## INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT

To the Plan Administrator of the  
Dominion Payroll Services, LLC 401(k) Profit Sharing Plan

### Scope and Nature of the ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) Audit

We have performed audits of the accompanying financial statements of Dominion Payroll Services, LLC 401(k) Profit Sharing Plan (the "Plan"), an employee benefit plan subject to the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 ("ERISA"), as permitted by ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C). The financial statements comprise the statements of net assets available for benefits as of December 31, 2024 and 2023, and the related statements of changes in net assets available for benefits for the years then ended, and the related notes to the financial statements.

Management has obtained certifications from qualified institutions as of December 31, 2024 and 2023, and for the years then ended, stating that the certified investment information, as described in Note 10 to the financial statements, is complete and accurate.

### Opinion

Notes to Financial Statements

**1. Description of Plan:**

The following description of the Dominion Payroll Services, LLC 401(k) Profit Sharing Plan (the "Plan") provides only general information. Participants should refer to the Plan agreement or summary plan description for a more complete description of the Plan's provisions.

**General:** The Plan is a defined contribution plan covering all eligible employees of Dominion Payroll Services, LLC (the "Company"). The Plan was formed on January 1, 2008. Full time employees become eligible to participate immediately upon employment. Part-time employees become eligible after working 1000 hours of service or one year of employment. The Plan is subject to the provisions of the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 ("ERISA").

In December 2022, the SECURE 2.0 Act (the "Act") was signed into law, including a range of provisions intended to enhance retirement savings, improve plan administration, and increase coverage of workplace retirement plans. No provisions of the Act required amendments to the Plan for compliance.

**Plan Administration:** Overall responsibility for administering the Plan rests with the Company. Participant accounts are administered by NFP Retirement Inc., which serves as the third-party administrator of the Plan. All assets of the Plan are held by the trustees Empower Trust Company, LLC and Empower Annuity Insurance Company of America (the "Trustees").

**Contributions:** The Plan provides for participant contributions of pre-tax and after-tax annual compensation for eligible employees, as defined in the Plan. Participants of qualifying age may make additional "catch-up" contributions. Participants may also contribute amounts representing distributions from other qualified defined benefit or defined contribution plans. The Plan provides for safe harbor matching contributions equal to 100% of the participant's deferrals up to 4% of the participant's compensation. The Company may make discretionary match or profit sharing contributions to the Plan for eligible employees as defined by the Plan. There were no discretionary match or profit-sharing contributions for 2024 or 2023.

**Participant Accounts:** Each participant's account is credited with the participant's contributions and allocations of (a) the Company's contributions and (b) Plan earnings or losses and charged with a portion of administrative expenses. Allocations are based on participant compensation or account balances, as defined by the Plan. The benefit to which a participant is entitled is the benefit that can be provided from the participant's vested account.

**1. Description of Plan, Continued:**

**Investment Options:** Participants may direct the Trustees as to the investment of their account balances in accordance with guidelines established by the Plan. Participants may change their investment elections at any time.

**Vesting:** Participants are immediately 100% vested in their contributions, plus actual earnings thereon, upon entering the Plan. Participants are also immediately 100% vested in Safe Harbor matching contributions. Vesting in other discretionary matching and employer profit-sharing contributions, plus actual earnings thereon, occurs on a graduated scale as follows:

Less than two years	0%
Two years	20%
Three years	40%
Four years	60%
Five years	80%
Six or more years	100%

Participants become fully vested in all contributions at the time of attainment of retirement age, disability, or death.

**Forfeitures:** Forfeited balances of terminated participants' non-vested accounts may be used to pay Plan administrative expenses or to reduce Company contributions. There were forfeited balances of \$627 and \$121 at December 31, 2024 and 2023, respectively. During 2024, there were \$506 in forfeitures and no forfeitures were applied to administrative expenses. During 2023, there were no forfeitures and \$7,835 of forfeitures were applied to administrative expenses.

**Notes Receivable from Participants:** Participants may borrow from their Plan accounts a minimum of \$1,000 and no more than \$50,000 or 50% of their vested account balance. Loan terms cannot exceed five years unless the proceeds are used to acquire a principal residence. The loans are secured by the vested balance in the participant's account and bear interest at a rate determined by the plan administrator, based on similar loans made by other entities at the time of loan issuance. Principal and interest are paid ratably through payroll deductions. Notes receivable from participants are measured at their unpaid principal balance plus any accrued but unpaid interest. Delinquent notes receivable from participants, deemed to be in default by Plan management, are reclassified as distributions based upon the terms of the Plan document. Management has evaluated notes receivable from participants for collectability and has determined that no allowance is considered necessary.

