We have performed an audit of the accompanying financial statements of Sharp Rees-Stealy Medical Group, Inc. Retirement Savings Plan (formerly, Sharp Rees-Stealy Medical Group, Inc. Profit Sharing Plan) (the "Plan"), an employee benefit plan subject to the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 ("ERISA"), as permitted by ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) [an ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) audit]. #### NOTE 1. DESCRIPTION OF THE PLAN

##### General

The Sharp Rees-Stealy Medical Group, Inc. Retirement Savings Plan (formerly, Sharp Rees-Stealy Medical Group, Inc. Profit Sharing Plan) (the "Plan") is sponsored by Sharp Rees-Stealy Medical Group, Inc. (the "Company" or the "Employer"). The following description of the Plan provides only general information. Participants should refer to the Plan documents for a more complete description of the Plan's provisions.

The Plan, which became effective April 1, 1989, is a single-employer defined contribution plan covering all eligible employees of the Company. The Plan is subject to the provisions of the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 ("ERISA"), and the provisions of the Internal Revenue Code ("IRC").

On December 31, 2023, the assets of the Sharp Rees-Stealy Medical Group, Inc. 401(k) Plan (the "401(k) Plan") were transferred to (merged into) the Plan. In connection therewith, the Plan was amended and restated, effective January 1, 2024, to incorporate the provisions of the 401(k) Plan and the Plan was renamed the Sharp Rees-Stealy Medical Group, Inc. Retirement Savings Plan.

##### Eligibility

For purposes of salary deferrals, employer matching contributions, and non-elective contributions, employees covered by a collective bargaining agreement, nonresident aliens with no income from U.S. sources, and leased employees are not eligible to participate in the Plan. For purposes of receiving matching contributions, excluded employees include physicians. For purposes of receiving non-elective (profit sharing) contributions, excluded employees include non-physician employees.

***Participant Contributions:*** Employees, except those excluded by the Plan, become eligible to make salary deferrals once they have completed three consecutive months of employment. For purposes of salary deferrals, the entry date will be the first day of the month coinciding with or next following the date the eligibility requirements are met.

***Employer Matching Contributions:*** Employees, except those excluded by the Plan, are generally eligible to participate in an allocation of the annual employer matching contributions once they have completed three consecutive months of employment, and provided they have completed at least 1,000 hours of service during the Plan year and are employed by the Employer on the last day of the Plan year.

***Employer Profit Sharing Contributions:*** Employees, except those excluded by the Plan, become eligible to receive non-elective (profit sharing) contributions upon completion of two years of service and reaching age 21. A year of service for eligibility purposes is based on an employee being credited with at least 1,000 hours of service during the 12-month period beginning on the employee's date of hire. An employee may enter the Plan on the first day of the month coincident with or next following the date the eligibility requirements are met. In addition, for an eligible employee to become a participant of the Plan for purposes of profit sharing contributions on the applicable entry date, the employee must elect to participate by providing written notice by the first of the month following three months after the employee's hire date.

#### NOTE 1. DESCRIPTION OF THE PLAN (Continued)

##### Contributions

Each year, participants may contribute up to 100% of their eligible compensation on a pre-tax basis, as defined in the Plan, subject to limits imposed by Internal Revenue Service ("IRS") regulations. Participants may also, at the discretion of the Plan administrator, contribute amounts representing rollover distributions from other qualified sources. Participants who have attained age 50 before the end of the Plan year are eligible to make catch-up contributions. Participants can change their contribution percentages on the first day of any month and may revoke their salary deferral election any time during the Plan year.

The Company makes matching contributions for all eligible participants. The Company's matching contribution calculation is as follows: (i) eligible participants with less than 10 years of service at the end of the Plan year receive a matching contribution equal to 100% of elective deferrals up to 2% of Plan eligible compensation; and (ii) eligible participants with 10 or more years of service at the end of the Plan year receive a matching contribution equal to 100% of elective deferrals up to 3% of Plan eligible compensation. A year of service is defined as having completed at least 1,000 hours of service during the Plan year.

The Company also makes non-elective (profit sharing) contributions. The Company's non-elective contribution calculation is 7% of a participant's compensation, as defined by the Plan, subject to certain limitations imposed by the IRC. The contribution is determined each pay period.

At the discretion of the Plan administrator, participants may also contribute amounts representing distributions from other retirement plans.

