## INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT

To the Board of Trustees of the  
Mid-Atlantic States District Council  
Participating Locals Annuity Fund

### Opinion

We have audited the financial statements of the Mid-Atlantic States District Council Participating Locals Annuity Fund (the Plan), an employee benefit plan subject to the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA), which comprise the statements of net assets available for benefits as of December 31, 2024 and 2023, and the related statements of changes in net assets available for benefits for the years then ended, and the related notes to the financial statements.

In our opinion, the accompanying financial statements present fairly, in all material respects, the net assets available for benefits of the Plan as of December 31, 2024 and 2023, and the changes in its net assets available for benefits for the years then ended, in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America.

### Basis for Opinion

We conducted our audits in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America (GAAS). Our responsibilities under those standards are further described in the Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements section of our report. We are required to be independent of the Plan and to meet our other ethical responsibilities, in accordance with the relevant ethical requirements relating to our audits. We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our audit opinion.

### Responsibilities of Management for the Financial Statements

Management is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of the financial statements in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America, and for the design, implementation, and maintenance of internal control relevant to the preparation and fair presentation of financial statements that are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

In preparing the financial statements, management is required to evaluate whether there are conditions or events, considered in the aggregate, that raise substantial doubt about the Plan's ability to continue as a going concern for one year after the date the financial statements are available to be issued.

Management is also responsible for maintaining a current plan instrument, including all Plan amendments, administering the Plan, and determining that the Plan's transactions that are presented and disclosed in the financial statements are in conformity with the Plan's provisions, including maintaining sufficient records with respect to each of the participants, to determine the benefits due or which may become due to such participants.

### **Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements**

Our objectives are to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements as a whole are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, and to issue an auditor's report that includes our opinion. Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance but is not absolute assurance and therefore is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with GAAS will always detect a material misstatement when it exists. The risk of not detecting a material misstatement resulting from fraud is higher than for one resulting from error, as fraud may involve collusion, forgery, intentional omissions, misrepresentations, or the override of internal control. We are required to communicate with those charged with governance regarding, among other matters, the planned scope and timing of the audit, significant audit findings, and certain internal control-related matters that we identified during the audit.

### **Report on Supplemental Information**

Our audits were conducted for the purpose of forming an opinion on the financial statements as a whole. The supplemental Schedule of Assets Held at End of Year is presented for the purpose of additional analysis and is not a required part of the financial statements. The supplemental Schedule of Assets Held at End of Year represents supplemental information required by the Department of Labor's Rules and Regulations for Reporting and Disclosure under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974, as amended. Supplemental information is the responsibility of the Plan's management and was derived from and relates directly to the underlying accounting and other records used to prepare the financial statements. The information has been subjected to the auditing procedures applied in the audits of the financial statements and certain additional procedures, including comparing and reconciling such information directly to the underlying accounting and other records used to prepare the financial statements or to the financial statements themselves, and other additional procedures in accordance with GAAS.

In forming our opinion on the supplemental information, we evaluated whether the supplemental information, including their form and content, are presented in conformity with the Department of Labor's Rules and regulations for Reporting and Disclosure under ERISA.

In our opinion, the information in the accompanying schedules is fairly stated, in all material respects, in relation to the financial statements as a whole, and the form and content are presented in conformity with the Department of Labor's Rules and regulations for Reporting and Disclosure under ERISA.

**NOTES TO FINANCIAL STATEMENTS**

DECEMBER 31, 2024 AND 2023

**NOTE 1. DESCRIPTION OF THE PLAN**

The following description of the Mid-Atlantic States District Council Participating Locals Annuity Fund (the Plan), provides only general information. Participants should refer to the summary plan description and Fund regulations for a more comprehensive description of the Plan's provisions.

**General** - The Plan is a defined contribution plan and is subject to the provisions of the Employee Retirement Income Security Act (ERISA) of 1974. The Plan was established in June 1995 by an agreement between Local Unions 697 of the International Association of Bridge, Structural and Ornamental Iron Workers and Employers to require contributions to this Plan. Subsequently, Local Union 843 joined July 1996, Local Union 201 joined May 1998, Local Union 28 merged January 2001 and Local Union 79 joined October 2010.

**Contributions** - Employers contribute an amount for each participant which is computed in accordance with the Collective Bargaining Agreement in effect.

**Participant Accounts** - Each participant's account is adjusted for its allocation of: (1) investment earnings or losses, as defined, (2) employers' contributions made for that account, and (3) administrative expenses. The benefit to which a participant is entitled is the benefit that can be provided from the participant's account.

