Our audits did not extend to the certified investment information, except for obtaining and reading the certification, comparing the certified investment information with the related information presented and disclosed in the financial statements, and reading the disclosures relating to the certified investment information to assess whether they are in accordance with the presentation and disclosure requirements of accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America.

Accordingly, the objective of an ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) audit is not to express an opinion about whether the financial statements as a whole are presented fairly, in all material respects, in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America.

We are required to communicate with those charged with governance regarding, among other matters, the planned scope and timing of the audit, significant audit findings, and certain internal control related matters that we identified during the audit.

### **Emphasis of Matter**

We draw attention to Note 1a in the notes to the financial statements which disclose that on April 20, 2016 at their board meeting, members of the Board of Trustees of the Leaguers Inc. (the Plan Sponsor) voted to appoint Lincoln Financial Group Trust Company, Inc. as the new Plan Trustee. On November 30, 2016 the plan assets were transferred from the former Plan Trustee, Voya Retirement Insurance and Annuity Company to Lincoln Financial Group Trust Company, Inc. Our disclaimer of opinion is not modified with respect to this matter. Subsequent to the November 30, 2016 transfer date, Voya continues to retain certain amounts of the assets, the bulk of which are insurance contracts in order to enhance orderly liquidation of those assets in the process of transfers to Lincoln.

### **Other Matter - Supplemental Schedules Required by ERISA**

The supplemental schedules of assets held for investment purposes as of December 31, 2024 and 2023 are presented for purposes of additional analysis and are not a required part of the financial statements but are supplementary information required by the Department of Labor's Rules and Regulations for Reporting and Disclosure under ERISA. Such information is the responsibility of management and was derived from and relates directly to the underlying accounting and other records used to prepare the financial statements. The information included in the supplemental schedules, other than that agreed to or derived from the certified investment information, has been subjected to auditing procedures applied in the audits of the financial statements and certain additional procedures, including comparing and reconciling such information directly to the underlying accounting and other records used to prepare the financial statements or to the financial statements themselves, and other additional procedures in accordance with generally accepted auditing standards. For information included in the supplemental schedules that agreed to or is derived from the certified investment information, we compared such information to the related certified investment information.

In forming our opinion on the supplemental schedules, we evaluated whether the supplemental schedules, other than the information agreed to or derived from the certified investment information, including their form and content, are presented in conformity with the Department of Labor's Rules and Regulations for Reporting and Disclosure under ERISA.

In our opinion—

- the form and content of the supplemental schedules, other than the information in the supplemental schedules that agreed to or is derived from the certified investment information, are presented, in all material respects, in conformity with the Department of Labor’s Rules and Regulations for Reporting and Disclosure under ERISA.
- the information in the supplemental schedules related to assets held by and certified to by a qualified institution agrees to, or is derived from, in all material respects, the information prepared and certified by an institution that management determined meets the requirements of ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C).

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**Note 1 Description of Plan**

The following brief description of The Leaguers Inc. 403(B) Plan (the “Plan”) is provided for general information purposes only. Participants should refer to the Plan agreement for more complete description of the Plan’s provisions.

**a. General**

The Plan is a defined contribution plan available to substantially all employees of The Leaguers Inc. (the “Plan Sponsor”) who have attained the age of 18 and who customarily work 20 hours or more per week. The Plan is subject to the provisions of Section 403(b) of the Internal Revenue Code and the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA) as amended.

The Plan Sponsor is the Plan’s named fiduciary and plan administrator and has retained the services of a third party to assist in the administration of the Plan. The Plan Sponsor has appointed Lincoln Financial Group Trust Company, Inc. as the Plan’s Trustee and also assist in the administration of the Plan.

*On April 20, 2016 at their board meeting, members of the Board of Trustees of the Leaguers Inc. (the Plan Sponsor) voted to appoint Lincoln Financial Group Trust Company, Inc. as the new Plan Trustee. On November 30, 2016 the plan assets were transferred from the former Plan Trustee, Voya Retirement Insurance and Annuity Company (Voya) to Lincoln Financial Group Trust Company, Inc. However, Voya continues to retain certain amounts of the assets, the bulk of which are insurance contracts in order to enhance orderly liquidation of those assets in the process of transfers to Lincoln. The proportion of assets held by Voya to the total Plan assets held at December 31, 2024 and 2023 were 0.67% and 0.99%, respectively.*

**b. Contributions**

- Each year, participants may contribute up to 100% of their eligible compensation as defined in the Plan, subject to the maximum allowed by the Internal Revenue Code (IRC). These contributions may be made either on a pre-tax basis or on after-tax (Roth) basis. Participants may also contribute amounts representing rollovers from other qualified defined benefit or defined contribution plans.
- Employer’s contribution to the plan (both matching and non-elective) are discretionary, to be determined by the employer for each plan year. However, when the employer does contribute, the matching contribution is equal to 1.125% of compensation for eligible participants plus an additional match of up to 2% of compensation for participants who make eligible deferrals. To receive the non-elective employer contribution, participant must complete one thousand hours of service during the plan year.
- Participant contributions are recorded in the period the related payroll is paid by the employer. Participant contributions are funded each payroll period. The employer’s matching and non-elective contributions are funded usually during the Plan’s year or at such times as may be determined by the Plan Sponsor.

