**INDEPENDENT AUDITORS' REPORT**

To the Trustees  
The Kay Management Co., Inc. Profit Sharing Plan and Trust

**Scope and Nature of the ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) Audit**

We have performed audits of the accompanying financial statements of The Kay Management Co., Inc. Profit Sharing Plan and Trust, an employee benefit plan subject to the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA), as permitted by ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C). The financial statements comprise the statements of net assets available for benefits as of December 31, 2024 and 2023, and the related statements of changes in net assets available for benefits for the years then ended, all on the modified cash basis, and the related notes to the financial statements.

As permitted by ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C), our audits need not extend to any statements or information related to assets held for investment of the plan (investment information) by a bank or similar institution or insurance carrier that is regulated, supervised, and subject to periodic examination by a state or federal agency, provided that the statements or information regarding assets so held are prepared and certified to by the bank or similar institution or insurance carrier in accordance with 29 CFR 2520.103-5 of the Department of Labor's Rules and Regulations for Reporting and Disclosure under ERISA (qualified institution).

The Plan administrator has obtained certifications from qualified institutions as of and for the years ended December 31, 2024 and 2023, stating that the certified investment information, as described in Note 7 to the financial statements, is complete and accurate.

**Opinion**

In our opinion, based on our audits and on the procedures performed as described in the Auditors' Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements section-

- the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements referred to above, other than those agreed to or derived from the certified investment information, are presented fairly, in all material respects, in accordance with the modified cash basis of accounting.
- the information in the financial statements referred to above related to assets held by and certified to by qualified institutions agree to, or is derived from, in all material respects, the information prepared and certified by the institutions that management determined meets the requirements of ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C).

## **Basis for Opinion**

We conducted our audits in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America. Our responsibilities under those standards are further described in the Auditors' Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements section of our report. We are required to be independent of The Kay Management Co., Inc. Profit Sharing Plan and Trust and to meet our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with the relevant ethical requirements relating to our audits. We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) audit opinion.

## **Basis of Accounting**

We draw attention to Note 2 of the financial statements, which describes the basis of accounting. The financial statements and supplemental schedules were prepared on a modified cash basis of accounting, which is a comprehensive basis of accounting other than accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America. Our opinion is not modified with respect to that matter.

## **Responsibilities of Management for the Financial Statements**

Management is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of the financial statements in accordance with the modified cash basis of accounting as described in Note 2; this includes determining that the modified cash basis of accounting is an acceptable basis for the preparation of the financial statements in the circumstances. NOTES TO FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

DECEMBER 31, 2024 AND 2023

1. DESCRIPTION OF PLAN:

The following description of The Kay Management Co., Inc. Profit Sharing Plan and Trust (Plan) is provided for general information purposes only. Participants should refer to the Plan Agreement for a more complete description of the Plan's provisions.

**General:** The Plan includes eligible employees of Kay Management Co., Inc. (Kay Management) and the employees of various real estate entities for which Kay Management provides general, administrative and property management services. The Plan is a defined contribution plan with a deferred tax arrangement under Section 401(k) of the Internal Revenue Code. The Plan is subject to the provisions of the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA). On February 1, 2021, the Plan adopted a prototype plan offered by Empower Trust Company, LLC.

**Eligibility:** All employees who have three months of consecutive service are eligible to participate in salary deferrals and rollover contributions on the entry date during the Plan year in which eligibility requirements are met. Participants become 100% vested once they have met eligibility requirements.

All employees who attain the age of 21 and have one year of employment and completed 1,000 hours of service are eligible to participate in 3% safe harbor non-elective contributions on the entry date during the Plan year in which the eligibility requirements are met. Participants become 100% vested once they have met the eligibility requirements.

All employees who attain the age of 21 and have two years of employment and completed 1,000 hours of service each year are eligible to participate in discretionary profit sharing plan contributions on the entry date during the Plan year in which the eligibility requirements are met. Participants become 100% vested once they have met the eligibility requirements.

