### **Scope and Nature of the ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) Audit**

We have performed audits of the accompanying financial statements of ABC DFW 401(k) Plan, an employee benefit plan subject to the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA), as permitted by ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) [ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) audit]. The financial statements comprise the statements of net assets available for benefits as of December 31, 2024 and 2023, and the related statement of changes in net assets available for benefits for the year ended December 31, 2024, and the related notes to the financial statements.

Management, having determined it is permissible in the circumstances, has elected to have the audit of ABC DFW 401(k) Plan's financial statements performed in accordance with ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) pursuant to 29 CFR 2520.103-8 of the Department of Labor's Rules and Regulations for Reporting and Disclosure under ERISA. As permitted by ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C), our audits need not extend to any statements or information related to assets held for investment of the plan (investment information) by a bank or similar institution or insurance carrier that is regulated, supervised, and subject to periodic examination by a state or federal agency, provided that the statements or information regarding assets so held are prepared and certified to by the bank or similar institution or insurance carrier in accordance with 29 CFR 2520.103-5 of the Department of Labor's Rules and Regulations for Reporting and Disclosure under ERISA (qualified institution).

Management has obtained certifications from a qualified institution as of December 31, 2024 and 2023, and for the year ended December 31, 2024, stating that the certified investment information, as described in Note 3 to the financial statements, is complete and accurate.

## **Opinion**

In our opinion, based on our audits and on the procedures performed as described in the Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements section—

- the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements referred to above, other than those agreed to or derived from the certified investment information, are presented fairly, in all material respects, in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America.
- the information in the financial statements referred to above related to assets held by and certified to by a qualified institution agrees to, or is derived from, in all material respects, the information prepared and certified by an institution that management determined meets the requirements of ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C).

## **Basis for Opinion**

We conducted our audits in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America. Our responsibilities under those standards are further described in the Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements section of our report. We are required to be independent of ABC DFW 401(k) Plan and to meet our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with the relevant ethical requirements relating to our audits. We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) audit opinion.

## **Responsibilities of Management for the Financial Statements**

Management is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of the financial statements in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America, and for the design, implementation, and maintenance of internal control relevant to the preparation and fair presentation of financial statements that are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error. Management's election of the ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) audit does not affect management's responsibility for the financial statements.

In preparing the financial statements, management is required to evaluate whether there are conditions or events, considered in the aggregate, that raise substantial doubt about ABC DFW 401(k) Plan's ability to continue as a going concern for one year after the date the financial statements are available to be issued.

Management is also responsible for maintaining a current plan instrument, including all plan amendments; administering the plan; and determining that the plan's transactions that are presented and disclosed in the financial statements are in conformity with the plan's provisions, including maintaining sufficient records with respect to each of the participants, to determine the benefits due or which may become due to such participants.

## **Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements**

Except as described in the Scope and Nature of the ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) Audit section of our report, our objectives are to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements as a whole are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, and to issue an auditor's report that includes our opinion. Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance but is not absolute assurance and therefore is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with generally accepted auditing standards will always detect a material misstatement when it exists. The risk of not detecting a material misstatement resulting from fraud is higher than for one resulting from error, as fraud may involve collusion, forgery, intentional omissions, misrepresentations, or the override of internal control. Misstatements are considered material if there is a substantial likelihood that, individually or in the aggregate, they would influence the judgment made by a reasonable user based on the financial statements.

In performing an audit in accordance with generally accepted auditing standards, we:

- Exercise professional judgment and maintain professional skepticism throughout the audit.
- Identify and assess the risks of material misstatement of the financial statements, whether due to fraud or error, and design and perform audit procedures responsive to those risks. Such procedures include examining, on a test basis, evidence regarding the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements.
- Obtain an understanding of internal control relevant to the audit in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of ABC DFW 401(k) Plan's internal control. Accordingly, no such opinion is expressed.
- Evaluate the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of significant accounting estimates made by management, as well as evaluate the overall presentation of the financial statements.
- Conclude whether, in our judgment, there are conditions or events, considered in the aggregate, that raise substantial doubt about ABC DFW 401(k) Plan's ability to continue as a going concern for a reasonable period of time.

Our audits did not extend to the certified investment information, except for obtaining and reading the certification, comparing the certified investment information with the related information presented and disclosed in the financial statements, and reading the disclosures relating to the certified investment information to assess whether they are in accordance with the presentation and disclosure requirements of accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America.

Accordingly, the objective of an ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) audit is not to express an opinion about whether the financial statements as a whole are presented fairly, in all material respects, in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America.

We are required to communicate with those charged with governance regarding, among other matters, the planned scope and timing of the audit, significant audit findings, and certain internal control-related matters that we identified during the audit.