##### Participant Accounts

Each participant has an account that is credited with the participant's contributions and employer contributions, if any. Participants direct the investment of their accounts among investment options made available by the Plan or in self-directed brokerage accounts. Investment income, losses, and expenses are allocated to participant accounts based on the performance of their investments or specific participant transactions, as defined. The benefit to which a participant is entitled is the benefit that can be provided from the participant's vested account.

##### Vesting

Participant accounts are 100% vested at all times.

##### Investment Options

Upon enrollment in the Plan, a participant may direct their and employer contributions in any of the Plan's investment options. Subsequently, participants may change their allocations and transfer account balances between investment options in accordance with Plan provisions. The Plan also permits self-directed brokerage accounts where participants may direct participant and employer contributions into investments of their choosing and change their investments at any time.

##### Notes Receivable from Participants

Participants may borrow from their fund accounts a minimum of \$1,000 up to a maximum generally equal to the lesser of \$50,000 or 50% of their account balance. The loans are secured by the balance in the participant's account. Loan transactions are treated as a transfer to (from) the investment fund from (to) the participant loan fund. Loan terms generally range from 1-5 years, but may extend up to 30 years for the purchase of a primary residence, and bear interest at a fixed rate of 1% over prime at the time of the loan. As of December 31, 2024, interest rates on outstanding loans ranged from 4.25% to 9.50%. Interest and principal are paid ratably no less often than monthly.

##### Payment of Benefits

On termination of service due to death, disability, or retirement, a participant will automatically receive a life annuity (if not married) and will automatically receive a joint and 50% survivor annuity (if married) under which payments will be received for life. Participants may also elect an alternative form of payment. Alternative forms of payment include:

- single lump sum payment; or
- partial withdrawals of at least \$1,000
- in-kind distributions permitted only from self-directed brokerage accounts

Participants who terminate employment for reasons other than death, disability, or retirement may elect to have their vested account balances distributed to them as soon as administratively feasible following their termination. At the election of the participant, upon reaching normal retirement age (55), a distribution will be made as soon as administratively feasible.

If a terminated participant's vested account balance is less than \$5,000 (\$7,000 effective January 1, 2024) but greater than \$1,000, the Plan administrator may distribute the account balance in the form of a joint and 50% survivor annuity. If a participant's vested account balance is greater than \$7,000, the participant may elect to receive benefit payments in a single lump sum or direct rollover, or remain in the Plan as described in the Plan document and postpone payment to a later date, as described below.

Pursuant to the Setting Every Community Up for Retirement Enhancement Act of 2019 (the "SECURE" Act), which became law on December 20, 2019, and the SECURE 2.0 Act (Note 10), which became law on December 29, 2022, participants may generally defer taking distributions as follows:

- If a participant reached the age of 70½ in 2019, the participant may defer receiving distributions until the later of April 1, 2020, or the April following the calendar year in which the participant retires;
- If a participant reached the age of 70½ in 2020 or later, the participant may defer receiving distributions until the later of the April following the calendar year in which the participant reaches age 72 or retires, except that –
- Beginning in 2023, the age a participant must begin taking distributions was raised to 73. If a participant reached the age of 72 during 2023, the participant may defer receiving distributions until April 1, 2025, the latest date that a required minimum distribution may be taken for 2024.

##### Payment and Benefits (Continued)

The Plan also allows for in-service distributions as follows: (1) from accounts in which the participant is fully vested if the participant has reached age 59½, (2) from the non-elective contribution account only if the participant has reached normal retirement age (55), and (3) from the rollover contribution account at any time.

#### NOTE 2. SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

##### Basis of Accounting

The financial statements of the Plan are prepared using the modified cash basis of accounting, which is a comprehensive basis of accounting other than accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America. Under the modified cash basis of accounting, contributions and interest and dividends are recognized when received rather than earned (or declared) and expenses are recognized when paid rather than incurred.

##### Estimates

The preparation of financial statements in accordance with the modified cash basis of accounting requires the Plan administrator to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts of assets and liabilities and changes therein, and disclosure of contingent assets and liabilities. Actual results may differ from those estimates.

##### Cash

The Plan, at times, has amounts deposited at financial institutions that exceed federally insured limits. The Plan believes there is no significant risk with respect to these deposits.

