**NOTE 1 - GROUP INSURANCE ARRANGEMENT DESCRIPTION**

The following is a description of the Hospital Employee Benefit Association Trust Employees' Life Group Insurance Arrangement ("the Group Insurance Arrangement"). Participants should refer to the plan document of their individual employers for a more complete description of the arrangement's provisions.

**General**

The Group Insurance Arrangement is established for the benefit of multiple employers and their employees. The Group Insurance Arrangement is defined as a group insurance arrangement for the purpose of filing a consolidated Form 5500 on behalf of all participating employer plans. The purpose of the Group Insurance Arrangement is to provide group insurance benefits to the employees of the participating employers.

**Trust Arrangement**

A trust is established as a conduit to receive premium contributions from participating employers of the Group Insurance Arrangement and subsequently to remit these premiums to the insurance carrier. The Trustee or its duly authorized representative, upon written direction of the Administrator, reserves the right to terminate the Group Insurance Arrangement, subject to the provisions set forth in the Trust document.

**Benefits**

Benefits are fully insured by the insurance carrier and are therefore not included in these financial statements.

**NOTE 2 - SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES**

**Cash and Cash Equivalents**

The Company considers all highly liquid instruments that are purchased within three months or less of an instrument's original maturity date to be cash equivalents.

**Basis of Accounting**

The Group Insurance Arrangement's policy is to prepare its financial statements on the modified cash basis. Therefore, income and expense items are recognized only as cash is received or paid, and receivables, payables (except amounts due to the insurance carrier), and accrued expenses are not reflected.

**Use of Estimates**

The preparation of financial statements requires the Group Insurance Arrangement Administrator to make estimates and assumptions that affect certain reported amounts and disclosures. Accordingly, actual results may differ from those estimates.

**NOTE 2 - SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES (CONTINUED)**

**Investment Valuation and Income Recognition**

Investments are reported at fair value. Fair value is the price that would be received to sell an asset or paid to transfer a liability in an orderly transaction between market participants at the measurement date. The Plan's Board of Directors determines the Plan's valuation policies utilizing information provided by the investment trustee. See Note 5 for discussion of fair value measurements.

Purchases and sales of securities are recorded on a trade-date basis. Interest income is recorded when posted to the Trust. Dividends are recorded on the ex-dividend date. Net appreciation includes the Plan's gains and losses on investments bought and sold, as well as held during the year.

**Contributions**

Contributions from Plan participants are recorded when received in accordance with the modified cash basis of accounting.

**NOTE 3 - INVESTMENTS**

The Group Insurance Arrangement's investments are held in a selection of investments by The National Bank of Indianapolis, the Group Insurance Arrangement's Trustee ("Trustee"). The following table presents the fair value of investments as represented by the Trustee:

**NOTE 4 - TAX STATUS**

The Group Insurance Arrangement is established pursuant to Section 501 of the Internal Revenue Code and, accordingly, is exempt from income taxes. The Administrator believes the Group Insurance Arrangement is currently designed and being operated in accordance with applicable sections of the Internal Revenue Code.

The Group Insurance Arrangement's trust pays taxes based upon the taxable income that is reported on the trust's Form 1041 that is filed on an annual basis. The trust taxes that are reported on the Statement of Changes in Net Assets Available for Benefits - Modified Cash Basis are the taxes that are allocated to the Group Insurance Arrangement.

**NOTE 4 - TAX STATUS (CONTINUED)**

Authoritative accounting standards require management to examine its tax positions for uncertain positions. Management is not aware of any tax positions that are more likely than not to change in the next 12 months or that would not sustain an examination by applicable taxing authorities.

**NOTE 5 - FAIR VALUE MEASUREMENTS**

The framework for measuring fair value provides a fair value hierarchy that prioritizes the inputs to valuation techniques used to measure fair value. The hierarchy gives the highest priority to unadjusted quoted prices in active markets for identical assets or liabilities (Level 1) and the lowest priority to unobservable inputs (Level 3). The three levels of the fair value hierarchy under Financial Accounting Standards Board ("FASB") Accounting Standards Codification (ASU) Topic 820 are described below:

- Level 1 Inputs to the valuation methodology are unadjusted quoted prices for identical assets or liabilities in active markets that the Plan has the ability to access.
- Level 2 Inputs to the valuation methodology include quoted prices for similar assets and liabilities in active markets; quoted prices for identical or similar assets and liabilities in inactive markets; inputs other than quoted market prices that are observable for the asset or liability; and inputs that are derived principally from or corroborated by observable market data by correlation or other means. If the asset or liability has a specified (contractual) term, the Level 2 input must be observable for substantially the full term of the asset or liability.
- Level 3 Inputs to the valuation methodology are unobservable and significant to measurement.

The asset or liability's fair value measurement level within the fair value hierarchy is based on the lowest level of any input that is significant to the fair value measurement. Valuation techniques used need to maximize the use of observable inputs and minimize the use of unobservable inputs.

Following is a description of the valuation methodology used for assets measured at fair value. There have been no changes in valuation methodologies at September 31, 2024 and 2023.

*Money Market Accounts:* Valued using pricing models maximizing the use of observable inputs for similar securities.

*Fixed Income Securities/Mutual Fund - Taxable Bond Funds:* Valued using pricing models maximizing the use of observable inputs for similar securities. This includes basing value on yields currently available on comparable securities of issuers with similar credit ratings.

*Mutual Funds:* Valued at the daily closing price as reported by the fund. Mutual funds held by the Plan are open-end mutual funds that are registered with the Securities and Exchange Commission. These funds are required to publish their daily Net Asset Value ("NAV") and to transact at that price. The mutual funds held by the Plan are deemed to be actively traded.

**NOTE 6 - PARTY-IN-INTEREST TRANSACTIONS**

The Group Insurance Arrangement investments are managed by the National Bank of Indianapolis. The National Bank of Indianapolis is the custodian and trustee of the Group Insurance Arrangement and, therefore, these transactions qualify as party-in-interest transactions.

A portion of administrative expenses are paid by the Group Insurance Arrangement to Gallagher Benefit Services and represent recordkeeping and fees, which amounted to \$88,181 for the year ended September 30, 2024.

**NOTE 7 - SUBSEQUENT EVENTS**

The Plan has evaluated subsequent events through October 30, 2025, the date on which the financial statements were available to be issued. No significant matters were identified for disclosure during this evaluation.
