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## **Report of Independent Auditors**

To the Participants and Trustees of  
International Foundation Employees' Thrift Plan

### ***Opinion***

We have audited the financial statements of International Foundation Employees' Thrift Plan (the Plan), an employee benefit plan subject to the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA), which comprise the statements of net assets available for benefits as of December 31, 2024 and 2023, and the related statements of changes in net assets available for benefits for the years then ended, and the related notes to the financial statements.

In our opinion, the accompanying financial statements present fairly, in all material respects, the net assets available for benefits of International Foundation Employees' Thrift Plan as of December 31, 2024 and 2023, and the changes in its net assets available for benefits for the years then ended, in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America.

### ***Basis for Opinion***

## Notes to Financial Statements

December 31, 2024 and 2023

### Note 1. Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

**Method of Accounting** - The accompanying financial statements of International Foundation Employees' Thrift Plan (the Plan) have been prepared using the accrual basis of accounting.

**Investments** - The Plan investments are reported at fair value. The fair value of a financial instrument is the amount that would be received to sell that asset (or paid to transfer a liability) in an orderly transaction between market participants at the measurement date (the exit price). Net appreciation or depreciation includes the Plan's gains and losses on investments bought and sold as well as held during the year.

Purchases and sales of the investments are reflected on a trade-date basis.

Dividend income is recorded on the ex-dividend date. Interest income is recorded on the accrual basis. Capital gain distributions on mutual funds are recorded as dividends.

**Notes Receivable from Participants** - Notes receivable from participants are measured at their unpaid principal balance plus any accrued but unpaid interest. Interest income is recorded on the accrual basis. Related fees are recorded as administrative expenses when incurred. No allowance for credit losses has been recorded as of either December 31, 2024 or 2023. If a participant ceases to make loan repayments and the Plan administrator determines the participant loan to be in default, the participant loan balance is recorded as a deemed distribution.

**Plan Administrator** - The Plan is maintained under a trust agreement, effective January 1, 1997, by John Hancock Trust Company LLC (John Hancock), who has custody of the assets of the Plan and makes payments to participants at the direction of the Plan sponsor.

**Payment of Benefits** - Benefit payments to participants are recorded upon distribution. There were no participants who elected to withdraw from the Plan but were not yet paid at either December 31, 2024 or 2023.

**Expenses** - Fees related to the administration of notes receivable from participants are charged directly to the participant's account and are included in administrative expenses. Certain investment related expenses are included in net appreciation (depreciation) of fair value of investments.

## **Note 1. Summary of Significant Accounting Policies (continued)**

**Estimates** - The preparation of financial statements in conformity with generally accepted accounting principles requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect certain reported amounts and disclosures in the financial statements. Actual results may differ from those estimates.

**Subsequent Events** - Subsequent events have been evaluated through October 13, 2025, which is the date the financial statements were available to be issued.

## **Note 2. Description of the Plan**

The Plan is a defined contribution retirement plan covering all employees of International Foundation of Employee Benefit Plans, Inc. (the Foundation) who have completed 1,000 hours of service in any period of 12 or fewer months. Once completing the requirement, participation begins the following January 1 or July 1. The Plan is subject to the provisions of the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA), as amended. Benefits under the Plan are not insured by the Pension Benefit Guaranty Corporation.

During 2024, certain initial eligibility provisions of the plan were amended. Effective January 1, 2025 the plan allowed all eligible employees of the Plan sponsor who are expected to complete 1,000 hours of service during the 12-consecutive month period following the employee's first day to enter the plan on the next applicable entry date. That entry date is defined as the first day of the month following the completion of 30 days of employment. Additionally, the participant will be automatically enrolled to make elective contributions equal to 6% of their compensation.

Participants may make both pre-tax contributions pursuant to Section 401(k) of the Internal Revenue Code (IRC), after-tax Roth contributions and non-Roth after-tax contributions. Pre-tax deferred annuity contracts under IRC Section 401(k) authorize employees to direct pre-tax contributions pursuant to salary reduction arrangements, the actual limits of which are determined by the employee's annual compensation. Additionally, total annual additions are limited under Section 415 of the Internal Revenue. Under the Foundation's matching provisions, the Foundation contributes 75% of the employee's pre-tax and after-tax elective contributions to the Plan for such year up to 6% of an employee's base compensation. Participants may also contribute amounts representing rollover contributions from other qualified retirement plans.

