SUMMARY OF PLAN PROVISIONS

Effective Date: January 1, 2016.

Plan Year: January 1 to December 31.

Participation: An eligible employee shall participate on the January 1 or July 1 coincident with or next following attainment of age 21 and 1 year of service. A special amendment effective 1/1/2016 that waives the service requirement for a participant to enter. A special amendment effective 1/1/2017 that waives the service requirement for a participant to enter.

Year of Service for Vesting and Eligibility: 1000 hours of service during a plan year. For eligibility, first year of service runs from date of hire to anniversary of hire. For vesting, shall not use years prior to attainment of age 18.

Year of Service for Benefit Computation: Employed during plan year and worked 1000 hours.

Compensation: Wages, tips, and other compensation on Form W-2.

Eligible Employee: An employee of the employer with the exclusion of union employees, leased employees, and non-resident aliens.

Normal Retirement Date: First of the month coincident with or next following the participant's 62nd birthday and 5 years of participation.

Early Retirement Date: The plan does not provide for retirement prior to the normal retirement date.

Normal Form of Benefit: Life annuity payable monthly for single employees or actuarially equivalent qualified joint and 50% survivor annuity payable monthly for married employees.

Accrued Benefit: Actuarial equivalent, using non lump sum assumptions, of participant's cash balance account at determination date projected with interest credits to Normal Retirement.

Vesting: Shall be 100% vested with 3 years of vesting service. Shall also become 100% vested if employed at normal retirement date, death or disability.

Pre-Retirement Death Benefit: The participant's accrued benefit.

Principal Credits: Jeffrey Mortier accrues \$75,000 per year. Jody Gale accrues \$25,000 per year. Jeffrey MacKinnon accrues \$100,000 per year. Edward Whitfield accrues \$60,000 per year. Sarah Walter accrues \$30,000 per year.

Interest Credits: Interest accumulated to prior cash balance account and principal credits. Shall cease accumulating at time participant's full benefits have commenced.

Cash Balance Account: Sum of accumulated principal and interest credits.

Top Heavy: Minimum benefits shall be governed under defined contribution plan.