##### Investment Valuation and Income Recognition

Investments are reported at fair value. Fair value is the price that would be received to sell an asset or paid to transfer a liability in an orderly transaction between market participants at the measurement date. See Note 4 for discussions of fair value measurements.

Purchases and sales of securities are recorded on a trade-date basis. Interest and dividend income are recognized when received. Net realized and unrealized appreciation (depreciation) in the fair value of investments includes the Plan's gains and losses on investments bought and sold as well as held during the year.

##### Notes Receivable from Participants

Notes receivable from participants are measured at their unpaid principal balance. Interest income is recorded when received. Related fees are recorded as administrative expenses and are expensed when they are paid. If the participant ceases to make loan repayments and the Plan administrator deems the participant loan to be in default, the participant loan balance is reduced and a benefit payment is recorded.

##### Excess Contributions Payable

Amounts payable to participants for contributions in excess of amounts allowed by the IRS are recorded as a liability with a corresponding reduction to contributions. For the year ended December 31, 2023, the excess participant contributions in the amount of \$72,431 were disbursed from the Plan during 2024.

##### Payment of Benefits

Benefits are recorded when paid.

##### Expenses

Certain expenses of maintaining the Plan are paid directly by the Company or the participants and are excluded from these financial statements. Certain fees related to the administration of notes receivable from participants and distributions are charged directly to the transacting participant's account and are included in administrative expenses or are paid directly by the participant. Administrative and other expenses include investment advisory and management fees.

##### Subsequent Events

The Plan has evaluated subsequent events through the date of the independent auditors' report, which is the date these financial statements were available to be issued.

#### NOTE 3. INFORMATION CERTIFIED BY THE TRUSTEE

Certain information related to investments disclosed in the accompanying financial statements and the ERISA-required supplemental schedule (Schedule H, Part IV, Line 4i), including investments held at December 31, 2024, and net realized and unrealized appreciation or depreciation in fair value of investments for the year then ended, was obtained by management and agreed to or derived from information certified as complete and accurate by Matrix Trust Company, a trustee of the Plan which is also a qualified institution as defined by ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C).

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#### NOTE 4. FAIR VALUE MEASUREMENTS

Financial Accounting Standards Board (“FASB”) Accounting Standards Codification (“ASC”) 820, *Fair Value Measurements and Disclosures*, provides the framework for measuring fair value. That framework provides a fair value hierarchy that prioritizes the inputs to valuation techniques used to measure fair value. The hierarchy gives the highest priority to unadjusted quoted prices in active markets for identical assets or liabilities (Level 1 measurements) and the lowest priority to unobservable inputs (Level 3 measurements). The three levels of the fair value hierarchy under FASB ASC 820 are described as follows:

##### *Level 1*

Inputs to the valuation methodology are unadjusted quoted prices for identical assets or liabilities in active markets that the Plan has the ability to access.

##### *Level 2*

Inputs other than quoted prices included within Level 1 that are observable for the asset or liability, either directly or indirectly, such as:

- Quoted prices for similar assets or liabilities in active markets;
- Quoted prices for identical or similar assets or liabilities in inactive markets;
- Inputs other than quoted prices that are observable for the asset or liability;
- Inputs that are derived principally from or corroborated by observable market data by correlation or other means.

If the asset or liability has a specified (contractual) term, the Level 2 input must be observable for substantially the full term of the asset or liability.

##### *Level 3*

Inputs to the valuation methodology are unobservable and significant to the fair value measurement for the asset or liability at the measurement date. These inputs reflect Plan management’s best estimate of what market participants would use in pricing the asset or liability at the measurement date. Consideration is given to the risk inherent in the valuation technique and in the inputs to the model.

The asset’s or liability’s fair value measurement level within the fair value hierarchy is based on the lowest level of any input that is significant to the fair value measurement. Valuation techniques used need to maximize the use of observable inputs and minimize the use of unobservable inputs. There have been no changes in the methodologies used at December 31, 2024 and 2023.

The following is a description of the valuation methodologies used for assets measured at fair value at December 31, 2024 and 2023.

*Money Market Funds and Certificates of Deposit (“CDs”):* Valued at carrying value, which approximates fair value.