The Foundation also makes non-elective contributions to the Plan on behalf of all eligible participants. Participants with less than 10 years of service receive a contribution of 3.25% of their eligible compensation into the Plan. Participants with more than 10 years of service receive a contribution of 6.50% of their eligible compensation. Participants are eligible for the contribution the next enrollment date following 1,000 hours of work.

Each participant's account is credited with the participant's contribution and allocations of (a) the Foundation's contributions and (b) Plan earnings or losses, and are charged with an allocation of administrative expenses. The benefit to which a participant is entitled is the benefit that can be provided from the participant's vested account.

**Note 2. Description of the Plan (continued)**

Participants are immediately vested in their contributions, rollovers and the Foundation's non-elective contributions plus actual earnings thereon. Vesting in the Foundation's matching contribution plus actual earnings thereon is based on years of continuous service, as follows:

1	20%
2	40%
3	60%
4	80%
5 or more	100%

Upon enrollment in the Plan, a participant may direct participant contributions among the available investment options in any whole percentage. In the absence of participant direction, contributions are invested in a default investment fund until changed by the participant. Participants must evaluate their own investment goals and objectives and choose investments best suited to achieve those goals and objectives. Poor investment performance by the investments selected by the participants may cause their vested balances to be lower than the amounts contributed to the Plan on their behalf. The Plan offers a choice of investment options with different degrees of risk and return. Participants may change their investment options based on the rules of the Plan.

Participants may borrow from their accounts a minimum of \$1,000 up to a maximum equal to the lesser of \$50,000 or 50% of their vested account balance. The loans are secured by the balance in the participant's account and bear interest at rates ranging from 3.25% to 8.50% which are commensurate with local prevailing rates as determined by the Plan Administrator. Principal and interest are generally repaid ratably through payroll deductions.

If a participant's employment terminates prior to normal retirement age for reasons other than death and the vested account balance is less than \$1,000, the Plan Administrator is required to make a lump-sum distribution to the participant. Participants with vested account balances that exceed \$1,000 must elect in writing to commence distribution. Such distributions may not commence prior to the participant's normal retirement age unless the participant consents, in writing, to the earlier distribution of the vested account. Unless a participant elects to defer distribution, distribution will commence no earlier than 30 days from the date the Administrator provides notice of the right to elect payment in a direct rollover and no later than an administratively feasible date following the end of the Plan year in which the participant's employment terminates. All distributions from participants' accounts occur in a single lump sum.

The Plan distributes the vested account balance of a deceased participant to the beneficiary within a reasonable time after the participant's death, but no later than by the end of the calendar year that contains the fifth anniversary of the participant's death.

**Note 2. Description of the Plan (continued)**

Forfeited nonvested account balances are applied to reduce future employer contributions and fund administrative expenses. Matching contributions made by the Foundation were reduced for the years ended December 31, 2024 and 2023, by \$0 and \$3,679, respectively, in forfeited account balances. Additionally, forfeitures were used to pay for \$7,125 in administrative expenses during 2024. The balance of forfeited nonvested account balances was \$15,843 and \$14,403 at December 31, 2024 and 2023, respectively.

Participants should refer to the summary plan description for more information.

**Note 3. Priorities upon Termination**

It is the intent of the Trustees to continue the Plan in full force and effect. However, the right to discontinue the Plan is reserved to the Trustees. Such termination shall not permit any part of the Plan to be used for or diverted to purposes other than the exclusive benefit of the participants and their beneficiaries. Provision may be made for the payment of necessary expenses resulting from the termination of the Plan.

In the event of termination, the net assets of the Plan will be allocated to pay benefits in priorities as prescribed by ERISA and its related regulations. Whether or not a particular participant will receive full benefits should the Plan terminate at some future time will depend on the sufficiency of the Plan's net assets at that time and the priority of those benefits.

