Scope and Nature of the ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) Audit

We have performed audits of the financial statements of EvensonBest LLC 401(k) (the "Plan"), an employee benefit plan subject to the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 ("ERISA"), as permitted by ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) (ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) audit). The financial statements comprise the statements of net assets available for benefits as of December 31, 2024 and 2023, and the related statement of changes in net assets available for benefits for the year ended December 31, 2024, and the related notes to the financial statements.

Management, having determined it is permissible in the circumstances, has elected to have the audits of the Plan's financial statements performed in accordance with ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) pursuant to 29 CFR 2520.103-8 of the Department of Labor's Rules and Regulations for Reporting and Disclosure under ERISA. As permitted by ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C), our audits need not extend to any statements or information related to assets held for investment of the Plan (investment information) by a bank or similar institution or insurance carrier that is regulated, supervised, and subject to periodic examination by a state or federal agency, provided that the statements or information regarding assets so held are prepared and certified to by the bank or similar institution or insurance carrier in accordance with 29 CFR 2520.103-5 of the Department of Labor's Rules and Regulations for Reporting and Disclosure under ERISA (qualified institution).

Management has obtained certifications from a qualified institution as of December 31, 2024 and 2023, and for the year ended December 31, 2024, stating that the certified investment information, as described in Note 3 to the financial statements, is complete and accurate.

Opinion

In our opinion, based on our audits and on the procedures performed as described in the Auditors' Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements section:

- the information in the accompanying financial statements related to assets held by and certified to by a qualified institution agrees to, or is derived from, in all material respects, the information prepared and certified by an institution that management determined meets the requirements of ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C).

Basis for Opinion

We conducted our audits in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America ("GAAS"). Our responsibilities under those standards are further described in the Auditors' Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements section of our report. We are required to be independent of the Plan and to meet our other ethical responsibilities, in accordance with the relevant ethical requirements relating to our audits. Responsibilities of Management for the Financial Statements

Management is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of the financial statements in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America, and for the design, implementation, and maintenance of internal control relevant to the preparation and fair presentation of financial statements that are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error. Management's election of the ERISA Section 103(a)(3)(C) audit does not affect management's responsibility for the financial statements.

1. Description of the plan

The following description of the EvensonBest, LLC 401(k) Plan (the “Plan”) provides only general information. Participants should refer to the Plan document for a more complete description of the Plan’s provisions.

General and Eligibility

The Plan is a defined contribution plan covering all full-time, nonunion employees of EvensonBest LLC (the “Company”) who have completed at least 60 days of service and attained the age of 21. The Plan is subject to the provisions of the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (“ERISA”). The assets of the Plan are maintained by Voya Retirement Insurance and Annuity Company, (the “Insurance Company”), who is also the record keeper of the Plan.

Contributions

Each year, participants may elect to make contributions of pre-tax annual compensation, up to the legal maximum allowable amount as defined by the Internal Revenue Code (“IRC”). In 2024, participants could contribute up to a maximum of \$23,000 with an additional \$7,500 catch-up contribution for employees over 50 years old. Participants direct the investment of their contributions into various investment options offered by the Plan. The employer, at its discretion, may make contributions to the Plan, subject to limitations.

Participant Accounts

Each participant’s account is credited with the participant’s contributions and allocations of (a) employer contributions, if any, (b) Plan earnings (losses), and (c) administrative expenses. Allocations are based on participant earnings (losses) or account balance, as defined. The benefit to which a participant is entitled is the benefit that can be provided from the participant’s vested account.

Vesting

Participants are immediately vested in their contributions plus actual earnings (losses) thereon. Vesting in the Company’s discretionary contributions is based on years of continuous service. A participant is 100% vested after six years of credited service according to the following schedule:

Cash and Cash Equivalents

The plan considers all highly-liquid investments with an original maturity of three months or less to be cash equivalents.

Participants' Loans Receivable

Participants may borrow from their fund accounts a minimum of \$1,000 up to a maximum equal to the lesser of (1) \$50,000 reduced by the highest outstanding loan balance during the one-year period on the day before the new loan is made or (2) 50% of the fair market value of the participant's vested account balance reduced by any outstanding loan balance on the date the new loan is made. All loans shall bear a reasonable rate of interest as determined by the Plan administrator, which was the prime rate (7.50% at December 31, 2024) plus 1%, and must be repaid in five years, unless the loan is for the purchase of a principal residence, then the term will be determined by the Plan administrator. Principal and interest are paid ratably through bi-weekly payroll deductions.

Payment of Benefits

Upon termination of employment due to retirement, death or disability, a participant will receive a lump-sum distribution in the amount equal to the value of the participant's vested interest in his or her account or may elect to have the entire distribution rolled into an IRA or a new employer's qualified plan if it accepts rollover contributions. Participants may withdraw their contributions upon demonstrating a hardship or attaining age 59 ½.

