As permitted by ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C), our audits need not extend to any statements or information related to assets held for investment of the plan (investment information) by a bank or similar institution or insurance carrier that is regulated, supervised, and subject to periodic examination by a state or federal agency, provided that the statements or information regarding assets so held are prepared and certified to by the bank or similar institution or insurance carrier in accordance with 29 CFR 2520.103-5 of the Department of Labor's Rules and Regulations for Reporting and Disclosure under ERISA (qualified institution).

Management has obtained a certification from a qualified institution as of December 31, 2024 and 2023, and for the year ended December 31, 2024, stating that the certified investment information, as described in Note 4 to the financial statements, is complete and accurate.

### Disclaimer of Opinion

We do not express an opinion on the financial statements of Warren County Community Services, Inc. Employees' Tax-Deferred Annuity Plan. Because of the significance of the matters described in the Basis for Disclaimer of Opinion section of our report, we have not been able to obtain sufficient appropriate audit evidence to provide a basis for an audit opinion on the financial statements.

### Basis for Disclaimer of Opinion

Warren County Community Services, Inc. Employees' Tax-Deferred Annuity Plan has not maintained sufficient accounting records and supporting documents relating to certain annuity contracts and custodial accounts issued to current and former employees prior to January 1, 2009. Accordingly, we were unable to apply auditing procedures sufficient to determine the extent to which the accompanying financial statements may have been affected by these conditions.

Further, as described in Note 7 to the financial statements, Warren County Community Services, Inc. Employees' Tax-Deferred Annuity Plan has excluded from investments in the accompanying statement of net assets available for benefits certain annuity contracts and custodial accounts issued to current and former employees prior to January 1, 2009, as permitted by the Department of Labor's Field Assistance Bulletin No. 2009-02, *Annual Reporting Requirements for 403(b) Plans*. The investment income and distributions related to such accounts have also been excluded in the accompanying statement of changes in net assets available for benefits. The amount of these excluded annuity contracts and custodial accounts and the related income and distributions are not reasonably determinable. Accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America require that these accounts and the related income and distributions be included in the accompanying financial statements.

**Responsibilities of Management for the Financial Statements**

Management is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of the financial statements in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America, and for the design, implementation, and maintenance of internal control relevant to the preparation and fair presentation of financial statements that are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error. Management's election of the ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) audit does not affect management's responsibility for the financial statements.

In preparing the financial statements, management is required to evaluate whether there are conditions or events, considered in the aggregate, that raise substantial doubt about Warren County Community Services, Inc. Employees' Tax-Deferred Annuity Plan's ability to continue as a going concern for one year after the date the financial statements are available to be issued.

Management is also responsible for maintaining a current plan instrument, including all plan amendments, administering the plan, and determining that the plan's transactions that are presented and disclosed in the financial statements are in conformity with the plan's provisions, including maintaining sufficient records with respect to each of the participants, to determine the benefits due or which may become due to such participants.

**Auditors' Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements**

Our responsibility is to conduct an audit of Warren County Community Services, Inc. Employees' Tax-Deferred Annuity Plan's financial statements in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America and to issue an auditors' report. However, because of the matters described in the Basis for Disclaimer of Opinion section of our report, we were not able to obtain sufficient appropriate audit evidence to provide a basis for an audit opinion on these financial statements.

We are required to be independent of Warren County Community Services, Inc. Employees' Tax-Deferred Annuity Plan, and to meet our other ethical responsibilities, in accordance with the relevant ethical requirements relating to our audits.

**NOTE 1 SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES**

***Basis of Presentation***

The financial statements of the Warren County Community Services, Inc. Employees' Tax-Deferred Annuity Plan (the "Plan") have been prepared under the accrual basis of accounting using accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America.

***Investment Valuation and Income Recognition***

Investments are reported at fair value. Fair value is the price that would be received to sell an asset or paid to transfer a liability in an orderly transaction between market participants at the measurement date. See Note 3 for discussion of fair value measurements.

Purchases and sales of securities are recorded on a trade date basis. Net appreciation includes the Plan's gains and losses on investments bought and sold as well as held during the year. Dividends are recorded on the ex-dividend date. Interest income is recorded on the accrual basis.

The Plan utilizes various investment instruments. Investment securities, in general, are exposed to various risks, such as interest rate, credit and overall market volatility. Market risks include global events which could impact the value of investment securities, such as a pandemic or international conflict. Due to the level of risk associated with certain investment securities, it is reasonably possible that changes in the values of investment securities will occur in the near term and those changes could materially affect the amounts reported in the statements of net assets available for benefits.