**Vesting** - Participants are at all times 100% vested in the contributions and earnings allocated or allocable to their account.

**Payments of Benefits** - Upon termination of service due to death, disability, or separation from service as a participating employer or union, a participant may choose from a variety of distribution options. The amount of benefits in this Plan depends on the amount in each participant's account and the extent to which the participant is vested in that amount.

**Investments** - The Fund has an investment contract with Massachusetts Mutual Life Insurance Company (MassMutual). MassMutual maintains the contributions in registered investment companies, guaranteed investment contract, and pooled separate accounts. A pooled separate account is a separate investment account in which several plans participate. Each plan's share of a pooled separate account is determined on a participation-unit or a variable-unit basis. The Plan's investment account provides a cumulative record of the number of participation units credited to the account and the number of units allocated or withdrawn from the account.

## **NOTE 1. DESCRIPTION OF THE PLAN (continued)**

The balance of the participation-units credited to the account multiplied by the current participation-unit equals the amount of investment account assets held on behalf of the participant at any given time. The participation-unit value is adjusted periodically, usually each business day, to reflect investment results under the separate account. The investments were stated at fair value.

Contributions may be invested in any one or a combination of the funds listed below. Participants may transfer existing account balances to or from any of the available funds on any business day.

## **NOTE 2. SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES**

**Basis of Accounting** - The financial statements of the Plan have been prepared using the accrual basis of accounting in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America.

**Use of Estimates** - The preparation of financial statements in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect certain reported amounts and disclosures in the financial statements. Actual results could differ from those estimates.

## **NOTE 2. SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES (continued)**

**Valuation of Investments and Recognition of Income** - Investments are stated at fair value. The fair value of investments is determined by the Plan's investment custodian and is based on quoted market prices or net asset value of the fund when available. The pooled separate accounts and registered investment companies are valued at their market value on the last business day of the year.

Pooled separate accounts (pooled accounts): These are comprised of the fund or units in pooled accounts that are not publicly traded. The fund administrator values the fund using the net asset value per fund share, derived from the value of the underlying assets. The underlying assets in these funds (equity securities, fixed income securities, and commodity-related securities) are generally publicly traded on exchanges and price quotes for the assets held by these funds are readily available.

Registered investment companies: Valued at the net asset value of the fund held by the Plan at year end.

Purchases and sales of securities are recorded on a trade-date basis. Interest and dividend income are recorded on the accrual basis. Net appreciation (depreciation) includes the Plan's gains and losses on investments bought and sold as well as held during the year.

**Employer Contributions Receivables** - Employers' contributions receivable is calculated by determining the contribution value of hours worked by eligible employees prior to year-end and reported by participating employers after year-end. All receivables are fully collectible; therefore, no allowance for uncollectible receivables has been set up.

**Payment of Benefits** - Benefits are recognized upon distribution.

## **NOTE 3. PRIORITIES UPON TERMINATION**

In the event of the termination of this Agreement and Declaration of Trust, the Trustees will provide for the payment out of the Plan of expenses incurred up to the date of termination of the Plan and the expenses in connection with the termination, also they will arrange for a final audit and report of their transactions and accounts for the purpose of terminating their Trusteeship. The Trustees will give any notice and prepare and file any reports which may be required by law and apply the Plan in accordance with the provisions of the Plan of Benefits including amendments adopted as part of the termination until the Plan is disbursed.

No part of the corpus of income of the Plan will be used for or diverted to purposes other than for the exclusive benefit of the Employees and Beneficiaries or the administrative expenses of the Plan. Under no circumstances will any portion of the Plan revert or inure to the benefit of any contributing Employer, the Association or Additional Association or the Unions either directly or indirectly.

#### **NOTE 4. TAX STATUS**

The Plan obtained its latest determination letter on February 12, 2016, in which the Internal Revenue Service stated that the Plan, as then designed, was in compliance with the applicable requirements of the Internal Revenue Code. The Plan has been amended since receiving the determination letter. However, Plan management believes that the Plan is currently designed and being operated in compliance with the applicable requirements of the Internal Revenue Code.

Accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America require Plan management to evaluate tax positions taken by the Plan and recognize a tax liability if the Plan has taken an uncertain position that, more likely than not, would not be sustained upon examination by the U.S. Federal, state, or local taxing authorities. The Plan is subject to routine audits by taxing jurisdictions; however, there are currently no audits for any tax periods in progress. Typically, plan tax years will remain open for three years; however, this may differ depending upon the circumstances of the Plan.

