### Scope and Nature of the ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) Audit

- the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements referred to above, other than those agreed to or derived from the certified investment information, are presented fairly, in all material respects, in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America (GAAP).
- the information in the financial statements referred to above related to assets which provides benefits under the Plan and held by and certified to by qualified institutions agrees to, or is derived from, in all material respects, the information prepared and certified by institutions that management determined meets the requirements of ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C).

### Basis for Opinion

I conducted my audits in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America (GAAS). My responsibilities under those standards are further described in the Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements section of my report. I am required to be independent of the Plan and to meet my other ethical responsibilities, in accordance with the relevant ethical requirements relating to my audits. I believe that the audit evidence I have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for my ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) audit opinion.

### Emphasis of Matter – Plan Merger

As discussed in Note 1 to the financial statements, effective July 10, 2024, the Company became a participating employer in the RMS EasyPlan and all Plan assets were transferred to the RMS EasyPlan. My opinion is not modified with respect to this matter.

## **Responsibilities of Management for the Financial Statements**

Management is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of the financial statements in accordance with GAAP, and for the design, implementation, and maintenance of internal control relevant to the preparation and fair presentation of financial statements that are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error. Management's election of the ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) audit does not affect management's responsibility for the financial statements.

In preparing the financial statements, management is required to evaluate whether there are conditions or events, considered in the aggregate, that raise substantial doubt about the Plan's ability to continue as a going concern within one year after the date that the financial statements are issued or are available to be issued.

Management is also responsible for maintaining a current plan instrument, including all plan amendments; administering the plan; and determining that the plan's transactions that are presented and disclosed in the financial statements are in conformity with the plan's provisions, including maintaining sufficient records with respect to each of the participants, to determine the benefits due or which may become due to such participants.

## **Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements**

Except as described in the Scope and Nature of the ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) Audit section of my report, my objectives are to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements as a whole are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, and to issue an auditor's report that includes my opinion. Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance but is not absolute assurance and therefore is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with GAAS will always detect a material misstatement when it exists. The risk of not detecting a material misstatement resulting from fraud is higher than for one resulting from error, as fraud may involve collusion, forgery, intentional omissions, misrepresentations, or the override of internal control. Misstatements are considered material, if there is a substantial likelihood that, individually or in the aggregate, they would influence the judgment made by a reasonable user based on the financial statements.

In performing an audit in accordance with GAAS, I:

- Exercise professional judgment and maintain professional skepticism throughout the audit.
- Identify and assess the risks of material misstatement of the financial statements, whether due to fraud or error, and design and perform audit procedures responsive to those risks. Such procedures include examining, on a test basis, evidence regarding the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements.
- Obtain an understanding of internal control relevant to the audit in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the Plan's internal control. Accordingly, no such opinion is expressed.
- Evaluate the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of significant accounting estimates made by management, as well as evaluate the overall presentation of the financial statements.
- Conclude whether, in my judgment, there are conditions or events, considered in the aggregate, that raise substantial doubt about the Plan's ability to continue as a going concern for a reasonable period of time.

My audits did not extend to the certified investment information, except for obtaining and reading the certifications, comparing the certified investment information with the related information presented and disclosed in the financial statements, and reading the disclosures relating to the certified investment information to assess whether they are in accordance with the presentation and disclosure requirements of GAAP.

Accordingly, the objective of an ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) audit is not to express an opinion about whether the financial statements as a whole are presented fairly, in all material respects, in accordance with GAAP.

I am required to communicate with those charged with governance regarding, among other matters, the planned scope and timing of the audit, significant audit findings, and certain internal control-related matters that I identified during the audit.

## Other Matter – Supplemental Schedule Required by ERISA

The supplemental schedule of delinquent participant contributions for the period ended July 10, 2024, are presented for purposes of additional analysis and is not a required part of the financial statements but is supplementary information required by the DOL's Rules and Regulations for Reporting and Disclosure under ERISA. Such information is the responsibility of management and was derived from and relates directly to the underlying accounting and other records used to prepare the financial statements. The information included in the supplemental schedule, other than that agreed to or derived from the certified investment information, has been subjected to auditing procedures applied in the audits of the financial statements and certain additional procedures, including comparing and reconciling such information directly to the underlying accounting and other records used to prepare the financial statements or to the financial statements themselves, and other additional procedures in accordance with GAAS. For information included in the supplemental schedule that agreed to or is derived from the certified investment information, I compared such information to the related certified investment information.