### **Other Matter—Supplemental Schedules Required by ERISA**

The supplemental schedule of assets held at end of year December 31, 2024 and schedule of delinquent participant contributions are presented for purposes of additional analysis and are not a required part of the financial statements but are supplementary information required by the Department of Labor's Rules and Regulations for Reporting and Disclosure under ERISA. Such information is the responsibility of management and was derived from and relates directly to the underlying accounting and other records used to prepare the financial statements. The information included in the supplemental schedules, other than that agreed to or derived from the certified investment information, has been subjected to auditing procedures applied in the audits of the financial statements and certain additional procedures, including comparing and reconciling such information directly to the underlying accounting and other records used to prepare the financial statements or to the financial statements themselves, and other additional procedures in accordance with generally accepted auditing standards. For information included in the supplemental schedules that agreed to or is derived from the certified investment information, we compared such information to the related certified investment information.

In forming our opinion on the supplemental schedules, we evaluated whether the supplemental schedules, other than the information agreed to or derived from the certified investment information, including their form and content, are presented in conformity with the Department of Labor's Rules and Regulations for Reporting and Disclosure under ERISA.

- the form and content of the supplemental schedules, other than the information in the supplemental schedules that agreed to or is derived from the certified investment information, are presented, in all material respects, in conformity with the Department of Labor's Rules and Regulations for Reporting and Disclosure under ERISA.
- the information in the supplemental schedule related to assets held by and certified to by a qualified institution agrees to, or is derived from, in all material respects, the information prepared and certified by an institution that management determined meets the requirements of ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C).

**NOTE 1 - DESCRIPTION OF THE PLAN**

The following description of the ABC DFW 401(k) Plan (the Plan) provides only general information. Participants should refer to the Plan and Trust Agreement (Plan Document) for a more complete description of the Plan's provisions.

*General*

The Plan is a 401(k) plan established on January 1, 2002. Employees of ABC Pest Control of Dallas, Inc. (the Company or Plan Sponsor) and participating employers are eligible to participate in the Plan once they have attained the age of eighteen and completed two hundred and fifty hours of service within the first three months of employment. Participants enter the Plan the first day of the month coinciding with or next following date requirements are met. The Plan is subject to the provisions of the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

*Contributions*

Participants may make voluntary salary reductions (participant contributions) up to the maximum amount allowed by the IRS. For 2024 this deferral limit was \$23,000. Participants may also rollover amounts from other qualified plans. Participants over the age of 50 are eligible for catch up contributions. The Plan includes automatic enrollment for current participants not deferring and will start deferring at 3% of eligible compensation and will automatically increase 1% each year to a maximum of 6%.

The Company may make discretionary nonelective contributions to the Plan, an amount the Company in its sole discretion may determine. Participants must be employed on the last day of the Plan year and complete 1,000 hours of service during the Plan year in order to share in the discretionary nonelective contributions. During 2024, the Company did not make any discretionary nonelective contributions.

The Company may also make discretionary matching contributions to the Plan, equal to a uniform percentage of elective deferrals but not to exceed 10% of eligible Plan compensation. During 2024, the Company made discretionary matching contributions of approximately \$278,000, using the following criteria:

*Participant Accounts*

Individual accounts are maintained to record participant contributions, discretionary nonelective contributions, discretionary matching contributions, rollover contributions, and earnings thereon for each participant. The benefit to which a participant is entitled is the total benefit, which can be provided from the vested portion of these individual accounts.

*Vesting*

Upon entry into the Plan, participants are 100 percent vested in their participant contributions, rollover contributions, and earnings thereon. Vesting for the discretionary nonelective contributions, discretionary matching contributions, and earnings thereon is based on years of service as follows:

*Notes Receivable from Participants*

Participants may borrow from their accounts. The amounts borrowed are limited to the lesser of \$50,000 or one half of the participant's vested account balance and must be greater than \$1,000. Loans must bear a reasonable rate of interest and must be repaid within five years, unless for the purchase of a primary residence.

*Payment of Benefits*

On termination of service due to death, disability, or retirement, a participant may request a distribution of their vested account balance from the Plan Administrator. Furthermore, upon approval of the Plan Administrator, participants may be entitled to take hardship distributions. Participants may elect to withdraw all, or a portion of their account while still employed, upon attainment of age 59 ½. Vested account balances less than \$5,000 for terminated participants, will be distributed as soon as administratively feasible after termination. Benefits are recorded when paid.

*Forfeited Accounts*

Forfeited accounts will be used to either pay Plan expenses or to reduce Company contributions. Forfeitures as of December 31, 2024 and 2023 were approximately \$13,000 and \$300, respectively. During 2024, no forfeitures were used to reduce employer contributions or pay Plan expenses.

