We have performed audits of the financial statements of the Heart of America 401(k) Plan, an employee benefit plan subject to the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA), as permitted by ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) (ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) audit). The financial statements comprise the statements of net assets available for benefits as of December 31, 2024 and 2023, the related statements of changes in net assets available for benefits for the year ended December 31, 2024, and the related notes to the financial statements.

## Heart of America 401(k) Plan Notes to Financial Statements

### NOTE 1 - DESCRIPTION OF PLAN

The following description of the Heart of America 401(k) Plan (the "Plan") provides only general information. The Plan document should be referred to for a more complete description of the Plan's provisions.

#### General

The Plan is a defined contribution plan covering certain employees of Heart of America Group (the "Company"), who are at least age 21 and have completed 6 months of service (defined as completing at least 500 hours of service) with the Company. The Plan provides retirement benefits and is subject to the provisions of the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 ("ERISA"). The Company serves as the Plan sponsor and administrator, and is responsible for the control, management, operation, and administration of the Plan. The President & CEO and Vice President & CFO of the Company serve as the trustees of the Plan (collectively, the "Trustee").

The Company has entered into a Group Annuity Contract (the "Agreement") with Principal Financial Group ("Principal") whereby Principal, as Investment Manager and Custodian, has a fiduciary responsibility to manage the activities of the Plan (including collection of contributions, payment of benefits, investment activities and performance, and record keeping). Under such Agreement, the Plan's net assets are maintained in an Investment Fund. The Investment Fund is allocated to individual participant accounts at all times, but funds are grouped for investment purposed to maximize returns. Principal invests the net assets of each participant among multiple investment options in accordance with the investment elections of participants.

#### Contributions

Employee elective deferral contributions (pre-tax) range from 0% to 100% of the participant's compensation, as defined by the Plan and subject to Internal Revenue Service ("IRS") limitations. Company matching contributions are equal to 25% of employee contributions up to 8% of compensation.

#### Vesting

Employee contributions (and any earnings thereon) are 100% vested and non-forfeitable at all times. Vesting in Company matching contributions (and any earnings thereon) is based on years of credited service as follows:

Company matching contributions are allocated in the same manner as employee contributions. Participants may change investment options or transfer balances in accordance with plan provisions.

### NOTE 1 - DESCRIPTION OF PLAN (CONTINUED)

#### **Participant Accounts**

A separate account is maintained for each Plan participant. Each participant's account is credited or charged with, as applicable, employee contributions, Company matching contributions, withdrawals, an allocation of investment earnings (losses) based on the participant's investment fund elections and relative account balances, and administrative expenses.

#### **Payment of Benefits**

Plan benefits accumulate and vest over the participant's service period. Plan benefits are available to participants in accordance with the hardship withdrawal provisions of the Plan. Plan benefits are due to participants at termination from the Plan due to employment termination, retirement, or death. Normal retirement age for participants is age 65. The benefit to which a participant is entitled is the benefit provided from the participant's vested account. Plan benefits payable to participants may be received in accordance with several benefit distribution options including lump-sum or annually. Terminated participants with vested balances of less than \$5,000 can be distributed in lump-sum without participant election.

#### **Forfeited Accounts**

At December 31, 2024 and 2023, forfeited nonvested accounts totaling \$4,831 and \$5,248, respectively, are included in the Plan's net assets available for benefits, and will be utilized to pay future Plan expenses and/or reduce employer contributions. For the year ended December 31, 2024, \$18,075 were used to offset employer contributions.

#### **Plan Termination**

Although no such intention has been expressed, the Company has the right under the Plan's provisions to discontinue its contributions and/or to terminate the Plan, subject to the provisions of ERISA. In the event of contribution discontinuance or Plan termination, participants would become 100% vested in their respective accounts. Upon plan termination, the Plan's net assets would be liquidated and distributed in accordance with ERISA.

### NOTE 2 - SUMMARY OF ACCOUNTING POLICIES

#### **Basis of Accounting**

The Plan's records are maintained on the accrual basis of accounting, in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America.

#### **Plan Year**

The Plan year is the calendar year.

#### **Contributions**

Contributions from Plan participants and the matching contributions from the Employer are recorded in the year in which the employee contributions are withheld from compensation.

### NOTE 2 - SUMMARY OF ACCOUNTING POLICIES (CONTINUED)

#### **Federal Income Tax Status**

The Plan received a determination letter dated June 30, 2020, in which the IRS stated that the Plan, as then designed, was in compliance with the applicable requirements of the Internal Revenue Code ("IRC"). The Plan has been amended since receiving the determination letter. The Company and the Plan's tax counsel believe that the Plan as currently designed and as being operated, is in compliance with the applicable requirements of the IRC. Therefore, they believe that the Plan is qualified and tax-exempt as of the financial statement date, and accordingly, no provision for income taxes has been included in the Plan's financial statements.

Accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America require Plan management to evaluate tax positions taken by the Plan and recognize a tax liability if the Plan has taken an uncertain position that more than likely would not be sustained upon examination by the IRS. The Plan administrator has analyzed the tax positions taken by the Plan, and has concluded that as of December 31, 2024 and 2023, there were no uncertain positions taken or expected to be taken that would require recognition of a liability or disclosure in the financial statements. The Plan is subject to routine audits by taxing jurisdictions; however, there are currently no audits for any tax periods in progress.