In forming my opinion on the supplemental schedule, I evaluated whether the supplemental schedule, other than the information agreed to or derived from the certified investment information, including their form and content, is presented in conformity with the DOL's Rules and Regulations for Reporting and Disclosure under ERISA.

In my opinion—

- the form and content of the supplemental schedule, other than the information in the supplemental schedules that agreed to or is derived from the certified investment information, is presented, in all material respects, in conformity with the DOL's Rules and Regulations for Reporting and Disclosure under ERISA.
- the information in the supplemental schedule related to assets which provides benefits under the Plan and held by and certified to by qualified institutions agrees to, or is derived from, in all material respects, the information prepared and certified by institutions that management determined meets the requirements of ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C).

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**NOTE 1      DESCRIPTION OF PLAN**

The following description of the Sunrise Services, Inc. 401(k) Plan (the Plan) provides only general information. Participants should refer to the plan agreement for a more complete description of the Plan's provisions.

**General**

Effective July 10, 2024, the Plan merged into the RMS EasyPlan. As a result, all Plan assets were transferred to the RMS EasyPlan. The provisions below describe the Plan prior to the merger.

The Plan was created on October 1, 1993, and was most recently restated as of January 1, 2021, and is a defined contribution plan covering substantially all eligible employees of Sunrise Services, Inc., and Sunrise Psychiatric & Professional Services, Inc. (a related employer, and collectively, "the Company"). The Plan is subject to the provisions of the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA). The Plan Trustees are responsible for oversight of the Plan, which include determining the appropriateness of the Plan's investment offerings, monitoring investment performance, and reporting to the Company's Board of Directors.

**Eligibility**

Substantially all employees may enter the Plan who have one year of service and are age 21 or older, with entry dates on the first day of the month coinciding with or next following date and age requirements met. Employees whose employment is governed by a collective bargaining agreement and leased employees are not eligible to participate in the Plan. A year of service is defined as completion of 1,000 hours of service.

**Contributions**

Participants – Each year, participants may contribute on a pretax and after tax (Roth) basis up to 100 percent of compensation, as defined by the Plan, and subject to certain Internal Revenue Service (IRS) limitations. Participants may also contribute amounts representing distributions from other qualified defined benefit or defined contribution plans (rollover). Participants age 50 and over may elect to defer additional amounts ("catch-up" contributions) to the Plan. The Plan includes an auto-enrollment provision whereby all eligible employees (i.e., one year of service (with 1,000 hours) and age 21) who are without a deferral election or a deferral election on file less than two percent, are automatically enrolled in the Plan unless they affirmatively elect not to participate in the Plan. Automatically enrolled participants have their deferral rate set at two percent of eligible compensation and their contributions invested in a designated balanced fund until changed by the participant. These automatically enrolled participants will have their automatic deferral percentage increase each year by one percent to a maximum of 12 percent of eligible compensation, unless otherwise designated by the eligible participant.

Discretionary Matching – The Company may make discretionary matching contributions. For the period ended July 10, 2024, the Company made discretionary matching contributions of \$293,576.

Discretionary Qualified Non-Elective – The Company may make a discretionary qualified non-elective contribution. There were no discretionary qualified non-elective contributions for the period ended July 10, 2024.

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**NOTE 1      DESCRIPTION OF PLAN (CONTINUED)**

Participant Accounts

Individual accounts are maintained for each participant. Each participant's respective account is credited with the participant's contributions and the Company's discretionary matching and qualified non-elective contributions, if any, and Plan earnings. Participant accounts are charged with withdrawals, an allocation of investment losses, and administrative expenses that are paid by the Plan. Allocations are based on participant earnings, account balances, or specific participant transactions, as defined. The benefit to which a participant is entitled is the benefit that can be provided from the participant's vested account.

Investment Options

Participants direct the investment of their contributions into various investment options offered by the Plan. Participants may move portions of their accounts between investment options and can change their salary deferral at the beginning of each month.