2. Summary of significant accounting policies

Basis of Accounting

The accompanying financial statements of the Plan are prepared in compliance with the Department of Labor's ("DOL") Rules and Regulations for Reporting and Disclosure under ERISA and the accrual basis of accounting in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America ("GAAP").

Income Recognition

Purchases and sales of securities are recorded on the trade date. Interest income is recorded on the accrual basis and dividends are recorded on the ex-dividend date. Net appreciation or depreciation includes the Plan's gains and losses on investments bought and sold as well as held during the year.

Payment of Benefits

Benefit payments are recorded when paid.

Administrative Expenses

The Plan is responsible for administrative fees and related expenses. The Company has assumed some of these expenses on behalf of the Plan.

Participants' Loans Receivable

Participants' loans receivable are valued at their unpaid principal balance plus any accrued but unpaid interest.

Income Taxes

GAAP requires plan management to evaluate tax positions taken by the Plan and recognize a tax liability (or asset) if the Plan has taken an uncertain position that more likely than not would not be sustained upon examination by the Department of Labor or the Internal Revenue Service. The Plan administrator has analyzed the tax positions taken by the Plan, and has concluded that as of December 31, 2024, there are no uncertain tax positions taken or expected to be taken that would require recognition of a tax liability (or asset) or disclosure in the financial statements. The Plan is subject to routine audits by taxing jurisdictions; however, there are currently no audits for any tax periods in progress.

Use of Estimates

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with GAAP and the DOL's Rules and Regulations for Reporting and Disclosure under ERISA requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect certain reported amounts of assets, liabilities and changes therein at the date of the financial statements and disclosures of contingent assets and liabilities. Accordingly, actual results may differ from those estimates.

Fair Value

Fair value is defined as the price that would be received to sell an asset or paid to transfer a liability (i.e., the "exit price") in an orderly transaction between market participants at the measurement date.

In determining fair value, the Plan uses various valuation techniques. A fair value hierarchy for inputs is used in measuring fair value that maximizes the use of observable inputs and minimizes the use of unobservable inputs by requiring that the most observable inputs are to be used when available. Valuation techniques that are consistent with the market or income approach are used to measure fair value. The fair value hierarchy is categorized into three levels based on the inputs as follows:

Level 1 - Valuations based on unadjusted quoted prices in active markets for identical assets or liabilities that the Plan has the ability to access.

Level 2 - Valuations based on inputs, other than quoted prices included in Level 1, that are observable either directly or indirectly.

Level 3 - Valuations based on inputs that are unobservable and significant to the overall fair value measurement.

Fair value is a market-based measure, based on assumptions of prices and inputs considered from the perspective of a market participant that are current as of the measurement date, rather than an entity-specific measure. Therefore, even when market assumptions are not readily available, the Plan's own assumptions are set to reflect those that market participants would use in pricing the asset or liability at the measurement date.

The availability of valuation techniques and observable inputs can vary from investment to investment and are affected by a wide variety of factors, including the type of investment, whether the investment is new and not yet established in the marketplace, the liquidity of markets, and other characteristics particular to the transaction. To the extent that valuation is based on models or inputs that are less observable or unobservable in the market, the determination of fair value requires more judgment. Because of the inherent uncertainty of valuation, those estimated values may be materially higher or lower than the values that would have been used had a ready market for the investments existed. Accordingly, the degree of judgment exercised by the Plan in determining fair value is

greatest for investments categorized in Level 3. In certain cases, the inputs used to measure fair value may fall into different levels of the fair value hierarchy. In such cases, the level in the fair value hierarchy which the fair value measurement falls in its entirety is determined based on the lowest level input that is significant to the fair value measurement.

The following is a description of the valuation methodologies used for assets measured at fair value. There have been no changes in the methodologies used at December 31, 2024 and 2023.

Pooled separate accounts: Valued at net asset value as a practical expedient, based on the market value of the underlying investments. The net asset value is not a publicly quoted price in an active market. The pooled separate account is comprised of mutual funds as the underlying investments.

The methods described above may produce a fair value calculation that may not be indicative of net realizable value or reflective of future fair values. Furthermore, while the Plan believes its valuation methods are appropriate and consistent with other market participants, the use of different methodologies or assumptions to determine the fair value of certain financial instruments could result in a different fair value measurement at the reporting date.

Guaranteed Investment Contract with Insurance Company

During 2020, the Plan entered into a benefit-responsive guaranteed investment contract with Voya Retirement Insurance and Annuity Company ("Voya"). Voya maintains the contributions in a general account. The contract is reported at contract value. The account is credited with earnings on the underlying investments and charged for participant withdrawals and administrative expenses. The guaranteed investment contract issuer is contractually obligated to repay the principal and a specified interest rate that is guaranteed to the Plan.

