## INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT

To the Participants and Administrator of the

### ***Scope and Nature of the ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) Audit for the Financial Statements***

We have performed the audits of the financial statements of the Sunwest Electric, Inc. 401(k) Profit Sharing Plan (the Plan), an employee benefit plan subject to the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA), as permitted by ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) (ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) audit). 1. DESCRIPTION OF PLAN

The following description of the Sunwest Electric, Inc. 401(k) Profit Sharing Plan (the Plan) provides only general information. Participants should refer to the plan agreement for a more complete description of the Plan's provisions.

General

The Plan is a defined contribution plan covering substantially all employees of Sunwest Electric, Inc. (the Company). The Plan is subject to the provisions of the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA), as amended. All non-union and non-leased employees who are U.S. residents may participate in the Plan on the date of employment. Eligible employees also qualify for employer discretionary profit sharing contributions upon one year of service.

Contributions

Participants may elect to contribute up to 100% of eligible pre-tax compensation, not to exceed the limits of the Internal Revenue Code (IRC). Unless a participant elects otherwise, the Company will automatically withhold 2% of the compensation as tax deferred contributions after attaining eligibility. Participants who have attained age 50 before the end of the plan year are also eligible to make catch-up contributions. Participants direct the investment of their contributions into various investment options offered by the Plan.

The Plan allows for employer prevailing wage contributions for each participant who performs an hour or more of service under a public contract subject to the Davis-Bacon Act. There are no age or service eligibility requirements for the purposes of determining an employee's eligibility. Contribution allocations are dependent on participants' job classification and the hourly rate. For the year ended December 31, 2024, the Company made employer prevailing wage contributions of \$46,285.

During 2024, the Company made matching contributions of 25% of participant deferrals up to 6% of eligible compensation. For the year ended December 31, 2024, the Company made matching contributions of \$153,921. The Company may also make discretionary profit sharing contributions as determined annually by the Company. For the year ended December 31, 2024, the Company made \$200,000 in discretionary profit sharing contributions.

Participant Accounts

Each participant's account is credited with the prevailing wage contributions, participant's contributions, employer matching contributions and allocations of the Company's profit sharing contributions, if any, and Plan earnings. Participant accounts may be charged with an allocation of administrative expenses that are paid by the Plan. Allocations are based on participant's eligible compensation, participant contributions, investment elections and/or account balances, as

defined. The benefit to which a participant is entitled is the benefit that can be provided from the participant's vested account.

Payment of Benefits

On termination of service due to death, disability, retirement or other reasons, a participant may elect to receive a lump-sum amount equal to the value of the participant's vested interest in his or her account. Participants may also elect to rollover their account to another tax deferred account or remain in the Plan until they are legally required to begin taking distributions. All vested account balances not exceeding \$1,000 may be immediately distributed in a lump-sum payment. All vested account balances exceeding \$1,000, but not exceeding \$5,000, may be rolled into an Individual Retirement Account. With the plan administrator's approval, participants may withdraw all or part of their aggregate contributions in the event of financial hardship.

Vesting

Participants are immediately vested in their contributions, prevailing wage contributions, plus actual earnings thereon. Participants vest in the Company's discretionary matching and profit sharing contributions, plus actual earnings thereon, at 33% following one full year of service, as defined, 67% following two full years of service, and 100% following three years of service, attaining normal retirement age, death, or disability.

Notes Receivable from Participants

Participants may borrow from their fund accounts a minimum of \$1,000, up to a maximum amount equal to the lesser of \$50,000 or 50% of their vested account balance. Loan terms range from 1 to 5 years or within a reasonable period of time that is longer than 5 years for the purchase of a primary residence. The loans are secured by the balance in the participant's account. The interest rate will generally be the prime interest rate plus 1%. Principal and interest is paid ratably through payroll deductions. Participants can only have one loan outstanding at a time.

Administration

The Plan is administered by the Company.