***Payment of Benefits***

Benefit payments to participants are recorded when paid.

***Related Party Transactions***

Certain Plan investments are shares of mutual funds managed by Voya Retirement Insurance and Annuity Company (the "Custodian"). Voya Retirement Insurance and Annuity Company is the asset custodian of the Plan. Therefore, these transactions qualify as exempt party-in-interest transactions.

Several employees of Warren County Community Services, Inc. (the "Plan Sponsor") provide administrative services to the Plan. These services include Plan oversight and day-to-day Plan administration. The Plan is not charged by the Plan Sponsor for the services of the employees of the Plan.

Certain expenses and costs of administering the Plan were paid by the Plan Sponsor, and accordingly are not reflected in the Plan's financial statements. Certain investment-related expenses are included in net appreciation in fair value of investments.

**NOTE 1 SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES (CONTINUED)**

***Estimates***

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with United States generally accepted accounting principles ("GAAP") requires the plan administrator to make estimates and assumptions that affect certain reported amounts and disclosures. Accordingly, actual results could differ from these estimates.

***Subsequent Events***

In preparing its financial statements, the Plan has evaluated events subsequent to the balance sheet date through October 14, 2025, which is the date the financial statements were available to be issued.

**NOTE 2 DESCRIPTION OF THE PLAN**

The following description of the Plan provides only general information. Participants should refer to the Plan document for a more complete description of the Plan's provisions.

***Eligibility***

Employees are eligible to participate in the Plan with respect to salary deferral contributions after completion of one hour of service. All employees performing 1,000 hours of service or more for the Plan Sponsor who have six months of service are eligible to receive employer matching contributions.

***Contributions***

Participants may voluntarily make salary deferral contributions up to 100% of their pre-tax compensation. However, contributions may not exceed limitations established under Section 402(g) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 as amended (\$23,000 at December 31, 2024). For 2024, Section 414(v) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 as amended allowed a maximum catch-up contribution of \$7,500. Participants designate the percentage of their total contribution to be invested in any of the Plan's investment funds. Participants may change the percentage of contributions invested in each account and may make transfers between accounts anytime during the year.

The Plan Sponsor may make a discretionary employer matching contributions to eligible participants. The discretionary contribution in 2024 was 50% of the participant's elective deferral up to a maximum of 6% of the participant's compensation until May 20, 2024 and 66.67% of the participant's elective deferral up to a maximum of 6% of the participant's compensation for the rest of the year.

***Rollover Contributions***

Participants may roll over their taxable portion of funds previously held for their account in another qualified employee benefit plan to the Plan on a tax-free basis.

**NOTE 2 DESCRIPTION OF THE PLAN (CONTINUED)**

***Participant Accounts***

Each participant's account is credited with allocations of (a) the participant's contribution, (b) the Plan Sponsor's contribution, and (c) allocation of Plan earnings. Allocations are based on participant earnings or account balances, as defined in the Plan document. The benefit to which a participant is entitled is the benefit that can be provided from the participant's account.

***Vesting***

Participants are immediately vested at the time of participation in the Plan in their voluntary contributions and rollover contributions, plus actual earnings thereon. Vesting in the remainder of their accounts is based on years of continuous service. A participant is fully-vested after five years of credited service.

***Payment of Benefits***

Upon a participant's retirement, death, disability, termination of employment, or termination of the Plan, the participant may receive benefits in accordance with the Plan's provisions and existing laws and regulations. The Plan Sponsor may initiate a mandatory distribution to an individual retirement plan (IRA) or lump-sum cash payment for those terminated participants whose vested account balance is \$5,000 or less. If the vested value of the participant's account is in excess of \$5,000, the participant will not receive a distribution unless the Plan has received consent in writing.

In conditions of "financial hardship", a participant may request approval to withdraw that portion of his or her 403(b) retirement account balance necessary to meet the financial hardship, subject to limitations of the Plan and the Internal Revenue Code.

In-service distributions are permissible for participants that have attained the age of 59 1/2, provided the participant is 100% vested and the balance in the participant's account has accumulated for at least two years, or the participant has completed five years of participation in the Plan.

Upon termination of the Plan, assets will be distributed to participants in accordance with the Plan's provisions and existing laws and regulations.