Because the guaranteed investment contract is fully benefit-responsive, contract value is the relevant measurement attribute for that portion of the net assets available for benefits attributable to the guaranteed investment contract. Contract value, as reported to the Plan by Voya, represents contributions made under the contract, plus earnings, less participant withdrawals and administrative expenses. Participants may ordinarily direct the withdrawal or transfer of all or a portion of their investment at contract value.

The traditional investment contract held by the Plan is a guaranteed investment contract. The contract issuer is contractually obligated to repay the principal and interest at a specified interest rate that is guaranteed to the Plan. The crediting rate is based on a formula established by the contract issuer but may not be less than 1% percent. The crediting rate is reviewed on a quarterly basis for resetting. At December 31, 2024 the current credit rating was 1.40%. The contract cannot be terminated before the scheduled maturity date.

The Plan's ability to receive amounts due in accordance with fully benefit-responsive investment contracts is dependent on the third-party issuer's ability to meet its financial obligations. The issuer's ability to meet its contractual obligations may be affected by future economic and regulatory developments.

Certain events might limit the ability of the Plan to transact at contract value with the contract issuer. These events may be different under each contract. Examples of such events include the following:

1. The Plan's failure to qualify under Section 401(a) of the Internal Revenue Code or the failure of the trust to be tax-exempt under Section 501(a) of the Internal Revenue Code;
2. Premature termination of the contracts;
3. Plan termination or merger;
4. Changes to the Plan's prohibition on competing investment options; or
5. Bankruptcy of the Plan sponsor or other Plan sponsor events (for example, divestitures or spinoffs of a subsidiary) that significantly affect the Plan's normal operations.

No events are probable of occurring that might limit the ability of the Plan to transact at contract value with the contract issuers and that also would limit the ability of the Plan to transact at contract value with the participants.

In addition, certain events allow the issuer to terminate the contracts with the Plan and settle at an amount different from contract value. Those events may be different under each contract. Examples of such events include the following:

1. An uncured violation of the Plan's investment guidelines;
2. A breach of material obligation under the contract;
3. A material misrepresentation; or
4. A material amendment to the agreements without the consent of the issuer.

3. Investment certification

The Plan administrator has elected the method of compliance permitted by 29 CFR 2520.103-8 of the DOL's Rules and Regulations for Reporting and Disclosure under ERISA. Accordingly, as permitted under such election, Voya Retirement Insurance and Annuity Company has certified to the completeness and accuracy of all investments and related investment activity and notes receivable from participants and related activity in the accompanying statement of net assets available for benefits as of December 31, 2024 and 2023, the statement of changes in net assets available for benefits for the year ended December 31, 2024 and the accompanying supplemental schedule of assets (held at end of year) as of December 31, 2024.

4. Tax status

The Plan has adopted a Non - Standardized Plan sponsored by Legacy Retirement Solutions LLC. On June 30, 2020, the Internal Revenue Service ("IRS") stated in an opinion letter that the prototype adopted by the Plan, as then designed, was in compliance with applicable requirements of the Internal Revenue Code ("IRC") and therefore, the related trust is exempt from taxation. The Plan has been amended since receiving the letter. However, the Plan administrator believes that the Plan is currently designed and being operated in compliance with the applicable requirements of the IRC. Therefore, the Plan administrator believes that the Plan is qualified and the related trust is tax-exempt.

5. Plan termination

Although it has not expressed any intent to do so, the Company has the right under the Plan to discontinue its contributions at any time and to terminate the Plan subject to the provisions of ERISA. In the event of Plan termination, participants are 100% vested in their accounts.

6. Parties-in-interest

Certain assets of the Plan are invested with and valued by the Insurance Company, which are considered parties-in-interest as a provider of administrative investment management and accounting services to the funds. These transactions are exempt from the prohibited transaction rules.

7. Risks and uncertainties

In the normal course of business, all of the Plan's assets are transacted with and held by the Insurance Company. The Plan is subject to credit risk to the extent the Insurance Company is unable to fulfill contractual obligations on their behalf. The Company has not experienced and does not anticipate any losses from this arrangement.

The Plan invests in various investments. Investments are exposed to various risks such as interest rates, market and credit risks. Due to the level of risk associated with certain investments, it is at least reasonably possible that changes in the values of investments will occur in the near term and that such changes could materially affect the participants' account balances and the amounts reported in the statements of net assets available for benefits.

The Plan's exposure to a concentration of credit risk is limited by the diversification of investments across participant-directed fund elections. Additionally, the investments within each participant-directed fund are further diversified into varied instruments.

Volatility in the financial markets may significantly impact the subsequent valuation of the Plan's investments. Accordingly, the valuation of the investments at December 31, 2024 may not necessarily be indicative of amounts that could be realized in a current market exchange.

8. Subsequent events

The Plan has evaluated subsequent events through August 26, 2025, the date the financial statements were available to be issued.