**Notes Receivable from Participants:** Participants may borrow from their fund accounts a minimum of \$1,000 up to a maximum equal to the lesser of \$50,000 or 50% of their vested account balance. Loan terms range up to 5 years, with exceptions made for the purchase of a permanent residence. The notes are secured by the balance in the participant's account and currently are charged interest from 4.25% to 9.50%, which is commensurate with local prevailing rates as determined by the Plan administrator. Principal and interest are paid ratably through monthly payroll deductions.

**Employer Contributions:** Employer contributions, in excess of a 3% safe harbor non-elective contribution, are discretionary, but in no event are they to exceed certain thresholds as defined in the Plan Agreement. Employer contributions to the Plan are recognized as income in the plan year in which such contributions are deducted for income tax purposes by the employer.

**Participant Contributions:** Each participant's account is credited with the participant's contribution. Participants may contribute up to the maximum amount allowed by the Internal Revenue Code. The Plan includes an autoenrollment provision whereby all newly eligible employees are automatically enrolled in the Plan, unless they affirmatively elect not to participate, with a default deferral rate set at 3% of eligible compensation.

**1. DESCRIPTION OF PLAN (CONTINUED):**

**Participant Accounts:** Employer contributions are allocated to the individual accounts of participants in accordance with a formula based upon compensation. The income and gains or losses (both realized and unrealized) arising from the Plan's investments are allocated to the individual accounts of participants in accordance with a formula based upon their account balances.

**Payment of Benefits:** On termination of service due to death, disability, or when the participant reaches age 59 ½, a participant may elect to receive a lump sum amount equal to the value of the participant's vested interest in his or her account. For termination of service for other reasons, a participant may receive the value of the vested interest in his or her account as a lump sum distribution.

**Forfeited Accounts:** At December 31, 2024 and 2023, forfeited nonvested accounts totaled \$24,537 and \$24,136, respectively. These accounts will be used to pay administrative expenses or reduce future employer contributions.

**2. SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES:**

**Basis of Accounting:** The financial statements are prepared on a modified cash basis under which revenues are recognized when collected rather than when earned, except for employer contributions to the Plan are recognized as income in the plan year in which such contributions are deducted for income tax purposes by the employer, and unrealized appreciation or depreciation, which are recognized when earned, and expenditures generally are recognized when paid rather than when incurred.

**Use of Estimates:** The accompanying financial statements have been prepared on a modified cash basis which require the Plan's trustees to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts of assets, liabilities, and changes in net assets as well as the disclosure of contingent assets and liabilities at the date of the financial statements. Actual results could differ from those estimates.

**Income Taxes:** The Plan's Forms 5500, Annual Return/Report of Employee Benefit Plan, that have been filed with the U.S. Department of Labor as of December 31, 2024, for the years ended December 31, 2023, 2022 and 2021 are subject to examination by the Internal Revenue Service, generally for three years after the date they were filed.

**Investment Valuation and Income Recognition:** All investments are participant directed. Investments in mutual funds are stated at market value as of the close of business on the last day of the Plan year. Fully benefit-responsive investments are reported at contract value. Contract value is the relevant measure for that portion of the net assets available for benefits of a defined contribution plan attributable to fully benefit-responsive investment contracts because contract value is the amount participants normally would receive if they were to initiate permitted transactions under the terms of the plan.

Purchases and sales of securities are recorded on a trade-date basis. Interest income and dividends are recorded as income when received. Net appreciation (depreciation) includes the Plan's gains and losses on investments bought and sold as well as held during the year.

**2. SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES (CONTINUED):**

**Notes Receivable from Participants:** Notes receivable from participants are measured at their unpaid principal balance plus any assessed but unpaid interest. Interest income is recorded when assessed. Related fees are charged directly to the borrowing participant's account. As of December 2024 and 2023, no allowance for credit losses has been recorded. If a participant does not make loan payments and the Plan administrator considers the participant loan to be in default, the loan balance is reduced, and delinquent participant note receivable is recorded as a benefit payment based on the terms of the Plan document.

**Payment of Benefits:** Benefits are recorded when paid.

**Operating Expenses:** Certain expenses of maintaining the Plan are paid directly by the Kay Management Company and are excluded from these financial statements. Fees related to the administration of notes receivable from participants are charged directly to the participant's account.