**c. Participant Accounts**

Each participant's account is credited with the participant's contribution and allocation of (a) the employer's contribution and, (b) Plan earnings, and charged with the allocation of administrative expenses. Allocations are based on participants' earnings or account balances, as defined. The benefit to which a participant is entitled is the benefit that can be provided from the participant's vested account.

Participants direct the investment of their contributions into various investment options offered by the Plan. The Plan currently offers several mutual funds as investment options for participants.

**d. Vesting**

Participants are immediately vested in their elective deferral contributions plus actual earnings thereon. Vesting in the employer's contribution portion (both matching and non-elective) is based on years of continuous service. A participant is 100% vested after four years of credited service. The vesting schedule is as follows:

<u>Years of Vesting Service</u>	<u>Vesting Percentage</u>
Less than one year	0%
One year but less than two years	25%
Two years but less than three years	50%
Three years but less than four years	75%
Four or more years	100%

Notwithstanding the foregoing, employees become fully (100%) vested while an employee of the Plan Sponsor, upon: (1) the attainment of Normal Retirement Age (age 65), (2) death, or (3) disability.

**Automatic Distributions/Roll Over:**

For participants whose vested account balance is \$1,000 or less at the time the vested benefit becomes payable, it automatically will be paid to the participant as a lump sum. For participants whose vested account balance is more than \$1,000, up to and including \$5,000, at the time the vested benefits becomes payable, it automatically will be rolled over to the *Lincoln Select-Solution IRA*. The funding vehicle is a fixed annuity issued by the Lincoln National Life Insurance Company and held in a custodial account with Lincoln Financial Group Trust Company, Inc.

**e. Participant Loans**

Participants may borrow from their accounts a minimum of \$1,000 up to a maximum equal to the lesser of \$50,000 or 50% of the present value of their vested account balance. The loans are collateralized by the balance in the participant's account and bear interest at reasonable rates which are commensurate with local prevailing rates as determined by the Plan administrator. Loan repayment (principal and interest) is paid by the participant directly to the Plan Administrator (upon billing) over a period not extending beyond five years from the date of the loan.

**f. Payment of Benefits**

On termination of service due to death, disability or retirement, a participant may elect to receive either a lump-sum amount equal to the value of the participant's vested interest in his or her account, or annual installments over a period not more than the joint life expectancy of the participant and their beneficiaries. For termination of service due to other reasons, a participant may receive the value of the vested interest in his or her account as lump-sum distribution.

**g. Forfeited Accounts**

In the event participants terminate their employment for reasons other than death, disability, or retirement, forfeitures of the unvested portion of their employer contribution accounts are used to reduce future employer contributions. Forfeited non-vested accounts totaled \$85,815 and \$8,466 as of December 31, 2024 and 2023, respectively. Conversion account totaled \$-0- and \$-0- as of December 31, 2024 and 2023, respectively. Further, approximately \$546 and \$34,135 of the employer's contributions for the years ended December 31, 2024 and 2023, respectively, were funded by transfers from the balance in the forfeited accounts.

**Note 2 Summary of Significant Accounting Policies**

**a. Basis of Accounting**

The financial statements of the Plan are prepared on the accrual basis of accounting.

**b. Use of Estimates**

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United State of America requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect certain reported amounts of assets and liabilities and changes therein, and disclosure of contingent assets and liabilities. Accordingly, actual results may differ from those estimates.

**c. Valuation and Income Recognition**

The Plan's investments are stated at fair value, generally as quoted on a recognized securities exchange. Purchases and sales of securities are recorded on a trade-date basis. Dividends are recorded on the ex-dividend date. The net appreciation or depreciation in the fair value of investments consists of the realized gains and losses and the unrealized appreciation or depreciation on the Plan's investments.

**d. Benefits**

Benefits are recorded when paid.

**e. Excess Contributions Payable**

Amounts payable to participants for contributions in excess of amounts allowed by the IRS are recorded as a liability with a corresponding reduction to contributions.

**f. Note Receivable from Participants**

Notes receivable from participants are measured at their unpaid principal balance plus any accrued but unpaid interest. Interest income is recorded on the accrual basis. Related fees are recorded as administrative expenses and are expensed when they are incurred. No allowance for credit losses has been recorded as of December 31, 2024 or 2023. If a participant ceases to make loan repayments and the plan administrator deems the participant loan to be in default, the participant loan balance is reduced and a benefit payment is recorded.