Vesting

Participants are vested immediately in their deferral contributions plus actual earnings thereon. Vesting in the Company's discretionary contribution portion of their accounts is based on years of continuous service. After two years of service, a participant vests 20 percent per year of service and are 100 percent vested after six years of credited service.

Payment of Benefits

On termination of service due to any reason, a participant may elect to receive a lump sum amount equal to the value of the participant's vested interest in his or her account. Participants with vested account balances of less than \$7,000 (\$5,000 in 2023) and more than \$50 without the participant's consent will receive an automatic distribution to an Individual Retirement Account (IRA), while any account less than \$50 will be distributed as a lump sum cash distribution.

Hardship withdrawals and in-service distributions are permitted by the Plan. Hardship withdrawals must be approved by the Plan administrator and are available from all money types that are 100% vested, including earnings.

Forfeitures

At July 10, 2024 and December 31, 2023, forfeited non-vested accounts totaled \$0 and \$7,999, respectively. These accounts will be used to pay administrative expenses under the Plan or reduce future employer contributions. Forfeitures of \$24,312 were used to reduce employer contributions during the period ending July 10, 2024.

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**NOTE 2      SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES**

Basis of Accounting

The financial statements of the Plan are prepared on the accrual basis of accounting.

Use of Estimates

The preparation of financial statements in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America (GAAP) requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts of assets and liabilities and changes therein, and disclosure of contingent assets and liabilities. Actual results could differ from those estimates.

Investment Valuation and Income Recognition

Investments are reported at fair value (except for the fully benefit-responsive stable value account, which is reported at contract value). Fair value is the price that would be received to sell an asset or paid to transfer a liability in an orderly transaction between market participants at the measurement date. The Plan's Trustees determine the Plan's valuation policies utilizing information provided by the investment advisers and custodian. See Note 3 for discussion of fair value measurements.

Purchases and sales of securities are recorded on a trade-date basis. Interest income is recorded on the accrual basis. Dividends are recorded on the ex-dividend date. Net appreciation in fair value of investments includes the Plan's gains and losses on investments bought and sold as well as held during the year.

Contributions

Contributions from participants are recorded as they are withheld from the participants' wages.

Payment of Benefits

Benefits are recorded when paid.

Administrative Expenses

Certain investment management fees and other charges paid to the Custodian are offset against fund performance in the net appreciation in fair value of investments on the statement of changes in net assets available for benefits, and are not, therefore, separately reflected as administrative expenses. Certain Plan expenses are paid directly by the Company and therefore are excluded from these financial statements. Fees are charged to participants on a pro rata basis, equally to participant accounts, or to a participant's account for transactions specifically related to that participant.

Subsequent Events

The Plan has evaluated subsequent events through October 15, 2025, the date the financial statements were available to be issued.

**NOTE 3      FAIR VALUE MEASUREMENTS**

The framework for measuring fair value provides a fair value hierarchy that prioritizes the inputs to valuation techniques used to measure fair value. The hierarchy gives the highest priority to unadjusted quoted prices in active markets for identical assets or liabilities (level 1) and the lowest priority to unobservable inputs (level 3). The three levels of fair value hierarchy under FASB ASC 820 are described as follows:

The asset or liability's fair value measurement level within the fair value hierarchy is based on the lowest level of any input that is significant to the fair value measurement. Valuation techniques maximize the use of relevant observable inputs and minimize the use of unobservable inputs.

Following is a description of the valuation methodologies used for assets measured at fair value. There have been no changes in the methodologies used at July 10, 2024 and December 31, 2023.

Mutual funds:

Valued at the daily closing price as reported by the fund. Mutual funds held by the Plan are open-end mutual funds that are registered with the SEC. These funds are required to publish their daily net asset value (NAV) and to transact at that price. The mutual funds held by the Plan are deemed to be actively traded.

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**NOTE 4 CERTIFIED INVESTMENTS**

Certain information disclosed in the accompanying financial statements and ERISA-required supplemental schedule, including the investments held at July 10, 2024 and December 31, 2023, and net appreciation in fair value of investments and interest and dividend income for the period ended July 10, 2024, was obtained by management and agreed to or derived from information certified as complete and accurate by Empower Annuity Insurance Company of America, and Empower Trust Company, LLC (the custodians of the Plan), qualified institutions. The Plan's independent auditor did not perform auditing procedures with respect to this information, except for comparing the information with the information included in the financial statements and supplemental schedule.

