<b>Effective Date</b>	Restated plan effective, March 1, 2013. Bargaining agreement effective, March 7, 2021.
<b>Plan Year</b>	Calendar year.
<b>Eligibility</b>	Employees covered by a collective bargaining agreement with the United Steel Workers of America, AFL-CIO, Locals 458 and 766. Participation begins upon employment.
<b>Normal Retirement</b>	
Eligibility	Age 65 and five years of service.
Benefits	A monthly benefit equal to the dollar amount multiplier times years of credited service. As of March 7, 2023, the dollar amount multiplier increased from \$34.00 to \$35.00 per year of service.
<b>Early Retirement</b>	
Eligibility	Age 55 and five years of service.
Benefits	An early retiree shall receive a monthly benefit computed in the same manner as a normal retirement benefit. This benefit will be reduced 0.4% for each month that benefits commence prior to age 65.
<b>Disability Retirement</b>	
Eligibility	Total and permanent disability with five years of service.
Benefits	A disability retiree shall receive a temporary annuity of \$500 per month until the earlier of recovery from disability, death, age 65, or application for early retirement or lump sum option. Normal retirement benefits are based on years of credited service up to date upon which disability benefit commenced.
<b>Deferred Vested</b>	
Eligibility	Five years of service.
Benefits	A vested participant who terminates shall receive a monthly benefit computed in the same manner as a normal retirement benefit based on the years of credited service to the termination date. The benefit is reduced 0.4% for each month that benefits commence prior to age 65.

### **Lump Sum Option (“Severance Award”)**

Any vested participant may elect a lump sum payment upon termination. The lump sum is the greater of \$600 per year of service or the actuarial present value of the participant’s accrued benefit.

### **Preretirement Death**

Eligibility

Five years of service.

Benefits

If a participant dies while vested, but before becoming eligible for early retirement, his surviving spouse (if any) is entitled to a monthly pension benefit for life commencing on the date the participant would have reached age 55. The benefit is equal to 50% of the benefit the participant would have received if he had terminated on the date of his death and retired at age 55 under the 50% joint and survivor annuity form of payment.

If a participant dies while eligible for early retirement, his surviving spouse (if any) is entitled to an immediate monthly pension benefit for life. This benefit is equal to 50% of the benefit the participant would have been entitled to receive had he retired on the day preceding his death having elected the 50% joint and survivor annuity form of payment.

### **Normal Form of Payment**

Single

Life annuity.

Married

Actuarially reduced 50% joint and survivor annuity.

### **Optional Forms of Payment**

The following actuarially reduced optional forms are available:

- 5-year certain and life annuity;
- 10-year certain and life annuity;
- 15-year certain and life annuity;
- 20-year certain and life annuity;
- 75% joint and survivor annuity; and
- Lump sum.

### **Definitions**

Credited Service

A year of credited service is granted for each plan year in which a participant works at least 1,000 hours of service. For the year of hire and year of termination, 1/12 of a year of credited service is granted for each whole calendar month of employment.

Year of Service

A year of service is for each plan year in which a participant had at least 1,000 hours of service.