**NOTE 2 - SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES**

*Subsequent Event*

Management has evaluated subsequent events through October 15, 2025, the date the financial statements were available to be issued.

*Use of Estimates*

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect certain reported amounts and disclosures. Actual results may differ from those estimates.

*Basis of Accounting*

The financial statements of the plan are prepared on the accrual basis of accounting in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America.

*Investments Contracts*

Investment contracts held by a defined contribution plan are required to be reported at fair value. However, contract value is the relevant measurement attribute for fully benefit-responsive investment contracts because contract value is the amount participants would receive if they were to initiate permitted transactions under the terms of the Plan. The investment contract held by the Plan is fully benefit-responsive. Therefore, the investment is recorded at contract value as of December 31, 2024 and 2023. See Note 5 for a description of the investment contract.

*Investment Valuation and Income Recognition*

Investments are reported at fair value (except for fully benefit-responsive investment contracts, which are reported at contract value). Fair value is the price that would be received to sell an asset or paid to transfer a liability in an orderly transaction between market participants at the measurement date. See Note 4 for discussion of fair value measurements.

Purchases and sales of securities are recorded on a trade-date basis. Interest income is recorded on the accrual basis. Dividends are recorded on the ex-dividend date. Net appreciation includes the plan's gains and losses on investments bought and sold as well as held during the year.

*Fair Value Measurements*

The Plan's investments are reported at fair value in the accompanying statement of net assets available for benefits. The methods used to measure fair value may produce an amount that may not be indicative of net realizable value or reflective of future fair values. Furthermore, although the Plan believes its valuation methods are appropriate and consistent with other market participants, the use of different methodologies or assumptions to determine the fair value of certain financial instruments could result in a different fair value measurement at the reporting date.

*Administrative Costs*

Expenses of maintaining the Plan are paid by the Company and the Plan. Investment-related expenses are included in net appreciation of fair value of investments.

*Excess Contributions Payable*

Amounts payable to participants for contributions in excess of amounts allowed by the IRS are recorded as a liability with a corresponding reduction to contributions.

*Notes Receivable from Participants*

Notes receivable from participants are measured at their unpaid principal balance plus any accrued but unpaid interest. Delinquent notes receivable from participants are recorded as a distribution based upon the terms of the plan document.

*Market Risk*

The Plan invests in various investment securities. Investment securities, in general, are exposed to various risks, such as interest rate, credit and overall market volatility risks. Furthermore, due to the level of risk associated with certain investment securities, it is reasonably possible that changes in the values of investment securities will occur in the near term and that such changes, could materially affect the amounts reported in the Statements of Net Assets Available for Benefits.

**NOTE 3 – CERTIFIED INVESTMENT INFORMATION**

Certain information related to investments and notes receivable from participants disclosed in the accompanying financial statements and ERISA-required supplemental schedule, related to investments and notes receivable from participants held as of December 31, 2024 and 2023, and net appreciation in fair value of investments, interest and dividends, and interest income on notes receivable from participants for the year ended December 31, 2024, was obtained by management and agreed to or derived from information certified as complete and accurate by Empower Trust Company, LLC and Empower Annuity Insurance Company of America (collectively Empower), a qualified institution.

**NOTE 4 – FAIR VALUE MEASUREMENTS**

FASB ASC 820, *Fair Value Measurements and Disclosures*, establishes a framework for measuring fair value. That framework provides a fair value hierarchy that prioritizes the inputs to valuation techniques used to measure fair value. The hierarchy gives the highest priority to unadjusted quoted prices in active markets for identical assets or liabilities (Level 1 measurements) and the lowest priority to unobserved inputs (Level 3 measurements). The three levels of the fair value hierarchy under FASB ASC 820 are described below:

Level 1: Inputs to the valuation methodology are unadjusted quoted prices for identical assets or liabilities in active markets that the Plan has the ability to access.

Level 2: Inputs to the valuation methodology include:

- Quoted prices for similar assets or liabilities in active markets;
- Quoted prices for identical or similar assets or liabilities in inactive markets;
- Inputs other than quoted prices that are observable for the asset or liability;
- Inputs that are derived principally from or corroborated by observable market data by correlation or other means.

If the asset or liability has a specified (contractual) term, the Level 2 input must be observable for substantially the full term of the asset or liability.

Level 3: Inputs to the valuation methodology are unobservable and significant to the fair value measurements.

The asset's or liability's fair value measurement level within the fair value hierarchy is based on the lowest level of any input that is significant to the fair value measurement. Valuation techniques used need to maximize the use of observable inputs and minimize the use of unobservable inputs.