**NOTE 5 CONTRACT WITH INSURANCE COMPANY**

The Plan entered into a traditional fully benefit-responsive Key Guaranteed Portfolio Fund (KGPF) with Empower Annuity Insurance Company of America (EAICA). EAICA maintains the contributions in a general account, with a period-end July 10, 2024 and year-end December 31, 2023 balance of \$0 and \$289,722, respectively. The KGPF issuer is contractually obligated to repay the principal and a specified interest rate that is guaranteed to the Plan. The methodology for calculating the interest crediting rate is based on the earnings of the underlying assets in the entire medium-long term new portfolio compared to the minimum interest crediting rate, as stated in the contract, and prevailing market conditions. Interest crediting rate is reset quarterly. The KGPF does not permit the insurance company to terminate the agreement under normal circumstances.

This contract meets the fully benefit-responsive investment contract criteria and therefore is reported at contract value. Contract value is the relevant measure for fully benefit-responsive investment contracts because this is the amount received by participants if they were to initiate permitted transactions under the terms of the Plan. Contract value, as reported to the Plan by EAICA, represents contributions made under the contract, plus earnings, less participant withdrawals, and administrative expenses. Participants may ordinarily direct the withdrawal or transfer of all or a portion of their investment at contract value.

The Plan's ability to receive amounts due is dependent on the issuer's ability to meet its financial obligations. The issuer's ability to meet its contractual obligations may be affected by future economic and regulatory developments.

There are no events that might limit the ability of the Plan to transact at the contract value with EAICA, and neither are there any events that would limit the ability of the Plan to transact at contract value with the participants.

**NOTE 6 PLAN TERMINATION**

Although it has not expressed any intent to do so, the Company has the right under the Plan to discontinue its contributions at any time and to terminate the Plan subject to the provisions of ERISA. In the event of Plan termination, participants would become 100% vested in their employer contributions.

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**NOTE 7 RELATED PARTIES AND PARTY IN INTEREST TRANSACTIONS**

Certain Plan investments are mutual funds, and the stable value account, managed by Empower Trust Company, LLC (Empower). Empower is the custodian as defined by the Plan and, therefore, these transactions qualify as exempt party-in-interest transactions.

The Company is a party in interest to the Plan. However, there were no transactions with the Company other than employer contributions and the payment of certain administrative expenses to the Plan. These transactions qualify as exempt party-in-interest transactions. Revenue sharing fees are collected from various mutual funds by Empower, and are used to offset the Plan's administration fees.

**NOTE 8 TAX STATUS**

The Company has adopted a Non-Standardized Pre-Approved Profit Sharing / Money Purchase / CODA plan document that has received an opinion letter from the IRS dated June 30, 2020, stating that the form of the pre-approved Plan document was in compliance with the applicable requirements of the Internal Revenue Code (IRC). The Plan administrator believes that the Plan is designed, and is currently being operated, in compliance with the applicable requirements of the IRC, and, therefore, believes that the Plan is qualified, and the related trust is tax-exempt.

GAAP requires Plan management to evaluate tax positions taken by the Plan and recognize a tax liability if the Plan has taken an uncertain position that more likely than not would not be sustained upon examination by the IRS. The Plan is subject to routine audits by taxing jurisdictions; however, there are currently no audits for any tax periods in progress.

**NOTE 9 RISKS AND UNCERTAINTIES**

The Plan invests in various investment securities. Investment securities are exposed to various risks such as interest rate, market, and credit risks. Market risks include global events which could impact the value of investment securities, such as a pandemic or international conflict. Due to the level of risk associated with certain investment securities, it is at least reasonably possible that changes in the values of investment securities will occur in the near term and that such changes could materially affect participants' account balances and the amounts reported in the statements of net assets available for benefits.

**NOTE 10 NONEXEMPT TRANSACTIONS**

During the Plan year ended December 31, 2023, participant deferral contributions totaling \$3,719 were not remitted to the Plan within the appropriate time period by the Company's management. These transactions constitute prohibited transactions as defined by ERISA. Lost earnings have been calculated and were contributed by the Company to the RMS EasyPlan in October 2024.