**Concentration of Credit Risk:** The concentration of credit risk is related to cash, investments, employer contribution receivable and notes receivable from participants. At times during the year, cash maintained at financial institutions may exceed the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation insurance limit. Employer contribution receivable represent amounts due from the employer which were received shortly after year end. See Notes 3 and 4 for a further explanation of the investments.

**Date of Management's Review:** Subsequent events were evaluated through October 6, 2025, which is the date the financial statements were available to be issued.

**3. INVESTMENTS AND FAIR VALUE MEASUREMENTS:**

FASB ASC 820-10 defines fair value, establishes a framework for measuring fair value, and expands disclosures about fair value measurements. Fair value is defined as the price that would be received to sell an asset or paid to transfer a liability in an orderly transaction between market participants at the measurement date (exit price). FASB ASC 820-10 includes a fair value hierarchy that prioritizes the inputs to valuation techniques used to measure fair value. The hierarchy gives the highest priority to unadjusted quoted prices in active markets for identical assets and liabilities (Level 1), and the lowest priority to unobservable inputs (Level 3). The Plan had no Level 2 or Level 3 investments. The following describes Level 1:

Level 1 - Unadjusted quoted prices for identical assets or liabilities in active markets.

Mutual Funds (Level 1): Valued at the net asset value (NAV) of shares held by the Plan at year end, which is also the price at which these funds are reported in the active market in which they are traded.

**4. GUARANTEED INVESTMENT CONTRACT WITH INSURANCE COMPANY:**

On February 1, 2021, the Plan entered into a traditional fully benefit-responsive guaranteed investment contract with Empower Annuity Insurance Company of America. Empower Annuity Insurance Company of America maintains the contributions in a general account. The account is credited with earnings on the underlying investments and charged for participant withdrawals and administrative expenses. The guaranteed investment contract issuer is contractually obligated to repay the principal and a specified interest rate that is guaranteed to the Plan.

**4. GUARANTEED INVESTMENT CONTRACT WITH INSURANCE COMPANY (CONTINUED):**

Because the guaranteed investment contract meets the criteria to be considered fully benefit-responsive, contract value is the relevant measurement attribute for that portion of the net assets available for benefits attributable to the guaranteed investment contract.

The guaranteed investment contract is presented on the face of the statements of the net assets available for benefits at contract value. Contract value, as reported to the Plan by Empower Annuity Insurance Company of America represents contributions made under the contract, plus earnings, less participant withdrawals and administrative expenses. Participants may ordinarily direct the withdrawal or transfer of all or a portion of their investment at contract value.

There are no reserves against the contract value for credit risk of the contract issuer or otherwise. The contract value of the investment contract was \$4,223,682 and \$4,537,286 at December 31, 2024 and 2023, respectively. The methodology for calculating the interest crediting rate is based on the earnings of the underlying assets in the entire medium-long term new portfolio compared to the minimum interest crediting rate, as stated in the contract, and prevailing market conditions. Interest crediting rate is reset quarterly. The average yield was 1.66% and 1.48% in 2024 and 2023, respectively.

Certain events limit the Plan's ability to transact at contract value with Empower Annuity Insurance Company of America. Such events include the following: (a) the complete or partial termination of the Plan; (b) the establishment or activation of, or material change in, any Plan investment fund, or an amendment to the Plan or a change in the administration or operation of the Plan, including the removal of a group of employees from Plan coverage as a result of the sale or liquidation of a subsidiary or division or a result of group layoffs or early retirement programs. The Plan administrator does not believe that any events that would limit the Plan's ability to transact at contract value with Plan participants or the issuer are probable of occurring.

**5. TAX STATUS:**

The Plan obtained its last determination letter on June 11, 1993, in which the Internal Revenue Service stated that the Plan, as then designed, was in compliance with the applicable requirements of the Internal Revenue Code (IRC).

On March 31, 2014, Empower Trust Company, LLC's master prototype plan received its last favorable determination letter, in which the Internal Revenue Service stated that the Plan and related trust are designed in accordance with applicable sections of the IRC.

**6. PLAN TERMINATION:**

Although the employer has not expressed any intent to do so, the employer reserves the right under the Plan to discontinue its contributions at any time and to terminate the Plan subject to the provisions of ERISA.