Forfeitures

The unvested portion of a terminated participant's account will be forfeited and used to pay plan expenses, then used to reduce future Company contributions. For the year ended December 31, 2024, employer contributions were reduced by \$1,227 from forfeited non-vested accounts. As of December 31, 2024 and 2023, the amount of available forfeitures totaled \$41,603 and \$28,920, respectively.

2. SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of Accounting

The financial statements of the Plan are prepared under the accrual basis of accounting.

Investment Valuation and Income Recognition

Investments are reported at fair value. Fair value is the price that would be received to sell an asset or paid to transfer a liability in an orderly transaction between market participants at the measurement date. See Note 3 for discussion of fair value measurements.

Purchases and sales of securities are recorded on a trade-date basis. Net appreciation includes the Plan's gains and losses on investments bought and sold as well as held during the year. Interest income is recorded on the accrual basis.

Payment of Benefits

Benefits are recorded when paid.

Subsequent Events

The Company has evaluated subsequent events through the date of the independent auditor's report, which is the date the accompanying financial statements were available to be issued.

Notes Receivable from Participants

Notes receivable from participants are measured at their unpaid principal balance plus accrued but unpaid interest. Related fees are recorded as administrative expenses and are expensed when they are incurred. No allowance for credit losses has been recorded as of December 31, 2024 or 2023. Delinquent participant loans are reclassified as distributions based upon the terms of the plan agreement.

Plan Fees and Administrative Expenses

Plan fees and administrative expenses (exclusive of investment related expenses) are generally paid by the Company unless paid by the Plan. Expenses that are paid by the Company are excluded from these financial statements. Certain transactional fees are charged directly to the participant's account and are included in administrative expenses.

Use of Estimates

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts of net assets available for benefits and disclosure of contingent assets and liabilities at the date of the financial statements and the reported amounts of changes in net assets available for benefits during the reporting period. Actual results could differ from those estimates.

3. FAIR VALUE MEASUREMENTS

The Financial Accounting Standards Board provides the framework for measuring fair value. That framework provides a fair value hierarchy that prioritizes the inputs to valuation techniques used to measure fair value. The hierarchy gives the highest priority to unadjusted quoted prices in active markets for identical assets or liabilities (level 1 measurements) and lowest priority to unobservable inputs (level 3 measurements). The three levels of the fair value hierarchy under this framework are described as follows:

Level 1            Inputs to the valuation methodology are unadjusted quoted prices for identical assets or liabilities in active markets that the Plan has the ability to access.

Level 2            Inputs to the valuation methodology include:

- quoted prices for similar assets or liabilities in active markets;
- quoted prices for identical or similar assets or liabilities in inactive markets;
- inputs other than quoted prices that are observable for the asset or liability;
- inputs that are derived principally from or corroborated by observable market data by correlation or other means.

If the asset or liability has a specified (contractual) term, the level 2 input must be observable for substantially the full term of the asset or liability.

Level 3 Inputs to the valuation methodology are unobservable and significant to the fair value measurement.

The asset or liability's fair value measurement level within the fair value hierarchy is based on the lowest level of any input that is significant to the fair value measurement. Valuation techniques used need to maximize the use of observable inputs and minimize the use of unobservable inputs.

Following is a description of the valuation methodology used for assets measured at fair value. There have been no changes in the methodology used at December 31, 2024 and 2023.

*Pooled separate accounts:* Valued at the net asset value (NAV) of units held by the Plan at year end. The pooled separate accounts unit prices are quoted on a private market that is not active; however, the unit prices are based on underlying investments which are traded on active markets. The NAV is used as a practical expedient to estimate fair value.

The preceding method described may produce a fair value calculation that may not be indicative of net realizable value or reflective of future fair values. Furthermore, although the Plan believes its valuation methods are appropriate and consistent with other market participants, the use of different methodologies or assumptions to determine the fair value of certain financial instruments could result in a different fair value measurement at the reporting date.