**1. Description of Plan, Continued:**

**Payment of Benefits:** Distribution of the vested portion of a participant's account will occur upon the participant's termination of service, retirement, death, hardship withdrawal, or attainment of age 65, as defined in the Plan. A participant is entitled to receive a lump-sum payment as described in the Plan documents, in an amount equal to the vested value of his or her account. As described in the Plan document, partial withdrawals or installments are only permitted for participants or beneficiaries required to receive minimum distributions.

**2. Summary of Significant Accounting Policies:**

**Basis of Accounting:** The financial statements of the Plan are prepared on the accrual method of accounting.

Investment contracts held by a defined contribution plan are required to be reported at fair value, except for fully benefit-responsive investment contracts. Contract value is the relevant measurement attribute for that portion of the net assets available for benefits of a defined contribution plan attributable to fully benefit-responsive investment contracts because contract value is the amount participants would receive if they were to initiate permitted transactions under the terms of the Plan.

**Investment Valuation and Income Recognition:** Investments are reported at fair value (except for fully benefit-responsive investment contracts, which are reported at contract value). Fair value is the price that would be received to sell an asset or paid to transfer a liability in an orderly transaction between market participants at the measurement date. See Note 3 for a further discussion of fair value measurements.

Net realized and unrealized appreciation is recorded in the accompanying statements of changes in net assets available for benefits as net appreciation in fair value of assets. Purchases and sales of securities are recorded on a trade-date basis. Interest income is recorded on the accrual basis. Dividends are recorded on the ex-dividend date.

**Payment of Benefits:** Benefits are recorded when paid.

**Use of Estimates:** The preparation of financial statements in conformity with generally accepted accounting principles requires the Plan administrator to make estimates and assumptions that affect certain reported amounts and disclosures. Actual results may differ from those estimates.

**2. Summary of Significant Accounting Policies, Continued:**

**Subsequent Events:** In February 2025, the Company terminated its separate sponsored plan, Dominion Payroll Services Tennessee 401(k) Plan. Through a company restructure, all participants of that prior plan became employees of the Company and therefore eligible for the Dominion Payroll Services 401(k) Plan in accordance with the Plan terms. Existing balances were migrated to the Plan. Management has evaluated subsequent events through July 23, 2025, the date the financial statements were available to be issued and has determined there are no other subsequent events to be reported in the accompanying financial statements.

**3. Fair Value Measurements:**

The Financial Accounting Standards Board ("FASB") has issued guidance for measurement and disclosure of fair value and establishes a three-tier fair value hierarchy, which prioritizes the inputs used in measuring fair value as follows:

- Level 1 Inputs to the valuation methodology are unadjusted quoted prices for identical assets or liabilities in active markets that the Plan has the ability to access.
- Level 2 Inputs to the valuation methodology are quoted prices for similar instruments in active and inactive markets; and model driven valuations with significant inputs and drivers derived from observable active markets.
- Level 3 Inputs to the valuation methodology are unobservable and significant to the fair value measurement.

Valuation techniques used should maximize the use of observable inputs and minimize the use of unobservable inputs. The following is a description of the valuation methodologies used for investments carried or disclosed at fair value:

**Mutual funds:** Valued at the daily closing price as reported by the fund. Mutual funds held by the Plan are open-end mutual funds that are registered with the Securities and Exchange Commission. These funds are required to publish their daily net asset value ("NAV") and to transact at that price. The mutual funds held by the Plan are deemed to be actively traded.

**3. Fair Value Measurements, Continued:**

The method described above may produce a fair value calculation that may not be indicative of net realizable value or reflective of future fair values. Furthermore, while the Plan administrator believes its valuation methods are appropriate and consistent with other market participants, the use of different methodologies or assumptions to determine the fair value of certain financial instruments could result in a different fair value measurement at the reporting date.