*Mutual Funds:* Valued at the daily closing price as reported by the fund. Mutual funds held by the Plan are open-end funds that are registered with the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission. These funds are required to publish their daily net asset value and to transact at that price. The mutual funds held by the Plan are deemed to be actively traded.

*Common Stock, Preferred Stock, Corporate Debt, and Government Securities:* Valued at the closing prices reported on the active market on which the individual securities are traded.

*Self-Directed Brokerage Accounts:* Accounts consist primarily of registered investment companies and shares in common stock that are valued on the basis of readily determinable market prices for identical assets. The accounts also include fixed income securities and government securities valued at the listed price adjusted for discounts, premiums, etc. All other investments are not actively traded and other significant observable inputs are not available. The best available unobservable inputs were used to estimate fair value for these investments.

*All Other Investments:* All other investments are not actively traded and other significant observable inputs are not available. The best available unobservable inputs were used to estimate fair value for these investments.

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#### **NOTE 5. PARTY-IN-INTEREST TRANSACTIONS**

Certain of the Plan's operating expenses are paid by the Company and the Company provides certain administrative services for the Plan at no cost to the Plan. In addition, the Plan allows participants to take loans against their account balances. These transactions are considered exempt party-in-interest transactions.

#### **NOTE 6. TAX STATUS**

The Company has adopted a pre-approved profit sharing plan and relies upon the pre-approved plan's opinion letter dated June 30, 2020, in which the Internal Revenue Service ("IRS") stated that, in its opinion, the form of the plan is acceptable under and is designed in accordance with applicable sections of the IRC. The Company has not applied for a determination letter from the IRS specific to the Plan. Although the Plan has been amended since receiving the opinion letter, the Plan administrator believes that the Plan is designed and is currently being operated in compliance with the applicable requirements of the IRC. Therefore, no provision for income taxes has been included in the accompanying financial statements.

The modified cash basis of accounting requires Plan management to evaluate the tax positions taken by the Plan and recognize a tax liability (or asset) if the Plan has taken an uncertain tax position that more likely than not would not be sustained upon examination by the applicable taxing authorities. The Plan administrator has analyzed the tax positions taken by the Plan and has concluded that as of December 31, 2024, there are no uncertain positions taken or expected to be taken that would require recognition of a liability (or asset) or disclosure in the financial statements. The Plan is subject to routine audits by taxing jurisdictions; however, there are currently no audits for any tax periods in progress. The Plan administrator believes it is no longer subject to income tax examinations for years prior to 2021.

#### **NOTE 7. PLAN TERMINATION**

Although it has not expressed any intent to do so, the Company has the right under the Plan to discontinue its contributions at any time and to terminate the Plan subject to the provisions of ERISA.

#### **NOTE 8. RISKS AND UNCERTAINTIES**

The Plan invests in various investment securities. Investment securities are exposed to various risks such as interest rate, market and credit risk. Due to the level of risk associated with certain investment securities, it is at least reasonably possible that changes in the values of investment securities will occur in the near term and that such changes could materially affect participant account balances and the amounts reported in the statements of net assets available for benefits – modified cash basis.

In addition, certain items are categorized differently in the accompanying financial statements compared to the Form 5500, as of December 31, 2024 and 2023 and for the year ended December 31, 2024.

**NOTE 10. SECURE 2.0 ACT**

On December 29, 2022, the SECURE 2.0 Act of 2022 (the "SECURE Act 2.0") became law. The purpose of the legislation is to expand access to retirement plans and to help working Americans increase their retirement saving. In addition to the changes to distributions described in Note 1, the SECURE Act 2.0 includes various required and optional provisions that become effective through 2033, certain of which are described below.

- Beginning in 2033, the age for required minimum distributions will increase from age 73 to 75.
- Beginning January 1, 2025, a participant from the ages 60 to 63 can elect catch-up contributions up to the limit of the greater of \$10,000 or 150% of the catch-up contribution limit imposed by the IRS.
- Beginning January 1, 2025, long-term part-time workers (defined as employees who have worked for two consecutive 12 month periods during each of which they have at least 500 hours of service) will become eligible to enroll in their employer's retirement plan after two years.
- Beginning January 1, 2026, catch-up contributions will be made on a Roth basis, unless the participant earns \$145,000 or less.

In addition, Plan management has not yet determined which of the optional provisions, if any, the Plan will implement. Plan management expects to formally amend the Plan by December 31, 2026.
