NOTE 1 - DESCRIPTION OF THE PLAN

The following description of the TCC Wireless, LLC 401(k) Plan (the “Plan”) provides only general information. Participants should refer to the Plan document for a more complete description of the Plan’s provisions.

Description and Eligibility

The Plan is a defined contribution plan available to all employees of the Company except for union employees covered by a collective bargaining agreement and nonresident aliens. The age requirement to participate in the Plan is 21 years and the employee will be entered into the Plan on the first day of the month coinciding with the eligibility requirements. The Plan is subject to the provisions of the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974, as amended (“ERISA”).

Contributions

Employees who are eligible to participate in the Plan may elect to have up to 90% of their compensation deducted from payroll and contributed to the Plan on a pre-tax basis subject to limitations as defined by the Internal Revenue Code (“IRC”). Safe harbor matching contributions are 100% of participants’ elective deferrals, up to a maximum of 3% of participants’ eligible earnings plus 50% of participants’ elective deferrals between 3% and 5%. Participants must complete 12 consecutive months of employment and complete 1,000 service hours to be eligible for employer matching contributions.

Vesting

Participants are always 100% vested for salary deferrals including Roth 401(k) deferrals and “catch-up” contributions, safe harbor contributions, and rollover contributions. Employer profit sharing contributions are determined under the following schedule. Participants employed on or after their Normal Retirement Age, or who have died or became disabled are 100% vested in their profit-sharing contributions.

Investment Options

Participants direct the investment of their contributions into various investment options offered by the Plan.

Participant Accounts

The allocation of a participant's contributions to the investment funds is selected by the participant and may be changed daily using an automated customer service system. Participants may also elect to have all or a portion of their prior contributions transferred between any of the available investment funds. Employer contributions are allocated to the same investment funds as elected for participant contributions.

Separate accounts are maintained for each participant representing his or her interest in the Plan. Each participant's account is re-valued daily. Plan earnings and other increases and decreases in value are allocated in direct proportion to the size of the participant's balance in a particular fund in relation to the balances of all participants in that fund.

Notes Receivable from Participants

The Plan allows participants to borrow from their fund accounts. Participants may borrow the lesser of 50% of the participant's vested account balance or \$50,000 reduced by the participant's highest outstanding note balance in the previous 12 months even if the amounts have been repaid. No loan less than \$1,000 will be made by the Plan and the maximum number of Plan loans a participant may have outstanding at one time is 1. Notes bear interest rates at prime rate plus 1%.

The repayments of principal and interest are credited to the participant's account balances within the respective funds. Principal and interest payments are made through payroll deductions according to each note's term per the promissory note.

Payment of Benefits

Participants whose employment terminates will be eligible for a distribution equal to the full amount of the separate accounts attributable to his or her participant contributions, plus any vested Company contributions.

Participants are entitled to receive a distribution of all or any portion of their deferral contributions account upon attainment of age 59½. In the event of financial hardship, participants may apply to receive a distribution from their deferral contribution accounts, subject to Internal Revenue Service ("IRS") mandated rules for hardship withdrawals. The minimum amount a participant can receive as an in-service distribution is \$500. If the participant's account balance is between \$1,000 and \$7,000, it will be rolled over to an Individual Retirement Account.

The liability of the Plan for benefits to participants is limited to the value of the participants' vested interest in their accounts.

Forfeited Accounts

Forfeited amounts are first applied to the expenses of administering the Plan, and any excess forfeiture is used to offset future safe harbor matching contributions. There were no forfeitures utilized for the year ended December 31, 2024. As of December 31, 2024 and 2023, there was no balance of unallocated forfeitures.

Plan Termination

Although the Plan is intended to be permanent, the Company reserves the right to terminate the Plan at any time. Upon termination of the Plan, all contributions become fully vested and non-forfeitable. If the Plan is terminated, all amounts credited to a participant's account will be paid to such participant.

NOTE 2 - SUMMARY OF ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of Accounting

The accompanying financial statements of the Plan have been prepared in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America. The accounting records of the Plan are accrual basis.

Investment Valuation and Income Recognition

Investments are stated at fair value. See Note 4 for discussion of fair value measurements.

