**December 31, 2024 And 2023**

**1. Description Of The Plan**

The following description of Swank Motion Pictures, Inc. Employee Profit Sharing 401(k) Plan (the Plan) provides only general information. Participants should refer to the Plan Document for a more complete description of the Plan's provisions.

**General**

The Plan was formed on July 1, 1988, and is a defined contribution plan with a 401(k) provision covering employees of Swank Motion Pictures, Inc. (the Company). The Plan was restated effective February 18, 2022. The Plan covers all full-time and part-time employees. Employees are eligible to begin to make salary deferral contributions in the month following their hire date. The Plan is subject to the provisions of the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA), as amended.

**Contributions**

Participants may make salary deferral contributions from 1% to 50% of compensation, not to exceed Internal Revenue Code (the Code) limits. Participants attaining the age of 50 during the Plan year may make additional catch-up contributions, as defined by the Plan Document. The Plan also allows for a Roth 401(k) contribution option.

The Plan provides for an automatic pre-tax deferral option for newly eligible employees. The automatic elective deferral contribution is 6% of compensation. The participant may affirmatively elect a different deferral percentage or may elect not to make deferral contributions.

Participants may also contribute amounts representing distributions from other qualified benefit plans (rollovers).

During 2024 and 2023 the Company contributed a discretionary matching contribution each year equal to 50% of the first 6% contributed by each participant. Participants are eligible to receive the matching contribution upon completing one year of service.

**Notes Receivable From Participants**

Participants may borrow from their account a minimum of \$500, up to a maximum equal to the lesser of \$50,000 or 50% of the participant's vested account balance. Participants are limited to one loan outstanding at any given time. Loans are for a period not exceeding five years. Interest rates on loans are set at the prevailing market rate. The loans are repaid through payroll withholdings, including principal and interest.

**Vesting**

Participants are immediately vested in their salary deferral contributions plus actual earnings thereon. Vesting in the Company matching contributions is based on years of service. A participant is 25% vested after two years of credited service, increasing 25% each year until 100% vested after five years of credited service. A participant will also become 100% vested upon reaching normal retirement age (59-1/2), death or becoming disabled.

**Forfeitures**

When certain terminations of participation occur in the Plan, the nonvested portion of the participant's account, as defined by the Plan Document, represent forfeitures. Forfeited nonvested accounts are used to reduce Company matching contributions. There were \$0 and \$1,553 in forfeiture balances available for future use as of December 31, 2024 and 2023, respectively. For the years ended December 31, 2024 and 2023, \$3,483 and \$19,077, respectively, of forfeitures were used to reduce the Company's matching contributions to the Plan.

**Participant Accounts**

Each participant's account is credited with the participant's salary deferral and rollover contributions, the Company's matching contributions and an allocation of Plan earnings or losses. The allocation of earnings or losses is determined based on each participant's pro-rata account balance in the fund and the timing of the fund purchase, as stated in the Plan Document. The benefit to which a participant is entitled is the benefit that can be provided from the participant's vested account.

**Payment Of Benefits**

Upon retirement, termination, death, or disability, a participant may make withdrawals from his or her vested account. A participant may elect to receive either a lump-sum amount equal to the value of his or her vested account or, if the value of the account is greater than \$5,000, various life and fixed period annuity options.

**In-Service Withdrawals**

Active participants who experience a qualifying financial hardship may withdraw all or part of their vested account resulting from elective deferral contributions. Hardship withdrawals will be approved only if they conform to the Plan provisions and established Internal Revenue Service (IRS) safe harbors.

**Administrative Expenses**

Administrative expenses, including investment advisory fees, loan fees, and disbursement fees, are paid by the Plan.

**2. Summary Of Significant Accounting Policies**

**Basis Of Accounting**

The accompanying financial statements are prepared on the accrual basis of accounting.

**Estimates And Assumptions**

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts of assets and liabilities, disclosure of contingent assets and liabilities at the date of the financial statements and the reported amounts of additions to and deductions from net assets during the reporting period. Actual results could differ from those estimates.

**Investment Valuation And Income Recognition**

The Plan's investments, other than fully benefit-responsive contracts, are reported at fair value. Fair value is the price that would be received to sell an asset or paid to transfer a liability in an orderly transaction between market participants at the measurement date. See fair value measurement discussions in Note 4.

Purchases and sales of securities are recorded on a trade-date basis. Interest income is recorded on the accrual basis. Dividend income is recorded on the ex-dividend date. The net change in fair value of investments includes the Plan's gains and losses on investments bought and sold as well as held during the year.

Investment contracts held by a defined contribution plan that are fully benefit-responsive are reported at contract value, rather than fair value, because contract value is the amount participants would receive if they were to initiate permitted transactions under the terms of the Plan. The Plan's investment in the Principal Fixed Income Guaranteed Option is a fully benefit-responsive investment contract and is reported at contract value in the statement of net assets available for benefits.

**Notes Receivable From Participants**

Notes receivable from participants are measured at their unpaid principal balance plus any accrued but unpaid interest. Delinquent notes receivable from participants are recorded as a distribution based upon the terms of the Plan Document.

**Payment Of Benefits**

Benefits are recorded when paid.

**Subsequent Events**

Management evaluates subsequent events through the date the financial statements are available for issue, which is the date of the Independent Auditors' Report.

**3. Certified Investment Information**

The Plan administrator has elected the method of annual reporting compliance permitted by 29 CFR 2520.103-8 of the Department of Labor's Rules and Regulations for Reporting and Disclosure under ERISA. Accordingly, Principal Trust Company (Principal) has certified that the following investment information included in the accompanying financial statements and supplemental schedule is complete and accurate:

- Investments and notes receivable from participants as shown on the statements of net assets available for benefits as of December 31, 2024 and 2023;
- Net investment income and interest income on notes receivable from participants as shown in the statement of changes in net assets available for benefits for the years ended December 31, 2024 and 2023;
- Investment information included on the supplemental schedule of assets held at end of year as of December 31, 2024.

