Responsibilities of Management for the Financial Statements

Management is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of the financial statements in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America, and for the design, implementation, and maintenance of internal control relevant to the preparation and fair presentation of financial statements that are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error. Management's election of the ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) audit does not affect management's responsibility for the financial statements.

In preparing the financial statements, management is required to evaluate whether there are conditions or events, considered in the aggregate, that raise substantial doubt about the English Gardens Group, Inc. 401(k) Plan's ability to continue as a going concern for one year after the date the financial statements are issued.

Management is also responsible for maintaining a current plan instrument, including all plan amendments, administering the Plan, and determining that the Plan's transactions that are presented and disclosed in the financial statements are in conformity with the Plan's provisions, including maintaining sufficient records with respect to each of the participants, to determine the benefits due or which may become due to such participants.

Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audits of the Financial Statements

Except as described in the Scope and Nature of the ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) Audit section of our report, our objectives are to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements as a whole are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, and to issue an auditor's report that includes our opinion. Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance but is not absolute assurance and therefore is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with GAAS will always detect a material misstatement when it exists. The risk of not detecting a material misstatement resulting from fraud is higher than for one resulting from error, as fraud may involve collusion, forgery, intentional omissions, misrepresentations, or the override of internal control. Misstatements are considered material if, individually or in the aggregate, they could reasonably be expected to influence the economic decisions of users made on the basis of these financial statements.

In performing audits in accordance with GAAS, we:

- Exercise professional judgment and maintain professional skepticism throughout the audits.
- Identify and assess the risks of material misstatement of the financial statements, whether due to fraud or error, and design and perform audit procedures responsive to those risks. Such procedures include examining, on a test basis, evidence regarding the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements.

Our audits did not extend to the certified investment information, except for obtaining and reading the certification, comparing the certified investment information with the related information presented and disclosed in the financial statements, and reading the disclosures relating to the certified investment information to assess whether they are in accordance with the presentation and disclosure requirements of accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America.

Accordingly, the objective of an ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) audit is not to express an opinion about whether the financial statements as a whole are presented fairly, in all material respects, in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America.

We are required to communicate with those charged with governance regarding, among other matters, the planned scope and timing of the audits, significant audit findings, and certain internal control-related matters that we identified during the audits.

Other Matters – Supplemental Schedule Required by ERISA

The supplemental schedule of assets (held at end of year) is presented for purposes of additional analysis and is not a required part of the financial statements, but is supplemental information required by the Department of Labor’s Rules and Regulations for Reporting and Disclosure under ERISA. Such information is the responsibility of management and was derived from and relates directly to the underlying accounting and other records used to prepare the financial statements. The information included in the supplemental schedule, other than that agreed to or derived from the certified investment information, has been subjected to auditing procedures applied in the audits of the financial statements and certain additional procedures, including comparing and reconciling such information directly to the underlying accounting and other records used to prepare the financial statements or to the financial statements themselves, and other additional procedures in accordance with GAAS. For information included in the supplemental schedule that agreed to or is derived from the certified investment information, we compared such information to the related certified investment information.

In forming our opinion on the supplemental schedule, we evaluated whether the supplemental schedule, other than the information agreed to or derived from the certified investment information, including its form and content, is presented in conformity with the Department of Labor’s Rules and Regulations for Reporting and Disclosure under ERISA.

In our opinion:

- The form and content of the supplemental schedule, other than the information in the supplemental schedule that agreed to or is derived from the certified investment information, is presented, in all material respects, in conformity with the Department of Labor’s Rules and Regulations for Reporting and Disclosure under ERISA.
- The information in the supplemental schedule related to assets held by and certified by a qualified institution agrees to, or is derived from, in all material respects, the information prepared and certified by an institution that management determined meets the requirements of ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C).

Note 1 – Description of the Plan

General

The Plan is a defined contribution plan that was established on January 1, 1996 by English Gardens Group, Inc. (the Company). The Plan is subject to the provisions of the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974, as amended (ERISA). The following description of the Plan is provided for general information purposes only. Participants should refer to the Summary Plan Description or the Adoption Agreement, including amendments thereto, for a complete description of the Plan's provisions.