The Plan entered into a collective trust fund ("Fund") with the Trustee. The objective of the Fund is to provide preservation of capital, relatively stable returns consistent with its comparatively low risk profile, and liquidity for benefit-responsive payments. The Fund seeks to achieve this objective by investment in conventional, synthetic and separate account investment contracts issued by life insurance companies, banks and other financial institutions. The net asset value ("NAV") of the Fund represents fair value since this is the value at which the Plan transacts with the Fund. NAV of the Fund, as reported to the Plan by the Trustee, represents contributions made under the underlying investment contracts, plus earnings at guaranteed crediting rates, less participant withdrawals and administrative expenses. Participants may ordinarily direct the withdrawal or transfer of all or a portion of their investment in the Fund at NAV.

Investment income consists of interest and dividend income. The net appreciation in the fair value of investments consists of realized gains or losses and the unrealized appreciation on those investments. Dividend income is accrued on the ex-dividend date. Purchases and sales of securities are recorded on a trade-date basis. Realized gains and losses from security transactions are reported based on historical cost.

Fair Value Measurements

Fair value estimates are made at a specific point in time based on relevant market information about the financial instrument. These estimates are subjective in nature and involve uncertainties and matters of significant judgment and, therefore, cannot be determined with precision. Changes in assumptions could significantly affect the estimates.

Notes Receivable from Participants

Notes receivable from participants represent participant loans and are measured at the unpaid principal balance plus any accrued unpaid interest. Delinquent participant loans are reclassified as distributions based upon the terms of the Plan document. Repayments of principal and interest are recognized in the period in which payroll deductions are processed.

Plan Expenses

Certain general and administrative expenses incurred in the administration of the Plan are paid by the Company. Expenses paid from Plan assets are reflected in the Statement of Changes in Net Assets Available for Benefits.

Payment of Benefits

Benefits are recorded when paid.

Use of Estimates

The preparation of the financial statements and footnote disclosures requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amount of assets and liabilities at the date of the financial statements and reported amount of additions and deductions to net assets available for benefits during the period. Although management believes such estimates and assumptions are reasonable, actual results could differ from those estimates.

Subsequent Events

The Plan has evaluated subsequent events through September 30, 2025, the date the financial statements were available to be issued and determined that there were no events or transactions which require recognition or disclosures in these financial statements.

NOTE 3 - INFORMATION CERTIFIED BY TRUSTEE

As permitted by 29 CFR 2520.103-8 of the Department of Labor's Rules and Regulations for Reporting and Disclosure under ERISA, and as instructed by the Plan administrator, no audit procedures have been performed on certain information certified by Reliance Trust Company, the Trustee of the Plan as of December 31, 2024 and 2023, except to compare such information to the information included in the accompanying financial statements and schedule. Information certified by the Trustee includes investments and notes receivable from participants included in the Statements of Net Assets Available for Benefits at December 31, 2024 and 2023, and investment income items and interest on notes receivable from participants included in the Statement of Changes in Net Assets Available for Benefits for the year ended December 31, 2024.

NOTE 4 - FAIR VALUE MEASUREMENTS

Fair value is a market-based measurement that is determined based on assumptions that market participants would use in pricing an asset or liability. As a basis for considering such assumptions, the Company uses a three-tier fair value hierarchy, which prioritizes the inputs used in measuring fair value as follows:

- Level 1 – Observable inputs such as quoted prices in active markets;
- Level 2 – Inputs, other than the quoted prices in active markets, that are observable either directly or indirectly; and
- Level 3 – Unobservable inputs in which there is little or no market data, which require the reporting entity to develop its own assumptions.

The following is a description of the valuation methodologies used for assets measured at fair value. There have been no changes in the methodologies used at December 31, 2024 and 2023.

- The fair value of mutual funds is based on prices in public exchanges of the securities held by the Plan at year-end.
- The fair value of the common collective trust investments is based on Net Asset Value ("NAV"), which represents fair value because NAV is the value at which the Plan transacts in this actively traded investment. NAV is used as a practical expedient to estimate fair value.

The Plan's investment in the collective trust fund may be redeemed on a daily basis and has a daily redemption notice period. There are no unfunded commitments related to this collective trust fund.

NOTE 5 - TAX STATUS

The Plan has adopted a non-standardized pre-approved profit sharing plan document. The plan document received an opinion letter from the IRS dated October 6, 2020, as to the Plan's qualified status. The Plan Sponsor can rely on the qualified status to the extent the Plan Document does not deviate from the IRS pre-approved provisions. The Plan administrator believes the Plan is designed and is being operated in compliance with the applicable provisions of the Internal Revenue Code and therefore, believes that the Plan is qualified and the related trust is tax-exempt.

Certain Plan investments are shares of a collective trust fund managed by the Trustee as defined by the Plan and, therefore, these transactions are party-in-interest transactions.