**g. Expenses**

Expenses are recorded when the corresponding liabilities are incurred, regardless of when payment is made. Certain expenses of maintaining the Plan are paid directly by the Plan Sponsor and are excluded from these financial statements. Fees related to the administration of notes receivable from participants are charged directly to the participant's accounts and are included in administrative expenses. Investment related expenses are included in net appreciation of fair value of investments.

**h. Current Legislation**

In March 2020, Congress passed the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (the "CARES Act") in response to the COVID-19 pandemic. The CARES Act allowed eligible Plan participants to request penalty-free distributions of up to \$100,000 through December 31, 2020 for qualifying reasons associated with the COVID-19 pandemic and to spread the related income tax over three years. As further defined within the CARES Act and among other benefits, it also permitted: (i) repayment of such distributions over a three-year period and (ii) deferral of 2020 required distributions. Plan management implemented these changes.

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**Note 3 Fair Value Measurements**

The framework for measuring fair value provides a fair value hierarchy that prioritizes the inputs to valuation techniques used to measure fair value. The hierarchy gives the highest priority to unadjusted quoted prices in active markets for identical assets or liabilities (level 1) and the lowest priority to unobservable inputs (level 3). The three levels of the fair value hierarchy under FASB ASC 820 are described as follows:

**Level 1** - Inputs to the valuation methodology are unadjusted quoted prices for identical assets or liabilities in active markets that the Plan has the ability to access.

**Level 2** – Input to the valuation methodology include:

- Quoted prices for similar assets or liabilities in active markets;
- Quoted prices for identical or similar assets or liabilities in inactive markets;
- Inputs other than quoted prices that are observable for the asset or liability;
- Inputs that are derived principally from or corroborated by observable market data by correlation or other means.

If the asset or liability has a specified (contractual) term, the level 2 input must be observable for substantially the full term of the asset or liability.

**Level 3** - Inputs to the valuation methodology are unobservable and significant to the fair value measurement.

The asset or liability's fair value measurement level within the fair value hierarchy is based on the lowest level of any input that is significant to the fair value measurement. Valuation techniques maximize the use of relevant observable inputs and minimize the use of unobservable inputs.

The following is a description of the valuation methodologies used for assets measured at fair value. There have been no changes in the methodologies used at December 31, 2024 and 2023.

**Mutual funds:** Valued at the daily closing price as reported by the fund. Mutual funds held by the Plan are open-end mutual funds that are registered with the Securities and Exchange Commission. These funds are required to publish their daily net asset value (NAV) and to transact at that price. The mutual funds held by the Plan are deemed to be actively traded.

**Common/collective trust fund:** Common/collective trusts are pooled investment vehicles designed primarily for certain qualified retirement plans. The fair value of this investment has been estimated using the net asset value per unit as a practical expedient, as provided by the fund manager, and is based on the fair value of the underlying investments held by the fund less its liabilities. The practical expedient would not be used if it is determined to be probable that the fund will sell the investment for an amount different from the reported net asset value. There are no restrictions on participants' redemptions, units may be redeemed daily and there are no unfunded commitments.

**Transfers Between Levels**

The availability of observable market data is monitored to assess the appropriate classification of financial instruments within the fair value hierarchy. Changes in economic conditions or model-based valuation techniques may require the transfer of financial instruments from one fair value level to another. In such instances, the transfer is reported at the beginning of the reporting period.

We normally evaluate the significance of transfers between levels based upon the nature of the financial instrument and size of the transfer relative to total net assets available for benefits.

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**Note 4 Group Deferred Annuity Contracts with Lincoln Financial Group Trust Company, Inc. and Voya Retirement Insurance and Annuity Company**

The Plan has traditional fully benefit-responsive guaranteed investment contracts with Lincoln Financial Group Trust Company, Inc. (Lincoln) and Voya Retirement Insurance and Annuity Company (Voya) totaling \$1,057,802 and \$955,817 at December 31, 2024 and 2023 respectively. Lincoln and Voya maintain the contributions in general accounts. The accounts are credited with earnings on the underlying investments and charged for participants' withdrawals and administrative expenses. The guaranteed investment contract issuers are contractually obligated to repay the principal and a specified interest rate that is guaranteed to the Plan. The crediting rate is based on a formula established by the contract issuers. The crediting rate is reviewed on an agreed basis for resetting. The guaranteed investment contract does not permit the insurance company to terminate the agreement prior to the scheduled maturity date.

The contracts meet the fully benefit-responsive investment contract criteria and therefore are reported at contract value. Contract value is the relevant measure for fully benefit-responsive investment contracts because this is the amount received by participant if they were to initiate permitted transactions under the terms of the Plan. Contract values as reported to the Plan by Lincoln and Voya represent contributions made under the contract, plus earnings, less participant withdrawals, and administrative expenses. Participants may ordinarily direct the withdrawal or transfer of all or a portion of their investments at contract value.