Administration

The Plan Sponsor and named Plan Administrator is English Gardens Group, Inc. The Plan Administrator is responsible for oversight of the Plan. The Plan Administrator has formed an Investment Committee made up of Company officers and members of the human resources department. The Investment Committee determines the appropriateness of the Plan's investment offerings and monitors investment performance and fees. The Trustees of the Plan are officers of the Company. The Investment Custodian as of December 31, 2024 is Standard Insurance Company. The Investment Custodian holds all of the Plan's assets and executes all of the Plan's transactions. The Company has also retained Standard Insurance Company to provide participant recordkeeping and administration services.

Eligibility

The Plan covers all employees of English Gardens Group, Inc. and related entities: English Gardens & Fairlane Florists, Inc., English Gardens & Fairlane Florist of West Bloomfield, Inc., English Gardens & Fairlane Florist - Lakeside, Inc., and EG Landscaping, Inc., (collectively, the Company), except for union employees, nonresident aliens, and residents of Puerto Rico. All eligible employees must have completed 1,000 hours of service with the Company during a one year period and must be 21 years of age. An employee becomes a participant in the Plan on the first day of the plan year or the first day of the 7th month of the plan year coinciding with or the next following date requirements are met.

Contributions to the Plan

Each year, participants may contribute up to 85% of eligible pre-tax compensation, as defined in the plan document, through payroll withholdings. The Plan also allows participants to make after-tax Roth contributions. Participants who have attained age 50 before the end of the year are eligible to make additional 'catch-up' contributions. Participants may also contribute amounts representing distributions from other defined benefit or defined contribution plans (rollovers). Those employees who become eligible, but do not make a deferral election or waiver, will be automatically enrolled to defer 3% of eligible compensation.

The Plan allows the Company to make discretionary matching and profit-sharing contributions on behalf of the participants. However, the Company did not make discretionary matching or profit-sharing contributions for the year ended December 31, 2024.

Participants direct the investment of both their individual contributions plus their share of employer matching and profit-sharing contributions into the various investment options offered by the Plan. The Company's contributions are allocated in the same manner as that of the participant's elective contributions.

Contributions are subject to certain Internal Revenue Service (IRS) limitations.

Participant Accounts

Each participant's account is credited with the participant's contributions. Participant accounts are charged with an allocation of administrative expenses that are paid by the Plan. Allocations are based on participant earnings, account balances, or specific participant transactions, as defined. The benefit to which a participant is entitled is the benefit that can be provided from the participant's vested account. Funds contributed by participants are invested at percentages as directed by participants in any one or more of several investment alternatives.

Notes Receivable from Participants

Participants may borrow from their fund accounts a minimum of \$1,000 up to a maximum equal to the lesser of \$50,000 or 50% of their vested account balance. Loan terms range from one to five years. Loan terms may exceed five years only in the event the loan proceeds are used to purchase or construct the participant's principal residence. Loans are secured by the balance in the participant's account and bear interest at the prevailing interest rates of similar loans for like circumstances. Principal and interest are paid through payroll deductions.

Payment of Benefits

On termination of service, participants with vested account balances greater than \$7,000 (\$5,000 prior to 2024) may elect to receive a lump sum distribution, a partial distribution, installment payments or rollover their account balance to another qualified account. Those participants whose account balances exceed \$7,000 (\$5,000 prior to 2024) may also elect to defer the distribution of their plan balance. If a participant's vested account is more than \$1,000 but less than \$7,000 (\$5,000 prior to 2024), the Plan Administrator may distribute the account balance into an individual retirement account for the benefit of the participant, absent a participant's affirmative distribution election. Participants with balances less than \$1,000 will receive a cash distribution. Participants who elect to have their benefit payments deferred continue to share in allocations of investment income and losses but do not share in subsequent allocations of employer contributions. Special rules apply to distributions due to death, disability, and retirement. Participants should refer to the full plan document for details.

The Plan allows for in-service distributions upon attainment of age 59 1/2 for all employee deferral contributions, employer contributions, and rollover contributions for any reason.

The Plan also allows for in-service distributions prior to attainment of the Plan's normal retirement age due to financial hardship, as defined in the plan document, from vested account balances.

Vesting

The balance in each participant's salary deferral and rollover accounts is 100% vested at all times.

Discretionary employer matching and profit-sharing contributions are subject to a graded vesting schedule based on years of service. A participant is 100% vested after six years of credited service. Participants also become 100% vested upon death, disability, or attainment of normal retirement age.

