employers participating in the ABC Nevada Chapter Apprenticeship Program and to member contractor firms of the ABC Nevada Chapter. The Plan provides these benefits through various contracts with insurance companies. The Plan purchases annual insurance contracts for these insured benefits. Premiums for these insured benefits are paid to the insurance company directly from the assets of the Plan.

Contributions

The participating employers contribute to the Plan for employees who are apprentices with the ABC Nevada Chapter Southern Division Apprenticeship Program. The trustees establish contribution amounts needed to pay premiums and Plan expenses. Participants are responsible to pay premiums for COBRA and dependent coverage. Employer contributions received in excess of Plan insurance premiums and other expenses are held in the Plan to pay premiums for all eligible participants during their coverage periods.

Member firms enroll in selective programs for their construction employees and office staff and contribute to the Plan based on the benefits elected and rates, which are set annually.

NOTE 2 SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of Accounting

The financial statements of the Plan are prepared on the accrual basis of accounting in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America.

Use of Estimates

The preparation of financial statements, in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America, requires the Plan's management to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts of assets, liabilities, benefit obligations, and changes therein, and disclosure of contingent assets and liabilities. Actual results could differ from those estimates.

Concentration of Credit Risk

The Plan maintains its cash in bank deposit accounts which, at times, may exceed federally insured limits. The Plan has not experienced any losses in such accounts. The Plan believes it is not exposed to any significant credit risk on cash.

NOTE 2 SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES (CONTINUED)

Employer Contributions Receivable

Contributions due but not paid prior to year-end are recorded as contributions receivable. Contributions are due from employers as specified in the participation agreement. In general, contributions are due on the 15th day of each month following the work month. Delinquent contributions are individually analyzed for collectability. The estimate for expected credit losses considers historical loss experience, current economic conditions, and forward-looking information, including factors such as payment history, employer financial condition, and labor trends. As of December 31, 2024, the allowance for credit losses was insignificant.

Administrative Expenses

All administrative expenses may be paid out of the Plan unless paid by ABC Nevada Chapter. During the years ended December 31, 2024 and 2023, the Plan paid for substantially all administrative expenses, which consisted of administration fees, professional fees, and other miscellaneous expenses.

Reclassification

Certain amounts in the 2023 financial statements have been reclassified to conform with the 2024 presentation. This reclassification does not affect net assets available for benefits as previously reported.

Subsequent Events

Subsequent events have been evaluated through September 2, 2025, the date on which the financial statements were available to be issued.

NOTE 3 HOUR BANK LIABILITY

As described in Note 1, indentured apprentices meeting eligibility requirements are entitled to coverage assuming the participating employee has at least 130 hours accumulated in their account. In months where the employee works fewer than 130 hours, their accumulated hour bank is used to pay that month's premiums until the hour bank drops below 130 hours. The estimate of the hour bank liability is based upon the accumulated hours for all participating employees at the equivalent hourly cost of insurance for the upcoming Plan year. As of December 31, 2024 and 2023, the estimated liability for the hour bank was \$728,487 and \$589,022, respectively.

An employee who terminates employment with less than 130 hours remaining in their hour bank will forfeit those hours after three months if no additional hours are contributed to increase the hour bank to 130 hours. Forfeitures may be used at the discretion of the Plan trustees to pay for plan benefits for all participants.

NOTE 4 TRANSACTIONS WITH PARTIES-IN-INTEREST

Plan Administrator

The Plan has several arrangements with service providers. These transactions are party-in-interest transactions under ERISA.

One of these arrangements is with ABC Nevada Chapter to provide certain accounting and administrative services. Administrative fees paid to ABC Nevada Chapter during the years ended December 31, 2024 and 2023 were \$254,962 and \$263,895, respectively. As of December 31, 2024 and 2023, payables to ABC Nevada Chapter of \$73,138 and \$45,812, respectively, were included in accounts payable in the accompanying statements of net assets available for benefits.

NOTE 5 TAX STATUS

The Plan is a multiple employer welfare arrangement under ERISA. The Trust established under the Plan to hold the Plan's assets has not applied for exemption from federal income taxes. The Plan is required to pay federal taxes on unrelated business income as defined by Internal Revenue Code Section 512(e)(3)(E). Unrelated business income consists of the investment income earned on the excess of the net assets available for benefits over the required reserve balance allowable under the Internal Revenue Code. The Plan administrator believes the Plan does not have any net taxable income for the years ended December 31, 2024 and 2023, therefore, no tax liability is reflected in these financial statements.

Accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America require Plan management to evaluate tax positions taken by the Plan and recognize a tax liability (or asset) if the Plan has taken an uncertain position that more likely than not would not be sustained upon examinations by the Internal Revenue Service. The Plan administrator has analyzed the tax positions taken by the Plan, and has concluded that as of December 31, 2024 and 2023, there are no uncertain positions taken or expected to be taken that would require recognition of a liability (or asset) or disclosure in the financial statements. The Plan is subject to routine audits by taxing jurisdictions; however, there are currently no audits for any tax periods in progress.

NOTE 6 PLAN TERMINATION

The Plan Sponsor and participating employers intend to continue the Plan but reserve the right to terminate or change the Plan at any time. The Plan Sponsor and participating employers do not promise continuation of any benefits nor do they promise any benefits at or during retirement. Benefits may also be terminated by the participating employer's failure to make contributions or by the termination or expiration of the participating employer's agreement adopting the Plan. Upon termination of the Plan, the trustees will wind up the affairs of the Plan and any remaining funds will be used to continue payment of benefits to participants and their beneficiaries under the Plan.