#### **Investment Valuation and Income Recognition**

Investments are reported at fair value. Fair value is the price that would be received to sell an asset or paid to transfer a liability in an orderly transaction between market participants at the measurement date. The Plan's Investment Committee determines the Plan's valuation policies utilizing information provided by the investment advisors, custodians and insurance company. See Note 6 for discussion of fair value measurements.

Purchases and sales of securities are recorded on a trade-date basis. Interest income is recorded on the accrual basis. Dividends are recorded on the ex-dividend date. Net appreciation includes the Plan's gains and losses on investments bought and sold as well as held during the year.

#### **Payment of Benefits**

Benefits are recorded when paid.

#### **Administrative Expenses**

Certain expenses of maintaining the Plan are paid by the Plan, unless otherwise paid by the Company. Expenses that are paid by the Company are excluded from these financial statements. Fees related to the administration of benefit payments are charged directly to the participants account and are included in administrative expenses. Investment related expenses are included in net appreciation of fair value of investments.

#### **Use of Estimates**

The preparation of financial statement in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America requires plan management to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts of net assets available for benefits and changes therein. Actual results could differ from those estimates.

#### **Subsequent Events**

The plan administrator has evaluated subsequent events through October 7, 2025, the date which the financial statements were available to be issued.

### **NOTE 3 - CERTIFICATIONS**

Certain information related to investments disclosed in the accompanying financial statements and ERISA-required supplemental schedule, including investments held at December 31, 2024 and 2023, and net appreciation in fair value of investments, and interest and dividends for the year ended December 31, 2024 was obtained by management and agreed to or derived from information certified as complete and accurate by Principal Trust Company and Principal Global Investors Trust Company (Custodians of the Plan).

### **NOTE 4 - RISKS AND UNCERTAINTIES**

The Plan utilizes several investment instruments. Investment securities, in general, are exposed to various risks, including but not limited to, interest rates, credit, inflation, economic conditions, and market volatility. Due to the level of risk associated with certain investment securities, it is reasonably possible that changes in the values of investment securities will occur in the near term and that such changes could materially affect the amounts reported in the financial statements.

### **NOTE 5 - TRANSACTIONS WITH PARTIES IN INTEREST**

The Plan holds investments in pooled separate accounts and a common collective trust totaling \$12,941,980 and \$12,644,404 as of December 31, 2024 and 2023, respectively. These investments are managed by affiliates of the Investment Manager of the Plan. During the year ended December 31, 2024, the Plan recorded net investment gains of \$1,489,338 from these investments.

### **NOTE 6 - FAIR VALUE MEASUREMENTS**

The framework for measuring fair value provides a fair value hierarchy that prioritizes the inputs to valuation techniques used to measure fair value. The hierarchy gives the highest priority to unadjusted quoted prices in active markets for identical assets or liabilities (Level 1) and the lowest priority to unobservable inputs (Level 3). The three levels of the fair value hierarchy under FASB ASC 820 are described as follows:

Level 1: Inputs to the valuation methodology are unadjusted quoted prices for identical assets or liabilities in active markets that the Plan has the ability to access.

Level 2: Inputs to the valuation methodology include:

- Quoted prices for similar assets or liabilities in active markets;
- Quoted prices for identical or similar assets or liabilities in inactive markets;
- Inputs other than quoted prices that are observable for the asset or liability;
- Inputs that are derived principally from or corroborated by observable market data by correlation or other means.

If the asset or liability has a specified (contractual) term, the Level 2 input must be observable for substantially the full term of the asset or liability.

Level 3: Inputs to the valuation methodology are unobservable and significant to the fair value measurement.

**NOTE 6 - FAIR VALUE MEASUREMENTS (CONTINUED)**

The asset or liability's fair value measurement level within the fair value is based on the lowest level of any input that is significant to the fair value measurement. Valuation techniques maximize the use of relevant observable inputs and minimize the use of unobservable inputs.

Following is a description of the valuation methodologies used for assets measured at fair value. There have been no changes in methodologies used at December 31, 2024 and 2023.

*Mutual Funds:* Valued at the daily closing price as reported by the fund. Mutual funds held by the Plan are open-end mutual funds that are registered with the SEC. These funds are required to publish their daily net asset value (NAV) and to transact at that price. The mutual funds held by the Plan are deemed to be actively traded.

*Pooled separate accounts:* Valued based on the fair value of the underlying assets owned by the pooled separate account and generally based on observable inputs. Assets within the pooled separate accounts included fixed maturity securities, equity securities, and cash and cash equivalents.

*Collective trusts:* Collective investment trusts (CIT) invest in collective trust funds as well as a variety of separate accounts and mutual funds. The fair value of all these investments are used in determining NAV of the CIT, which is not publicly quoted but is available to current investors via the Employer website or when plan participants access their account values.

The methods described may produce a fair value calculation that may not be indicative of net realizable value or reflective of future fair values. Furthermore, while the Plan believes its valuation methods are appropriate and consistent with other market participants, the use of different methodologies or assumptions to determine the fair value of certain financial instruments could result in a different fair value measurement at the reporting date.