Forfeitures

Forfeited balances of terminated participants' non-vested accounts are used to pay plan expenses and to reduce future employer contributions. The balance in the forfeitures account at December 31, 2024 and 2023 was \$24,130 and \$5,680, respectively. During the year ended December 31, 2024, no forfeitures were used to reduce the employer's matching contributions or pay plan expenses.

Note 2 – Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

Basis of Accounting

The financial statements are prepared using the accrual basis of accounting. Income from investments is recorded when it is earned. Employee contributions are recorded when withheld from pay. Employer matching contributions are recorded in the period to which they are earned. Expenses are recorded in the accounting period in which they are incurred.

Estimates

The preparation of financial statements in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts of assets and liabilities and disclosure of contingent assets and liabilities at the date of the financial statements and the reported amounts of revenues and expenses during the reporting period. Actual results could differ from those estimates.

Investment Valuation and Income Recognition

Investments are reported at fair value, except for the fully benefit-responsive investment contract, which is reported at contract value. Fair value is the price that would be received to sell an asset or paid to transfer a liability in an orderly transaction between market participants at the measurement date. See Note 4 for a discussion of fair value measurements.

Purchases and sales of securities are recorded on a trade-date basis. Interest income is recorded on the accrual basis. Dividends are recorded on the ex-dividend date. Net appreciation or depreciation includes the Plan's gains and losses on investments bought and sold as well as held during the year.

Notes Receivable from Participants

Notes receivable from participants are valued at their unpaid principal plus accrued but unpaid interest. Interest income is recorded on the accrual basis. Related fees are recorded as administrative expenses and are expensed when they are incurred. No allowance for credit losses has been recorded as of December 31, 2024 and 2023. Delinquent participant notes receivable are reclassified as distributions based upon the terms of the plan document.

Payment of Benefits

Benefits are recorded when paid.

Fees and Expenses

The Plan's administrative expenses, including salaries, accounting, and legal, are paid directly by the Plan Sponsor and are excluded from these financial statements.

Fees related to the administration of loans and benefit payments are charged directly to the participants' accounts and are included in administration expenses. Direct fees for custodian and recordkeeping services are paid by the Plan and are also included in administration expenses. Investment-related expenses are included in the net appreciation or depreciation in fair value of investments.

Subsequent Events

The financial statements and related disclosures include evaluation of events up through and including September 30, 2025, which is the date the financial statements were available to be issued.

Note 3 – Unaudited Information Certified by the Custodian

Plan management has elected the method of compliance permitted by 29 CFR 2520.103-8 of the Department of Labor's Rules and Regulations for Reporting and Disclosure under ERISA. As permitted under such election, the following information has been certified by Standard Insurance Company as to its completeness and accuracy and was not subjected to any auditing procedures performed by the Plan's independent auditors:

1. All investment balances reflected in the accompanying statements of net assets available for benefits as of December 31, 2024 and 2023;
2. All investment activity reflected in the statement of changes in net assets available for benefits for the year ended December 31, 2024;
3. All investment-related information included in the Supplemental Schedule H, Line 4i – Schedule of Assets (Held at End of Year) as of December 31, 2024; and
4. Notes receivable from participants as of December 31, 2024 and 2023 and the related income on notes receivable from participants for the year ended December 31, 2024.

Note 4 – Fair Value Measurements

The following is a description of the valuation methods used for assets measured at fair value. There have been no changes in the methodologies used at December 31, 2024 and 2023.

Pooled Separate Accounts

The pooled separate accounts are not publicly traded and are measured at fair value based on the fair value of the underlying assets of the pooled separate accounts, using net asset value (NAV) as a practical expedient. This practical expedient is not used when it is determined to be probable that the fund will sell the investment for an amount different than the reported NAV.

The preceding methods described may produce a fair value calculation that may not be indicative of the net realizable value or reflective of future fair values. Furthermore, although the Plan believes its valuation methods are appropriate and consistent with other market participants, the use of different methodologies or assumptions to determine the fair value of certain financial instruments could result in a different fair value measurement at the reporting date.

Note 5 – Group Annuity Contract With Standard Insurance Company

The Plan holds a traditional fully benefit-responsive guaranteed investment contract with Standard Insurance Company (Standard) totaling \$24,182 for 2024 and \$72,669 for 2023. Standard maintains the contributions in a general account. The account is credited with earnings on the underlying investments and charged for participant withdrawals and administrative expenses. The guaranteed investment contract issuer is contractually obligated to repay the principal and a specified interest rate that is guaranteed to the Plan. The crediting rate is based on a formula established by the contract issuer but may not be less than 1 percent annually. The crediting rate is reviewed on a quarterly basis for resetting. The guaranteed investment contract does not permit the insurance company to terminate the agreement prior to the scheduled maturity date.