Mutual funds - Valued at the daily closing price as reported by the fund. Mutual funds held by the Plan are open-end and closed-end mutual funds that are registered with the Securities and Exchange Commission. These funds are required to publish their daily net asset value (NAV) and to transact at that price. The mutual funds held by the Plan are deemed to be actively traded.

Collective trust funds - Valued at daily NAV based on the market value of the underlying investment assets divided by the number of units outstanding at the end of the Plan year. The NAV, as provided by the custodians and trustee, is used as a practical expedient to estimate fair value. The practical expedient is not used when it is determined to be probable that the fund will sell the investment for an amount different than the reported NAV. Participant transactions (purchased and sales) may occur daily.

**NOTE 5 – INVESTMENT CONTRACT WITH INSURANCE COMPANY**

The key guaranteed portfolio is a guaranteed return contract with quarterly interest rate guarantee. Deposits are guaranteed in both principal and interest by Empower. Amounts are held in Empower’s general account and are credited on a net daily basis at annual effective rates. This contract is fully benefit responsive and is reported at contract value. Valued using the net investment factor (NIF) at the accumulated cash contributions, transfers and interest credited to the Plan’s contract less any withdrawals. The fair market value is equal to contract value less any contingent deferred sales charge, if applicable.

**NOTE 5 – INVESTMENT CONTRACT WITH INSURANCE COMPANY, CONTINUED**

Certain events might limit the ability of the Plan to transact at contract value with the issuer. Such events include (1) amendments to the Plan documents (including complete or partial Plan termination or merger with another plan), (2) changes to the Plan's prohibition on competing investment options or deletion of equity wash provisions, (3) bankruptcy of the Plan Sponsor or other Plan Sponsor events (for example, divestitures or spin-offs of a subsidiary) that cause a significant withdrawal from the Plan, (4) the failure of the trust to qualify for exemption from federal income taxes or any required prohibited transaction exemption under ERISA, or (5) premature termination of the contract. No events are probable of occurring that might limit the ability of the Plan to transact at contract value with the contract issuers and that also would limit the ability of the plan to transact at contract value with the participants.

In addition, certain events allow the issuer to terminate the contract with the Plan and settle at an amount different from contract value. Such events include (1) an uncured violation of the Plan's investment guidelines, (2) a breach of material obligation under the contract, (3) a material misrepresentation, or (4) a material amendment to the agreement without the consent of the issuer.

**NOTE 6 – TAX STATUS**

The Company has adopted a pre-approved plan document that has received an opinion letter from the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) dated November 14, 2022 stating that the form of the preapproved plan document was in compliance with the applicable requirements of the Internal Revenue Code (IRC). The plan administrator believes the Plan is designed, and is currently being operated, in compliance with the applicable requirements of the IRC, and, therefore, believes that the plan is qualified, and the related trust is tax-exempt.

Accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America require plan management to evaluate tax positions taken by the plan and recognize a tax liability if the plan has taken an uncertain position that more likely than not would not be sustained upon examination by the IRS. The Plan administrator has analyzed the tax positions taken by the Plan, and has concluded that as of December 31, 2024, there are no uncertain tax positions taken or expected to be taken that would require recognition of a liability (or asset) or disclosure in the financial statements. The Plan is subject to routine audits by taxing jurisdictions; however, there are currently no audits for any tax periods in progress.

**NOTE 7 – PLAN TERMINATION**

Although it has not expressed any intent to do so, the Company has the right under the Plan to discontinue their contributions at any time and to terminate the Plan subject to the provisions of ERISA. In the event of Plan termination, participants will become 100% vested in their accounts.

**NOTE 8 – PARTY-IN-INTEREST TRANSACTIONS**

Empower holds the Plan’s assets, performs the record-keeping function and plan administration. The Plan’s investment advising was performed by World Investment Advisors, LLC. Therefore, any investment or administrative fees paid during the year to these parties qualify as party-in-interest transactions.

**NOTE 9 – DELINQUENT CONTRIBUTIONS**

During 2024, the Company remitted employee contributions for thirteen pay periods after the date required during the year by the Department of Labor. The Company will determine the amount of lost earnings and contribute the amount to the participant accounts in 2025.

**NOTE 11 – SECURE 2.0**

The SECURE 2.0 Act of 2022 introduces several changes to qualified retirement plans, with various implementation dates ranging from 2023 to future years. Key provisions include enhanced catch-up contribution limits for participants ages 60-63 (effective 2025), requirements for higher-income participants to direct catch-up contributions to Roth accounts (effective 2026), increases to required minimum distribution ages (phasing up to age 75), and the option to increase the automatic rollover threshold for force-out distributions from \$5,000 to \$7,000.