The Plan's ability to receive amounts due is dependent on the issuers' ability to meet its financial obligations. The issuers' ability to meet its contractual obligations may be affected by future economic and regulatory developments.

Certain events might limit the ability of the Plan to transact at contract value with the issuers. Such events include the following:

1. Amendments to the Plan documents (including complete or partial Plan termination or merger with another plan),
2. Changes to the Plan's prohibition on completing investment options or deletion of equity wash provisions,
3. Bankruptcy of the Plan sponsor or other Plan sponsor events (for example, divestitures or spin-offs of a unit) that cause a significant withdrawal from the Plan,
4. The failure of the trust to qualify for exemption from federal income taxes or any required prohibited transaction exemption under ERISA, or
5. Premature termination of the contract.

No events are probable of occurring that might limit the ability of the Plan to transact at contract value with the contract issuers and that also would limit the ability of the Plan to transact at contract value with the participants.

In addition, certain events allow the issuers to terminate the contract with the Plan and settle at an amount different from contract value. Such events include:

1. An uncured violation of the Plan's investment guidelines,
2. A breach of material obligation under the contract,
3. A material misrepresentation,
4. A material amendment to the agreement without the consent of the issuers.

**Note 5 Plan Termination**

Although it has not expressed any intent to do so, the Plan Sponsor has the right under the Plan to discontinue its contributions at any time and to terminate the Plan subject to the provisions of ERISA. In the event of the Plan termination, participants would become 100% vested in their employer contributions.

**Note 6 Tax Status**

The Plan administrator believes that the Plan is designed and is currently being operated in compliance with the applicable requirements of the IRS and, therefore, believes that the Plan is qualified.

Accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America require plan management to evaluate tax provisions taken by the Plan and recognize a tax liability if the organization has taken an uncertain position that more likely than not would not be sustained upon examination by the Internal Revenue Service and New Jersey Division of Taxation. The Plan is subject to routine audits by taxing jurisdictions; however, there are currently no audits for any tax periods in progress. The plan administrator believes it is no longer subject to income tax examinations for years prior to December 31, 2021.

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**Note 7 Risks and Uncertainties**

The Plan invests in common stocks and mutual funds with underlying assets consisting of any combination of stocks, bonds, fixed income securities and other investment securities. Investment securities are exposed to various risks such as interest rate, market and credit risks. Due to the level of risk associated with certain investment securities, it is at least reasonably possible that changes in the fair value of investment securities will occur in the near term and that such changes could materially affect the amounts reported in the statements of net assets available for benefits and the statements of changes in net assets available for benefits.

**Note 8 Related-Party and Party in Interest Transactions**

Certain Plan investments are shares of mutual funds managed by Lincoln Financial Group Trust Company, Inc. (Lincoln). Lincoln is the trustee as defined by the Plan and, therefore, these transactions qualify as party in interest transactions. Also, it should be noted that up until November 30, 2016, the appointed Plan Trustee was Voya Retirement Insurance and Annuity Company (Voya). The plan assets were transferred to Lincoln Financial Group Trust Company, Inc. as of that date. Therefore, the transactions attributable to the period for which Voya was the trustee qualify as party in interest transactions. Subsequent to the November 30, 2016 transfer date, Voya continues to retain certain amounts of the assets, the bulk of which are insurance contracts in order to enhance orderly liquidation of those assets in the process of transfers to Lincoln. The proportion of assets held by Voya to the total Plan assets held at December 31, 2024 and 2023 were 0.67% and 1%, respectively. The transactions attributable to the assets held by Voya also qualify as party in interest transactions.

Fees incurred by the plan for the management services are included in net appreciation in fair value of the investment, as they are paid through revenue sharing rather than a direct payment. As described in Note 2, the Plan paid certain expenses related to plan operations and investment activity to various service providers. These transactions though considered party in interest transactions under ERISA, are permitted under the Plan provisions and are specifically exempt from the prohibition of party-in-interest transactions under ERISA.

**Note 9 Certified Investments**

The Plan Sponsor has elected the method of compliance permitted by 29 CFR 2520.103-8 of the Department of Labor's Rules and Regulations for Reporting and Disclosure under ERISA. Information regarding investments held and notes receivable from participants as of December 31, 2024 and 2023, and investment income and net appreciation in fair value of investments for the years ended December 31, 2024 and 2023 that is disclosed in the accompanying financial statements and supplemental schedules was obtained or derived from information supplied to the Plan Sponsor and certified as complete and accurate by Lincoln Financial Group Trust Company, Inc., the trustee of the Plan and by Voya Retirement Insurance and Annuity Company, the former trustee of Plan.