#### **NOTE 5. RECIPROCAL CONTRIBUTIONS**

The Plan has signed a national reciprocal agreement with other participating Funds. Under this agreement, certain employer contributions are received from and/or paid to reciprocating Local Union Pension Funds for hours worked within each Local Union's respective jurisdiction.

#### **NOTE 6. FAIR VALUE MEASUREMENTS**

The framework for measuring fair value provides a fair value hierarchy that prioritizes the inputs to valuation techniques used to measure fair value. The hierarchy gives the highest priority to unadjusted quoted prices in active markets for identical assets or liabilities (Level 1) and the lowest priority to unobservable inputs (Level 3). The three levels of the fair value hierarchy are described as follows:

##### **Basis of Fair Value Measurement:**

Level 1 - Inputs to the valuation methodology are unadjusted quoted prices for identical assets or liabilities in active markets that the Plan has the ability to access.

Level 2 - Inputs to the valuation methodology include: quoted prices for similar assets or liabilities in active markets; quoted prices for identical or similar assets or liabilities in inactive markets; inputs other than quoted prices that are observable for the asset or liability; inputs that are derived principally from or corroborated by observable market data by correlation or other means.

If the asset or liability has a specified (contractual) term, the level 2 input must be observable for substantially the full term of the asset or liability.

Level 3 - Inputs to the valuation methodology are unobservable and significant to the fair value measurement.

**NOTE 6. FAIR VALUE MEASUREMENTS (continued)**

The asset's or liability's fair value measurement level within the fair value hierarchy is based on the lowest level of any input that is significant to the fair value measurement. Valuation techniques maximize the use of relevant observable inputs and minimize the use of unobservable inputs.

The availability of observable market data is monitored to assess the appropriate classification of financial instruments within the fair value hierarchy. Changes in economic conditions or model-based valuation techniques may require the transfer of financial instruments from one fair value level to another. In such instances, the transfer is reported at the beginning of the reporting period. For the years ended December 31, 2024 and 2023, there were no transfers in or out of level 1, 2, or 3.

There have been no changes in valuation methodologies at December 31, 2024 and 2023.

## NOTE 7. INVESTMENT CONTRACT WITH INSURANCE COMPANY

The Plan has entered into a fully benefit-responsive guaranteed investment contract with MassMutual. MassMutual maintains the contributions in a general account. The account is credited with earnings on the underlying investments and charged for participant withdrawals and administrative expenses. The guaranteed investment contract issuer is contractually obligated to repay the principal and a specified interest rate that is guaranteed to the Plan. The crediting rate is based on the contract and was not greater than three percent (3%). The crediting rate is reviewed periodically, typically on a quarterly basis for resetting.

The investment contract provides that withdrawals for benefit payments at death, retirement, disability, termination of employment, and for loans, or in-service withdrawals as permitted by the Plan at contract value. Transfers to other funds are also made at contract value. At contract termination, a participant may elect to receive an immediate lump-sum distribution subject to a market value adjustment. Certain distributions, distributions resulting from employer-initiated events such as plan termination, merger, spin-off, lay-off, early retirement incentives, etc., may be subject to a market value adjustment. An event that limits the plan's ability to transact at contract value with participants in the plan must be probable of not occurring for the contract to be considered benefit responsive. The Plan Sponsor is responsible for making this determination. Participant-initiated transactions are permitted on a daily basis.

## NOTE 8. RISKS AND UNCERTAINTIES

The Plan invests in various investments. Investments are exposed to various risks such as economic, interest rate, market and credit risks. Due to the level of risk associated with certain investments, it is at least reasonably possible that changes in the values of investments will occur in the near term and that such changes could materially affect the amounts reported in the Statements of Net Assets Available for Benefits.

**NOTE 9. PARTY-IN-INTEREST TRANSACTIONS**

Certain plan investments are shares of pooled separate accounts managed by MassMutual. MassMutual is the Custodian, as defined by the Plan, and therefore, these transactions qualify as party-in-interest transactions. These transactions have been denoted as such on the supplemental schedule of assets held at end of year. For the years ended December 31, 2024 and 2023, the Plan paid custodial fees of \$235,784 and \$203,302, respectively, to MassMutual.

**NOTE 10. SUBSEQUENT EVENTS**

The Fund has evaluated subsequent events through September 23, 2025, the date the financial statements were available to be issued, and they have been evaluated in accordance with relevant accounting standards.