**Note 4. Tax Status**

The Plan obtained its latest determination letter on December 5, 2017, in which the Internal Revenue Service stated that the Plan, as then designed, was in compliance with the applicable requirements under Section 401(a) of the Internal Revenue Code, and was, therefore, exempt from federal income taxes under provisions of Section 501(a). The Plan has been amended since receiving the determination letter. The Plan's Administrator and the Plan's legal counsel believe that the Plan is currently designed and being operated in compliance with the applicable requirements of the Internal Revenue Code.

Accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America require the Plan to evaluate tax positions taken by the Plan and recognize a tax liability if the Plan has taken an uncertain position that more likely than not would not be sustained upon examination by tax authorities. The Plan is subject to routine audits by taxing jurisdictions; however, there are currently no audits for any tax periods in progress.

**Note 5. Party-in-interest Transactions**

Certain Plan investments are shares of a common trust fund managed John Hancock, who serves as custodian of the Plan, and therefore, these transactions qualify as exempt party-in-interest transactions. Fees paid by the Plan for investment management and administrative services amounted to \$22,096 and \$18,506 for the years ended December 31, 2024 and 2023, respectively.

## **Note 6. Related Organizations**

The Plan has several related entities which include the following: the Foundation, three other non-profit corporations, a defined benefit pension plan and a health and welfare plan. All are separate tax-exempt entities.

## **Note 7. Fair Value Measurements**

The *Fair Value Measurements and Disclosures* Topic of the FASB Accounting Standards Codification established a fair value hierarchy that prioritizes the inputs to valuation techniques used to measure fair value. The hierarchy gives the highest priority to unadjusted quoted prices in active markets for identical assets or liabilities (Level 1 measurements) and the lowest priority to unobservable inputs (Level 3 measurements). The three levels of the fair value hierarchy are described below:

The methods used to measure fair value may produce an amount that may not be indicative of net realizable value or reflective of future fair values. Furthermore, although the Plan believes its valuation methods are appropriate and consistent with other market participants, the use of different methodologies or assumptions to determine the fair value of certain financial instruments could result in a different fair value measurement at the reporting date.

## Note 7. Fair Value Measurements (continued)

The following tables set forth, by level within the fair value hierarchy, the Plan's investment assets at fair value as of December 31, 2024 and 2023. As required, assets and liabilities are classified in their entirety based on the lowest level of input that is significant to the fair value measurement. In accordance with generally accepted accounting principles, certain investments that are measured at fair value using the net asset value per share (or its equivalent) practical expedient have not been classified in the fair value hierarchy. The fair value amounts presented in the following tables are intended to permit reconciliation of the fair value hierarchy to the amounts presented in the statements of net assets available for benefits.

### Level 1 Measurements

The fair values of mutual funds are determined by reference to the funds' underlying assets which, are principally marketable equity and fixed income securities. Shares held in the mutual funds are traded on national and international securities exchanges and are valued at the net asset value as of the last business day of each period presented.

## **Note 7. Fair Value Measurements (continued)**

### Measurements Using Net Asset Value as a Practical Expedient

The Plan's investment in a common trust fund is valued at the net asset value per share, used as a practical expedient to estimate fair value. The net asset value is based on the fair value of the underlying investments held by the fund less its liabilities. This practical expedient is not used when it is determined to be probable that the fund will sell the investment for an amount different than the reported net asset value.

The common trust fund is a direct filing entity (DFE) and files a Form 5500 annual report with the U.S. Department of Labor. The Plan is not required to disclose the significant investment strategies of DFE investments. Redemptions are generally allowed daily without notice.

## **Note 8. Risks and Uncertainties**

The Plan invests in various investment securities. Investment securities are exposed to various risks such as interest rate, market, and credit risks. Due to the level of risk associated with certain investment securities, it is at least reasonably possible that changes in the values of investment securities will occur in the near term and that such change could materially affect the amounts reported in the statements of net assets available for benefits. The current economic environment has increased the degree of uncertainty.