The Plan's independent auditors did not perform auditing procedures with respect to this information, except for comparing such information to the related information included in the financial statements and supplemental schedule.

During 2023, the Plan was invested in a benefit-responsive annuity contract (the Contract) with Principal, which maintains the contributions in a guaranteed investment contract. During 2024, this contract was terminated.

There were no reserves against contract value for credit risk of the contract issuer or otherwise at the year ended December 31, 2023.

The crediting interest rate is reset every six months. The average crediting rate for 2024 was 1.55%. The average crediting rate for 2023 ranged between 1.75% and 1.55%.

#### **4. Fair Value Measurements**

The Plan follows current accounting rules that establish a framework for measuring fair value. The framework provides a fair value hierarchy that prioritizes the inputs to valuation techniques used to measure fair value. The hierarchy gives the highest priority to unadjusted quoted prices in active markets for identical assets or liabilities (Level 1 measurements) and the lowest priority to unobservable inputs (Level 3 measurements). The three levels of the fair value hierarchy are described below:

- Inputs that are derived principally from or corroborated by observable market data by correlation or other means.

If the asset or liability has a specified (contractual) term, the Level 2 input must be observable for substantially the full term of the asset or liability.

Level 3 Inputs to the valuation methodology are unobservable and significant to the fair value measurement.

The asset's or liability's fair value measurement level within the fair value hierarchy is based on the lowest level of any input that is significant to the fair value measurement. Valuation techniques used need to maximize the use of observable inputs and minimize the use of unobservable inputs.

The following is a description of the valuation methodologies used for assets measured at fair value:

**Pooled Separate Accounts**

Valued at the net asset value (NAV) of units held by the Plan at year end. The NAV is determined by dividing the net assets, at fair value, of the fund by the number of units outstanding on the day of valuation. The NAV, as provided by Principal, is used as a practical expedient to estimate fair value. This practical expedient is not used when it is determined to be probable that the fund will sell the investment for an amount different than the reported NAV. Pooled separate accounts are comprised primarily of shares of mutual funds that are traded on an active market. Pooled separate accounts may be redeemed by participants daily at NAV with no advanced redemption notice required. There are no unfunded commitments.

All pooled separate accounts held by the Plan file an annual report on Form 5500 as a direct filing entity. Participants may ordinarily direct the withdrawal or transfer of all or a portion of their investment at fair value under all circumstances including termination of the Plan.

**Common/Collective Trusts**

Valued at NAV, as provided by the fund, and is used as a practical expedient to estimate fair value. The NAV is based on the fair value of the underlying investments in the funds less its liabilities. This practical expedient is not used when it is determined to be probable that the fund will sell the investment for an amount different than the reported NAV. Participant transactions (purchases and sales) may occur daily with no trading restrictions. There is no advanced redemption notice required and no unfunded commitments.

All common/collective trusts held by the Plan file an annual report on Form 5500 as a direct filing entity. Participants may ordinarily direct the withdrawal or transfer of all or a portion of their investment at fair value under all circumstances including termination of the Plan.

**Registered Investment Companies**

Valued at the daily closing price as reported by the fund. Registered investment companies held by the Plan are open-end investment companies that are registered with the Securities and Exchange Commission. These funds are required to publish their daily NAV and to transact at that price. The registered investment companies held by the Plan are deemed to be actively traded.

The methods described above may produce fair value calculations that may not be indicative of net realizable value or reflective of future fair values. Furthermore, while the Plan believes its valuation methods are appropriate and consistent with other market participants, the use of different methodologies or assumptions to determine the fair value of certain financial instruments could result in a different fair value measurement at the reporting date.

## 5. Plan Termination

Although the Company has not expressed intent to do so, the Company has the right under the Plan to terminate the Plan at any time subject to the provisions of ERISA. In the event of Plan termination, participants will become 100% vested in their accounts.

## 6. Income Tax Status

Principal, the pre-approved plan document sponsor, has obtained an opinion letter dated June 30, 2020 in which the IRS stated that the restated pre-approved plan document was in compliance with the applicable requirements of the Code. The Plan itself has not received a determination letter. The pre-approved plan document has been amended since receiving the opinion letter. However, the Plan Administrator believes that the Plan is currently being operated in accordance with the Code.

The Plan follows accounting rules for uncertain tax positions. Those rules require financial statement recognition of the impact of a tax position if a position is more likely than not of being sustained on audit, based on the technical merits of the position. The rules also provide guidance on measurement, derecognition, classification, interest and penalties, and disclosure requirements for uncertain tax positions. The Plan is subject to routine audits by taxing jurisdictions; however, there are currently no audits for any tax periods in progress.

**7. Transactions With Parties In Interest**

The Plan pays Principal contract administration fees and invests in proprietary funds in pooled separate accounts, common/collective trusts and a guaranteed investment contract managed by Principal. Fees for these services are paid from Plan assets and investment transactions represent allowable party in interest transactions under ERISA. The Plan also has notes receivable with participants which are allowable party in interest transactions under ERISA.

**8. Risks And Uncertainties**

The Plan invests in various investment securities. Investment securities are exposed to various risks such as interest rate, market and credit risks. Due to the level of risk associated with certain investment securities, it is at least reasonably possible that changes in the values of investment securities will occur in the near term and that such changes could materially affect participants' account balances and the amounts reported in the statement of net assets available for benefits.
