To Whom It May Concern:

I am submitting this late Form 5500-SF filing for the Cross & Black, Inc. 401(k) Retirement Plan and respectfully request penalty relief for late filing due to reasonable cause.

On March 19, 2025, the plan's owner and administrator, John L. Zarnick, passed away unexpectedly. Mr. Zarnick's passing caused an immediate and prolonged disruption in business operations, including the management and administration of the company's retirement plan. At the time of his death, no transition arrangements, successor administrator appointment, or guidance for plan administration had been established.

As his son and successor, I, Mark L. Zarnick, was required to assume responsibility for Cross & Black, Inc. and its retirement plan operations. This required:

- Taking ownership of the company and navigating probate and estate matters;
- Coordinating with Paychex to transfer plan administrative authority;
- Completing all documentation necessary to become Plan Administrator, which was not finalized until mid-fall 2025;
- Reconstructing plan records and learning required federal filing obligations without prior transition support;
- Attempting to engage our accountant, who was unable to provide guidance or assistance with the necessary filings.

Due to these circumstances and the administrative burden caused by the unexpected death of the plan administrator, the Form 5500-SF could not be filed by the deadline. As soon as administrative control was obtained and I understood the filing requirements, I completed the filing to the best of my ability and am submitting it now.

The late filing was not the result of willful neglect. The delay was solely the result of the death of the plan administrator, the transition of responsibility, and the time required to gain access, obtain records, and understand the filing obligations. All efforts have been made to bring the plan into full compliance as promptly as possible.

I respectfully request that any penalties be waived on the basis of reasonable cause under these circumstances.