In accordance with Subtopic 820-10, certain investments with total fair value of \$14,846,064 and \$13,371,589 at December 31, 2024 and 2023, respectively, were measured at NAV per share (or its equivalent) as a practical expedient and have not been classified by level in the fair value hierarchy.

In regards to the classification of investment options offered by the Plan, there were no reclassifications in or out of levels 1, 2 or 3 during the year ended December 31, 2024. The nature, risks and investment objectives of the investments described above, for which fair value is estimated at NAV, can be found in the Plan's enrollment literature. These investments can be redeemed immediately and without a redemption notification period.

4. TAX STATUS

The Company adopted a Non-Standardized Pre-Approved Profit Sharing Plan which received a favorable opinion letter from the IRS, on June 30, 2020, which stated that the Plan, as then designed, was in accordance with applicable sections of the IRC. The Plan has since been amended. The plan administrator believes the Plan is currently designed and being operated in compliance with the applicable requirements of the IRC. Therefore, no provision for income taxes has been included in the Plan's financial statements.

Accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America require plan management to evaluate tax positions taken by the Plan and recognize a tax liability if the Plan has taken an uncertain tax position that more likely than not would not be sustained upon examination by the IRS. The plan administrator has analyzed the tax positions taken by the Plan, and has concluded that as of December 31, 2024, there are no uncertain positions taken or expected to be taken that would require recognition of a liability or disclosure in the financial statements. The Plan is subject to routine audits by taxing jurisdictions; however, there are currently no audits for any tax periods in progress.

5. RISKS AND UNCERTAINTIES

The Plan invests in various investment securities. Investment securities are exposed to various risks such as interest rate, market, and credit risks. Due to the level of risk associated with certain investment securities, it is at least reasonably possible that changes in the values of investment securities will occur in the near term and that such changes could materially affect participants' account balances and the amounts reported in the statements of net assets available for benefits.

6. INFORMATION CERTIFIED BY THE PLAN'S CUSTODIAN

The plan administrator has elected the method of compliance permitted by 29 CFR 2520.103-8 of the Department of Labor's Rules and Regulations for Reporting and Disclosure under ERISA. Accordingly, John Hancock Life Insurance Company (John Hancock), the custodian of the Plan, has certified to the completeness and accuracy of:

- Investments and notes receivable from participants reflected on the accompanying statements of net assets available for benefits as of December 31, 2024 and 2023.
- Net appreciation in fair value of investments and interest income from notes receivable from participants reflected on the accompanying statement of changes in net assets available for benefits for the year ended December 31, 2024.
- Investments and notes receivable from participants reflected on the schedule of assets (held at end of year).

7. PARTY-IN-INTEREST TRANSACTIONS

The Plan allows for transactions with certain parties who may perform services or have fiduciary responsibilities to the Plan. Certain Plan investments are managed by John Hancock. The Plan paid contract administration and advisory fees of \$67,443 during 2024. The Plan issues loans to participants, which are secured by the balances in the participants' accounts. The Company paid certain administrative expenses of the Plan, including recordkeeping and audit fees. These transactions qualify as party in interest transactions for which a statutory exemption exists.

8. PLAN TERMINATION

Although it has not expressed any intent to do so, the Company has the right to terminate or amend the Plan at any time, subject to the provisions of ERISA. In the event of Plan termination, participants become 100% vested in their accounts.

9. PROHIBITED TRANSACTIONS

During the Plan year ended December 31, 2024, the plan sponsor inadvertently failed to deposit \$66,645, of participant deferrals and participant loan repayments within the required timeframe as stated by Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA). These deferrals and loan repayments were deposited beyond the earliest expected date on which assets could be segregated from the employer's assets. The U.S. Department of Labor considers late deposits to be prohibited transactions. The plan sponsor has calculated and remitted lost earnings on these deferrals and loan repayments during 2025, and does not believe that these issues will have a material impact on the Plan's net assets available for benefits or the Plan's tax status.