***Notes Receivable from Participants***

The Plan permits participants to borrow from their vested account. The maximum amount that may be borrowed is the lesser of \$50,000 or 50% of the vested balance of the account. The loans are secured by the balance in the participant's account. The interest rate on the loan is determined by the plan administrator. Loans are payable within five years except for those used to acquire a principal residence. Principal and interest are paid ratably through bi-weekly payroll deductions. Participant loans outstanding as of December 31, 2024 and 2023 was \$12,434 and \$13,927, respectively.

***Forfeited Accounts***

Forfeitures may be used to pay plan administrative fees or reduce future employer contributions. The balance in the forfeiture account available for employer matching contributions was \$23,761 and \$18,101 at December 31, 2024 and 2023, respectively. Forfeitures used to reduce employer contributions were \$-0- in 2024.

**NOTE 3 FAIR VALUE MEASUREMENTS**

Financial Accounting Standards Board *Accounting Standards Codification 820, Fair Value Measurements and Disclosures* provides the framework for measuring fair value. That framework provides a fair value hierarchy that prioritizes the inputs to valuation techniques used to measure fair value. The hierarchy gives the highest priority to unadjusted quoted prices in active markets for identical assets or liabilities and the lowest priority to unobservable inputs.

The hierarchy is broken down into three levels based on the ability to observe inputs as follows:

*Level 1* – Inputs to the valuation methodology are unadjusted quoted prices for identical assets or liabilities in active markets that the Plan has the ability to access.

*Level 2* – Inputs to the valuation methodology include:

- Quoted prices for similar assets or liabilities in active markets;
- Quoted prices for identical or similar assets or liabilities in inactive markets;
- Inputs other than quoted prices that are observable for the asset or liability;
- Inputs that are derived principally from or corroborated by observable market data by correlation or other means.

If the asset or liability has a specified (contractual) term, the Level 2 input must be observable for substantially the full term of the asset or liability.

*Level 3* – Inputs to the valuation methodology are unobservable and significant to the fair value measurement.

The asset's or liability's fair value measurement level within the fair value hierarchy is based on the lowest level of any input that is significant to the fair value measurement. Valuation techniques used need to maximize the use of observable inputs and minimize the use of unobservable inputs.

Following is a description of the valuation methodologies used for assets measured at fair value.

*Pooled separate accounts:* Valued based on the net asset value ("NAV") of shares of the underlying fund as published by the trustee.

*Insurance company general account:* Valued at contract value, which equals cash contributions plus interest credited to the Plan's contract. VOYA has represented that contract value approximates fair value due to current crediting rates being comparable to those of similar investments. Principal and previously credited interest may be subject to market value adjustments prior to withdrawal.

The methods described above may produce a fair value calculation that may not be indicative of net realizable value or reflective of future fair values. Furthermore, while the Plan believes its valuation methods are appropriate and consistent with other market participants, the use of different approaches or assumptions to determine the fair value of certain financial instruments could result in a different fair value measurement at the reporting date.

**NOTE 4 INFORMATION CERTIFIED BY QUALIFIED INSTITUTION**

- (c) The supplemental schedule of Schedule H, Line 4i – Schedule of Assets (Held at End of Year) at December 31, 2024.

**NOTE 5 PLAN TERMINATION**

Although it has not expressed any intent to do so, the Plan Sponsor has the right under the Plan to discontinue its contributions at any time and to terminate the Plan subject to the provisions of ERISA. In the event of plan termination, participants will become fully vested in their accounts.

**NOTE 6 TAX STATUS**

The Plan has been designed to qualify under Section 403(b) of the Internal Revenue Code (the "Code"). The terms of the Plan have been prepared to conform with the sample language provided by the IRS in Revenue Procedure 2007-71. The Plan Administrator intends to apply for a determination letter on the Plan once the IRS opens such a program. The Plan is required to operate in conformity with the Code to maintain the tax-exempt status for plan participants under Section 403(b).

**NOTE 7 CONTRACTS EXCLUDED FROM INVESTMENTS**

As permitted by the Department of Labor's Field Assistance Bulletin No. 2009-02, Annual Reporting Requirements for 403(b) Plans, the Plan has elected to omit certain contracts from the investment balance reported on the Form 5500. These contracts were created prior to January 1, 2009 and contain fully vested, participant-directed investment accounts. Those accounts are owned by the individual participants for whom the accounts were initially established and the Plan no longer has any obligation to such accounts.