This contract meets the fully benefit-responsive investment contract criteria and therefore is reported at contract value. Contract value is the relevant measure for fully benefit-responsive investment contracts because this is the amount received by participants if they were to initiate permitted transactions under the terms of the Plan. Contract value, as reported to the Plan by Standard, represents contributions made under the contract, plus earnings, less participant withdrawals, and administrative expenses. Participants may ordinarily direct the withdrawal or transfer of all or a portion of their investment at contract value.

The Plan's ability to receive amounts due is dependent on the issuer's ability to meet its financial obligations. The issuer's ability to meet its contractual obligations may be affected by future economic and regulatory developments.

Certain events might limit the ability of the Plan to transact at contract value with the issuer. Such events include: (1) amendments to the plan documents (including complete or partial plan termination or merger with another plan), (2) changes to the Plan's prohibition on competing investment options or deletion of equity wash provisions, (3) bankruptcy of the Plan Sponsor or other Plan Sponsor events (for example, divestitures or spin-offs of a subsidiary) that cause a significant withdrawal from the Plan, (4) the failure of the trust to qualify for exemption from federal income taxes or any required prohibited transaction exemption under ERISA, or (5) premature termination of the contract. No events are probable of occurring that might limit the ability of the Plan to transact at contract value with the contract issuers and that also would limit the ability of the Plan to transact at contract value with the participants.

In addition, certain events allow the issuer to terminate the contract with the Plan and settle at an amount different from contract value. Such events include: (1) failure to abide by state or federal law, (2) failure to render performance necessary to comply with the terms of the contract, (3) failure to maintain assets of at least \$25,000, (4) plan disqualification, and (5) failure to adopt the Plan in a reasonable period of time.

Note 6 – Party-in-Interest Transactions

Certain plan investments are managed by Standard Insurance Company, who is the Plan's Custodian. Transactions involving these investments are considered party-in-interest transactions. These transactions are not, however, considered prohibited transactions under 29 CFR 408(b) of the ERISA regulations.

During the year ended December 31, 2024, the Plan paid direct compensation to the Custodian related to recordkeeping. Additionally, indirect compensation (that is netted against investment income on the statement of changes in net assets available for benefits) was paid to the Custodian from total annual operating expenses charged on the balance of fund investments, which ranges, depending on the particular fund.

Note 7 – Plan Termination

Although it has not expressed any intent to do so, the Company has the right under the Plan to discontinue its contributions and to terminate the Plan at any time subject to the provisions of ERISA. In the event of plan termination, participants would become 100% vested in their employer contributions.

Note 8 – Plan Amendment and Tax Status

The Plan is a volume submitter plan, which has been filed with the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) and has received a favorable opinion letter dated June 30, 2020 from the IRS. The Plan Sponsor has not elected to apply for an individual IRS Determination Letter on the adoption of the Plan nor on any subsequent amendments. However, the Plan Sponsor believes that the Plan is currently designed and being operated in compliance with applicable requirements of the Internal Revenue Code and, therefore, that the Plan is qualified under Section 401(a) and that the related Trust is tax-exempt as of December 31, 2024.

As of December 31, 2024, the Plan was most recently amended and restated effective January 1, 2022. The Plan permitted provisions of SECURE Act 2.0 during the years ended December 31, 2024 and 2023. Written amendments to the plan document to reflect these operational changes will be adopted at a later date in accordance with the deadlines pursuant to applicable laws and IRS guidance.

Accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America require plan management to evaluate tax positions taken by the Plan and recognize a tax liability if the Plan has taken an uncertain position that more likely than not would not be sustained upon examination by the applicable taxing authorities. The Plan is subject to routine audits by taxing jurisdictions; however, there are currently no audits for any tax periods in progress.

Note 9 – Risks and Uncertainties

The Plan invests in various investment securities. Investment securities are exposed to various risks such as interest rate, market and credit risks. Due to the level of risks associated with certain investment securities, it is at least reasonably possible that changes in the values of investment securities will occur in the near term and that such changes could materially affect participants' account balances and the amounts reported in the statements of net assets available for benefits.