**4. Fixed Annuity Contract:**

The Plan offers a fixed annuity contract with Empower Annuity Insurance Company of America ("Empower Insurance") that totaled \$44,498 at December 31, 2024 and \$63,534 at December 31, 2023. Contributions are maintained in a general account that is credited with earnings on the underlying investments and charged for participant withdrawals and administrative expenses.

The guaranteed investment contract issuer is contractually obligated to repay the principal and a specified interest rate that is guaranteed to the Plan. The methodology for calculating the interest crediting rate is based on the earnings of the underlying assets in the entire medium-long term new portfolio compared to the minimum interest crediting rate (0%) and prevailing market conditions. The interest crediting rate is reset quarterly. The guaranteed investment contract does not permit the insurance company to terminate the agreement prior to the scheduled maturity date. The average yield earned by the fund was 1.41% for 2024 and 1.23% for 2023.

**4. Fixed Annuity Contract, Continued:**

This contract meets the fully benefit-responsive investment contract criteria and therefore is reported at contract value. Contract value is the relevant measure for fully benefit-responsive investment contracts because this is the amount received by participants if they were to initiate permitted transactions under the terms of the Plan.

Contract value, as reported to the Plan by Empower Insurance, represents contributions made under the contract, plus earnings, less participant withdrawals and administrative expenses. Participants may ordinarily direct the withdrawal or transfer of all or a portion of their investment at contract value.

The Plan's ability to receive amounts due is dependent on the issuer's ability to meet its financial obligations. The issuer's ability to meet its contractual obligations may be affected by future economic and regulatory developments.

Certain events might limit the ability of the Plan to transact at contract value with the issuer. Such events include (1) amendments to the Plan documents (including complete or partial Plan termination or merger with another plan), (2) changes to the Plan's prohibition on competing investment options or deletion of equity wash provisions, (3) bankruptcy of the Plan sponsor or other Plan sponsor events (for example, divestitures or spin-offs of a subsidiary) that cause a significant withdrawal from the Plan, (4) the failure of the Plan to qualify for exemption from federal income taxes or any required prohibited transaction exemption under ERISA, or (5) premature termination of the contract. No events are probable of occurring that might limit the ability of the Plan to transact at contract value with the contract issuers and that also would limit the ability of the Plan to transact at contract value with the participants.

In addition, certain events allow the issuer to terminate the contract with the Plan and settle at an amount different from contract value. Such events include (1) an uncured violation of the Plan's investment guidelines, (2) a breach of material obligation under the contract, (3) a material misrepresentation, (4) a material amendment to the agreement without the consent of the issuer.

**5. Administrative Expenses:**

The Plan's administrative expenses are paid by either the Plan or the Company, as provided for in the Plan document. Certain administrative functions are performed by employees of the Company. No such employee receives compensation from the Plan. Expenses related to specific participant transactions are charged directly to the participant's account. The Plan paid administrative fees totaling \$32,772 in 2024 and \$31,701 in 2023.

**6. Related-Party Transactions:**

The Plan offers a fixed annuity contract that is administered by a Trustee of the Plan. This is considered a related-party transaction and is identified as party-in-interest in the accompanying Schedule of Assets (Held at End of Year). Fees paid to the Trustee totaled \$16,592 in 2024 and \$10,460 in 2023.

**7. Plan Termination:**

Although it has not expressed any intent to do so, the Company has the right under the Plan to discontinue its contributions at any time and to terminate the Plan subject to the provisions of ERISA. All contribution amounts become 100% vested at the time of termination.

**8. Tax Status:**

The Internal Revenue Service has determined and informed the prototype sponsor by letter dated June 30, 2020 that the adopted prototype plan and related trust are designed in accordance with the applicable sections of the Internal Revenue Code. The Plan has been amended since receiving the opinion letter; however, the Plan administrator believes the Plan is currently designed and being operated in compliance with the applicable requirements of the Internal Revenue Code.

Management has evaluated the effects of accounting guidance related to uncertain income tax positions and concluded that the Plan had no significant financial statement exposure to uncertain income tax positions at December 31, 2024 and 2023. The Plan is not currently under audit by any tax jurisdiction.

**9. Risks and Uncertainties:**

The Plan provides for various investments that are exposed to various risks, such as interest rate, market, and credit. Due to the level of risk associated with certain investment securities and the level of uncertainty related to changes in the value of investment securities, it is at least reasonably possible that changes in risks in the near term could materially affect participants' account balances and the amounts reported in the financial statements.
